We regret to finally announce that the Pan Africa Hash 2015 in Freetown, Sierra Leone, has fallen victim to the Ebola Virus Disease Pandemic in West Africa. After monitoring the situation over the last few months, we have come to the conclusion that it will not be possible to host the PAH in 2015. While there are hopeful signs of getting the EVD under control in some of the worst hit districts in the country the situation in Freetown proper and the surrounding Western Area and a few other districts are still not safe.

So far we have more than 160 registrations for the PAH2015.

We propose the following:

The Freetown HHH will host the PAH 2017. We keep the registrations we received for the Freetown PAH 2015. For hashers who will not be able to come in 2017 we will make arrangements to sell registrations as soon as new registrations come in. For those, who wish to withdraw immediately we will reimburse the registration fee at 90% minus the cost of money transfer. This is because we have already spent money on preparations and promotional activities.

This opens up the opportunity for other African HHH kernels to step in to host the PAH2015 at a suitable time in 2015.

We regret the inconveniences and ask all hashers to bear with us.

1 On 15-17 July, **Euro Hash** will be hosted in the charming Polish town of Krakow, located at the foot of the Carpathian Mountains. Dating back to the 7th century, the historic centre of Krakow boasts a rich variety of architecture, including Renaissance, Gothic and Baroque buildings and has been designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Gothic Wawal Castle and Cathedral sit prominently on the hill overlooking the magnificent medieval town square, the largest in Europe. Trails will be through the beautiful forests, rivers and rolling hills around



Brussels 2014 is in the past and the European hashing community looks forward to five important events in 2015. The biannual events of Euro Hash, Interscandic and UK Nash Hash lead the way, whilst the annual German Nash Hash is always an efficiently mismanaged event. The quirky Full Moon Nash Hash, with some of the most fabulous RA's in the business, rounds off the top 5. Two smaller events off the beaten path are also recommended. If you fancy a European tour, 2015 could be a good year to pick an event and experience some European hashing.

the city. All this, along with the low price of beer, will bring a fabulous atmosphere. The venue for sleeping and partying will be at the University where the tourists will not bother the hashers. Krakow is well connected with direct flights from many European cities on budget airlines like Ryan Air and EasyJet. A Red Dress Run is planned for the Thursday before the event, with the money being raised going to a local charity. The sight of hundreds of hashers in Red Dresses running through the historic centre will be a great warm-up event for Euro Hash

2015. Don't despair, registration will reopen in January for a limited amount of additional spaces.

Top Hashing Events: Asia



The sport of Hashing started in Kuala Lumpur, Malaya in 1938 when a small group of expats took the children's game of "Hare and Hound" and altered it slightly to turn it into an amazingly adaptable sport that could be played by anyone and almost anywhere. The jungles and palm plantations around KL at the time were perfect hashing territory, providing a verdant playground for hashers.

Over the years, hashing spread from Kuala Lumpur to nearly every country in the world. Hash kennels are somewhat different from each other as there is no central governing body. There are even bicycle hashes, motorcycle hashes and kayak hashes, to name a few variations on the original running, hiking and walking origins of the Hash House Harriers.

Regional Hashes, including Pan Asia Hash, EuroHash and InterAmericas Hash are now held every other year on the odd number years. These regional events are a time when hashers from around the region and around the world join their friends for a few days of hash trails, eating and drinking and singing with their kindred souls.

Top Hashing Events: Americas

(including North, Central & South America)

The sport of hashing started in Asia and has spread all over the globe since its humble beginnings in 1938. Although precise numbers are difficult to come by, Asia reportedly has over 300 HHH kennels today, and Australia may have well over 200 chapters.

The Americas, including North America, Central America and South America, by some estimates has over 500 HHH kennels. The following are some of the Best HHH Events in the Americas in 2015, as nominated by our readers.



1 The biggest and possibly the best event in the Americas in 2015 will be InterAmericas Hash in Portland, Oregon over Labor Day weekend 4-7 September. InterAm 2015 “sold out” a year before the event and the official hash hotel was fully booked within a matter of hours after rooms were first available. There are several other hotels within walking distance of the main venue. Organizers are looking into opening up additional registrations but it is unlikely that the hundreds of hashers who would like to attend will be able to do so.

Portland boasts more microbreweries per capita than any other city in the world, according to InterAm sources. Four local breweries have come on board as InterAm Sponsors including Lompoc Brewing, BridgePort Brewing, Lagunitas Brewing and Deschutes Brewing

MADRAS (CHENNAI) - INDIA

HOW IT ALL BEGAN (23rd September, 1990)

A few months ago in Chennai, a film review of one of my father's movies, (reproduced in the "Hindu" newspaper) inspired me to extract all the reviews of his various films from the archives and share it on FB for those amongst us who were not aware, and refresh the memories of those who did. I was proud to be my father's son and all the more as I compiled this for FB.

Following this endeavor and the additional inspiration that always un-mysteriously appears through the downing of a 'few' vodkas, with some of the Thursday Night Hashers at "Bike and Barrel", I was compelled to write about the history of Hashing in Chennai and how it all started. Being the only founding member currently in Chennai of the Madras Hash House Harriers (MH3), I felt a distinct urge to share this piece of history for those

who did not know and to refresh the memories of those who did and were part of the first hash run at Chennai.

So, here goes...

It was the early 90s when major American oil companies like Chevron, Amoco and IPC from U.A.E came to drill for oil in the KG basin. There were support companies like Reading & Bates (Rig Owners), Schlumberger, Swire Pacific as well. They all came looking for the "mother lode" - Chevron, Amoco and IPC came one after the other and took up a whole floor as office space at the Park Sheraton Hotel. Naturally, the expatriate crowd came along with some of them staying at the hotel and most of them taking up houses at Boat Club and Kotturpuram areas.

During this period, Roop Chadda (who is now managing the Residency Towers Hotel) was then the Manager at Park Sheraton and he started "Cocktail Evenings" fortnightly at the hotel. With the liquor flowing during these get-togethers, it was not long before acquaintances were made, friendships forged and 'affairs' blossomed naturally within this community of expats and locals.

A bunch of people from this group, who were keen to include some physical activities (no pun intended here!), started playing Tennis in the evenings at the house of John Mulvey, who happened to have a tennis court behind his house (the lucky SOB). John M of course was a very generous soul who not only allowed us to play tennis but also provided the appropriate libations after the game. Sometimes, there was dinner as well, with his lovely Philipino wife cooking and serving us delicious "Gumbo". On Saturdays, it was volleyball at the IIT grounds.... followed by libation – what else. Not sure if anyone reading this probably assumes that it was an ongoing libation inspirations spree. One evening, after a game of tennis,

we were sitting around, with beers in hand, when the conversation turned towards doing something new and different in Chennai and out of the blue the suggestion came forth to start a “Hash club”.

Everybody nodded, not really knowing what it was all about (some were smiling in anticipation, assuming that it was the smokin’ kind). I must remind folks here that at that point of time, “Google” was non-existent.

Sunil Narang from BJ Hughes and Steve Ponman from Kone Elevators, who were animatedly leading the conversation, took it upon themselves to secure more information on the hash while the rest of us promising to support all the way to make it happen.

The first mis-management committee of the MH3 was then formed and the members were as follows:

- Sunil Narang (BJ Hughes) & Steve Ponman (Kone) - Joint Masters
- Larry Cohen – US consulate
- Wolfgang S – German Consulate
- Tim W – Private Co.
- Madhi Ramaswamy (ex. Arya Offshore. Current - Ericsson)
- Kimmo Lehtonen – Kone
- John Geddes – British Consulate

The seeds were sown for history to be made. John M, who was not keen on being a committee member, opened up his house for the regular committee meetings we had. Very soon the pace and enthusiasm started picking up as more and more information was pouring in.

The house of John M was located at S.N.Avenue, Boat Club (for the curious ones, I have given enough clues – try figuring it out) and we could say that this was the house where MH3 was born. I consider John M as a founding member as well simply because he was very much part of the initial conversation when the idea surfaced and ever since, participated in all the committee meetings giving us valuable inputs. The tennis court is no more and has been replaced by a concrete structure.

The search for sponsors for the first Hash was limited to Taj, Park Sheraton and Trident hotels out of choice and it was Sanjeev T – GM, Trident who welcomed us without the slightest hesitation, promising to host the first run and sponsor the whole event. The venue for the first MH3 run was confirmed as Trident hotel and the date was set for, 23rd September, 1990.

The committee members accorded themselves the privilege of wearing different T shirts from the rest of the first time hashers since we felt privileged to be starting off a new Hash in a new Location. (Nobody complained J – those were innocent times!) This would also explain why, in the pictures attached, you can see the committee members wearing orange Benetton T-shirts (which were not sponsored but bought from their show room at Nungambakkam High Road) as compared to the rest of the hashers wearing white T-shirts.

Canvassing for recruitment of members for the first run started in earnest and a lot of explaining had to be done on this seemingly new concept, to convince people to register and show up. Soon, we had quite a number registered for the first run.

On the fateful day, there was a big turn out for the first run and it turned out to be a tremendous success all the way.

I have not mentioned the names of all those who participated in the first run because I do not have the full list and obviously cannot remember each and everyone who turned up. This list is in a file somewhere with one of the GMs. So, it would not be fair to mention a few names and leave out some, but every member who participated, supported in their own way by spreading the word and recruiting members and made the event a huge success.

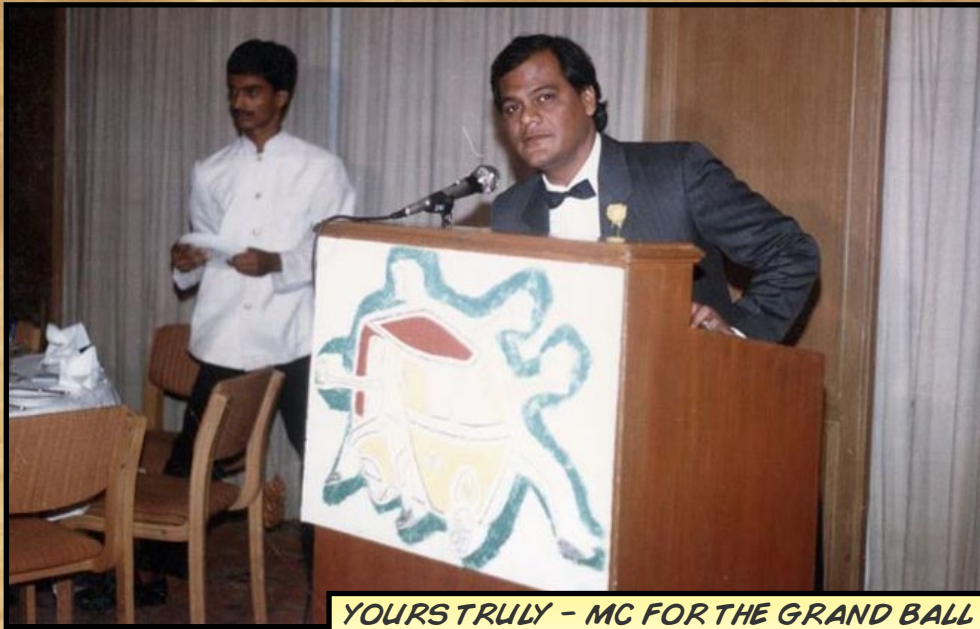
The run, as such, was from Trident all the way up St.Thomas Mount and back. Then it was the “down downs” followed by the partying accompanied by libations which went on till the early hours of the next day.

The MH3 brought a lot of people together in the subsequent runs and was very popular with some even suggesting it should be held twice a week. One of the highlights during the first year was being invited by the Columbo Hash for a relay run where MH3, Bangalore and Hyderabad Hash participated.

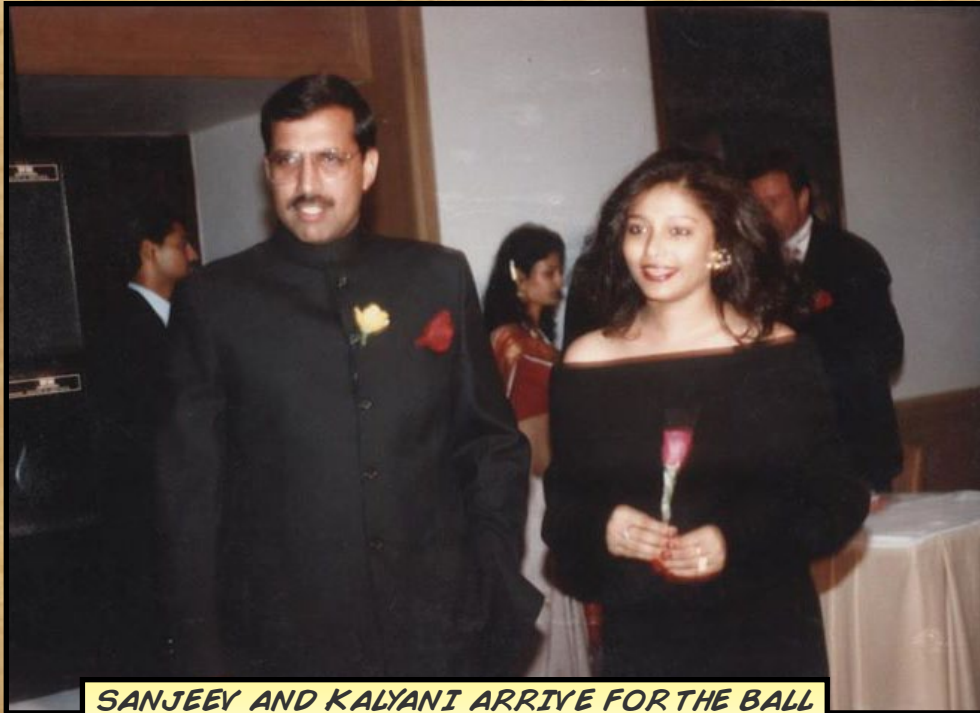
For the first anniversary of the MH3, we organized a formal Grand Ball at the Trident hotel which was an exciting way to celebrate completion of one year of hashing with MH3. We had an “Auto” drive into the Trident and parked it at the entrance of the Ball room. Silver Hash Mugs were presented to the first ‘mis’-management committee members as recognition of their contributions.

Thereafter, during the Grand Ball, Lord Krishna and John Geddes were handed over the responsibility to continue organizing and running the MH3 as Joint Masters. They did it with aplomb and one of the highlights during their tenure was to organize the 2nd Nash Hash in Chennai where Hashers from all over India participated.

So folks, this was how it all began and I must say, now when I see Madras (Chennai) having three thriving Hashes, that I am proud to have been part of the Hash History of Chennai by being a founding member of the first Hash - MH3.

POLAR CIRCLE MARATHON

The Polar Circle Marathon - often referred to as "the coolest marathon on earth" takes place in Kangerlussuaq, Greenland. The endless ice and arctic tundra of this vast country make up the backdrop of this unusual race, in which runners pass glacier tongues, moraine landscapes and the soundless, arctic desert. This is a rare opportunity to visit one of the most remote corners of the world combined with a challenging running event.

A part of the route takes place on the ice cap itself, but the main part of the course is run on the gravel road (often snow covered) that connects the inland ice with the small township of Kangerlussuaq, just north of the Polar Circle.

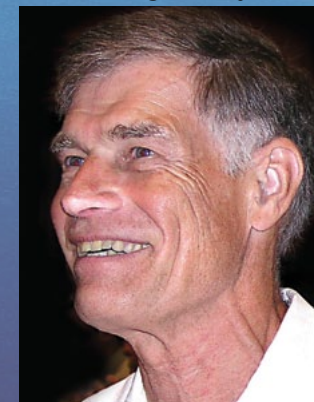

Conquer the Wall

As runners we have all encountered “the wall” during a marathon, and at times passing this invisible obstacle has seemed a daunting task. However in China organisers of the Great Wall Marathon have added the real wall, just to make your race day a bit more exciting.

Whether you are running a half or a full marathon you will be running on the Great Wall of China, and it is just as hard as it sounds, and bear in mind that the full marathon runners pass the wall twice. This is a real challenge and it is not a fluke that this particular race is on many Top 10 lists of races to try out in a lifetime.

The race starts in Tianjin province approximately 70 km from the capital, Beijing, and is being run for the 16th time in 2015, and with more than 2,500 runners from 54 countries, it is a draw that will attract runners from all over the world. The organisers have combined the race with vacation packages, so it is a great opportunity to see China at the same time and make it a family vacation.

Apart from running part of the race on the wall you will be running on paved roads, gravel and one of the highlights is the stretch through small rural Chinese villages where the inhabitants either sit outside the house as on any other normal day, not paying attention to the more than 2,500 runners dressed in colourful clothing or the other part of the village who think that this is the highlight of the year. Children, old folks and dogs all cheer you along, using all the phrases they know in English to the fullest such as “Hello” and “Yes”. For many runners, this is one of the highlights, the wall naturally being the “main event”.

The stretch on the actual wall may not seem so long, but it's enough, more than enough. Every year full marathon runners will be seen climbing the stairs on all four, some will take a nap on the way and it seems more like a battlefield than a race course. But it's all worth it.



FINISH

To give you an idea of your encounter of the wall - count on your pace being less than half, and for some even three times slower than your normal running pace, and you still feel like you are running, legs shaking and pulse over 174 bpm. So after a few miles you are happy to explore other kinds of surfaces. And for the full marathon runners, prepare yourself mentally to do it all over again from the other side.

However, the spectacular views and the sheer immensity of the wall combined with the unique atmosphere of the race make every step up (and down) worth your while.

China is in itself an amazing place and combining a visit to China with this race gives it another perspective.

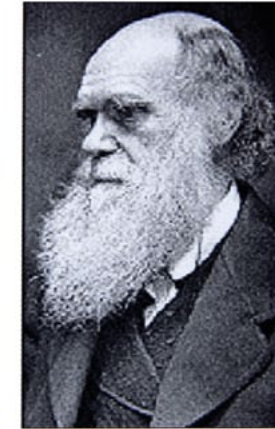

Of course the wowsers have long sought to strike back as the natural superiority of the drinker, almost always with a farrago of lies such as how drinkers ran the risk of bursting into flame if they stood too near open fires because of the large amounts of alcohol in their bodies, and the picture of a group of prim, prune-faced women of the American temperance movement photographed in the late 19th Century seated under a banner reading, "Lips that touch liquor will never touch ours". Bringing to mind, for me at least, the age-old adage that sometimes when you lose, you win.

Similarly, around the same time, a Pennsylvania doctor named Benjamin Rush produced a "Moral and Physical Thermometer" which listed the effects arising from drinking different types of drinks on a scale running from water, his preferred beverage, through beer, to the worst and most heinous of drinks, rum with pepper in it. Really? I've never tried it but it doesn't sound that bad. However, Rush cautioned that drinking strong drink like that would lead to such things as "idleness, peevishness, swearing, obscenity, anarchy, and hatred of government". He also warned of punishments like, "ostracism from civilized society, abandonment by wife and children, and being forced to live in the company of other habitual drunkards". Is it just me, or not only do these things not seem so bad, many of them actually sound quite appealing?

So, as has been shouted at me many times while I have been in the mist of delivering one of my literate and witty (to my mind at least) diatribes in the circle, what has this got to do with the hash? Nothing, other than to remind you that, as hashes, we are continuing the grandest and most central traditions of our species by placing alcohol, particularly beer, at the center of our social conventions,

Thus I spoke and speaking sighed.
Scarce repressed the starting tear;

“Come, my lad, and drink some beer “
