Winter blizzards blow across
Europe from Stockholm
to Helsinki. Back in the
USA, Sioux Falls welcomes
hashers all winter long with hot toddies
and schnapps.

Sioux Falls, the Heart of America, is the
fastest growing city in South Dakota.
The city is situated on the prairie of the
Great Plains at the junction of Interstate
90 and Interstate 29. Average monthly
temperatures range from 16.6 °F (-8.6
°C) in January to 73.0 °F (22.8 °C) in
July. Snowfall occurs in light to moderate
amounts during the winter. The North
Plains Hash House Harriers run every
week, snow or shine.

Puerto Galera, is located at the
southwestern end of the Isla Verde
Passage, 81 miles (130 Km) south of
Manila, the capital city of the Philippines.

The island is renowned for some of the most diverse coral reef diving in Asia. Sabang Beach has an active nightlife with numerous bars, restaurants, and accommodations from inexpensive to luxurious.

The average air temperature in February is 30 degrees Centigrade (85 degrees Fahrenheit), and the ocean is almost as warm.

Find out what lies in store on Verde Island for the upcoming 1300th run of the Puerto Galera H3. You can get to Puerto Galera via a two-hour boat journey from Port Batangas, weather permitting, as the port closes down during winter storms. The Puerto Galera Hash runs every Sunday at 3:30 from Captain Gregg's on Sabang Beach.

Some snowbound hashers may dream of heading south for the winter to the warmer climes of the Philippines, Malaysia or Cambodia.

Mekong Indochina Hash will be in Myanmar this year, but the government's plans for elections might disrupt the traditional end of October timeline for this popular event.

Grab your bike and head to the land of the Borneo headhunters for InterBike 3 this April.

A great month for hashing is coming up this May in Cambodia, before and after Cambodia Nash Hash.

All this and more in the February edition of Harrier Magazine.

Hashing in South Dakota!

Wait, there are people who actually live in South Dakota? The Northern Plains Hash House Harriers are located in Sioux Falls, South Dakota. They were started in July 2013 and will reach trail number 58 by December 30, 2014. The other kennel in South Dakota is Big Heads Hash House Harriers in Rapid City, South Dakota, which has well over 200 trails in the bank. Rapid City and Sioux Falls are 350 miles apart and could not be more different. Rapid City is located 350 miles from Sioux Falls, not far from the Wyoming border. Sioux Falls is on the eastern side, not far from the Minnesota and Iowa borders. Rapid City is nestled in the Black Hills which is full of trails, pine trees, and even buffalo. Sioux Falls is in the middle of corn country (think continuation of the Iowa corn belt) and is full of....corn. Both are blessed with breweries, wineries, and bars... lots of bars. In fact, South Dakota is full of drive-up liquor stores and municipal-owned bars. Hashing in South Dakota, east or west, is fun and full of unique opportunities and a lot of fun.

BVC/DBD:


Often our hares use the chalk symbols BVC (Be Very Careful) and DBD (Don't Be Dumb)—but for the most part, if you hash in eastern South Dakota, you must know to always BVC and DBD, whether the hare marks it or not. The average high in Sioux Falls is 56.8 degrees and the average low is 34.5 degrees. That sounds nice and pretty moderate, and oh so pleasant. Wrong! Those “averages” are the result of our Sioux Falls extremes. The record low is minus (yes, freaking MINUS) 42 degrees in 1899. The record high is 110 degrees in 1988. (Nothing like a 152 degree swing.) It is unusual to have a winter without the mercury dropping to minus 20 multiple times and it is unusual to see a summer without at least one day above 100.

As a result, trail revolves around the weather. Winter hashing can be the hardest. It is tough to plan as our usual trails, paths and parks are cold and have no shelter from the wind (oh, the wind!). When the mercury drops, NPH3 meets at bars. We have “circle” and chalk talk (without any chalk) around a bar table. The hare then takes off—sometimes to run down the street to another bar to buy a pitcher. Winter trail has included beer in bus shelters, beer in park lodges, and beer in persons' homes. It is just too damn cold to drink the beer outside (or even *stand* outside). Once out on trail, the hashers must be careful around ice, snow, drifts, etc. Also, because it gets dark very very early, we need our cranium lamps. But even with cranium lamps, we need to be very careful of traffic. Sioux Falls drivers are not always looking out for runners in the winter—especially not intoxicated runners—so the hashers need to always be particularly careful when encountering cars.

Hashing in spring and summer includes challenges as well. Spring brings torrential rains. June of 2014 saw 10 inches in 2 days (yes, June is still “spring”, don’t judge us). The result is the river flooding the biking and hiking trails, and even making some of the streets temporary lakes. Hares will take this challenge and wade into the temporary lakes and streams. Again, the hashers know to be very careful as we don’t know



if we will encounter glass, potholes or other unseen dangers under the murky flood waters. Sioux Falls hashers have also had to end trail early due to rain—we are talking rain so heavy that the chalk marks are washed away within minutes of being marked. We once found a beer stop in a park gazebo and watched the “BS” mark wash away as we finished our beverages. At that point, the hashers know to just give up and zen on in. Also, the summer brings the hail, lightning, and tornados. The hares usually will mark a short trail based on weather, but all hashers are told DBD—Don’t Be Dumb!!! If the sky looks green-black, zen on in. If hail the size of golf balls pours from the heavens, take cover—and protect the beer!

Finally, we always are very careful about our consumption. Although Sioux Falls does have a cab company, most hashers are responsible for their own rides home. As a result, most of our trails are “A to A” so you arrive back at your vehicle for circle. Also, in circle, we allow for those called into center to limit their intake by lifting their beer over their cranium after a swallow or two. Our version of “what doesn’t go in you, goes on you”, is “what doesn’t go in you, goes on top of you.” Meaning, just hold the beer on top of you. Because most of us have to limit our intake, we create an atmosphere that encourages planning or limiting your alcohol intake so that you can get home safe.

NPH3 and Unique Traditions

The Sioux Falls NPH3 has developed some of their own traditions that occur on trail. First, as mentioned above, when drinking in circle, you are welcome to take a swallow or two and then hold the rest of the beer above your cranium. Second, when possible, the hares will mark trail near playground equipment and mark the trail with “PLAY.” NPH3 hashers will jump on the swings and jungle gyms; we take pictures sliding down the children’s slides. We do get stares (and one child

yelled “stranger danger”), but we take it in stride. Third, at hash-halts, we each stick one foot on the edge of the circle and take a photo. The photo is always posted. It is a great way to remember all of our hashes. Also, it is not unusual to have snacks on trail. One of our hares baked homemade pretzels once and since then, it is fairly common to find cookies, cheese and crackers, Hostess Ho-Hos, or other snacks on trail. Finally, our harrows always have a curved tail on the end (called a “spunky tail” in honor of Spunky Booster, of CoMoTION H3). Just a little something we do different than other hashes.

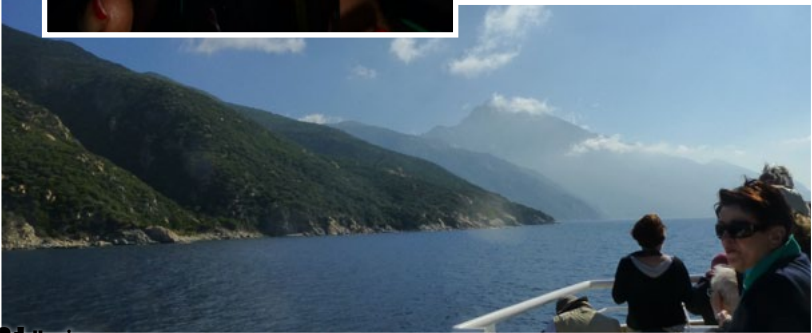

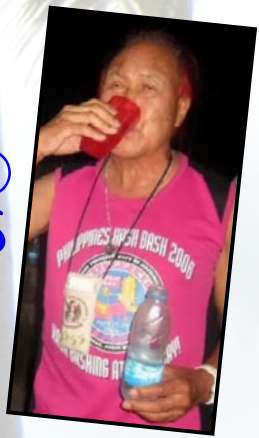

ost International Hashers visiting Philippines usually bypass Cebu City, being drawn to the Hashing excitement of Manila, Angeles City, Subic Bay, Baguio City and La Union H3 Chapters.

In the Philippines Visayas area, Cebu City is the capital of the Province of Cebu, Cebu City is the second largest city in the Philippines and is a significant centre of commerce, trade and education.



So most hashers might not be familiar with the Cebu H3 Hash, being off the well beaten track.

Established in 1987 by 'Stubbies', the Cebu Hash House Harrier Chapter is a family friendly Hash that runs each Saturday, usually from the Sand Trap Pub in Banilad Cebu.

Apart from a run with the local hash, another reason to visit Cebu is for the experience of swimming with the whale sharks at the Osbud Whale Shark Sanctuary.



'Kuntfoo' and Terry 'Testicles' Tsikleas enjoyed the one and half hour taxi journey to the south through busy satellite towns and tranquil fertile countryside to seaside Osbud to experience and view the famous of shark whale feeding.

The sea level picturesque Seafari Resort was an ideal location being only a short local boat ride to the Whale Shark Information Centre.

After this worthwhile diversion, 'Kuntfoo' and 'Testicles' returned refreshed to Cebu City ready to meet the pack at the Sand Trap Pub for the Cebu H3 Saturday run.

For run number 948, they were made welcome by On Sec, Richard 'Disco Dick' Weeks, Hash Cash n Booze, 'Dribbles Weekly' and GM 'Sherpa'.

Refreshingly, a mixed pack of both youngsters and oldies attended.

After the necessary beer or two for tropical rehydration, 'Disco Dick' drove to a roadside parking for the start of the run and later the circle area.

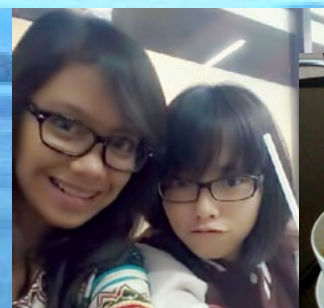

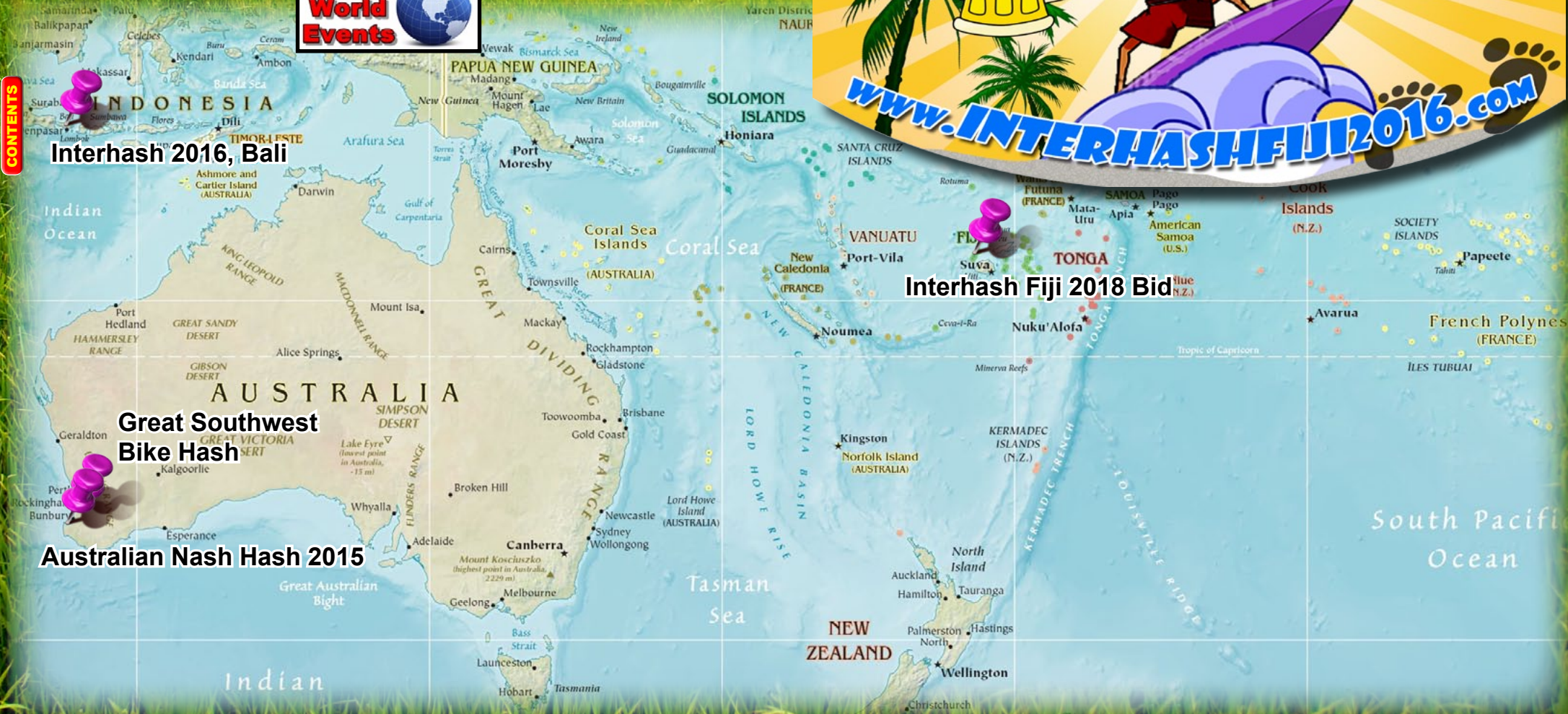

POLAR CIRCLE MARATHON

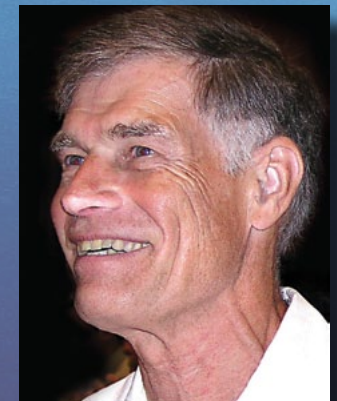

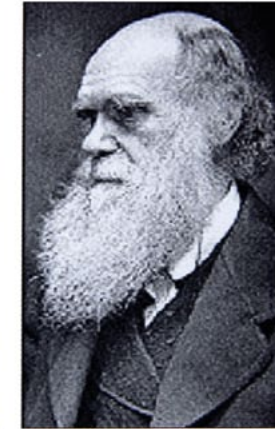

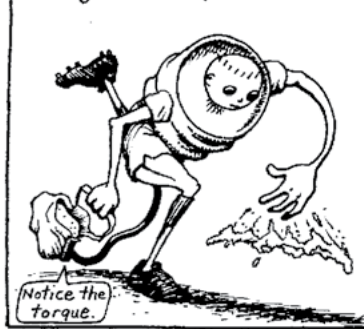


fig2.5 "Behold the Glory that is... YER MASTERPIECE ... then run like hell!"
