For those of us from Nebraska Kennels who like to do a little "Road-Tripping" to some of the bigger events, the most common question we always get from other hashers is always "There's hashing in Nebraska?". **The answer is ABSOLUTELY!!!**

So what kennels does Nebraska have to offer? Well hashing in Nebraska (as far as our foggy beer laden memories can recall) started back in June of 1996 with the inaugural running of the Omaha H3 in Omaha Nebraska. Several years later in 2000 Lincoln Nebraska took a stab at it with a short lived running of the Prick of the Prairie H3 (Named for the wonderful nickname for the state capitol building in Lincoln Nebraska). Though it did not last, just a year later in October of 2001 the Lincoln H3 was founded. Hashing on opposite weekends and only a stone's throw away from Omaha H3, this opened up the doorway to hash every weekend! In 2007, folks outside the Omaha/Lincoln area felt left out and the Columbus H3 was founded in Columbus Nebraska. Subsequent years have also seen the res-erection of the Prick of the Prairie H3 in Lincoln, and the founding of the OSO H3 in Omaha.

In addition every once in a while you can find a Dark Side of the Full Moon H3 hash in Omaha, or when our hasher's kids (we call them terror's!) want in on the action we occasionally have a Children of the Corn H3 hash (kid run, kid hared, kid friendly!)

So what do all these kennels have to offer? Here's some info about the active hashes in Nebraska: Omaha H3 is a 3-5 mile trail with 2-3 beer checks, they like their pub crawls as well and that has gotten them the unofficial tagline of "More Beer Checks Than Miles On Trail!!!" It hashes bi-weekly on Saturdays. OSO H3 was founded to put more focus on the "Running" aspect of hashing and traditionally enjoys 5-7 mile trails once to twice a month, usually on Saturdays. Lincoln H3 generally offers 3-5 mile trails with a good mix of shiggy and pavement. It hashes bi-weekly on opposite weekends of Omaha H3. Prick of the Prairie H3 is a "Hares Choice" kennel that runs once a month on whatever day the hare for the month chooses. It offers varying length trails.

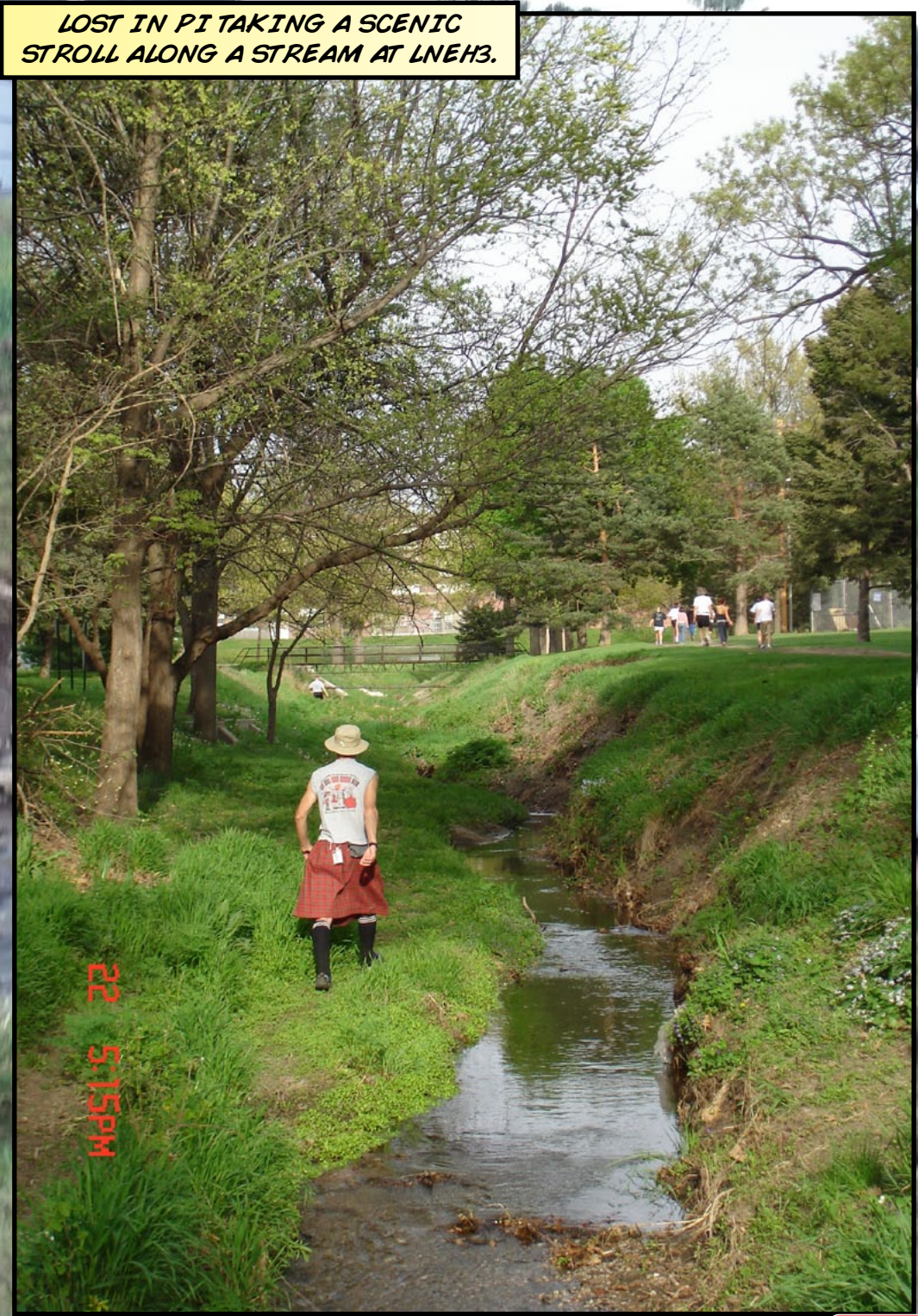

When it comes to events, Nebraska hashers traditionally get together and participate in them as a group. We celebrate many themes throughout the year to include: World Peace Through Beer, Red Dress (hosted in Lincoln Nebraska around the University of Nebraska's Memorial Stadium during a Husker home game), Green Dress (hosted by Omaha H3), Blue Dress Hash (to celebrate Monica Lewinsky's Birthday), Wedding Dress Hash (for the wedding anniversary of one of the Lincoln H3 founders), Hash-A-Thon, the 12 Down-Downs of Hashmas, and summer and winter camp outs.

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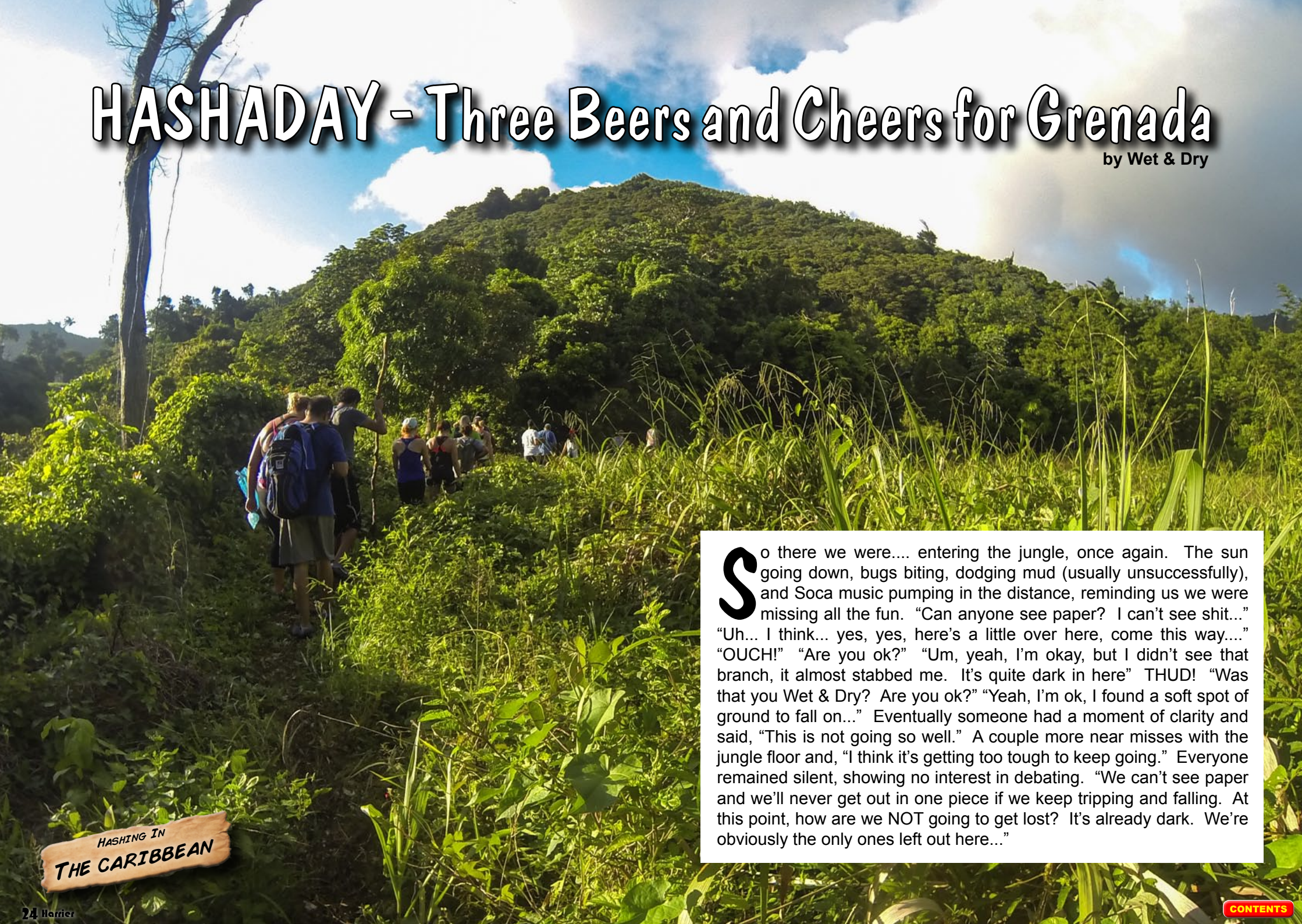

HASHADAY - Three Beers and Cheers for Grenada

So there we were.... entering the jungle, once again. The sun going down, bugs biting, dodging mud (usually unsuccessfully), and Soca music pumping in the distance, reminding us we were missing all the fun. “Can anyone see paper? I can’t see shit...” “Uh... I think... yes, yes, here’s a little over here, come this way...” “OUCH!” “Are you ok?” “Um, yeah, I’m okay, but I didn’t see that branch, it almost stabbed me. It’s quite dark in here” THUD! “Was that you Wet & Dry? Are you ok?” “Yeah, I’m ok, I found a soft spot of ground to fall on...” Eventually someone had a moment of clarity and said, “This is not going so well.” A couple more near misses with the jungle floor and, “I think it’s getting too tough to keep going.” Everyone remained silent, showing no interest in debating. “We can’t see paper and we’ll never get out in one piece if we keep tripping and falling. At this point, how are we NOT going to get lost? It’s already dark. We’re obviously the only ones left out here...”

HASHING IN
THE CARIBBEAN

Dammit! Why are you yawning? I was trying to come up with an interesting opening paragraph, but knowing you all, it probably isn't the attention grabbing paragraph I had hoped for. Only "normal" people would find that adventurous, interesting or out of the ordinary. You all are dumb-assed hashers who enjoy doing this stuff regularly. You're just sitting there thinking "Ho hum, sounds like a typical hashing day to me." Ok then, let me try again to make this more interesting....

We were hashing in Grenada. If you don't know where that is and you're too lazy to check Google Earth, it's a small, 133 square mile, Caribbean island north of Venezuela, as in South America. I had always wanted to visit Grenada, and that was long before I began my hashing career. But about a year ago, I "discovered" the Grenada H3's Facebook page and started monitoring it to get a feel as to what was going on down there. One day, and I can't quote it exactly, but someone commented, "About 500 people at the hash today. That's possibly one of our biggest hashes yet!" Whuh... whuh... WHAT? Ya mean, 500 for a typical weekly hash? And so, with interest piqued, I went to Grenada.

The GH3 hashes every Saturday or as they call it “Hashaday.” I attended runs #847 and #848, and had a monster of a time. Upon arrival, you sign in and pay 2 Eastern Caribbean Dollars (2 EC is about 75 cents) and socialize while a few hundred or so others arrive. Beer is available before the run, and although you have to pay for your beer (Carib and Stag), it is quite cheap. 3 Caribs (or Stags) are sold for 10 EC (about \$3.70 USD). Soon a DJ arrives, unloads his system and starts playing party music. Since this is Grenada, Soca is often played. At 4 pm (they start rather promptly as they want everyone back by dark), everyone with new shoes is called forward. The GM, AC/DC, tells them the worthiness of their shoes must be tested and beer is poured into the new shoes and they drink their down down.

The hares then give a quick “chalk talk,” to include runner/walker splits, and before you can shout “On On!” you ARE On On! This is where I should tell you, Grenada is a very hilly island. I mean very hilly. Don’t be thinking it’s like that flat-assed Barbados or whatever those flat, boring islands to the north are named. Mount Saint Catherine, a stratovolcano, at 2760 feet (850 m), is Grenada’s highest peak, and don’t be thinking that’s the only hill around either. There are six hills over 1500 feet peaks and a total of 14 peaks on the island according to peakery.com. Obviously they are not the highest peaks in the world, but when the elevation is accompanied by Caribbean heat and humidity, the hills seem to double in height. The Grenada H3 embraces tough, shiggy filled trails. You will be sweaty and dirty at the end. Both runs had runner/walker splits, with walker trails being shorter in length, but not necessarily less shiggy or flatter. On both runs the hares did a terrific job. We hashed in a town, on a beach, up many hills, splashed in a waterfall, viewed scenic overlooks, crossed water, mud surfed and bush whacked. What can be finer?



Trails are “A to A” and everyone checks back in at the end so no one is out in the rain forest after dark... well except for me and two others, almost. We came close to spending the night in the jungle (see paragraph 1), but we managed to find our way back to “A,” and of course, DFL (dead fu\$*ing last). Upon our arrival, all on going circle festivities were promptly suspended and we became the new center of attention. After proposing a defense for our tardiness, we were ignored (of course). We were “punished” with down downs and an extra special bonus of a shower of at least five Caribs exploding on us all at once. Other than the alcohol burning my eyes, it felt quite nice.

Since I wasn’t DFL on the second run, I was able to experience more post run fun and games during Run #848. Due to the large number of hashers, circle was fairly short, but virgins were given special attention they always deserve. At this run, there were fifty virgins. FIFTY! I was told that was typical. Because of the Med School, a healthy expat community, a large number of “yatchies,” and webpages that encourage Grenada tourists to go hashing, there are always plenty of virgins. They were called up in front of AC/DC, who informed them they are no longer considered virgins among this prestigious group. He read a proclamation, from a certificate they would soon receive. It was rather long so I’ll be brief, “we just put your throw hell and you smell like a ram goat. Congratulations on the loss of your virginity!”

Immediately after that, the virgins were thoroughly dosed in a shower of beer and given their Certificates of Loss of Virginity. And then, we adjourned to much rejoicing. The Soca was turned up and there was much dancing, drinking and laughing in the cool Caribbean evening. All is well until... some poor, innocent hashers decided to get in their car and drive home. (Say it isn’t so!!)

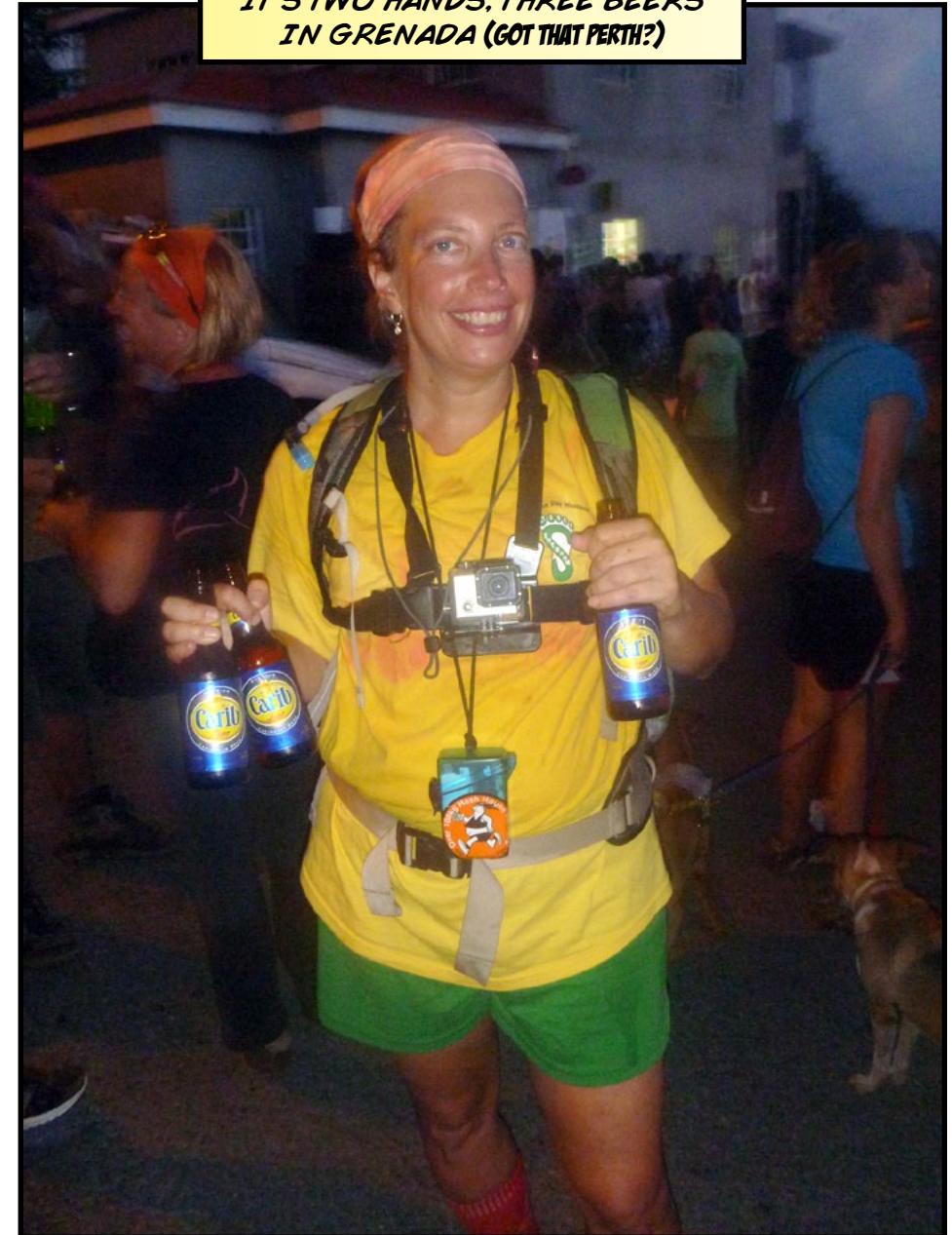

**IT'S TWO HANDS, THREE BEERS
IN GRENADA (GOT THAT PERTH?)**

Because of the large crowd, the parties are often held in the street, nearby hashers' parked cars. When some decides to leave, they have to drive through the throng of partiers before they can make their way home. You try to drive home through a party of two hundred hashers. Picture the possibilities. You know the hashers won't just smile, make a hole and let you drive on (on). I'll leave it at that!

There are four things that I really love about the GH3. The first was three beers for 10 EC. Call me goofy, but even if you're really, really thirsty, you can only hold two beers comfortably. What better to do with that third beer than pass it on to a needy hasher? Is there a better way to spread good will and make friends among the hash? The second was how simple the logistics were even though there were a few hundred in attendance weekly. The hares volunteer to set a run, choose the run site and ask a local rum shop (think neighborhood bar) owner if he wants to host the hash. If they're willing, they're asked to stock at least 40 cases of beer (a mix of Carib and Stag), organize some locals to cook up some food because the hash was coming to their town! Oh yeah, and find a DJ! They may also ask the rum shop owner for some information to help them set the trail. When Hashaday comes (that's what they call it), the hashers show up, have their run, food, drink, and dance, while the locals enjoy the proceeds of the party. The third was of course the hashers themselves. Everyone was so kind and didn't hesitate to offer up world class hashpitality. Two Shits and Monkey Business really displayed their love for all things hashing and don't hesitate to show hashers a great time. That said, the only thing I have left to add, number four, is it's my humble self-centered opinion Grenada would make a TERRIFIC location for a future InterAmericas Hash (IAH). Wink, wink, nudge, nudge.



The Grenada H3 was founded in 1985 by Paul “Rigor Mortis” Slinger by way of the Trinidad and Tobago H3. If you can handle the math, that means the GH3 will be having its 30th anniversary next fall.

The Grenada H3 is On On every Saturday (Hashaday) at 4 p.m. Run locations can be found by “friending” the Grenada Hash House Harriers on Facebook or by visiting their regularly updated website: www.grenadahash.com. Run locations are throughout the island. Transportation to/from run sites can be obtained via island bus, taxi or by coordinating via Facebook site “SGU Hash Bus.”

Hashers “Monkey Business” manages the Cabier Ocean Lodge, <http://www.cabier-vision.com>, located about 45 minutes from St. Georges airport (GND). I stayed there and highly recommend it and the extra special bonus is Monkey Business is a wonderful French trained chef! If you want to eat terrific food and laze around listening to pounding surf and Caribbean breezes, this is the place! The Petit Anse Hotel is owned and operated by “Grandad.” Unfortunately I wasn’t able to visit, but from their website, <http://www.petiteanse.com>, there’s no reason to believe the Petit Anse looks absolutely marvelous.

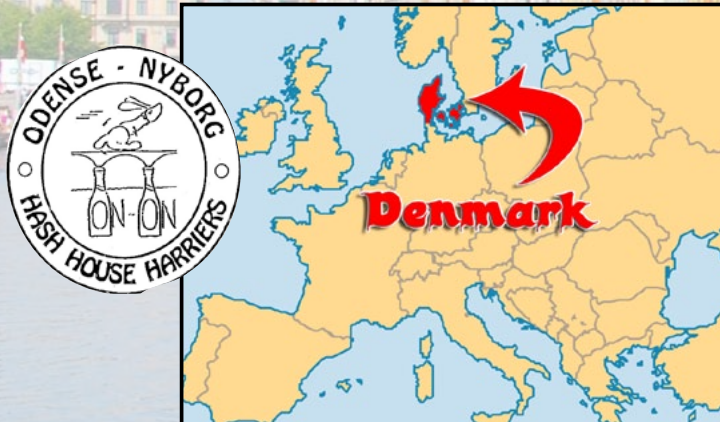

It is characteristic for ONH3 that we supplement the standard Hash songs with a large number of our own songs for each occasion, as an example a DOWN-DOWN song for P.O.T. (tune: Jingle Balls):

VIETNAM NASH HASH

NHA TRANG, 24-26 OCT 14

In an effort to bring Vietnam's Hashes together on a regular basis, Nha Trang H3 in a moment of drunken inspiration/stupidity made a decision to resurrect Vietnam Nash Hash. As Mekong Indochina Hash was to be held in Thailand on 31st Oct. it was thought a prelude the weekend before might be a good idea for those already in the region. Even given the late announcement, 74 Hashers fronted from across the country and overseas and were given a bloody good time.

Sign-on at the NTH3 sponsors, Watering Hole Bar and Patricks Wine Bar got the ball rolling and well lubricated by the time the Welcome Dinner at Patricks kicked off. 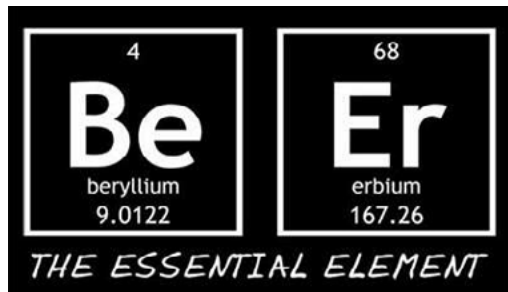
MR CHURCHILLS FULL TEXT FROM 1890

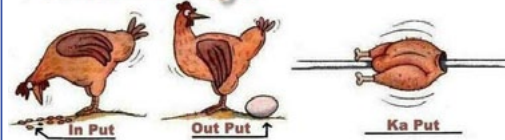

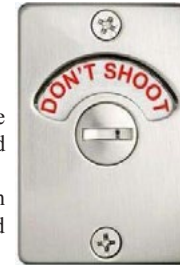

The Absolut Hash runs every other Saturday afternoon at 15.00 (14.00 during Nov, Dec, Jan.) usually from someone's home and there is always food and beer served after the runs at a cost of 70 SEK. The run length could be anything from 50 minutes to 2 hours., depending on who is haring.

THE FULL MOON BERSERKERS HASH

Founded in the Autumn of 1994 by Malibog, the Full Moon Berserkers is for those who think running a longer distance is more fun..... Besides it builds up more of a thirst for drinking beer. The runs are approx. 10 to 12 K. long and can be BYOB, from a pub or someone's home..



UNDERGROUND HASH HOUSE HARRIERS

In the Summer of 1994 some of the Harriettes thought that the Absolut Hash was a bit too family oriented and that they should start a Hash more geared to beer drinking and pubbing, and thus the Underground Hash was born. The UH3 runs every Wednesday evening at 18.30 from a pub near You. The run length should be about 1 to 1½ hrs (with beer stops to slow things up).
