HASHING IN ASIA

The following is some basic information about Siem Reap.

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The City:

There is a bit of smog and dust when travelling the main roads, so many wear dust masks. The town is mostly centralized, and most shopping and restaurants are within walking distance.

Q How much should I pay for airport transfers or temple tours?

A If you need transport to and from the airport or want to visit the temples, please contact Mr. Proeun at proeun@adventure.com.kh. Fares are as follows:

* City Sedan: airpot-pickup cost: 11\$/way, trasfet to airport cost: 11\$/way.

* City Sedan: tmeple tour (Grand tour/mini tour) cost: 35\$/day

@ Remok (Tuktuk) airport-pickup cost: 7\$/way, transfer to airport cost: 7\$/way.
@ Remok (Tkutuk) temple tour (Grand/Mini tour) cost: 20\$/day.

& Minivan: airport-pickup- cost: 15\$/way, transfer to airport cost: 15\$/way. & Minivan: temple tour (Grand tour/minitour) cost: 40\$/day.

QWhat currencies are used in Cambodiaand should/can I exchange my money?AAs the date for the IMH draws near,

some advice on money:

US Dollars are the currency of choice in Cambodia and accepted everywhere with the exception of 2 USD bills. Whilst not as anal as Myanmar, try and have bills that are not too damaged or soiled as businesses may refuse them.

Other major currencies are easily exchanged in Temple Town; do NOT change into local currency (Riel), no matter what they tell you at the border or airport and I suggest that you do not change into USD at the airport either.

Getting around:

Tuk Tuk:

Visitors usually get around by hiring a tuk-tuk, which is basically a motorbike with a carriage. 1 way trips around town are about \$2 US. You can do daily hires (5-8 hours or so) for about \$15. THis is a great way to travel when exploring the Angor Wat complex. They will drive you around, to the different spots and then wait for you as you go exploring.

Motobike:

You can rent 100cc motorbikes for about \$10 per day. This is a great option if you already have experience with driving motorbikes in SE Asia. The randomness of traffic requires you to be 100% alert in all directions. Other motorbikes will pop out of no-where, drive the wrong way, with no lights at night...ALL THE TIME You can also rent these new electric "green" motorbikes, but I have not seen too many of them in use around town yet.

Bicycle:

Rent a bike for \$2 a day. It's easy to get around because there are no hills. The traffic may be very disorganized and random, but at least people usually do not drive fast. You will be sharing the road with many fellow bicyclists, along with all the other motorbikes, Tuk-Tuks, cars, etc.

It's easy to ease into the chaotic flow, and soon you will be riding just as incomprehensible as everyone else. Many roads just outside of town center do not have any street lights, so that's something to keep in mind.

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

hen the Aloha H3 was founded back in 1991, none of us ever thought about how long it would last. But here we are, 25 years later, and wondering how we lasted 2 weeks of celebration. We started out with a few days of hashes on the island of Oahu with some prelube events, beginning with a Tuesday evening trail from the oldest, and original hash club in Hawaii . . .

The Honolulu Hawaii Hash House Harriers, also known as the H5, was founded on 16 March 1978, and started from the Hee Hing Chop Suey shop in Kapahulu. The H5 traces its roots back to the Bangkok H3 in Thailand where Castel Myers had been working, and found the hash to be great fun. So, once he moved to Hawaii, all it took was to gather up some friends (Russ Hoylman, Hutch Hutchinson, Dave Benson, and Dick Hoyer) and a new era was born.







On Wednesday, we all gathered at our usual watering hole (Gordon Biersch Brewery) for an evening of beer appreciation and revelry. Thursday found us the windward side of the island for trail with the Oahu Pick Up H3. Then on Friday evening, we enjoyed the 300th running of the Hawaii Full Moon H3 in down town Honolulu, which was adorned with a beer check on the beach and 15 minutes of fireworks.


By the time Saturday morning rolled around, almost all of our guest had arrived to participate in our sendoff hash trail by the Aloha H3 (trail #1334) which included jungle shiggy and waterfalls.

Next, it was on to the main event. Departing from Honolulu Harbor on Saturday evening (15 Oct), an eclectic rabble of 75 hashers boarded Norwegian Cruise Lines for a seven-day adventure of the Hawaiian Islands. First stop was Maui for Aloha H3 (trail #1335) which ended behind, you guessed it, the Maui Brewing company, where one (or maybe three, no . . . several) delicious local brews. Maui was an overnight stay, so we once again entertained the pack with a Volcano H3 trail that started from the pier and ended on the beach. Which allowed for some up close and personal sightings of our local sea turtles.

Waving goodbye to Maui, next we were off to "The Big Island" for a visit with the Hilo Gets Me Wet H3, where local hashers "Takes It In The Aft" & "Trojan" provided us with an unusually dry trail ending on lovely Coconut Island.

After stopping at the Kona Brewing company on the way back to the ship, we were once again underway to our next island adventure . . . on Kauai. Like Maui, there is currently no active hash club running on Kauai, so it was the perfect opportunity for another Aloha H3 (trail #1336) event. This would be the most energetic and scenic trail of the cruise, as we climbed up and over "The Sleeping Giant".

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THE INTERNATIONAL HASH CHALLENGE: A PARTICIPANT S PERSPECTIVE

THE 9TH IHC AND LOSS OF A PARTICIPANT

uch has been said and written about the tragedy of Thomas J.F. Cools who, at 34 years-old, was one of the younger participants of the 9th IHC on September 17, 2016. However, some pertinent facts were misrepresented by the media. Here are the facts:

- All the runners have no problems continuing after the layover at CP1, but at CP2, basically the half-way stage, 15 dropped out or were disqualified. Thomas and his team managed to scrap through by a whisker (5 min).

- Some 700m into the sector, Thomas stopped to attend to blisters developing on his legs, and told his team-mates to continue on, and that he will catch up with them later. A separate team – Rapid Cripples, the most senior team and last to depart from CP2, overtook Thomas at this point and enquired about his situation, and he assured them he was alright.

- Approximately between 2-3km from CP2, a resurgent Thomas overtook Team Rapid Cripples.



- Separately, youngest participant Kelly Heng confirmed that somewhere past CP2, Thomas came trundling past her on a downhill stretch at a furious pace.

- At the cut-off time on CP3, Thomas has still not arrived.

- Sweepers, who trailed after the last runners who left CP2 and honking all the way, did not come across Thomas up to CP3.

SEARCH & RESCUE OPERATIONS

Upon learning of a missing runner, hares for the 3rd sector between CP2 and CP3 immediately swept in reverse from CP3 back for up to 3km, blaring their horns and shouting for Thomas. The search continued late into the night at either end of the plantations, and teams were dispatched to all the CPs. Plantation workers in the vicinity of the running area were alerted and asked to keep a look-out. The searches – and the vigil at the finishing point - were futile.

18th September, 2016: early Sunday morning, search and rescue operations were immediately launched at first light, with messages being flashed out to the hashing community for volunteers. Hopes of finding Thomas were high. By the end of the day, the total involved in the S & R numbered close to 100, mainly hashers. Possible angles were assessed, and parties were sent to various directions, even to areas thought less probable. At noon, a missing person report was filed by the Belgian Embassy in downtown Kuala Lumpur, and the organizers made a similar report at mid-afternoon at the nearest police station. The police, together with the Fire & Rescue Department, sent about 20 personnel to CP2, but as it was late afternoon, they made




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an expeditionary foray towards where Thomas was last seen. With the night settling in, the search operations by both the authorities and hashers were adjourned.

19th September 2016: Hashers again set off very early combing from different vantages out of CP2 and CP3 independently of the authorities. The authorities' search efforts were to be concentrated from and around CP2, and 3 dozen personnel, together with 2 K-9 units, were marshalled. Just as the briefings were coming to an end and the various teams were about to be allocated search sectors, at a little before 10am, a message came through that a S & R team which set off from CP3 has found Thomas. There was a collective sigh of relief, with many whooping cries of joy at the happy news. However, the initial relief and euphoria was short-lived, for the missing runner has succumbed to injuries. The initial report of having 'found' the victim has been misinterpreted; tragically, the rescue has become a recovery effort to retrieve Thomas' body.

Thomas was found just over 2km short of CP3, and about 200m off the paper trail, at the foot of a slope. The post-mortem was to list the cause as 'blunt injuries secondary to fall'.



THE CONCEPT:

The International Hash Challenge (IHC) was conceived to give hashers an opportunity to experience the rigours of participating in a full marathon, albeit hash-style, in a Malaysian jungle and plantation environment. The idea, as conceptualized by the hosting hash, Petaling H3 based out of Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, are:

- It is a team event comprising 4 members, of whom one must be of the opposite sex

each team must finish together

- there are 3 interim Check-points (CPs), where teams must check out together before proceeding. At each of these CPs, there are water supply, ORS, light refreshments, and First Aid plus ambulance. Trucks are on standby to evacuate dropped out, exhausted, or lightly injured participants

- cut-off times are pre-set at each CP, and beyond these times, participants are barred from continuing

Although termed as a challenge, the event, like true-blue hash events, is a non-competitive one in the real sense of the word, for there are NO prizes to be won, except self-fulfillment, bragging rights and self-esteem. It is fundamentally a challenge to participants to persevere through the arduous and punishing trails, and to their team spirit in helping and coaxing their teammates on to the finishing point.

By setting up CPs at approximate intervals of roughly 10km apart (the positioning of the CPs are of course determined by accessibility and location), the Challenge trails are basically segmented into 4 quadrants, each approximating a regular Petaling H3's run. In hashing (at least Petaling H3's) terms, the Hash Challenge can therefore be considered


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simply as a combination of 4 hash runs, with the exception that it is fully-supported at each CP, augmented by the hares of each sector sweeping for, and assisting, stragglers.

THE EXPERIENCE

Like many runners, I have always harboured hopes of running a full marathon, having completed a few half-marathons within respectable times. However, a head-on car collision in 1991 put paid to my hopes and, although I made a near-complete recovery, the allure of the marathon dims out of fear that injuries sustained on road running might jeopardize my hashing career. So, when in 2000 Petaling H3 first announced the hosting of the Challenge, I immediately signed up, and have remained an ardent participant since, except for one occasion when I took up the mantle of event organizer to ensure continuity rather than seeing the event get terminated prematurely for want of an organizer; it tickles me to tell others that the only time I didn't run the Challenge as a participant, I ran the event!

What's so special about the Challenge? Because being a team event, it encourages teamwork and imbues in each a kindred spirit unique unto itself. The shared sense of camaraderie between team members is unequalled, and the euphoria of finishing together is absolutely incomparable. That the event is a Challenge, and yet not a competitive one, is best exemplified by the rapturous cheers that greet each participant as he/she reaches the finishing line, not just coming from the observers, regular hashers, and volunteers, but particularly so from other participating teams who finished earlier. The voluminous outpouring of mass jubilation is so hearteningly palpable, it stays and lingers in our psyche...



THE PARTICIPANTS & SOME STATS

Contrary to what many might expect, the participants of the Challenge were not the usual young and gung ho type, nor were they the fit-asa-fiddle distance runners; in fact, the majority were simply the average hash Joes and Janes, who simply relishes the premise of the Challenge. For example, at the recent 9th edition – the lowest turn-out thus far due to many prospective teams lacking a female team member - the average age of participants was a very mature 46 years, the youngest at 17, and the oldest at 65; 40% of them were 50 years or older, and around half were veterans of past Challenges. Of the 88 individuals who started, 69 managed to complete the full distance within the stipulated time, representing 78% finishers. These include the oldest, and 2 of the 3 teens. (Lamentably, I wasn't one of the conquerors, having pulled out at the half-way stage (CP2) due to the debilitating effects of a persistent injury, exacerbated by a silly omission to hydrate sufficiently).

WHITHER, THE INTERNATIONAL HASH CHALLENGE?

Like most sports, hashing carry with it inherent risks. These risks are not necessarily any more, or less, dangerous than other sports. The susceptibility to injuries in hashing is just different, and all hashers should be fully aware of this fact.

In terms of diligence of care, the organizers and the hares have done everything according to the book in setting the run, and ensuring that all CPs were properly staffed and attended to. True to hash traditions, each of the 4 sectors contained 2 checks in order to restrain the faster runners and allow slower ones to catch up. The refreshment stations at the CPs were well-stocked and well-manned, and so were the First Aid stations. The sweepers went right after the last teams set off, and blared the horns loud and clear all along the way. Those who don't make it on time within the cut-off threshold were not allowed to continue on. Could the disappearance and ultimate demise of Thomas be averted? I don't think anybody could answer this with any degree of conviction and certainty. It was likely a case of Murphy's Law at play, when a slight misstep off the trail snowballed to a frantic effort to retrace or intercept the trail. The case of Thomas was best adjudged a misadventure contributed by his haste to catch up with his team mates, which unfortunately ended up tragically.

I really hope that Petaling H3, and their very dedicated cadres of organizers and hares will not let this calamity preclude them from organizing future Challenges. Perhaps some things could be improved further, particularly the safety aspect, but the basic ingredients have always been right. I am certain its 200+ strong membership will continue to support the event in every which capacity, including their generous financial contributions that have always lessened the burden on participants. They should all be mightily proud of the fact that Petaling H3 is creator and custodian of the greatest Challenge there is in all of hashdom; a Challenge, but a surmountable one.







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

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airobi, capital city of Kenya is home to several active hash groups with some hashers who are quite active on the international circuit. Last month Head Mistress flew down from Addis Ababa and joined them for one of the major yearly hashing events in East Africa, the Naivasha Relay and a regular Monday Hash. The Naivasha Relay involves a relay run from Nairobi to Naivasha on unsealed roads in teams of 9 with members seeded according to their running ability with the higher seeds running longer distances several times throughout the day and the lower seeds maybe doing a short run once. Different hashes from Kenya and international hashers particularly from Kampala, Uganda come together to make up teams and some teams have more than one group. Each team is distinctive by its individual t-shirts sporting its team names and teams travel in several vehicles or one big vehicle when not running. The relay is made up of a series of legs of different lengths for different seeds so around 30 runners run at one time.



Highlights of the Naivasha Relay

- The carb-loading session at a bar the night before with plenty of Tusker Beer, BBQ goat and beef ribs and a chance for teams to get together to make final arrangements – some hashers only left the bar to go to the start point.

- Meeting at 5.45am in the chilly morning air on the dirt track road up a steep hill from the highway - a training ground for Kenya's serious runners [their peace must have been shattered with the arrival of 250 hashers in a whole variety of vehicles from pick up trucks to huge overland safari vehicles)

- 15 different teams, some with up to 3 groups of 9 who were seeded in order of their running ability or lack of it with names such as Bad Boys, Team Mix, Smoothies, Hot Dogs - 89 kms of mainly dusty unsealed, bumpy and often rocky roads filled with local villagers cheering everyone on – event provides annual entertainment to them.

- Lots and lots of Kenyan beer such as Tusker, White Cap and Summit

- Leg after leg of different distances with team members competing to be first and being welcomed at the finishing line by a carnival other team members and GM Tuzo tits and her team of strict judges busy shouting orders and recording the finishers and time of each hasher

- Losing one team member but luckily finding him again through mobile phone and getting him rescued.

- Range of temperatures from an early chilly morning to a baking hot afternoon and then to rain and cold again as night fell.

- The extra route provided this year that led to hashers getting wet in the rain but running past herds of zebra and impala

- Food and party all night until the resort switched the electricity off at 4am (only way it seems to get the Kenyan hashers to go to bed)

- Team games on the lawn the next day reminiscent of a British school sports day with games such as egg and spoon and the three legged race.

- Compulsory impromptu team performances from each team with the best act from Mombasa Hash House Harriers putting on their beach clothes and bringing out their coconuts.

- Performances hit by heavy rain showers but GM Tuzo Tits carried on indoors with an all afternoon circle of many charges and gift giving of team t-shirts until the hashers finally staggered out to drive the 2 hour sealed road back to Nairobi.

- Trail carried on up the road going against all the arrows (were we running the trail the wrong way round?) to meet the hares who made everyone run with their knees up




- Strange markings on the trail which deviate away from the usual international markings (evidently hare Finger of God normally pays someone to set her trails so she's not sure herself).

REGISTRATIONS ABOUT TO OPEN

Cebu Hash is close to 20 years old and is based in and around Cebu City (approximately half way up or down on the east coast of Cebu Island).

Cebu is a longish, thin island with a narrow coastal plain along each coast with a multitude of steep-sided hills running south to north along its central spine. For Hashers, this means that much of the flat land is built up or fenced in. This leaves the hilly interior for most of our Runs. Browse our website at http://cebuhash.org/index.php to see the sort of places we regularly Hash.

Unfortunately, some of these places are a tad off the beaten track – they might not require a 4 wheel drive vehicle to get there but definitely need something with a high ground clearance (SUV, pickup, etc). Normally, we use our own vehicles to get to the start of our Runs. This can be problematical when we have a shit load of visitors to transport.

Cebu City itself has many upmarket (expensive) hotels and a wide variety of lower cost (but OK) places to stay at. There are also a handful of large (expensive) beach resorts scattered around the island. Unfortunately, the more economical resorts are not very large. We do not recommend staying on Mactan Island (Lapu Lapu) over a Hash weekend. By the way, there is not a large red-light bar district as such in Cebu.
