




VICTORIA ANGKOR RESORT & SPA Le Charme de l'Indochine



hashers all winter long with hot toddies
and schnapps.

Sioux Falls, the Heart of America, is the fastest growing city in South Dakota. The city is situated on the prairie of the Great Plains at the junction of Interstate 90 and Interstate 29. Average monthly temperatures range from 16.6 °F (-8.6 °C) in January to 73.0 °F (22.8 °C) in July. Snowfall occurs in light to moderate amounts during the winter. The North Plains Hash House Harriers run every week, snow or shine.

Puerto Galera, is located at the southwestern end of the Isla Verde Passage, 81 miles (130 Km) south of Manila, the capital city of the Philippines.

The island is renowned for some of the most diverse coral reef diving in Asia. Sabang Beach has an active nightlife with numerous bars, restaurants, and accommodations from inexpensive to luxurious.

The average air temperature in February is 30 degrees Centigrade (85 degrees Fahrenheit), and the ocean is almost as warm.

Find out what lies in store on Verde Island for the upcoming 1300th run of the Puerto Galera H3. You can get to Puerto Galera via a two-hour boat journey from Port Batangas, weather permitting, as the port closes down during winter storms. The Puerto Galera Hash runs every Sunday at 3:30 from Captain Gregg's on Sabang Beach.

Some snowbound hashers may dream of heading south for the winter to the warmer climes of the Philippines, Malaysia or Cambodia.

Mekong Indochina Hash will be in Myanmar this year, but the government's plans for elections might disrupt the traditional end of October timeline for this popular event.


Grab your bike and head to the land of the Borneo headhunters for InterBike 3 this April.

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
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
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

Finally, we always are very careful about our consumption. Although Sioux Falls does have a cab company, most hashers are responsible for their own rides home. As a result, most of our trails are "A to A" so you arrive back at your vehicle for circle. Also, in circle, we allow for those called into center to limit their intake by lifting their beer over their cranium after a swallow or two. Our version of "what doesn't go in you, goes on you", is "what doesn't go in you, goes on top of you." Meaning, just hold the beer on top of you. Because most of us have to limit our intake, we create an atmosphere that encourages planning or limiting your alcohol intake so that you can get home safe.

NPH3 and Unique Traditions

The Sioux Falls NPH3 has developed some of their own traditions that occur on trail. First, as mentioned above, when drinking in circle, you are welcome to take a swallow or two and then hold the rest of the beer above your cranium. Second, when possible, the hares will mark trail near playground equipment and mark the trail with "PLAY." NPH3 hashers will jump on the swings and jungle gyms; we take pictures sliding down the children's slides. We do get stares (and one child





yelled "stranger danger"), but we take it in stride. Third, at hash-halts, we each stick one foot on the edge of the circle and take a photo. The photo is always posted. It is a great way to remember all of our hashes. Also, it is not unusual to have snacks on trail. One of our hares baked homemade pretzels once and since then, it is

fairly common to find cookies, cheese and crackers, Hostess Ho-Hos, or other snacks on trail. Finally, our harrows always have a curved tail on the end (called a "spunky tail" in honor of Spunky Booster, of CoMoTION H3). Just a little something we do different than other hashes.

As I'm sure other hashers will attest to, people don't always know what to think when they encounter a group of runners blowing whistles, yelling "on-on", and reeking of beer. We do get long stares and double-takes, but mostly we get a lot of smiles and good humor. We have been invited into a yard to take pictures with the owners' Halloween decorations. We have had parents point out our superhero costumes to their smiling children. We've serenaded

many bartenders and wait staff, who invite us back for future hashes. Most people notice how much we are smiling and how much fun we are having. Ok-there was that one time we got yelled at and kicked off private property, and maybe another time we were banned from McD's, but most just take it all in stride.

And that is the true joy of hashing in Sioux Falls. No matter the weather, no matter the trail, we always encounter people who just enjoy us. And NPH3mostly we do it because we enjoy each other. We

hope to hash for many years to come and continue to develop good friends and to have the opportunities to not take life (or ourselves) too seriously.

ost International Hashers visiting Philipinnes usually bypass Cebu City, being drawn to the Hashing excitement of Manila, Angeles City, Subic Bay, Baguio City and La Union H3 Chapters.

In the Philipinnes Visayas area, Cebu City is the capital of the Province of Cebu, Cebu City is the second largest city in the Philipinnes and is a significant centre of commerce, trade and education.



So most hashers might not be familiar with the Cebu H3 Hash, being off the well beaten track.

Established in 1987 by 'Stubbies', the Cebu Hash House Harrier Chapter is a family friendly Hash that runs each Saturday, usually from the Sand Trap Pub in Banilad Cebu.

Hashing in the Philippines this March 2015




ON THE ICE




LESS A MATTER OF FAITH




