Those lucky hashers who plan on being in Angeles City for the local chapter's 2000th hash run in early December will have an extra special treat in store for them in the form of the 1st Annual Angeles City Craft Beer Festival, which will be held on the very same weekend as the local hash club's big celebration run.

This amazing event, which will take place on December 2-4 at Marquee Mall's beautiful outdoor Marquee Park, will offer the perfect spot for pre and post hash run revelry. 15 micro-breweries from around the Philippines will be showcasing their latest hand crafted lagers, pilsners, ales and IPA's, plus a handful of imported craft beers. All in all, festival goers will have nearly 100 different artisanal beers to choose from in one single place. Happy days indeed!

Of course no event in the Philippines is complete without a great spread of food and music. Festival goers will have the opportunity to enjoy their craft beers with a selection of gourmet international and local food provided by celebrity chefs and unique local food outlets, live jazz music, educational beer seminars and plenty of fun and games.

For those unfamiliar with the term, craft beer refers to beer that is made by a brewery that is small, independent and that uses traditional methods of brewing. Craft beers are made by hand using the highest quality ingredients, with no preservatives or chemicals, and come in literally endless varieties with varying tastes and alcohol content.

Craft beer has literally exploded in popularity in most parts of the world over the last decade and has, in the last three years, started to take hold in the Philippines. Several dozen micro-breweries have sprung up throughout the country, including the Pinatubo Craft Brewery in Angeles City, to service a fast growing demand for better quality beer. And these breweries are starting to consistently deliver some very good world class beers.



One unique feature of the Angeles City Craft Beer Festival will be that patrons can meet the brewers behind the very drinks they are holding in their hand. It all adds up to what looks to be one amazing time.

“This is a chance for the beer drinking public in Angeles, Central Luzon and beyond to experience something new, to meet the very people who create this liquid gold and to have a lot fun” said festival organizer Ted Lerner, a long time Angeles City resident.

“I’ve always loved the vibe that surrounds craft beer gatherings. It makes people happy and the scene is really cool. We are going to have breweries from Cebu, Manila, Sagada, Palawan, the US, and Japan, and right here in Angeles City all together in one place. Throw in the amazing food and music, and a spectacular outdoor venue at Marquee Mall and we have the ingredients for a legendary great time. In my opinion it can’t get much better than that.”



Tickets for the festival will cost P250 and include one free craft beer.

Vienna hosts the world's greatest EuroHash

Vienna, Austria's capital, lies in the country's east on the Danube River. Its artistic and intellectual legacy was shaped by residents including Mozart, Beethoven and Sigmund Freud. The city is also known for its Imperial palaces, including Schönbrunn, the Habsburgs' summer residence. In the MuseumsQuartier district, historic and contemporary buildings display works by Egon Schiele, Gustav Klimt and other artists.

With half of the places for next year's EuroHash already snapped up, the pressure is on the organisers to ensure Vienna is in a fit state to welcome 800 arm-raising thirsty athletes in July 2017.

The event's committee are closely observing the progress of similar prestigious spectacles, such as the UEFA Euro football championships in Paris this month and the Olympic shindig in bankrupt Rio in August, swapping notes to ensure excellence is achieved and the same old slip-ups are avoided.



As with any major sporting event, the key occupation for participants is making sure there is enough drinking, a place to sleep is secured and a crazy amount of enjoyable fun is had, (while some sporting activity is engaged on the margins). EuroHash 2017 is no exception.

Taking these in turn, an extraordinary venue has been secured for evening festivities. The owners of the huge hundred-year-old bake house, which until recently provided most 'Wieners' (or Viennese) with their daily doughy sustenance, will have just completed renovations to their large and spacious hall in time for us to mess it all up.



The Ankerbrot (no errant 'W's in front, please) is conveniently located close to the four star Hash hotel and the Hash hostel. Mates-rates have been specially negotiated and they are taking reservations **now**.

As for the fun, give us a chance, it was tough enough working on the first two.

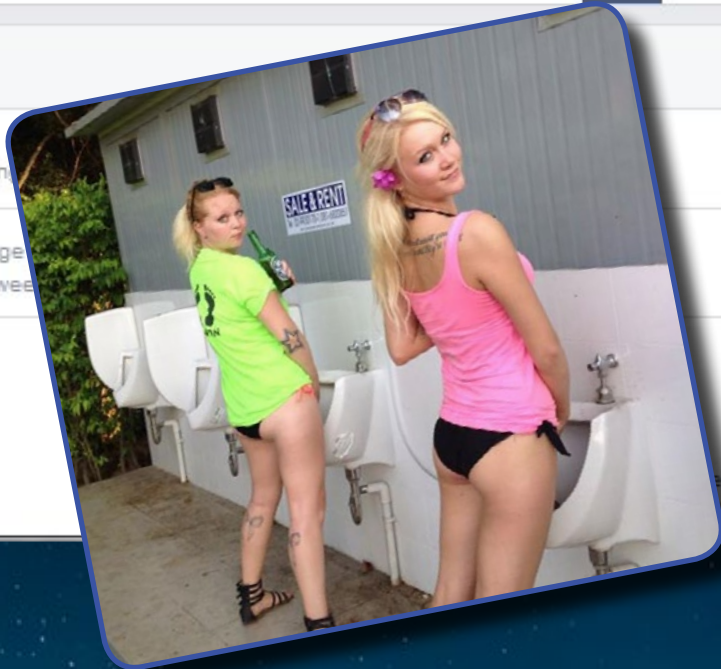

HAWAIIAN TRAILS

There are a few things you should know about Hawaiian trails. Most are on sand, mud, boulders, or other surfaces that you may be familiar with in your part of the world. Then there are mountain trails with pockets of muddy feral pig wallows, stream crossings, tree roots, pine forests, thorny fern undergrowth, and lots of mosquitoes. Hawaii does not have bears, snakes, rabid animals, poison oak, poison ivy or stinging nettle in our forests and jungles. You may encounter an occasional wild pig, feral chicken, hunting dog or lost tourist.

We recommend that anyone intending to do the trails on O'ahu, Maui, the Big Island or Kaua'i bring a pair of trail shoes with good tread, mosquito repellent (if these critters find you delectable), and knee length socks so you don't leave your skin attached to the ferns. You will be rewarded with panoramic views of our mountain ranges and beaches, cascading waterfalls, bamboo groves, fragrant ginger and wild orchids.

HASHING IN 'THE WORLD OF SUZY WONG'

The Wanchai Hash was founded by Howard 'Dances With Dogs' McKay, Bruce 'Shirley Temple' Fletcher and Tony 'Nana' Caplan in 1988. The first run was just after church on Sunday the 10th of April from The Wanch bar, just a stone's throw from the bar district and Lok Fuk hotel immortalised in the Richard Mason novel and Nancy Kwan – William Holden movie, The World of Suzie Wong.

WH3 is the largest of the 17 Hong Kong hash kennels and was originally set up to cater for the many Filipina domestic helpers who have Sunday as a holiday but little to do, and although mixed, the Wanchai Hash is always lead by a Grand Mattress. A typical Sunday run will see around 50 to 70 Harriettes and Hashers following trail somewhere in the rugged countryside of one of Hong Kong's 237 islands, many beaches or the New Territories and occasionally amongst the skyscrapers and parks of Kowloon or Central.

The Harriettes are the backbone of the Wanchai Hash, often organising themed runs, Circle games, and on site home cooked OnOns. WH3 certainly embraces the age old Hash philosophy of "a drinking club with a running problem" and is home to the World renowned 'Flipper Boat Race Team'. This team of under 5 foot tall Harriettes challenges all

comers to a beer drinking competition and are, as yet, unbeaten. Even the mighty visiting U.S. Navy teams have slunk back to their ships with their tails between their legs. There have been accusations of breaking the rules, not drinking all their beer, getting the sailors drunk before the race and spiking the Navy drinks but there are no rules on the Wanchai Hash!

The Wanchai Hash still runs In The World of Suzy Wong at 4pm, just after church, every Sunday. All Harriettes and Hashers are most welcome. Check out our next run at www.wanchai3.com.

REGISTRATIONS ABOUT TO OPEN

Cebu Hash is close to 20 years old and is based in and around Cebu City (approximately half way up or down on the east coast of Cebu Island).

Cebu is a longish, thin island with a narrow coastal plain along each coast with a multitude of steep-sided hills running south to north along its central spine. For Hashers, this means that much of the flat land is built up or fenced in. This leaves the hilly interior for most of our Runs. Browse our website at <http://cebuhash.org/index.php> to see the sort of places we regularly Hash.

Unfortunately, some of these places are a tad off the beaten track – they might not require a 4 wheel drive vehicle to get there but definitely need something with a high ground clearance (SUV, pickup, etc). Normally, we use our own vehicles to get to the start of our Runs. This can be problematical when we have a shit load of visitors to transport.

Cebu City itself has many upmarket (expensive) hotels and a wide variety of lower cost (but OK) places to stay at. There are also a handful of large (expensive) beach resorts scattered around the island. Unfortunately, the more economical resorts are not very large. We do not recommend staying on Mactan Island (Lapu Lapu) over a Hash weekend. By the way, there is not a large red-light bar district as such in Cebu.

The 2017 Philippine Nash Hash over May 19TH to 21ST



BASIC OUTLINE PROGRAM – (more to be added)

Friday 19TH there will be an afternoon arduous hills hike trail just outside the city proper.

For evening fun, a bar crawl run is being arranged.

Saturday 20TH is the main run day and après cycle party at Genesis Valley Resort (current plan) just over the Cebu City / Consolacion border. A short walkers trail, a slightly longer one, and a 12km minimum ball buster. Open air circles leading on to gallons of beer with grub and entertainment. (Small swimming pool available at extra cost).

Sunday 21ST will see a late morning set of recovery runs (one short + one long). We hope this will be in sight of the sea and we can find a field in which to party away the afternoon.

FEES

We are working on the host of logistics matters regarding accommodation, transport, grub, beer, etc, but to keep you all satisfied with beer and grub quantities plus transporting you to the venues we have set the fee at Phil Peso 4,500 per head.

This is based on a limit of +/- 150 Hashers and will need to be paid (IN PHILIPPINE PESO) by 28TH February 2017 latest. Higher priced rego's may still be available up to final cut-off date of 20TH April 2017. For those able to pay in cash in Cebu there will be a discount. Otherwise, payments are to be made in Peso through PayPal.

Details will be on a special Cebu Nash Hash 2017 website currently under construction but available soon.

Through Beer

There are more than 130 countries celebrating World Peace Thru Beer in 2016. including groups in Europe, Asia, Oceania, the Middle East and the U.S. The web site with info is worldpeacethroughbeer.org. There are no rules, though the way most runs are constructed is short legs of trail leading to beer stops that each represent another country, based on the local availability of imported beer. In Music City we serve a 4 ounce cup of beer (the imports are expensive) at each stop, and have about six stops plus beer at the end. The theme beer of the year is usually served at the end (this year Tsingtao, in honor of the Interhash in Hainan).

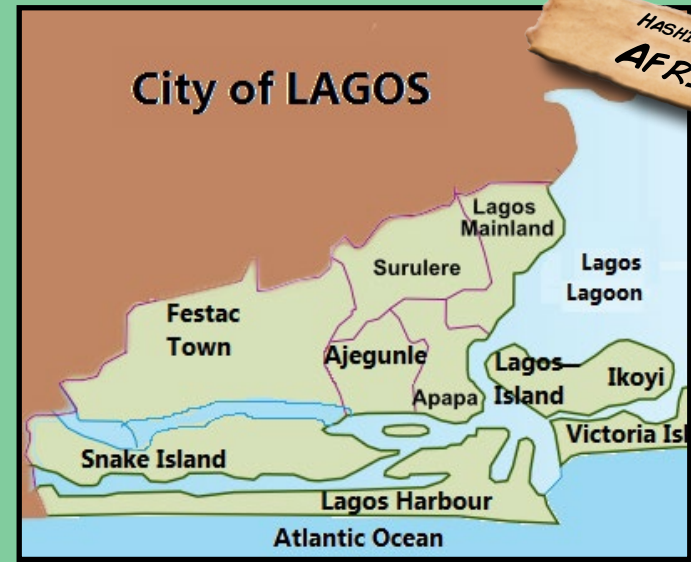
Pan Africa Hash 2017 in Lagos

Death on the Hash Challenge

As a veteran of 3 hash challenges in Malaysia and a keen, if somewhat irregular hasher, I was very sad to hear of the death of 'Thomas Cools', on the trail.

I was at the finish this year and ran the normal run whose run-site coincided with the Challenge end. After the normal run a few of us went back in to rescue a guy who had been attacked by bees and was having a bad reaction, luckily the St. John's ambulance were there on standby for the Challenge, so we made use of one of their stretchers and they took him to hospital later. It shows that things can occur on a normal run, not just the Challenge.

As time went on and dusk began to fall, it was noted that Thomas was later than expected. His team mate who had pulled out at the water stop after Thomas was last seen, went back to see if he could find him, to no avail. Others searched as much as possible until the fading light made the jungle impossible to see off trail.

The trail is divided into 4 sections each with a water stop where some water, food, bananas, rice etc is provided. After the last runner enters a new section, the hares will walk through behind them to look for people injured or unable to continue and help them out. Sweepers.

.... I am certainly not a front runner, nor all that competitive, but last time I ran the Challenge we finished about halfway down the list of finishers. I was 58 yrs old then and took about 11 hours to complete it. We (my team) did however start to train gently about 4 months before the event. My strategy was to maintain a fast walking speed throughout the challenge, I had to 'regulate' one of my team mates, who is a much better runner, as he would not have lasted the distance. My wife, also in the team, managed to keep up pretty well.

It is an event that puts very different demands on your body than the normal hash. For our club, the normal run is about 1.5 hours, for me maybe 1hr 50min. So an 11 hour event is a totally different kettle of fish. We never trained more than 4 hours in one go, but found that adequate to build our endurance up. I have friends who are far better runners than I in the club (nearly everyone!) but many of them cannot manage the challenge/ It is only when you try, that you know if you can hydrate properly. The first thing is of course to drink enough, to eat bananas, to have electrolyte in your drink...but not to have too much electrolyte, that can also cause problems, and to drink before you are thirsty. The second thing, that you probably cannot control, is how fast your metabolism allows the water you drink to get into your body. This is most likely where Thomas had a problem, it is likely that he had enough to drink, but that his body didn't absorb it fast enough, and hence he dehydrated. I have occasionally seen others have this problem and they were helped out of the trail and given medical care.

Sunday Search Site



Some questions were raised if the challenge was properly administered, or if it should be stopped. I have to say that the people who arrange it spend a lot of time and effort to not only set the run, but to organise water stops, sweepers for each section, to arrange communication between the water stops, the sweepers and the organizing team, and to arrange for St John's ambulance to be on site. Many of the organizing team have done the challenge before, or organised previous ones, so it is an experienced team that sets the challenge.

I went in the following morning to search for Thomas with around 50 hashers and many rubber estate workers who knew the area well. The paper trail was well laid and easy to follow, so there can be no criticism there. Later in the morning we had not found him and the authorities were informed. By evening, fire, police and civil defence teams had joined the search, but all were unsuccessful. The search resumed Monday morning and a hasher found him just 200 metres off the trail. He had died of heat exhaustion and dehydration.

I am sure in the next weeks and months there will be many discussions on how to improve safety and that is a positive thing. At the end of the day it is exactly what it says ...a challenge, it is something different, not for everyone, but still with the excellent hash camaraderie which sets it apart from the other 42km trail runs that exist around the world. Is there an element of risk? Absolutely, but there is also a risk in riding a motor bike to work. The Challenge is safer than motor racing, and safer than climbing Everest!

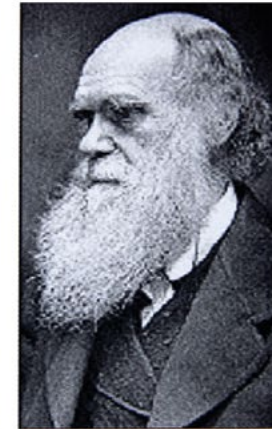

The Hash Darwin Awards

Old Chaz, the chap on the right, in one of his sober moments, put forward the notion of “survival of the fittest”, a concept that implies that the removal from the gene pool (usually by death) of its weaker members, thereby strengthens the survival chances of the remainder. However, here at OTI, we do not encourage the extermination of the less able, the feeble, or the intellectually challenged. Rather, we encourage them to become hashers! Further, this column aims to be a forum where the moronic misdeeds of hashers might be chronicled in pursuit of that noblest of pastimes, namely, having cheap laughs at other people’s expense. With that in mind, I offer the following:

The title of this latest installment in the long-running experiment in sub-Gonzo journalism that is “On The Ice” is taken from a poem by William Blake, one of the greatest English poets and a man memorably described by the critic Robert Hunt as “an unfortunate lunatic, whose personal inoffensiveness secures him from incarceration”. In his poem, Blake was meditating on the mental and physical price we pay for the experiences we encounter on our all too brief journey through life. Thoughts of this nature often occur to me and they usually centre on the price my body, principally my liver, is paying

for the experiences I have been putting it through, particularly over the last twenty years of hashing and drinking in Southeast Asia.

Well it seems there is some good news related to those latter two inextricably linked pastimes. New research by University College London and the University of Sydney (good school that) found that drinking - even within the so-called “safe” guidelines issued by nanny states the world over - raises the risk of early death by at least 16 per cent and cancer by 47 per cent. Sounds bad, right? However, the researchers also found

that two hours a week of moderate physical activity completely cancelled out the increased risk of death while lowering the cancer risk by 36 per cent. Two hours a week of moderate physical activity for most of us is two hash runs. In fact, depending on the

hare, it could be just one. This is great news. It means the price of one enjoyable activity (drinking) can be paid at the low cost of another (usually) enjoyable one. (I say “usually” because, again, a lot depends on the hare.)

But the good news doesn't end there. Exercise has benefits even for those of us who drink at levels considered to be “hazardous” by lemon-faced prudes who work in government offices. (If you must know, in the UK “hazardous” is defined as more than 49 standard drinks a week, a level that I would define, borrowing the line from the great Hunter

S. Thompson as “the high end of social”.) The researcher found that while “hazardous” drinking usually raises the risk of early death by 20 per cent and cancer death by 52 per cent, moderate exercise lowered the risks to 9 per cent and 18 per cent respectively. Two hash runs a week is a price I am more than willing to pay. In fact the researchers found that if you bumped the exercise up to five hours a week, even the additional risks from “hazardous” drinking dropped back to zero. So if you are lucky enough to live in a city that boasts multiple hashes, what are you waiting for? Pour yourself a large one just as I am doing right now.

Of course, there is a price beyond the physical to be paid for drinking and here I must delve into the vulgar topic of money. Most of my alcohol purchasing decisions these days are based on price. This has become particularly true since I acquired two things I had long lived without – a wife and a child: one of them cries a lot and is expensive and the other is my child. Consequently, I like to get as much bang for my buck as possible. Thus it was that I was horrified recently to see Carlsberg had started selling a product in Thailand called “Carlsberg Zero”. The more literate among you may have guessed that this product is that most pointless of all things, a no-alcohol beer. Since it is for sale it must have a price but I did not bother even to look for whatever the price is. It is one I am unwilling to pay. In fact, I am fairly sure that I wouldn't drink it even if given it for free – unless of course it had some potential as a gin mixer that is.


I did attempt to look up some online reviews for Carlsberg Zero and, while I did find vendors selling it even in the UK (Has the land that produced Winston “I have taken more out of alcohol than alcohol has taken out of me” Churchill fallen so low?), I couldn’t find any comments on its taste; or is that what the zero refers to, perhaps?

No Carlsberg Zero for me then. An old friend in Australia once said that drinking low-alcohol beer was like getting “half a headjob” and I’m certainly not paying any price for the metaphorical equivalent of no headjob at all.

Pondering the bizarre world of no-alcohol beers led me to look into what the world’s strongest beer might be. At first guess, I thought the Belgians or possibly the Germans would be leading the field in this area but I was wrong. It is in fact the Scots.

A beer called “Snake Venom”, from Scottish brewery, Brewmeister, clocks in at 67.5% ABV and is made with smoked peat malt and both Champagne yeast and ale yeast. It sounds a cracker to me. 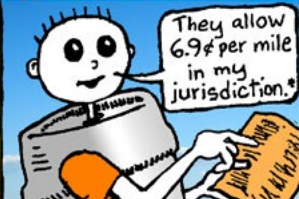

A Charity fun run that invited men to dress up as women is being investigated by police after a transgender charity claimed that the dress code constituted a crime.

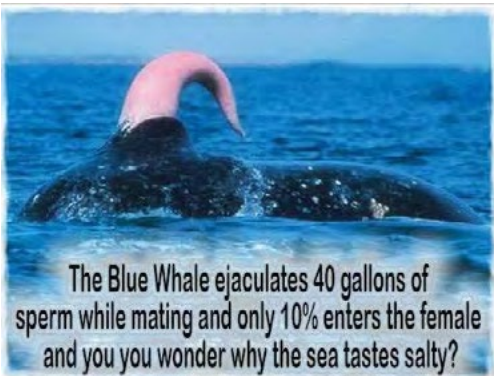

HASH LEGENDS

AGREAT HASHER - SIR CLEVER DICK

Stockholm must be one of the best know Hash Clubs in Europe at the moment, thanks largely to MaliBog’s Hash Trash followed enthusiastically throughout the hashing world and voted best Hash Trash a couple of years ago.

Stockholm Hash runs from subway, tram and commuter stations, so drinking is no problem, a large pack and a close group of friends who have been hashing together for years. They sent a large contingent to EuroHash where they suffered two injuries. Little Brother was one of the hashers ‘roughed up’ by local thugs who didn’t appreciate men running around the street in dresses. (Little Brother is by the way a 2.30 marathon runner).

Then Richard ‘Sir Clever Dick’ Holroyd managed to fall off the stage while dancing. Luckily he landed on his head, so escaped any serious injury, although my sources tell me he was unconscious for a while. Clever Dick is a great character, an Englishman living in Stockholm, who has been a central figure on the various Stockholm Hashes for decades.

LIGHTNING

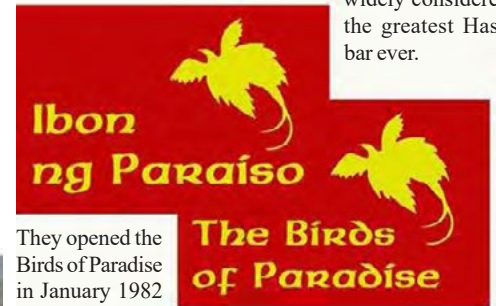

THE INCREDIBLE FLYING MALIBOG ROTHERS

John and Rob Denny really are hash legends, the owners of the Birds of Paradise (BOP) Bar in Angeles City, widely considered the greatest Hash bar ever.



They opened the Birds of Paradise in January 1982 and became the official home of the Angeles City Hash one month later.

Their contribution to Philippine Hashing is immense and includes Rob’s role as Joint Master of InterHash Philippines 1990.

While the Bird survived the closure of Clark Field, from which the USAF operated, it was almost driven out of business by the eruption of Mount Pinatubo, which not only destroyed the Region’s tourist trade but also half buried the Bird of Paradise and most of the rest of Angeles City. Sadly the BOP finally closed its doors in 1999

The brothers moved on.

Rob ‘MaliBog’ Denny back to Kimbe in PNG, where he hashed and worked to support his hashing. He made regular end of year guest appearances at the bars and restaurants on Mooloolaba Beach at Queensland’s Sunshine Coast.

He now lives in Mooloolaba and is now the proud owner of the Fusion On Ocean Restaurant in Maroochydore and an avid member of the Sunshine Coast Hash.

John ‘Malibog’ Denny became a central figure on the Stockholm Hash. Making regular visits to Mooloolaba and running the SCH3, also running the Chichester, Brighton and Henfield Hashes in Sussex UK

When injured just prior to the 2003 Stockholm Marathon John gave his race number to hash colleague, Nick ‘Blind Pew’ Bramble. Nick had not trained for a marathon but, as a member of the British Orienteering team, was quite a fit young man. He decided to tuck in with one of the front groups and finished in a very respectable 2 hours 33minutes. As Blind Pew was running under John’s name, this appeared to have broken the Swedish veteran’s national record!

The boys were banned from the Stockholm Marathon for life but, I believe, later forgiven.....Shakesprick

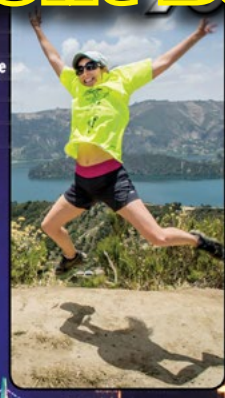
