





VICTORIA ANGKOR RESORT & SPA Le Charme de l'Indochine



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
SAN DIEGO RED DRESS TME MACCICAL MYSTERY TOUR

hese days almost every city with a moderately sized population of hashers has an annual Red Dress Run. It's one of our most visible annual events and it all started here in San Diego in 1988. We're gearing up again for another one in June. The theme this year, is Magical Mystery Tour and the magic happens June 13th.

Although the main event is Saturday, San Diego Area hashes have created a long weekend around the event. Festivities kick off Wednesdays with a Red Dress Run in the wine country of Temecula. Thursday is the Blackshirt Hash, with a heavy metal theme to the trail and a concert at the on-in. Friday is the incredibly popular Pretty in Pink hash, and then Saturday is RDR. Sunday brings a choice of two hangover runs, one in Tijuana with the TJ hash and one in San Diego with the Humpin Hash.







Last year's theme was Wet and Reckless and RDR started at the hash hotel Saturday afternoon, but before the pack was away, we watched two of our local hashers tie the knot out by the pool. Before the happy couple could start feeling the inevitable regrets, the hares from Team Amazeballs took the stage with hare lies and then they were off.

The A-B trail featured four drink checks. The first featured a keg of Green Flash beer and an inflatable slide. The second was on a bridge over

a harbor inlet, and surprisingly only one person was dumb enough to jump off it into the water below....but we didn't get caught so everything was cool (oh and he was fine too). The third check was a fireball shot along the harbor near a playground. The fourth check was the "Reno

911" check, where our helpers were dressed up as cops with short shorts administering sobriety checks to the pack and handing out Capri-Sun packets which had been injected with an ounce of vodka.

Join Interscandi-2015 for the Vikings Raid of Galway, a city on the Atlantic Coast of Ireland! It will be a lucky charm, for this is Interscandi No. 13. Galway is located far from Dublin. Therefore, be prepared for exploring the real Ireland, superb scenery with rugged mountains. Imagine the possibility of beautiful trails filled with swamp-like shiggy. Shiggy socks are a must on one's packing list. Take a tour through the historic medieval town of Galway, the capital of the Western Ireland. Experience the vibrant pub culture, walk the charming cobble stoned streets, breathe in the intoxicating ocean air and relax on the green grass of Eyre Square.


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

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

Dinner was fantastic with choices to please everyone's taste and was available from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. Plus pizza at 10 p.m. The area around Busselton is flat for Kilometres so the trails were flat which was a different experience for one used to the jungle trails around Puerto Galera, Philippines. I was a bit disappointed that there was only one day of real runs plus the recovery run although there were 7 different trails so there were lots of options. The organization was superb even the buses

to the different trails had signs for the ball breaker, long run, medium run, medium and short run, medium walk, and short walk so no mistake could be made. There was a bus provided from the Perth Airport March 4-6 and back again March 9 with beer provided for little more than the cost on Southwest Coach lines. What I really appreciated was the provision of a bus leaving the venue every 1/2 hour from 10 p.m. to 12:30 a.m. to the front door of your accommodation. The cost was much higher than is common for events in Southeast Asia, but it was well worth it. Every one enjoyed their time and many are looking forward to the next Nash Hash in Oz. Overall I would rate it a fantastic experience.

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
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A few years later and the membership had grown to 80 people with about 75% of those being Malaysian and the remainder Mat Saleh. In the mid nineties when the membership got to 160 the committee decided this was enough and capped the membership numbers. This did not really work as those on the waiting list just attended as guests for months and months until they were allowed to join. However it was good for the club's finances. Sense eventually prevailed and the club has stabilised at about 200 - 220 members with an even split between Malaysians and Mat Saleh and a turnover of 20 - 25% per year.

In the early eighties the club adopted the running tree man as its logo. Although the club takes its name from Petaling Jaya, a city just outside KL, petaling is actually a species of tree and hence the running tree man logo.

In the early days the runs were confined to an area defined by Rawang to the north and Kajang to the south of Kuala Lumpur. However now most of those run sites are part of the great concrete jungle that covers the Klang Valley. Whereas a run site would be within 30 minutes drive of the centre of KL it is now normal to drive for an hour from a toll booth on the outskirts of KL.

By the mid eighties it was decided that the runs were too short, too long, too, many hills, too flat, too much shiggy, not enough shiggy and therefore a system of run judging would be introduced. This covered all aspects of the hash from how good the run directions are, car parking, length of run, variety of terrain and quality of check. The best hares get awarded a t-shirt for their efforts to be presented at the ON ON. Below this you can get an ON-Down, Toilet Seat or a 10 Weeker. 10 Weekers rarely appear, if the run is that bad does anyone want the same hare in 10 week's time. Your chances of getting a t-shirt seem to be enhanced if you are female and well endowed. The run judging still goes on to this





day and yes, the general consensus is that the runs are too short, too long, too, many hills, too flat, too much shiggy, not enough shiggy.

PH3 will run any terrain - rubber and oil plantation, dusan (orchards) and secondary jungle - there is no primary jungle near KL left. The runs are not judged by their length but by taking between 1 hr 15 and 1hr 30 long for the front runner, and bringing the majority of the pack back in another 30 minutes. Quite regularly the hare will set an longer loop for the super FROPS.

PH3 has not been afraid to be different and in 1983 introduced the torchlight run, where the run starts at 7:30pm, instead of the regular 4:30pm start, and much to the amazement of some hashers a torch is advisable to run in the dark. This will be followed by makan, hash acts (all home produced no imports for PH3) and a disco going on late into the night in some part of the jungle or plantation.

In 2000 PH3 introduced the Hash Challenge, which is not really a hash, but an endurance trek. For teams of four [4] this takes the form of a 42km A – B trail (marathon distance) basically all off road and going to places that are not normally visited by hash. Divided in to 4 sectors where refreshments are provided and teams can pull out if not able to continue. The super fit teams arrive promising to cover this in under 6 hours. So far the hares have always won with the first teams to finish taking more than 9 hours.

In 2002 and for our 1300th run celebration we had the first red dress run in KL even though cross dressing is not allowed in Malaysia.

The wide range of nationalities, nearly 20, allows the club to have quite a few celebration runs each year and has / had included through the years as different groups get larger or smaller, Australia Day, Waitangi Day, Chinese New Year, St David's Day, St Georges Day, Dutch Con-





nection, Bastille Day, Swiss, Oktoberfest, Coalition Day, Deepavali, St. Andrew's Christmas, New Year. And every two years we will go and do an outstation run allowing two days of partying and drinking instead of just Saturday Night.

Onwards to 11 July 2015 and our 2000th run. The celebrations will start the night before with a themed evening at a well known bar somewhere in KL. Saturday we will be using the abandoned Elmville Golf Course and clubhouse, south of KL. Three runs long, medium and short starting at 4:00pm. Followed by ON ON onsite, Hash Acts brought to you by Paul (Beano) Kirkman and company and disco until late. Sunday lunch will be at a venue in KL.

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
ON THE ICE

Naturally, she was unanimous choice for the BMH3's equivalent of the Darwin Awards, Hash S**t.
