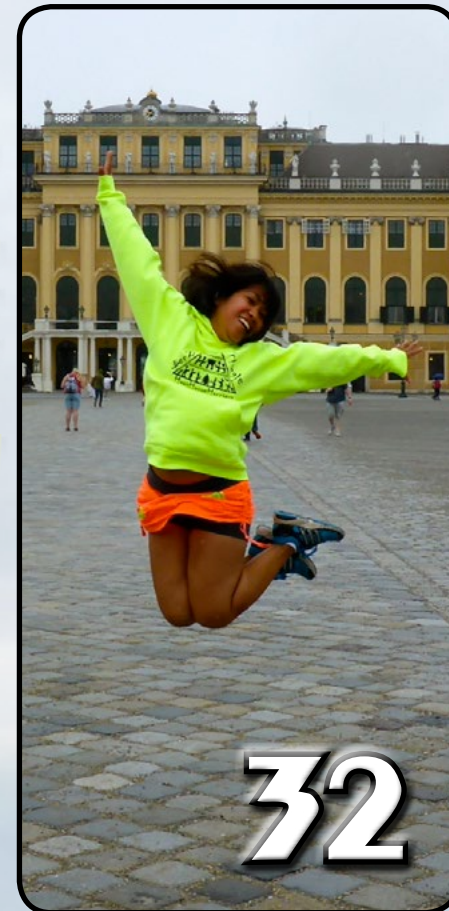

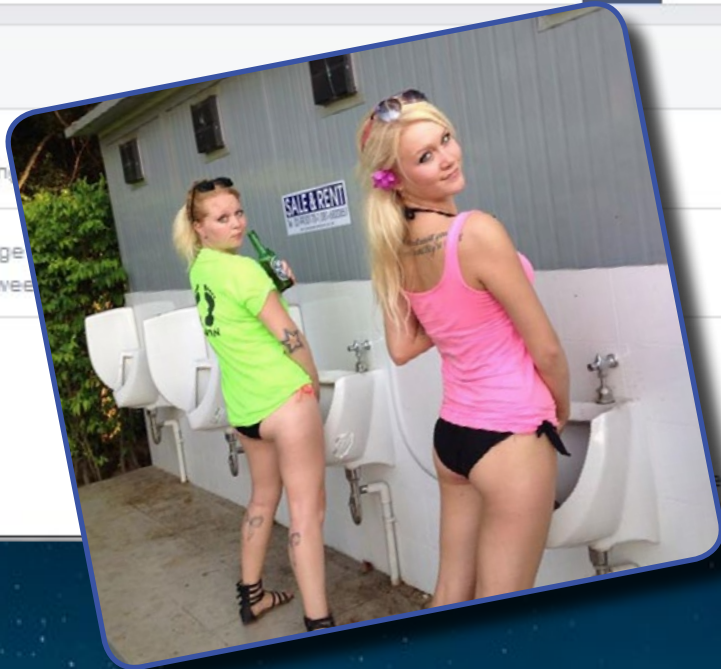

2015 Southeast Regional Hobo Hash

Every year, a multi-city hash event occurs in the Southeast region of the United States. Charlotte and Tampa Hash House Harriers alternate as hosts each year of this “Hobo Hash”, where first-time ambassawhores and veterans alike are encouraged to visit and explore other regional kennels.



This year's Hobo Hash, hosted by and originating at Charlotte H3, will head south, actually connecting directly with Florida state hashers with Jacksonville and working its way north up the coast. This gauntlet of debauchery runs through Savannah, GA, Fayetteville, NC with the famed Carolina Trash, their neighbors Southern Pines (SoPi) and end back up in Charlotte to finish off the shenanigans with Charlotte's newest and currently rowdiest kennel, SMUSHHH (South Mecklenburg Urban Shiggy H3).

Each kennel's mismanagement is providing camping and/or crash space, a meal, a shiggy trail and of course plenty of beer. Rego fees will be kept relatively modest and the traveling hobos are strongly encouraged to carpool with one another, not only to ensure that designated drivers can change hands and save on fuel, but gives an opportunity for same town hashers to bond a little more closely.

EUROPEAN BUS TOUR RECAP

Six European countries in five days. Sounds adventurous, exciting, maybe even exhausting? Well, for 35 hashers from all parts of the world on their way to Eurohash in Krakow, it was all of the above.

The European Bus Tour organized by Hash Travel took us through some of the most scenic landscapes and exciting cities in Europe. HashTravel.com is the master half-mind of Automatic Balls, a well-known hasher based in Frankfurt. He organizes hash trips for hashers, usually as a pre- or post lube to bigger hash events.

The bus trip started off bright and early on a Sunday morning from Frankfurt. Most of the visiting hashers had the opportunity to attend the S.H.I.T.S. (Saturday Hash In The Summertime) the previous day. After a speedy drive south down the German autobahn the pack arrived in the Bavarian city of Munich. Here we were greeted by local hashers Cumming Numb & Smokestack with a glass of champagne. Nice DIVA touch.

The trail along the Isar river passed the nudist beach (the liberal Bavarian mentality grants nudists their place by the river since the 1960s) and continued into the Hofbräu Keller beer garden where a typical snack of Brezel & Obatzer (Bavarian cheese delicacy) was served. The evening saw plenty of imbibing of Munich's finest Weissbier (wheat beer). There is no better way to spend an evening in Munich!

The next leg of the journey was to beautiful, romantic Vienna, Austria's capital.

Vienna lies on the Danube river and is packed with imperial history. It was once the capital of the Austro-Hungarian Empire.

Most hashers spent their free time wandering the historical streets sightseeing before meeting up for their third hash in three days! The trail was laid by local hashers leading from the city center to the famous amusement park Prater. The Prater includes the famous Giant Ferris Wheel which is the trademark of Vienna.

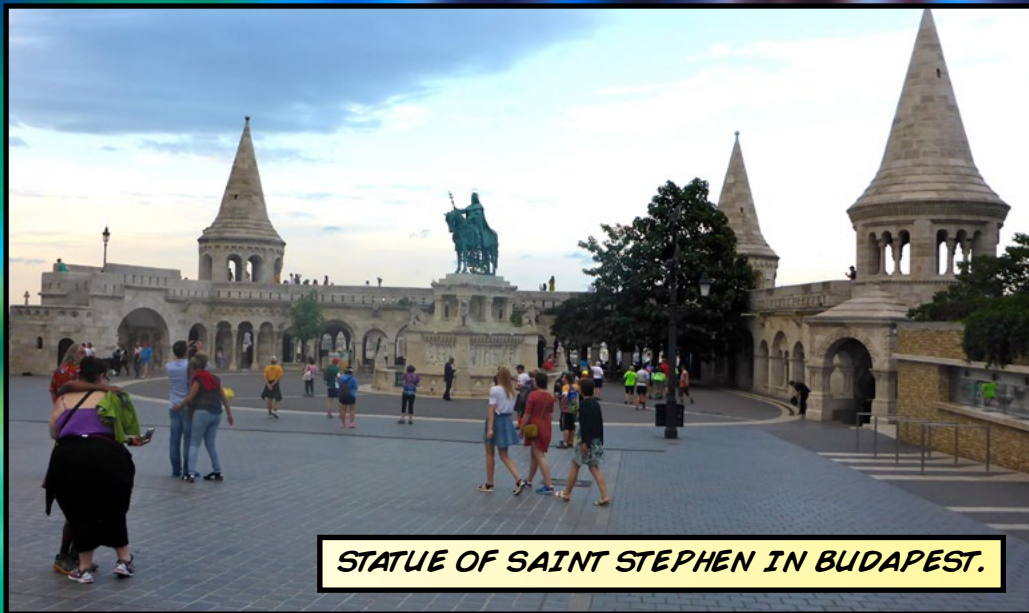
On day three the bus journey continued to Bratislava, Slovakia. Vienna and Bratislava are only 35 miles (56km) apart. This is where Daffidilo (my worthier half in terms of drinking) and myself joined the tour as mystery hares. We flew into Bratislava the night before with a vague plan of laying trail from the castle into town. We had been to Bratislava five years earlier on a day trip from Vienna and knew that the main sights were in walking distance and that the beer was cheap. We found two lovely beer stops and hosted a short circle before hopping on the bus to continue to Budapest. First part of the mission accomplished!

In the evening we arrived in the capital city of Hungary and were once again greeted by local hashers who took us on a walking tour of their stunning city.

Budapest occupies both banks of the Danube with Buda on the west bank and Pest on the east. We were staying in the flat eastern district of Pest and had to climb up Castle Hill to reach Buda's Old Town with sweeping views of the cities numerous World Heritage Sites.

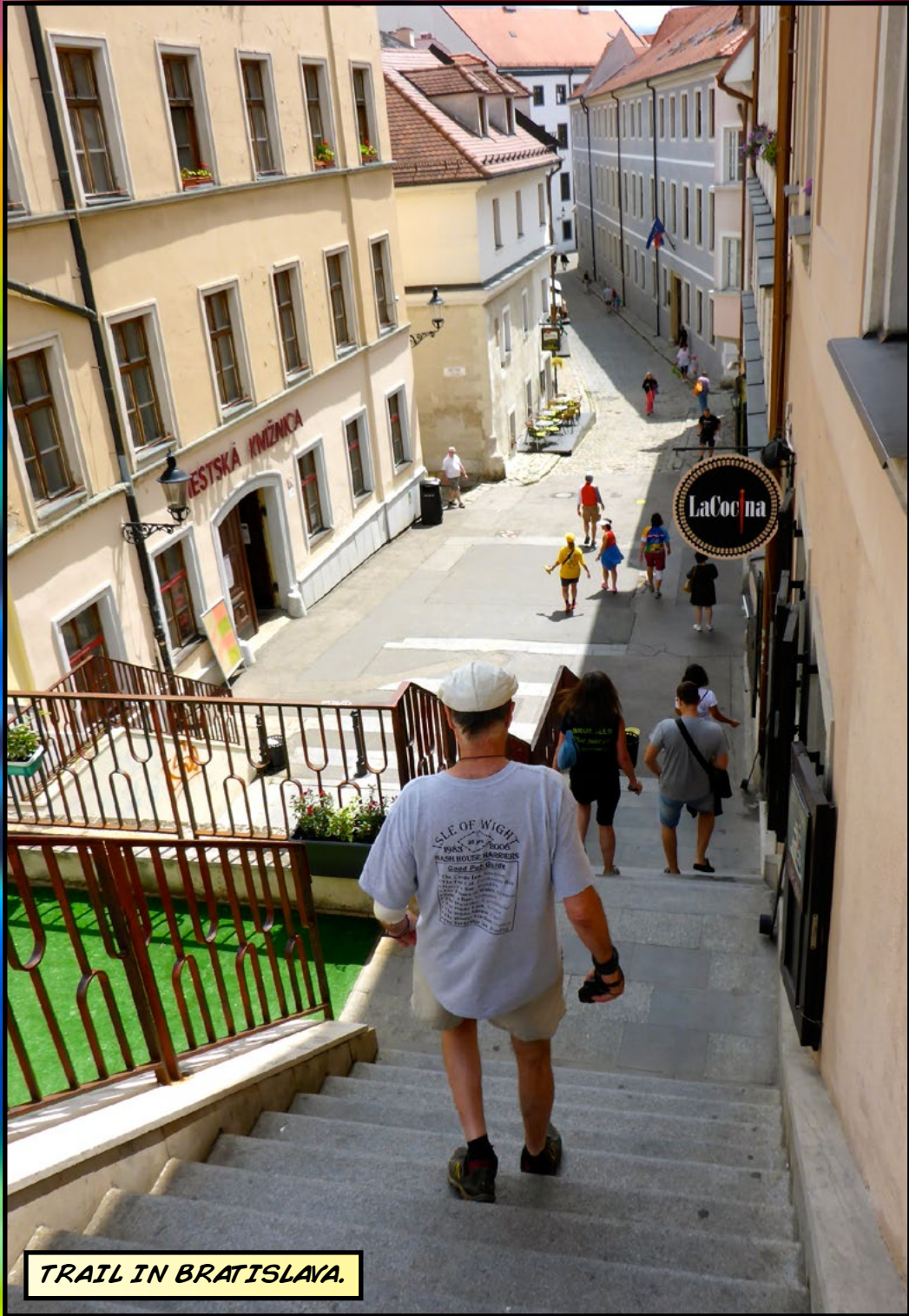


After several beerstops on our pub crawl we stopped for a traditional Hungarian dinner. The city was amazingly illuminated in the dark and the hashers enjoyed the night lit river side attractions before heading back to the hotel.

As our journey continued the next day, we found ourselves on the longest leg of the trip. For hours and hours we passed fields of sunflowers. With no border control, it was difficult to figure out in which country you were in. Hash songs and adult beverages did not help either!

When we finally reached our late lunch stop in the city of Ostrava in the Czech Republic , the bus parking lot was being used as an open air festival. We weren't successful in convincing the guards that we were a live-act arriving to perform at the festival. He must have heard us singing hash songs on arrival!

The bus driver found parking elsewhere and our tour here was off to lay a short trail.

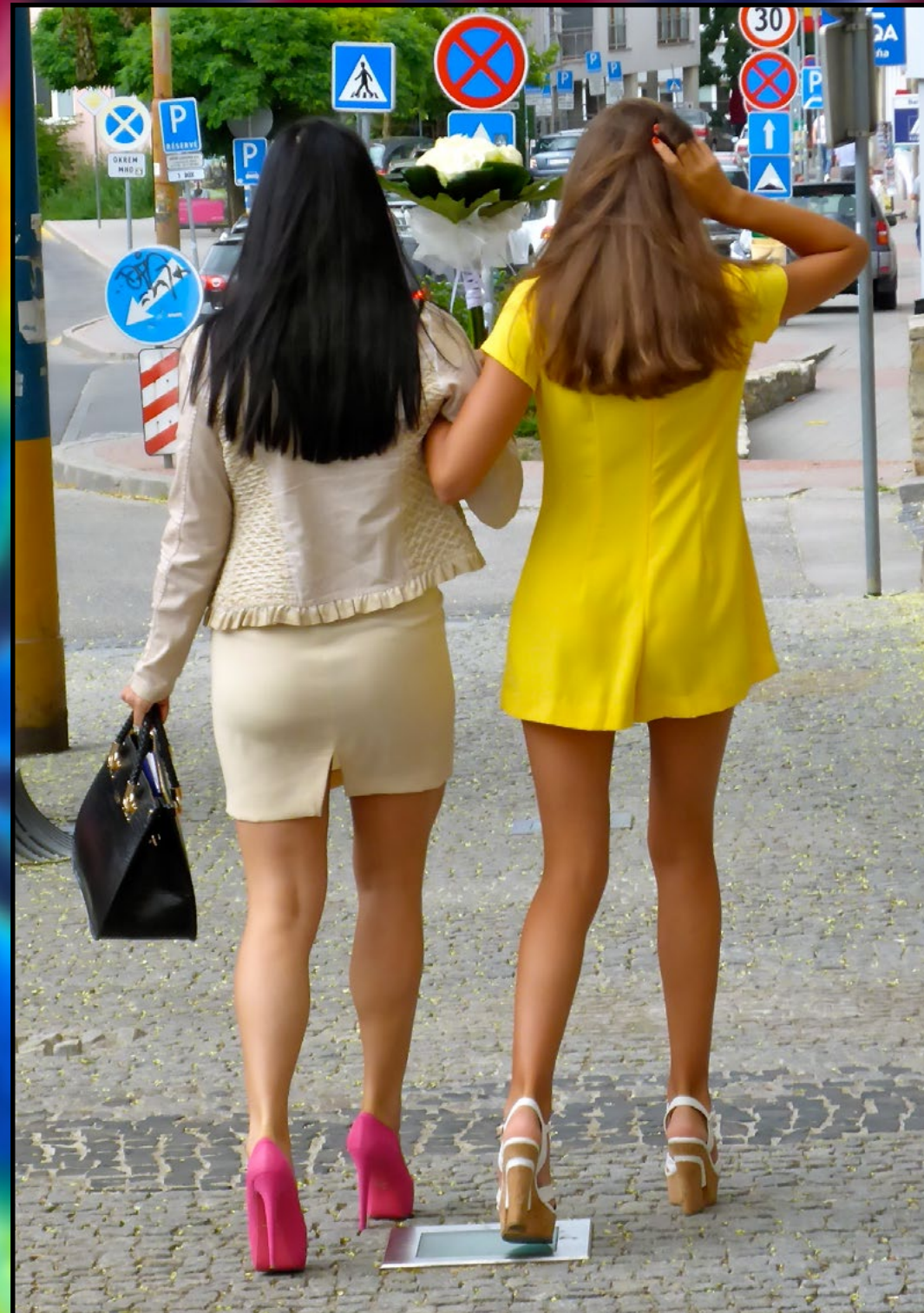

It got very confusing at times. Germany, Austria and Slovakia are on the Euro, The Hungarian currency is the Forint and the Czech pride the Koruna. Of course in Poland we would have to get used to another currency. At the end of my trip I had six currencies in my wallet including US Dollar and British Pounds. 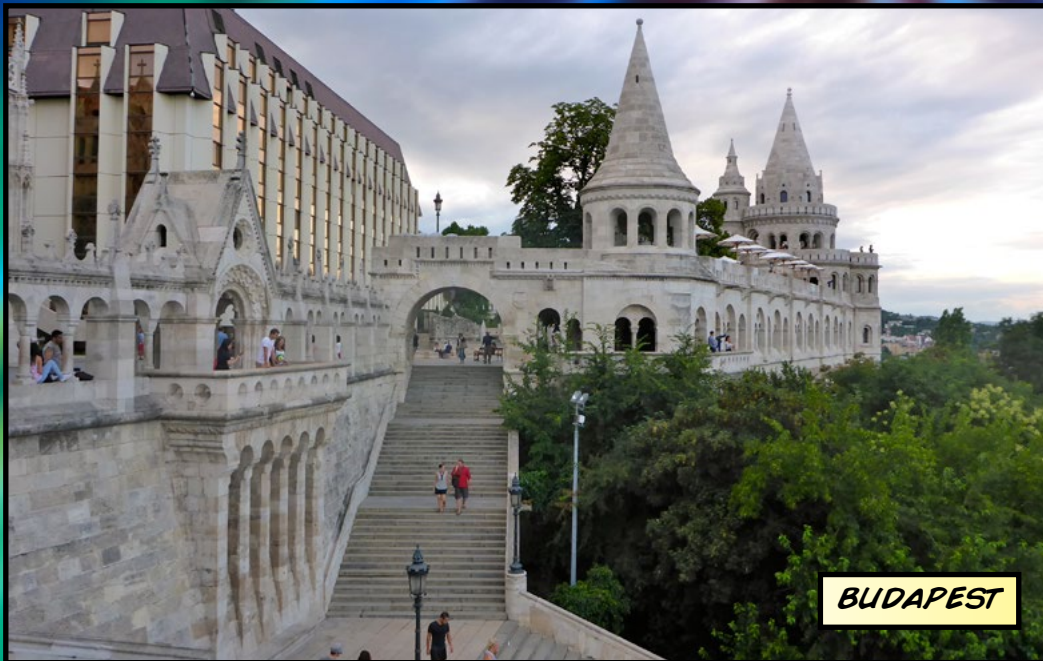

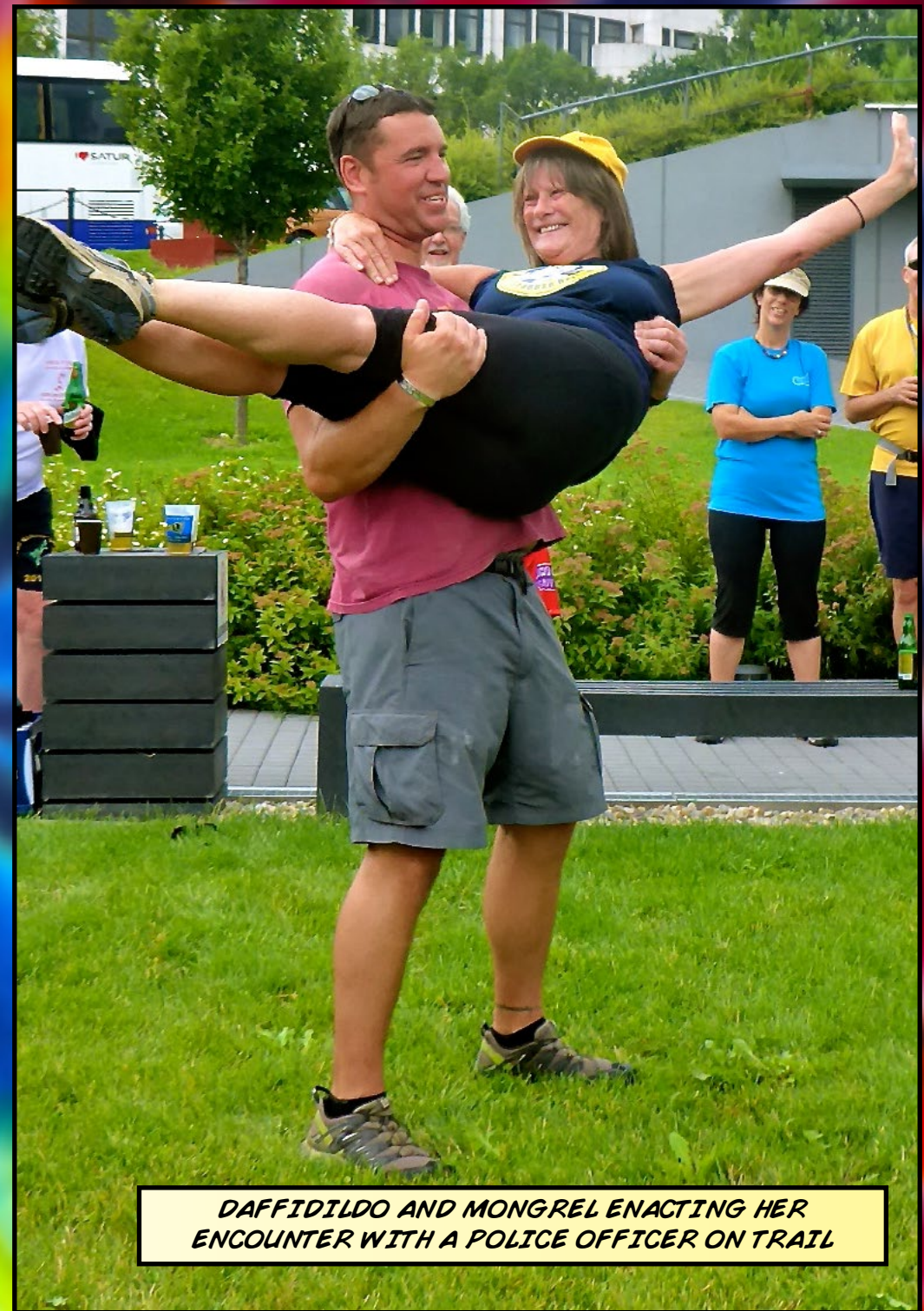
On our fifth and last day of the bus tour it was only a short drive to Krakow and we were treated to another brewery tour. This time it was the Tyskie brewery, the largest brewery in Poland. The one hour tour was informative and the beer at the end was highly appreciated. Once the hash learned that there were "take-away beers" available, most partook in them. Many hash hymns were brought to their best (or worse). The bus arrived in time for the red dress run.

We hashed all over Europe, consuming local beers, tasting traditional cuisine and enjoying amazing scenery while making new friends from all over the world. The European Bus Tour was a success and I look forward to seeing my hash friends at future events.

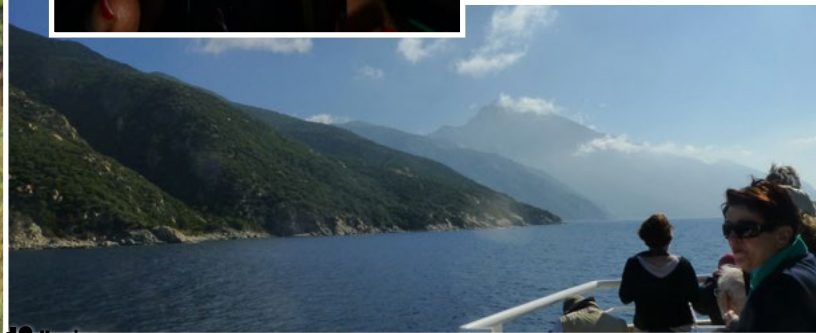

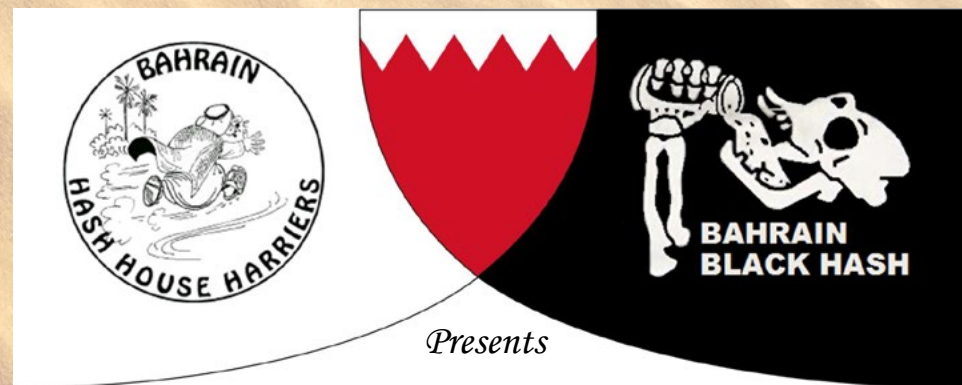

The 3rd International Mountain Bike Hash was held recently in Kuching, Sarawak, Malaysia over the weekend of 10 – 12 July. With over 150 bike hashers from 14 nationalities and some 14 chapters in attendance, the event featured some great jungle single track, lots of food and grog and the type of Borneo tribal onon that one would expect in Kuching.

The event was hosted by the Kuching Bike Hash (established in 2003), which offered to host the event after attending the IBH2 in Thailand. Both the IBH2 and the inaugural IBH1 were organized and hosted by the Bangkok Mountain Bike Hash.

For the IBH3, the hashers were based in Kuching with the registration and welcome dinner held at the Kuching City South complex. During the welcome dinner all the various chapters were introduced in the appropriate manner and the host chapter thanked their sponsors for supporting the event. With the formalities out of the way, a free flow of draft beer and some local entertainment kept the spirits high for the evening.

The main Saturday ride was held out of town in the village of Apar at the Borneo Tribal Village. The bikes and hashers were transported to the start site where they met the village headmen before embarking on either the long or short ride. Prior to the flag off, a donation to each of the three local communities was made on behalf of the event.

The long ride started first and many of the riders who scoffed at the 'only' 23 km long ride were soon humbled as it became clear that this was to be 23 km of jungle track, narrow root-covered trails, narrow bamboo bridges and river crossings. The Borneo jungle does not allow one to coast along the trail easily, so it was a well-earned beer when the last check finally came.

The short ride was a mere 12 km and followed the second half of the long ride so all the bashers were able to experience the Borneo single tracks. As the pack emerged from the jungle, the final section was 2 km of rocky road before the beer wagon. At the end of the ride, the registration crew was busy checking in all the riders and announced that there were still 5 to come – including the Bangkok Hash GM. No one was too worried as a sweeper was coming last and would find anyone on the trail. The trouble was – he was not on the trail. The sweeper arrived and no GM.

A truck was dispatched to collect the cargo and the down-downs were prepared for his arrival.

The rest of the evening was a blur of rewards, down-downs, performances, boat races, lucky draws (donated thanks to Giant) and lots of beer.

The Sunday ride was a city ride to nurse sore legs and heads and a second jungle ride was also arranged for those still keen to experience more Kuching trails. The city ride took those who showed up through the central part of Kuching, across the river and through the Malay villages surrounding some of the more historical parts of the city. The ride ended at the City South Car park where final photos were taken before the bashers headed back to pack bikes and get ready for flights home.

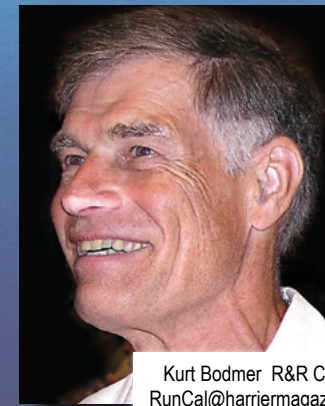

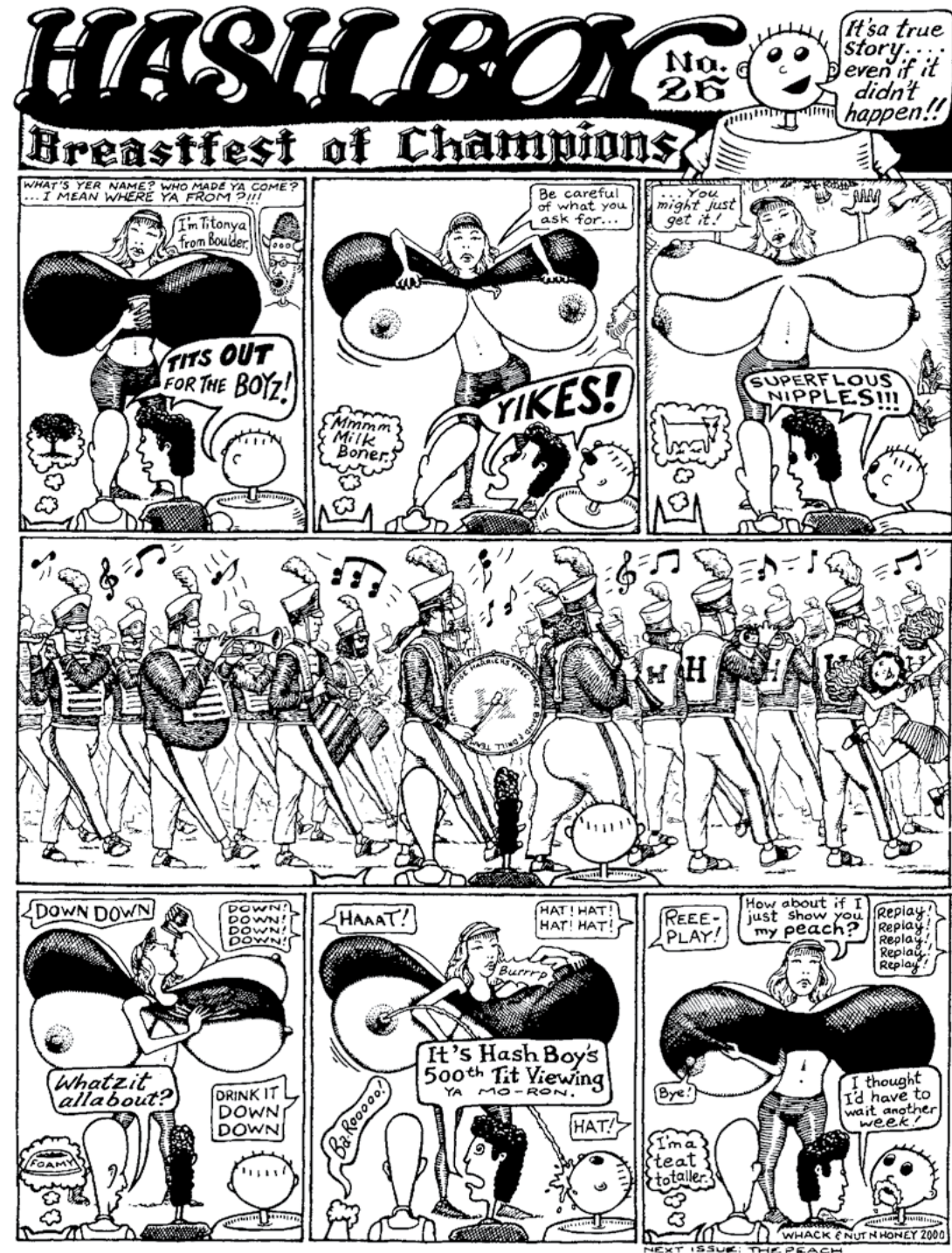

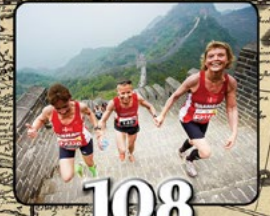
