




# VICTORIA ANGKOR RESORT & SPA Le Charme de l'Indochine



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Registration for the event went smoothly, ably ran by 'Beaky's Bitches and was held at the hostel. However, check in at the hostel was a different story. It went very slowly. I arrived on Wednesday so it wasn't an issue for me. But the lines were quite long for those on Thursday arriving just before the red dress run.

Goody bag included a nice tech tshirt which I really like. We also got a small camelback type bag which you could wear on a run. Other stuff was a pin, a plastic mug similar to what Brussels handed out last year and a patch. We also got a bottle of vodka, some thought it was beer a quick 'gulp'! Shock, horror '.

As already mentioned, accommodation was included in the registration fee which is not normally the case at these type events. The rooms were basically college dorm rooms although they had a bathroom attached. My room had two bunk beds. No air con. I suspect that is rarely needed but it would have come in handy for eurohash weekend as it was quite warm.

Anyway, it worked for me. Some people were complaining about internet access. I brought an internet cable and a portable wireless router with me, so I had wifi access the entire time, but for those who didn't, access was sporadic. The organizers also arranged with the hostel for additional days at a very reduced rate. A lot of people stayed Thursday and Sunday nights.







One other point about the food stations. They were outside and the barbeque was being cooked as the food was being served. It didn't rain on Friday and there were a few drops on Saturday night but I was wondering if there was a plan b in case of inclement weather. You could have moved the food lines inside but what about the barbeque itself? Would they have just kept on cooking in the rain? Not sure there was a plan B but it turned out that it didn't matter. The hash gods smiled on us for nearly the entire weekend.

There were lots of beer stations however, so no queues for getting alcohol.



Saturday was the big run day.. There were quite a few choices ranging from the ballbreaker to the old farts run. All the runs involved buses. As usual, at these type of events, lots of people didn't get on the run they wanted because the run or bus was full, etc. Those of you who have done these big events know the drill: Get their early so you can get on the bus you want.. I opted for trail 3 which was organized by the BRAS. So this meant it was a bra and panties run (similar to what was done in Brussels).. We had to pay extra to go on this run as we ended up on a brewery tour at the Tyskie brewery which is one of the largest in the world. Bus ride was quite a distance; nearly 90 minutes. The run was in this forest/nature preserve and it was flat.. Worked for me.. I think it was about 3 miles tops. After that, we had lunch, a short circle, and then it was off to the brewery.. Lunch was a sandwich but apparently they didn't pack enough back at the start so some people didn't get anything. We had lots of chips/crisps though. Also plenty of beer, but no ice. So everyone was drinking warm beer. As a result, not too much beer consumption after the run. I heard at least one other run had the same problems: not enough sandwiches and no ice...It was all on the Ballbreaker bus!



The Tyskie brewery was great. They kept the tour itself to a merciful 20 minutes. Normally, it's well over an hour. Then it was on to beer tasting! We also got a souvenir bottle to take back on the bus. Plus a nice bottle opener. I drank my bottle on the long bus ride back to Krakow.

As already mentioned, Saturday night dinner was a repeat of Friday night. Food lines might have been a bit shorter.

After the food, it was inside Klub Studio for skits, music, etc. The theme for Saturday night was Medieval dragons, knights, and damsels. Think Renaissance festival. A lot of people went all out for this. Some pretty innovative costumes. The Hardy hashers started the proceedings with a great 'Dragon' chase around the venue.

There weren't many skits but they were all quality acts. The one I really remember was the woman, 'Fire Flaps' with the fire batons. That got a standing ovation. Also, the dueling 'Wessex' banjos skit was funny..

Vienna made a presentation for Eurohash 2017. It was pretty much a lock. Paris made a half assed bid but they were relieved Vienna got it. We voted right then and there.. If you wanted Vienna you went to the left side of the stage and if you wanted Paris, you went to the right. It was close to unanimous. No drama, no counting ballots.. It was democracy in action. Perhaps this is how we should handle all these bids in the future.

After skits, etc. were over, a live band came out and they played a pretty good mix of music. The female lead singer was quite good. Their rendition of "somebody to love" by Jefferson Airplane was excellent.

Party went on late... It was well after midnight when the band stopped. Party continued at the so called "old farts student bar".









Sunday featured a hangover run which started from the hostel. No buses for this one.. A lot of people were leaving early or went sightseeing in Krakow. But the run was basically a stroll through the gardens near the university. There was a longer run up the nearby 'mound' which a few 'die hards' did. More food(lunch), Down Downs and drinks afterwards..

# Overall, I would rate this event an A.

The event went pretty smoothly and not many hiccups. It was well organized and communication was excellent. I have commented on this point before. Communication is paramount at these large events and we received lots of newsletters (email blasts) which were also posted on the website.. So nobody can complain they didn't know what was happening. Well done, Polly, Mr. Beaky, and the rest of the organizing committee and Mr Beaky's 'Slaves'! You guys did a bang up job! It was a Kracking event in Krakow.







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# HAWAII'S NEWEST HASH

rojan F\*ck Horse (TFH) and Take it in the Aft (Aft) moved to the Big Island of Hawaii in early 2014. It was a move made for completely selfish reasons. Although the island of Oahu had been home for almost a decade, it was too busy, traffic was terrible, and the concrete jungle was just too hot. TFH and Aft had traveled to Hilo on previous occasions and had found that it felt like home. So they ditched their loved ones and their mother hash, the Aloha H3, to start a new life in the rainiest city in the United States.





The Big Island held wondrous new adventures and multiple adjustments for the pair. The most daunting predicament to face them upon arrival was learning to slow down. "Island Time" had never so blatantly controlled day to day activities as it did in sleepy Hilo. The next thing that taunted Aft was both the abundance of wilderness and the lack of a local Hash House. While driving the nearly two hours to the Kona Coast Hash House Harriers helped their hash fix, something was still missing. Thus, the Hilo Gets Me Wet Hash House Harriers (HGMWH3) was born.

The Island of Hawaii is the creation of five volcanoes, one of which has been erupting since 1983. Two of the volcanoes stretch almost fourteen thousand feet towards the stars and create a barrier that results in ecological diverse climates found in few places on Earth.





A simple drive around the perimeter of the island presents a wide variety of climates and sub-climates.

Hilo's rainy weather can prove a challenge for hashing logistics. Hash marks get washed away and circle often happens in the rain, but drinking beer in the rain never killed anyone. All the rain; however, makes for beautiful scenery, rushing waterfalls, green landscapes, and the HGMWH3 strives to explore the lush landscape the Hilo area has to offer. Although still in its infancy, the HGMWH3 has already welcomed visitors from across the United States, held a successful Red Dress Run, and is continuing to establish its own hash traditions. November 2015 will mark the one year anniversary for the HGMWH3 and its founders look forward to what adventures lay ahead.

You can now hash at least twice a month on the Big Island. HGMWH3 usually runs the first or second Saturday of the month.

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

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# **Our History**

he Gold Coast Hash House Harriers is the original Gold Coast club formed in May, 1978 by Terry Morrow (aka the Illusive Illusion) who had spent considerable time Hashing in South East Asia. After settling back on the Gold Coast, Terry and a few of his local mates decided the Gold Coast was ripe for Introducing some Hash culture. They put a hierarchy in place, found a suitable inaugural run site at the then Surfers Paradise Raceway, set a date and a run and bought some beer. After staggering through the local shiggy for a couple of hours with 40 other like-minded fools, then celebrating accordingly, a new Hash club was born.

GCH3 has gone from strength to strength and still hosts 30 to 40 runners and walkers each Monday evening with the emphasis being on a gourmet meal prepared by the hare, the traditional circle and a few beers and red wines to replace lost fluids. A GCH3 "Splinter Lunch" is held on the last Friday of every month for more gourmet food, beer and wine tasting and often attracts more attendees than the Monday night runs.

he Philippines hosts a number of hash anniversaries this coming October and La Union's 32<sup>nd</sup> Anniversary run takes place on Saturday 24th October On Friday, the day before, there will be a special hike to San Gabriel (Northeast of San Fernando) where you can cool off at the famous Tangaden waterfalls nearby.

La Union's premier annual hash event – the Haggis Bash – takes place later on Saturday 5th December. It's a unique event, incorporating a hash run, followed by the 'Highland Games' - a great collection of events with the emphasis on fun more than might. Volunteers and those 'volunteered' partake in games such as the sack race, egg and spoon race, tug of war, the plank walk, tossing the caber, and wanging the wellie. Scotch eggs are laid on for the spectators, and lots of





beverages. The final event – the pie eating contest – involves eating not only pies, but eggs and scotch eggs, washed down with San Miguel and whisky. It really is great fun –with the hashers normally supporting their participants. A regular winner, Nancy Boy from Angeles, has an unfair advantage as he evidently has a liking for egg shells as well as what is inside – everything just seems to go straight down this gullet.

The games take place in quiet rustic surroundings, close to Ask My Wife's Tropical Gardens, one of our hash venues. This year after the games we head back to JDs Beach Bar where the fun continues – the circle takes place followed by an excellent meal – and needless to say beer is flowing throughout.

Honey Dew, the incorrigible Scot and ex GM of La Union Hash, has been the main driving force behind organizing the Haggis Bash. Despite producing tones – literally – of mangoes yearly on his Pangasinan farm – he still finds time to ensure this event continues to be a success. Thanks to his consummate persuasive skills enough sponsorship money pours in each year to allow hashers to register for the Haggis Bash at a bargain basement price. And he has a good many hashers, including myself, locked in to sponsoring the event, at least for this lifetime.





The hash shirts provided for this event always have a peculiar Scottish theme and invariably are a good quality – I noticed quite a few hashers wearing them when hashing in Cambodia this year.

The Haggis Bash always attracts many visitors. The rainy season has ended and temperatures are down – ideal time of year for hashing. Driving time to La Union from Angeles and Manila continues to gets shorter as the new expressway makes it way further north.

Come along and take part in the fun of the Haggis Bash. It starts early at 2pm to allow enough time for a hash run – usually not very long – before the highland games at 4.30pm. This year there will be prizes for the winners. Try your luck in some of the events - you may even get a chance to join in the pie-eating contest.

#### THE FIRST (AND HOPEFULLY NOT LAST) ANNUAL UBBYLANGSJON RUN.

So I bought a summerhouse just north of Stockholm, and have been settling in there. The previous summer I did a few runs with the Absolut - and it seems that summer runs in the country are a good idea. Silly ConFeets run in Ljusterö, and Blo Queens run in Norrtalje. Well I figure I should do the same thing, and have a summer run from the new place. Everything is booked up except for July 18 2015, so I sign up for the date.

A year later and I'm back in Sweden for the summer, and I find out why the particular date was free - it coincides with Eurohash in Krakow, so most everyone will be away. That's OK, I am still happy to put on a hash for even one hasher on several occasions, Malibog and I were the only runners on an Underground trail I had set, and I have even set a trail in the depths of winter with noone turning up.

Anyway, I figure out I will see how many are coming, and can put on a trail and dinner for those who do turn up. It is wonderful running country, lots of forest, forestry roads, trails, bush and shiggy. Plus a number of lakes with good swimming, we can have a long run and a swim in the hot summer, perhaps even swim across the lake. One highlight of SillyCOnFeets

run was swimming half a kilometer o the final drink stop, so I figure I an do the same.

Fo cater for people coming by bus, figure we will do an A-B run from Gottrora Kyrka to the house, and then get people home by suitable logistics. So in the weeks up to the run I am scouting out the forestry roads and countryside north of the 77 highway between Rimbo and Uppsala, with a pretty good idea of where the trail will go. However three days before the run, we only

have one signed up, SCF, who will be driving there. Logistics dictate it is hardly worth meeting a single runner, and then having to get back to the starting point once we are done with the trail, so I figure that we can run from the house instead. So the trail gets changed, now I will run around the lake, with a possible swim across at the narrowest point. Its a good run, about 10km, and I did the circumnavigation last (dry) summer, so I start rescouting. Now we have had a very wet spring (May was the wettest since the 1960's), and it has continued to rain for the last couple of months, so everything in the country around the lake is boggy and overgrown. Plenty of shiggy, but this is going too far. The morning of the run, it is still raining so I figure another change of trail is going to be needed.

Also in the last couple of days we have had a few more sign up. Sprintosaurus had previously (in a ten page email) indicated he \*might\* be coming, depending on weather and the bad weather caused him to cut short his holiday and come back for the run. SCF managed to sign up JB and FB at the Underground, so now we had four, Four is a pack as far as am concerned (a four-pack?). So on the morning I get an email from the Doggys, indicating they will be here, along

with hashlings. The trail I had planned was definitely not child friendly (shiggy and wet forest) so a walkers trail would be difficult to arrange. Instead I figured on a shorter shiggy trail, followed all doing a walkers trail ending up to look at some local wildlife.

Trail laid, and all ready to go. SCF turns up with Sprinto, FB and JB, a bit early becaues meeting the bus at Rimbo. We have a pre run beer - Sprinto has nicely bought some Coopers Stout. (Coopers is the last remaining Australian family owned brewery, and they make pretty good beers, all the rest are sold to Kirin and other multinationals). Come 3.00pm and no sign of the Doggy's, but they call and are just a few minutes away, so we wait, no hurry here, the sun is out and it is a nice afternoon.

We leave Doggy Style and kids (plus visitor) and set off into the wet and wild. We run around the lake for a few checks, then branch back on the southern forestry road. A short run along the main road to Knutby, then off east towards Naturreservat. More forestry tracks, then into the forest and off trail for a km or so. SCF finds chantarelle mushrooms. Noted for later visit. Back across the main road, past the

> phone mast, through some more shiggy, along the power lines and back home. About 6.5km with a few checks.

Now we pick up the family for part II. A short walk along the lake, then another forestry road, ending in a swampy lake with a lot of dead trees. The question is what killed the trees. Answer, beaver, or rather the beaver dam, which I found by looking for the exit of the lake, and where it was blocked. We have a drink stotp and then We make our

way to the dam for a photo stop, with SCF crossing the dam and photographs us.

Then on in for the circle. A few fines, for the hare, virgin run, visitor, wrong habadashery, Sprinto for his long email. Next, a swim in the lake, the children play in the boat while the rest of us swim out to the deeper water. Lake is quite warm even without much of a summer.

Time to light the grill, which is your generic aussie barbie, constructed from cinder blocks, bits of grill and iron, a pipe duct and other bits and pieces I have scavenged from here and there. Basically you just load it with wood (of which I have vast quantities), allow it to burn down to coals, then grill on radiant heat. I need to plant a few oaks to get some good hardwood, since fir burns too quickly.





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
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
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
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




















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
