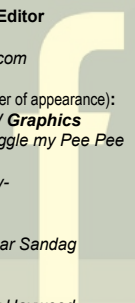

This was also an 8 day Hash River Cruise, but it went up the Rhine River from Amsterdam to Basel, Switzerland. Everyone enjoyed the daily escorted tours, the fine cuisine, the six hash runs, and the free beer, mimosas, champagne, and wine on board so much that we decided to do another one.

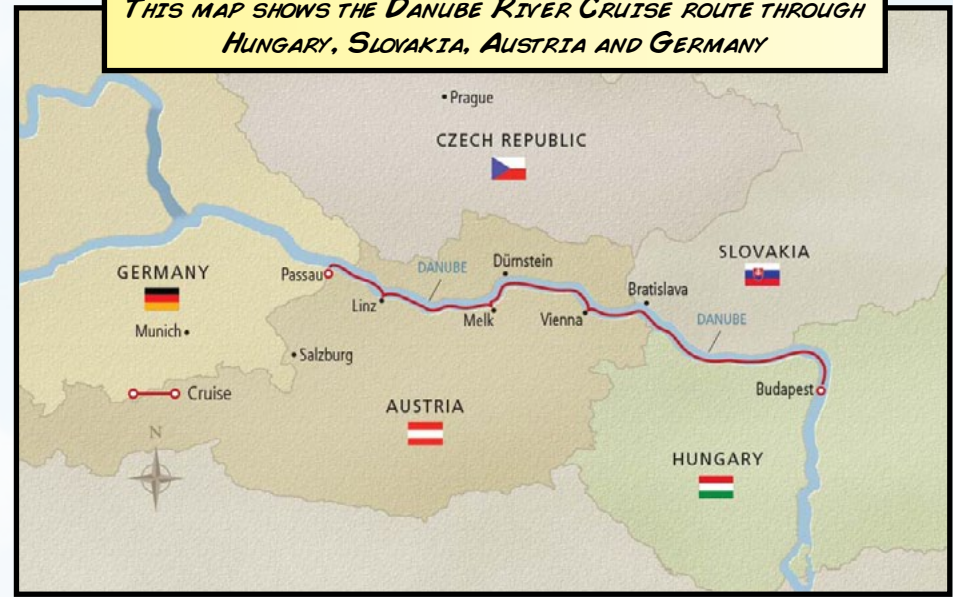
Some hashers have told me about previous hash river cruises set up by Wolf, before he passed away, but no one stepped forward to set up one after Brussels. So I did, and I am very grateful. Viking cruises has been very helpful in giving us special group rate discounts on this and the previous cruise: discounts that make the cruise less expensive than travel agents, or first time or repeat customers can get themselves.

The Danube River Hash Cruise is an 8 day all-inclusive hash event on board the Viking Ship Legend sailing and hashing through 4 countries to Passau, Germany.

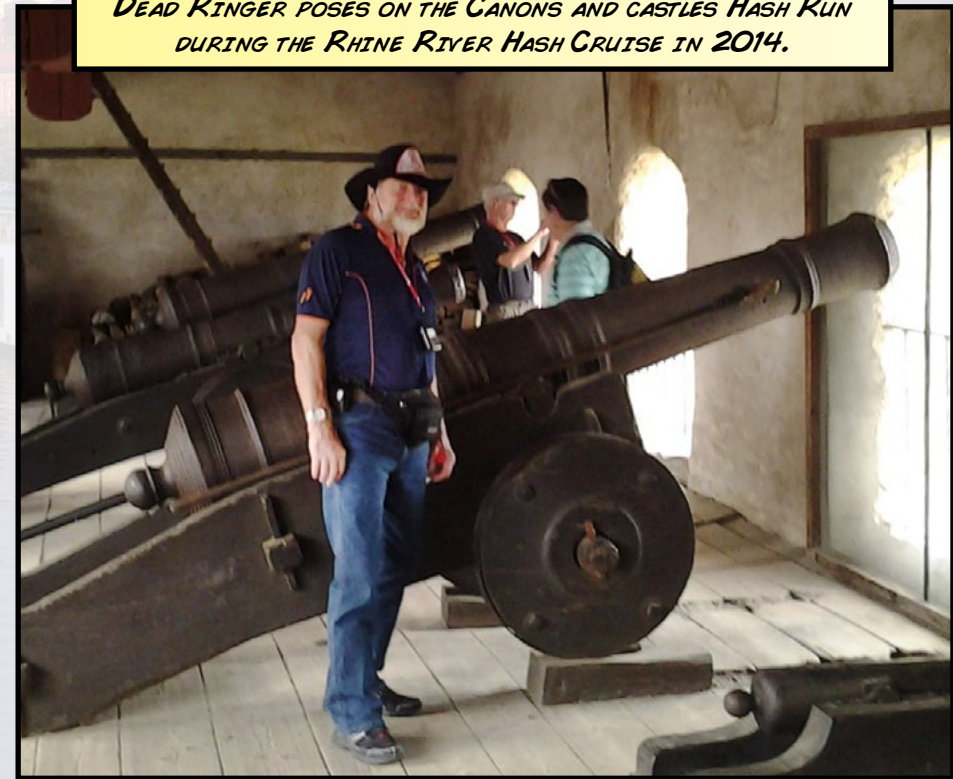
After Disembarking in Passau, you have the option of hashing with the Prague Hash. This PostLube event is being offered after Eurohash 2015 and goes from Budapest on 26 July cruises through 4 countries, and finishes in Passau, Germany, cruising down the Danube River. The cruise includes 3 meals per day, champagne & mimosas for breakfast, beer & wine with lunch & dinner, 6 day tours, 5 hash runs, and you don't have to pack your bags each day!

If you are in the UK or a commonwealth country other than Canada you need a European (non-UK) or North American address to get the discount prices; contact Mu-Sick for quotations on this. For those of you in Commonwealth countries, if it is less expensive to book locally, then you can just pay a \$100 rego fee to Mu-Sick and enjoy all the hashes, the giveaway, etc. In order to confirm your reservation, you need to put down your \$500 per person deposit. The Balance is due in 30 days. Even after you pay your entire amount, you can still cancel up until 3 April 2015 and only forfeit \$100. If you elect to buy the travel insurance, then you can cancel at anytime up and until 14 days prior to sailing and

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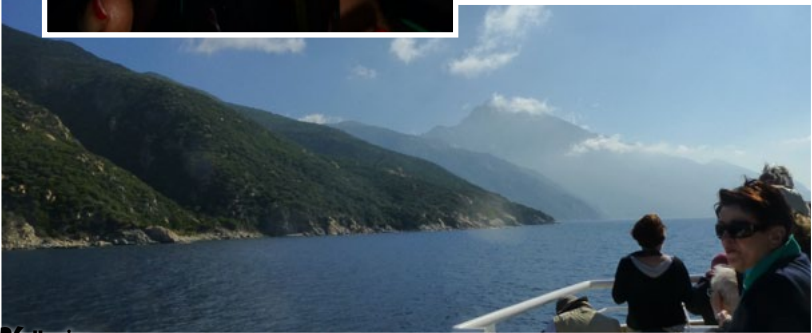
receive all of your money back. For more information on the Viking Ship Legend which we will be cruising on you can visit the Viking Cruise's website at www.vikingrivercruises.com.

The fascination with river cruises versus ocean cruises is quite interesting. I have personally done 21 hash cruises on the ocean. But on a River Cruise, you get to see beautiful historic scenery every day and see it all the time during the day, you get to hash and visit a different place every day, take a guided tour each day, don't have to worry about the weather or sea state stopping or diverting you, and many of the places have their own hash club which we can join and run with.

Many times, when hashers travel a long way to a large hash event, they want to take advantage of being in that area and want to experience the area. Bus tours have been fun, but the drudgery of packing and unpacking each day are eliminated on a River Cruise.

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Lisbon, Portugal and Laredo, Texas have virtually nothing in common. Or they didn't, until now. Lisbon is the ancient capital of Portugal, complete with Roman ruins. Laredo is a city in southern Texas on the border with Mexico. But now, as of Saturday, February 7, 2015, Laredo, Texas, has a Hash whose Mother Hash is in Lisbon, Portugal.

The Laredo Hash was founded by husband and wife Hashers K2 and Loo Seeker, who met at a dinner hosted by the Lisbon Hash. On October 29, 2011, the Lisbon Hash celebrated its 700th Hash. After the Hash, Hashers celebrated at a 007-themed Hash dinner. No Name



Ginny attended the dinner - her first-ever Hash event - dressed as a Bond Girl. The then-Hash Master of the Lisbon Hash, K2, attended as Dr Goldfinger. The rest, as they say, is history. Fast-forward three years or so and K2, Loo Seeker, and the Seeker children are living in Nuevo Laredo, Mexico.

For safety and security reasons, it's not a good idea to go running around new and strange places in Nuevo Laredo. So, we decided to establish the Hash on the US side of the border in Laredo, Texas. There isn't a lot of variety in the landscape - a lot of scrubland with mesquite trees, and a few smallish hills. The temperatures can get extremely high - triple digits (farenheit) are not uncommon from April to October. Therefore, we've decided that the majority of our Hashes will be around an hour or so (compared to around two hours at the Mother Hash in Lisbon). And while Lisbon Hashes happen every other Saturday, here in Laredo, we will only Hash about once a month (at least in the beginning).

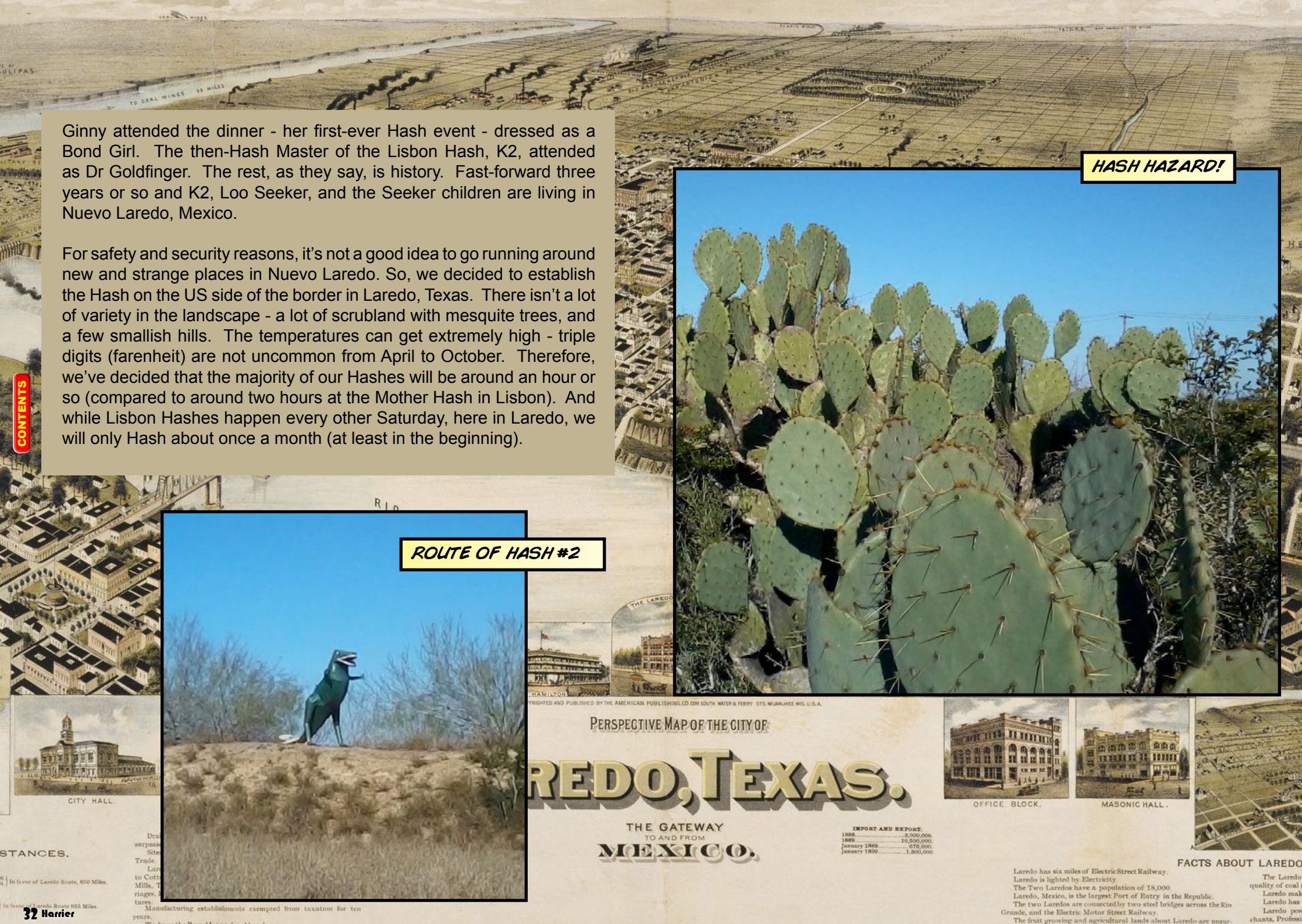

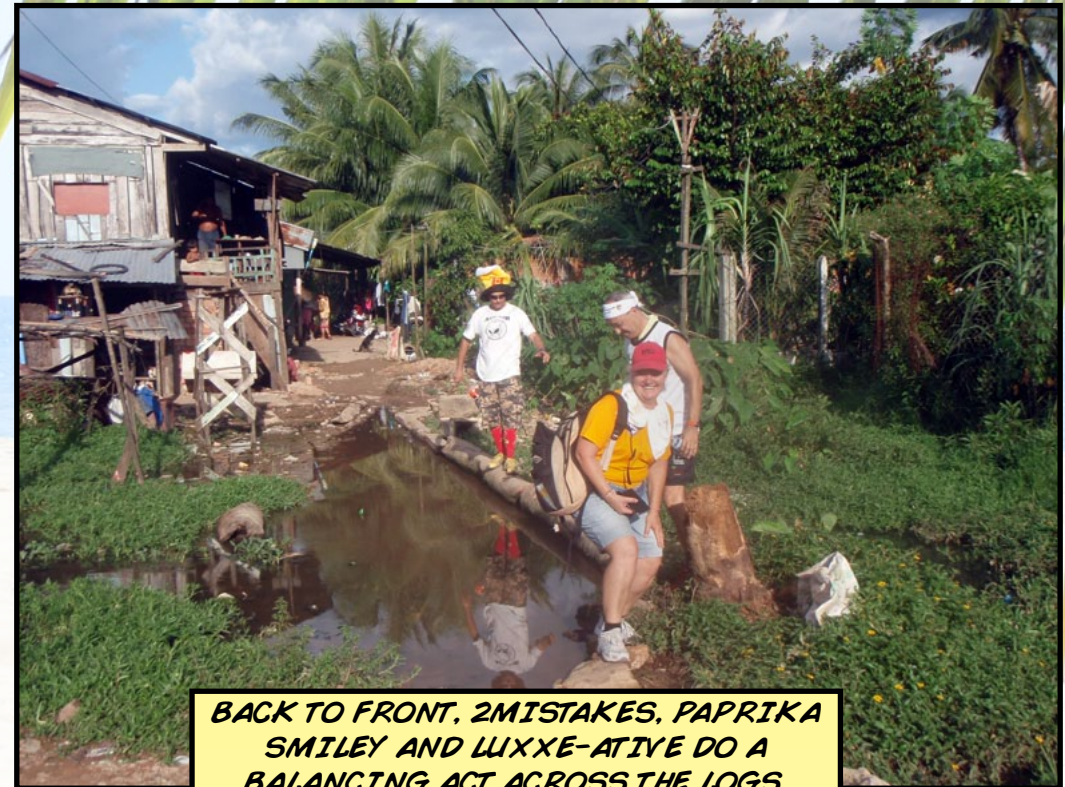


AN OPEN LETTER REGARDING PAN ASIA 2015

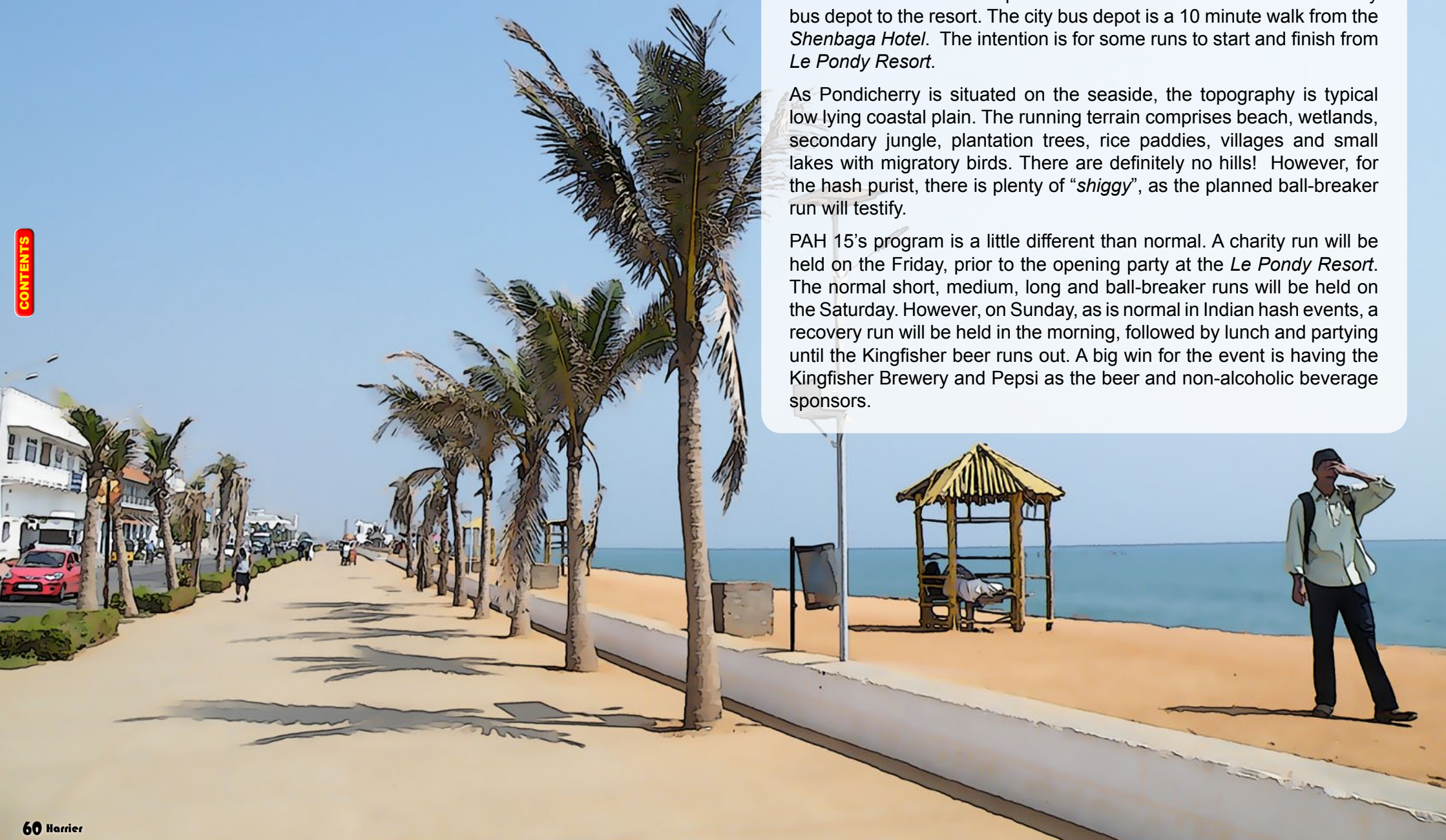
Given the debacle of Pan Asia Hash 2013, some interested hashers may be considering whether or not to attend Pan Asia Hash 2015 (PAH 2015) in Pondicherry. They may have already decided to boycott the 2015 event; or even future Pan Asia events. Given that, during a recent trip to India we visited Pondicherry to meet with the PAH 2015 Committee and Project Manager to assess the event's preparedness.



Even though at seven months before the event, we were impressed with the registration and party venues; the event program; the sponsorship arrangements and the general progress of preparations. Given the professional approach and level of planning for PAH 2015, it should deliver a quality and value for money event for all attending hashers.

Pondicherry is the former French colony on the southeast coast of India. The heritage French district (White Town) of the city stretches several kilometres along the coast and inland for about four to five street blocks. The registration venue (*Shenbaga Hotel and Convention Centre*- <http://shenbagahotel.com/index.html>) is located near the city's night market area, adjacent to White Town.

The *Shenbaga Hotel* only opened in December 2014. The hotel's convention centre has plenty of space and facilities for hash registration, hash bazaar and importantly the hash bar. The hotel's separate accommodation building uses an atrium style layout, with the majority of upper floor rooms having either city or ocean views. Standard double or king rooms have typical business hotel features, separate bathroom and good wi-fi. There is a swimming pool and bar on the roof. We stayed at the *Shenbaga Hotel* during our recent visit and were impressed with the level of service and food.



The *Le Pondy Resort* - <http://lepondy.com/>, the party and after run venue, is located south of Pondicherry's city district. The resorts grassed beach area, alfresco dining area and pool is an ideal location for staging the Friday and Saturday run parties. The facilities and catering are excellent. Buses will transport hashers to and from the PAH 2015's city bus depot to the resort. The city bus depot is a 10 minute walk from the *Shenbaga Hotel*. The intention is for some runs to start and finish from *Le Pondy Resort*.

As Pondicherry is situated on the seaside, the topography is typical low lying coastal plain. The running terrain comprises beach, wetlands, secondary jungle, plantation trees, rice paddies, villages and small lakes with migratory birds. There are definitely no hills! However, for the hash purist, there is plenty of "shiggys", as the planned ball-breaker run will testify.

PAH 15's program is a little different than normal. A charity run will be held on the Friday, prior to the opening party at the *Le Pondy Resort*. The normal short, medium, long and ball-breaker runs will be held on the Saturday. However, on Sunday, as is normal in Indian hash events, a recovery run will be held in the morning, followed by lunch and partying until the Kingfisher beer runs out. A big win for the event is having the Kingfisher Brewery and Pepsi as the beer and non-alcoholic beverage sponsors.

Another contributing sponsor is PAH 2015's appointed travel agent *Parveen Holidays* - tours@parveenholidays.com Apart from assisting with your Pondicherry accommodation bookings and transfers, *Parveen Holidays* can arrange pre or post event tours throughout India. Why not get a hash group together and travel before or after PAH 2015 to visit - Agra to see the Taj Mahal; Delhi and the forts of Rajasthan and Jodhpur; Kerala to sail the Backwaters; or Aurangabad to see the Ajanta and Ellora Caves.

If you have ever thought about visiting India; then PAH 2015 provides the perfect "introductory" opportunity to visit "*Incredible India*". If you haven't already, then seriously consider attending PAH 2015.

For the 17th time already, adventure seeking runners from all over the world will gather at the shores of Lake Hovsgol in Northern Mongolia for a very special experience: the Mongolia Sunrise to Sunset 42k and 100k ultra trail marathon. Until March 1st, 2015, runners can book a discounted early bird travel package on the event website www.ms2s.org. "It is a whole week of exploration with horseback riding, kayaking, hiking, fishing, sleeping in traditional Mongolian Gers – and of course running", says race director Nicolas Musy.



The race on August 5th will be as challenging as it is beautiful. Runners pass by yak herds and wild horses, shamanistic Ovoos as well as Mongolian yurts and horsemen, in one of the most pristine and spectacular areas on this planet. Amongst participants, the race is known as the world's most beautiful 42k and 100k run. A lakeside single track through woods and over windblown lowlands; steep, rocky mountain passes with breath-taking views; river valleys and marshy forests; seas of wildflowers. The accumulated elevation gain/loss for the marathon distance is 2.255 meters, for the 100k course it is 3.365 meters.

POLAR CIRCLE MARATHON

The Polar Circle Marathon - often referred to as "the coolest marathon on earth" takes place in Kangerlussuaq, Greenland. The endless ice and arctic tundra of this vast country make up the backdrop of this unusual race, in which runners pass glacier tongues, moraine landscapes and the soundless, arctic desert. This is a rare opportunity to visit one of the most remote corners of the world combined with a challenging running event.

A part of the route takes place on the ice cap itself, but the main part of the course is run on the gravel road (often snow covered) that connects the inland ice with the small township of Kangerlussuaq, just north of the Polar Circle.

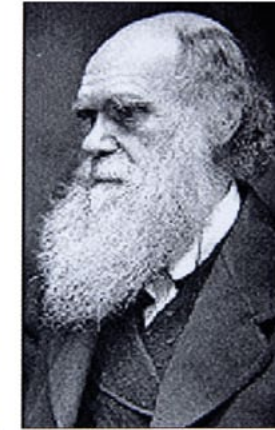

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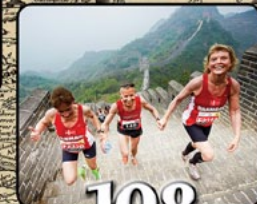
