

APEC Travel Card: OK for USA

The American Chamber of Commerce in Thailand, as the voice of U.S. business in Thailand, Myanmar, and Laos, has been a strong supporter of the United States' participation in the APEC Business Travel Card (ABTC) program and applauds the Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) decision to allow American business travelers access to such program. The card gives frequent business travelers pre-cleared, facilitated short-term entry to participating APEC member economies, saving them valuable time at immigration points in APEC member countries. Please note that for U.S. citizens the APEC Business Travel Card does not eliminate the need to have a valid visa for countries that require U.S. citizen business travelers to have a visa.


For several years, the card had been available to citizens of every APEC economy except the United States and Canada; however after an "interim final rule" published by DHS, the U.S. government has begun to issue APEC Business Travel Cards (ABTC) to qualified U.S. travelers since June 12, 2014.

In order for a person to obtain an ABTC, the applicant must comply with the following criteria:

- The person must be a U.S citizen.
- After login to the Global Online Enrollment System (GOES), the person must self-certify that he/she is:
- An existing member in good standing of a U.S. Custom and Border Protection (CBP) trusted traveler program (such as Global Entry) or that the person has submitted an application to a CBP trusted travel program (which may be done concurrently);
- A "verified" U.S. business person, or a U.S. government official, engaged in business in the APEC region. According to the ABTC regulations, a "verified business person" engaged in APEC business is defined as a person engaged in the trade of goods, the provision of services, or the conduct of investment activities;
- Not a professional athlete, news correspondent, entertainer, musician, artist or person engaged in a similar occupation, as these professions would not fall under the program's definition of a "verified business person."





If the applicant is able to comply with these criteria, then upon completion of the GOES online application, which includes a US \$70 application fee, and submission of an electronic signature at a CBP Global Entry Enrollment Center, the CBP will mail the applicant's completed card to the address provided in the GOES account.

In order for a U.S. business person to apply for a Trusted Traveler program, the applicant must schedule an appointment and physically appear at a designated CBP office in the U.S. Given that Trusted Traveler appointments often cannot be done in conjunction with planned travel to the U.S. due to appointment scheduling difficulties, it becomes difficult for U.S. business travelers, who are stationed in Thailand, Myanmar, and Laos, to apply. If a U.S. business person is already enrolled to a Trusted Traveler program, the enrollment centers where it is possible for the applicant to submit his/her electronic signature for the ABTC application are located only in the U.S, thus creating a major inconvenience.

Hence, in the interest of maximizing the number of interested individuals who are able to obtain the APEC Business Travel Card promptly, AMCHAM Thailand is encouraging DHS to collaborate with the U.S. Embassies and Consulates in Asia-Pacific, as well as with the respective American Chambers of Commerce, to find ways to schedule Trusted Traveler appointments outside the United States, either on a regular basis or around major U.S. regional business events such as the annual meeting of the Asia-Pacific Council of American Chambers of Commerce (APCAC). The Chamber is also urging CBP and relevant institutions to make it possible for current Trusted Traveler members to have their electronic signatures collected overseas, so as to minimize the inconvenience for Trusted Traveler members of having to travel to the U.S. to complete their APEC Business Travel Card application.

The idea for the Train Crawl was first mooted as a successor to the Jungle Pub Crawl held in 2012, followed by the Bus Crawl in 2013. The name was derived from the famous Sixties TV western, 'The Wild Wild West' featuring the adventures of two US Secret Service agents traversing the West on their luxury train. Hence, the concept of merging a train ride with a hash pub crawl, where participants follow a paper trail leading from pub to pub, was born.



Preparation for the event began months ahead with the Organising Committee ascertaining the feasibility of procuring tickets for 3 KTM ETS (Electric Train Service) coaches from Kuala Lumpur to Tanjong Malim to Ipoh. Everyone in the organizing as well as the working committee were strenuously briefed on their respective roles.

19:00 CIRCLE, and refreshment.

20:00 ON ON “Chinese Food” at Bungaraya Restaurant.

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Tucson H3's Tour de Tucson

The jHavelina Hash House Harriers were started in 1994 as a family-friendly hash. Throughout the years, it has grown and morphed into an adult-only kennel with over 347 members. The jHavelina run weekly trails as well as full moons throughout Tucson and surrounding Sonoran desert. If you want shiggy, we can accommodate you. If you like roadworthy trails, we have that too. There are only 2 erected positions for mismanagement, with most positions being filled on a volunteer basis.

Hash de Tucson was started in 1998 by Communicable Disease. The GM was Cheetah and the RA was Chief Shitting Bullshit. It originally ran in both the Spring and Fall, but started being a once-yearly even while Cavity Search was GM.

Hash de Tucson is a day-long event, starting with a themed pub crawl on Friday evening which starts from the hotel. Our hares will lead us on a 4-6 mile adventure, stopping in at various pubs and bars for fun and beer.

Saturday is when the real fun starts. This is an endurance event, consisting of four back-to-back trails of 4-7 miles each, for a full day total of 16 to 20 miles. Most legs offer both an Eagle and Turkey trail. Trails begin at 10 am, and then start at 12 Noon, 2 and 4 PM. One leg begins where the last leg ended. Participants are able to run all four legs, or pick and choose the legs they want to run. A shuttle service is available to pick up hashers at the hotel and take them to the next trail start point.

There is a short circle between each leg where trail crimes are brought to light. Between legs 2 and 3 there is also a catered lunch break. The event ends with a regular circle where all crimes throughout all 4 legs are brought to light. We have even done namings at the final circle. Shortly after circle, there is a catered meal where everyone can get their fill and share the good times.

This is the 20th anniversary year for the Jhavelina Hash House Harriers. This year's Hash de Tucson will be hared by many of our original or long-term members. The founders and former GMs will be honored at the final circle before dinner.

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
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
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
HASHERS STRANDED OVERNIGHT ON MOUNTAINTOP A GUAMAZING TRUE TRAIL ADVENTURE

So, there we were, eighteen hashers stuck on the upper slope of a mountain, well past dark, unable to scale the steep and slippery slope back to the top, incapable of climbing down the sheer cliff face leading to the bottom, shivering in the frigid rain, huddling tightly together to stay warm, clinging to roots and clumps of sword grass to keep from sliding to our doom, dehydrated and out of water, waiting to be rescued, and wondering whatever became of the poor bastard who fell over the cliff a few hours ago. A well respected local hasher put us into this predicament trying to be helpful by telling the pack of a much safer way down from the mountain in the dark, only he had his mountains mixed up and actually gave the pack the worst directions in hash history. Oh, if only I hadn't visited Guam! If only that fool hadn't directed the pack off true trail! If only the pack hadn't listened! And, if only we had a rope and a grappling hook with which to climb to safety! But, I did, he did, they did, and we didn't. At least Guam Fire Rescue was on the way and would soon save us, because they must be experts at this sort of thing... right?



Then, the phone rang. The emergency dispatcher was calling us back! We were saved! There was probably a helicopter already on the way by now, right? Wrong. “Good news!” she said, “Guam Fire Rescue already has two teams on their way up Mount Schroeder to find you.” By this point, we had figured out roughly where we were, and though we didn’t know the name of the mountain, we knew it damn well wasn’t Mount Schroeder. Besides, that joke had already been told to us by the veteran hasher on the peak a few hours ago. The irony of hearing the same joke again wasn’t lost on us but somehow the joke no longer seemed funny. Then, she asked where we had parked our vehicles, so that the Fire Rescue team could start there and then make their way to our location. That joke wasn’t funny either. We explained that our vehicles were miles away and told her straight up that the fastest way to reach us was to proceed directly to the GPS coordinates that we had already given her earlier. She hung up to talk to Guam Fire Rescue again and promised to call us back soon. It was around this time that we began to see flashlights making their way up from the ravine far below, but they appeared to be climbing a completely different peak across from the one on which we had made camp. Let the games begin.

Seriously, we started playing word games to pass the time, having now come to the realization that we might be in for a very very long night. From time to time we flashed our flashlights towards the other mountain and the lights slowly making their way up, which were now about a kilometer away from us. They seemed to acknowledge our presence, but we had no way of knowing if these were other hashers, Guam Fire Rescue, or just some locals with a passion for mountain climbing at night who were now probably wondering who the idiots were having the late night rave party on the next peak over from theirs. We didn’t really care, as long as they brought us water and a way to climb out of our predicament. Over the course of the next hour we watched the lights




move upwards, finally reaching the ridgeline that extended between the two peaks.

Then, the phone rang again. The emergency dispatcher was calling us back. Were we saved? Was there finally a helicopter on it's way? No. "Good news!" she said, "Guam Fire Rescue knows where you are, and they have two teams trying to get to your location from two different directions." Well, at least this seemed to be progress, and hopefully whichever team was approaching from the direction of the cliff would find the remains of the anonymous hasher who had fallen to his death, pull his corpse from the tree, give him a decent burial, and inform his next of kin. And, at least the rain had finally stopped. Huzzah.

One of the mystery lights began to move along the ridgeline in our direction, while the others stayed behind. Who were they? Why had they split up? More importantly, how were we going to deal with the hares and the veteran hasher once we finally got down from this fucking mountain? A general consensus had formed around the idea of taking turns punching them in the face, followed by biblical crucifixion, then castration, and finally a good old-fashioned bonfire to warm our bones while doing away with the evidence. However, there were some who favored taking turns kicking them in the balls and then using a series of special branding irons featuring all of our hash names. This idea too had its merits.

Then, the phone rang again. The emergency dispatcher was calling us back. We weren't saved. There was no helicopter. She was calling to tell us something else. "Good news!" she said, "Guam Fire Rescue has reported that they found a group of individuals and helped them down from the mountain. So, I'm just calling to confirm that you have, in fact, been rescued at this time." Time froze for a moment. We were incredulous. The hasher holding the phone gave the best possible



answer, “No ma’am. As a matter of fact, I can confirm for you that we are SUPER NOT RESCUED at this time! Are you kidding me?!” She was not kidding, though if she had been, it would have actually been a better joke than her previous attempts. Guam Fire Rescue had apparently found the half dozen hashers who set out on their own from our little camp earlier, along with multiple others still on true trail and slowly making their way down the rocky ravine.

The mystery light continued along the ridgeline, and eventually it made its way to the peak above us. “Hello down there! How many are you?!” the light called out into the night. “There are eighteen of us!” we yelled back. “Do you need help?!” the light asked. “Yes, we need help!” we yelled back at what now suddenly seemed to be the stupidest light in the fucking universe, “We can’t climb down to reach the ravine, and we can’t climb up to get back to the ridgetop!” What the hell? Did this light think we had simply paused to have a midnight picnic in the rain on the side of a fucking mountain? “Okay, we’ll come down to you! We have a rope and some water!” the incredibly wonderful and courageous light responded. This was now our favorite light in the history of ever.

A short while later, two hashers had found a way to climb down to us, and we eagerly passed around the few bottles of water that they had managed to bring with them. Those precious sips of water were like a miracle tonic to all us poor dehydrated souls. We also passed around some small packets containing the most delicious gummy bears on earth. As the sugar and water hit our systems, we suddenly felt like we might actually have just enough energy left within us to climb our way out of this little slice of hell. Our new guides showed us the way to where they had placed the rope. It was extremely slippery and tough going, but we forced our tired limbs back into action, once again crawling up the mountainside by holding on to fistfuls of sword grass. Getting up the rope was a bitch, and halfway up I made the mistake of

glancing down. Holy fucking shit. How had we ever managed to get down there? What's more, how did we not slide right off this mountain, bounce like pinballs through those trees, and shoot one by one right over the cliff lurking down there in the darkness?

All of us finally made it to the top, where we collapsed along the ridgeline for a few minutes to catch our breath before continuing. There, I saw my first Guam Fire Rescue member. It was like seeing a Sasquatch or the Loch Ness Monster for the first time. I tell you truly though, they do exist! He didn't have a rope for us, or any water, or food, or extra flashlights, or anything of any use whatsoever. But he was definitely real.

We started making our way down the ridge back to the point where we first left true trail six hours earlier. It was 1:30 in morning, and we were all damned ready to get off this mountain. We had to slide on our butts again to get down the steepest parts, being careful not to fall off the ridge to the left or to the right. As our butts slid over the mix of mud, rocks, and sword grass, those who wore lycra shorts that day learned a valuable lesson. Lycra does indeed make your ass look amazing, but it leaves a hell of a lot to be desired in any survival scenario. After sliding for about 200 meters, we were finally back on true trail! Huzzah!

I'll gloss over the details of how we got the rest of the way down. That's not to say that it wasn't grueling. It was. There was a lot more butt sliding. There were rocks to climb down. There was mud that was ankle deep. There were two more Guam Fire Rescue members waiting at the top of the ravine, similarly unencumbered by anything of any use to us whatsoever. They told us that they had been carrying some bottles of water earlier, but they had already given them to the other hashers that they found before we came along. Once in the ravine, we made our way down the waterway, climbing, sliding, jumping, and wading to get



through the water and the rocks with roughly one flashlight for every three hashers. At one point, we had to take turns rappelling down a waterfall on a rope. Eventually though, we made it to the bottom, where another group of considerate hashers were waiting for us with a case of water and some snacks. God bless you, fellow hashers!

Another thunderstorm rolled through as we were making our way down that ravine, and this one rained much harder than the first. We didn't care though. It helped to wash away some of the dirt and grime that was caked to every surface of our bodies, and it took away some of the sting from the hundreds of cuts that the sword grass had inflicted upon our legs, arms, and butts. Not one pair of shorts survived the evening intact. So please, raise a glass to the shorts that died that day, especially the poor lycra.

EPILOGUE — TL/DR

We started trail around 1700, we were directed off true trail around 1915, our rescuers arrived around midnight, we all managed to climb back up to the ridge by 0130, and by the time we all reached the trail's end it was close to 0330. The hasher who fell off the cliff lost one of his shoes and bruised some ribs, but fortunately that was all. He estimated that he probably fell/slid about 80 feet down the mountain, with one good bounce about halfway down. Nobody knows how the story about the tree and the broken leg got started. He was able to crawl down the rest of the way, until some hashers found him and helped him to the end of the trail while we were still enjoying our camping trip on the mountainside. In the end everyone made it off the mountain alive and relatively intact, somewhat miraculously given everything that could have gone wrong and very nearly did.

Thanks to the Agana H3 for the most insane and memorable hashing experience of my lifetime. And, thanks for rescuing our sorry asses off that fucking mountain. I've left out people's names and a few other



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details to protect the innocent and the guilty alike. Everyone involved that night properly atoned for their sins at the following week's hash. No further persecution is warranted, and there are no hard feelings. There is no 10% truth rule in effect here either. Everything really happened, pretty much as I've laid it down for you to read. The details may not be 100% accurate, but they're the best I could manage without sending myself into fits of PTSD.

This story got into the local papers, and somehow the tale became twisted into 79 hikers saved by Guam Fire Rescue. Every damn one of us who were on that mountain know who really saved us though, our fellow hashers. The local media tried to interview several local hashers to get the full story, but they are keeping quiet. The kennel doesn't want or need any negative publicity in the press. I've written this account for my personal friends and for hashers to share with hashers. If you copy this story to share somewhere else, I ask that you respect the wishes of the Agana H3 and keep it limited to private hasher forums only.

tropical waterborne pathogen that gets into waterways from the urine of infected animals, where it can then easily get into any cuts in the skin, of which I had about a hundred that night. Apparently, at least six other hashers who were on the trail with me are also being treated for this nasty infection. Hash trail from hell, it's the gift that keeps on giving!

That is 100% for real, true, and accurate. Fortunately, I went to the emergency room before my infection advanced to the stage of liver damage, kidney failure, and internal bleeding within the lungs. This leptospirosis stuff is no joke!

POST SCRIPT

It's now been two weeks since the trail from hell, and 14 days is the ideal incubation time for leptospirosis, which I now have. This was confirmed by the doctors in the emergency room this morning, where I went to ask why I felt like I was dying. It turns out that it was because I was dying, or at least I could have died if I hadn't gone in for treatment. Leptospirosis is a

CORR STONE A CROWS

Researchers for the Ministry of Transport found over 200 dead crows near greater Manchester recently, and there was concern that they may have died from Avian Flu. 



A teddy bear is working on a building site. He goes for a tea break and when he returns he notices his pick has been stolen. The bear is angry and reports the theft to the foreman.





