
Asia Hash will be in Sokcho, Korea in October, and Mekong Indochina Hash will be in Laos.



Much older than the Rhine, its basin is thought to have been the site of some of the earliest human cultures, and it remains one of Europe's most important and historic waterways and a popular river cruise destination.

Flowing through 10 countries, the Danube is the heart and soul of Central Europe. Countless cultures and civilizations have used it as a trade route and economic artery. Armies have been stopped at its banks. Its boundaries marked the edge of the Roman Empire, and its bridges have linked nations. It has inspired vintners to create prized wines, composers to write enduring music and hashers to lay adventurous trails.

### Details

Slovakia is Europe's best kept secret and Bratislava is attractive and dynamic town. Time to discover Bratislava on a hash run... Who want's to lay a trail? After hash & circle we will have dinner in a nice and typical Slovakian restaurant. More beer and wine waiting for you.

### 3 JULY 2017 SMALL CARPATHIAN WINE TRAIL DURATION CA. 5-6 HOURS

The region and its sights are accessible all year round. At certain times of the year, there are fairs and other events promoting wine production – for example, a wine fair in April, grape harvest festivals in September and Days of Open Wine Cellars in November.

The Small Carpathian Wine Trail tour offers a genuine possibility to enjoy the Slovak countryside outside of Bratislava. The landscape is a perfect blend of vineyards – cultivated for centuries on the southern slopes of the Small Carpathians – and small historic towns with typical wine-country houses.

**CERVENÝ KAMEN CASTLE** – Cervený Kamen [Red Stone] Castle is located above the village Píla some 30 kilometres northeast of Bratislava. This massive military stronghold was originally constructed as a part of a defensive castle chain spreading along the Small Carpathians that guarded the borders of the medieval Hungarian Kingdom. The current appearance of the castle is a result of radical Renaissance reconstruction in the wake of the Turkish military threat in the 16th-17th centuries. In recent decades the castle underwent a lengthy restoration process, which resulted in its opening to the public in 1992. Rich collections of historical furniture from Pálffy estates, memorabilia from the anti-Ottoman wars and other items illustrate the lifestyle of the nobility in this part of Europe. A beautiful forested landscape and a nearby a falconer's station, which presents summer shows, make this castle one of most popular tourist attractions in the region.

After lunch time we will board our ship again and continue direction Hungary.

### 4 JULY 2017

### **IMPRESSIVE BUDAPEST (Hungary)**

Crossing border to Hungary today and arriving before lunch in Budapest. We will diretly check-in at our hotel and start our sightseeing. In the evening we plan to meet up with the local hash chapter either for a run or pub crawl followed by typical dinner. - Party time in Budapest!

Part of the visit to the cave is done on the train and part of it on foot. Tour takes approx. 90 Min.



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
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# South America Hashing Tour

I would recommend that you schedule your planned visit to Buenos Aires, Argentina, to coincide with their Bi-weekly Hash schedule, as you would not want to miss an opportunity to hash with this group. I would also suggest contacting a member of their mismanagement team during your planning process. This extra step ensures you may become aware of any potential changes due to season, Holidays, special events, etc.

A very reliable contact for the Buenos Aires hash is "Inspect Her Assets", who will make sure the group knows you are coming and will also answer any questions you may have. Traveling with "Rawhide" and "Lifa", both former GM's of the Seoul Hash, was an added bonus vs traveling by oneself. "Inspect Her Assets" put us into contact with "Good Service", whom we met at her house, so we could all ride together with "Doon Doon". The BAH3 Saturday Oct 15th hash (rescheduled from Sunday the 16th due to Mother's Day) started/finished at the hare's house. It would have been much more challenging to reach that location, an hour from our hotel, on our own.

Our Hare on this day, was "One Bolt, Two Nuts" who proceeded to live hare the trail for the running members of the group, while I was part of the three-walking hash group. The light rain falling both before and during the hash, failed to dampen any hash spirits as expected. There was a generous beer stop, where both groups met, in a local park and then it was off again onto the finish.



Circle activities were conducted in the hares' spacious house, by acting GM "Meat My Pussy" most recently from hashing with the Cairo Hash. There were also four virgin Hashers in attendance on this day. As sometimes commented upon when referencing Latin American venues, there was no hurry to conclude the generous festivities and we enjoyed the company of this lively group for the greater part of the afternoon. Visitors should not consider driving to a BAH3 event, unless they are planning on being the designated driver upon its conclusion, as this group does not skimp on the Beer or food provided and is in no hurry for anyone to depart.

Thanks to everyone in the Buenos Aires Hash for making our visit to your beautiful city a very memorable one.


The recommended way of reaching Montevideo from Buenos Aires is by using one of the several Ferry's, not an overnight round-trip airfare, as we did. Arriving into Uruguay via Colonia would then give you the opportunity to visit that historic and picturesque town, which we saved for a possible next trip due to time and schedule constraints.

We did have the afternoon available to visit (via the efficient local bus system) the center of Montevideo and explore its old town area. While doing this, we highly recommend having a beer and a meal at one of the restaurants within the historic Mercado del Puerto building. They all have wood fired open grills so you can watch your entrée cooked, while drinking your cold beer and admiring your pleasing surroundings.

The 8:30 PM start of the Montevideo Hash Red Dress run on Monday 17 Oct, in the Carrasco area, was a little on the chilly side, mostly due to a brisk wind, but this hearty hash group was unconcerned. The hares - "Farts Like Men", "Barely Came, Dust In The Wind" fortified both the runner and walker groups with ample Sangria shots, at the drink stops, before reaching the ON IN. Large portions of Hawaiian themed food greeted the pack, along with still more Sangria and cold beer. As circle and social activities came to a close nearing 11:30 PM, "Rawhide", "Lifa" and I headed off to get a few hours of sleep before our 8AM flight back to Buenos Aires.






Harare Hash has still retained its friendly, welcoming atmosphere, despite the fact that in common with many hashes worldwide, the average age has risen somewhat!! As a result H4 is now more of an adult Hash, if you consider the content of the Circle songs and the general ambiance of the Circle. Nevertheless, broadminded family members are welcome!!

H4 runs every Monday whatever else happens and whatever the weather! There are also at least 3 'away weekends' during the year – Mad March, Midwinter (usually in July) and the AGPU in November. In addition, a Zim-Zam run is sometimes held in May, linking Lusaka and Harare hashes.

Harare Full Moon Hash was started as an extension of H4, although this is run rather spasmodically at present.

H4 has had a number of milestone event in its history. The 1000<sup>th</sup> run was held at Kushinga on Lake Kariba. There was a very long and steep hill to get in and out of the venue. So much so that the hares had to lay on a bus to bring back the less fit members after they had staggered







up the hill! Part of the run took us past a marula tree on the edge of Lake Kariba. A couple of elephants had been feasting on the fermenting marula fruits on the ground, and turned out to be much more drunk than the hashers!!

Perhaps the most memorable H4 event has been the Africa Interhash in 1999 (judged as one of the greatest hashes ever by some of those who attended) - held at the newly built Kingdom Hotel at Victoria Falls. For an event involving African wildlife (the animals – not the Hashers!!) an attendance of over 400 was a tight call. The slogan for this Hash was:' The only Hash where the pussy eats you!' A train was used to take the participants out to a Holistic Centre where the first day's runs were held. No sooner had the train cleared the town, than it was stopped by a herd of elephants. Consternation was replaced by excitement when it was realised that these were tame and laid on by one of the Hash member's father, so some of the hashers even had a ride!

The following day's 'recovery run' was anything but!! A group of Malaysian hashers insisted that some of them cosied up to what were a small herd of wild elephants so they could take pictures. The hares tried to explain, with their hearts in their mouths, that these were wild! Fortunately the elephants obediently obliged for the photos – but you wonder what they thought of the 'tourists'! The trail took us along the mighty Zambezi, where the Malaysians wanted photos standing on rocks in the river. The hares pointed out that there were crocodiles and hippos there, both of which can move very fast. Fortunately no one was eaten! Your faithful scribe was one of the hares, and was laying trail early in the morning with shredded paper from a black bag. On passing an old bull elephant



feeding upon a bush, the elephant decided that yours truly must have food in the bag, There followed a charade of trying to lay a trail around the elephant, only to have him come to try and grab the 'food'. Needless to say, the trail route was changed!! That run culminated in a lively circle with some of the sinners being dumped unceremoniously in an animal feeding trough full of ice – well it was a hot day!!

H4 set another run at 'the Falls' in as a post ramble for the Africa Interhash in CapeTown in April 2005. This one involved the use of rafts as used in white water rafting, and hashers paddled themselves to several islands in the middle of the Zambezi, past pods of hippos, where the runs took place – and even included a beer stop!! A silver service dinner in the bush and a circle interrupted by a herd of elephants made the event memorable.

On the weekend of 24 to 26 February 2017, H4 celebrates its 2000<sup>th</sup> run – another memorable H4 event. This time the event is being held in the majestic mountain ranges of Nyanga, and is being hosted at the Rhodes Nyanga Hotel in the Rhodes National Park. The scenery is stunning and the beer will flow! The area does not have any large wild animals, but arrangements can be made for visitors to safely see the wildlife travelling to or from the venue, either side of the event, if they so wish.

Vientiane itself is good for a couple of days as a tourist. It is small and has not that many tourist attractions; hence coming for a hash makes it ideal. Anybody planning to be in Laos for longer should definitely look at travelling to Vang Vieng- 4 hours by road, spectacular scenery, cheap accommodation and food, and great times, and Luang Prabang- the world heritage listed old capital of Laos- 8 hours by road, multiple daily flights, spectacular scenery, great accommodation and food, and good times. Of course, there are many, and varied, other places in Laos to visit.

### **Laos Hashing History**


Vientiane is the home of three hashes. VH3, every Monday evening; VBH3, every Saturday in the bush; and the push bike thingy, last Sunday of every month.

The Vientiane Hash House Harriers (VH3) was founded by Doug Stewart &Tom Holbrook and held its first run on Monday, 13th April, 1981. Since then the VH3 has run every Monday without exception and has clocked up more than 1916 consecutive runs (to November 2016). Numbers on regular runs vary between 10 and 20 nowadays.










The Bike Hash was founded in 2010 by Mother Trucker and Plastic Paddie. It meets at the Nam Phou Fountain at 9.30am every last Sunday of the month and goes to the start point by arranged transport. The rides are generally a mix of bush trails, with often some better tracks and sealed roads. The Bike Hash gets to many interesting and scenic places, generally unseen by many people and is a great social day out.

There are also a number of now defunct hashes that sprung up as the need arose for large mines and road building projects i.e. Sepon, Phu Bia, Pakse. As all that have hashed in Laos before will tell you "It is an experience", and they will all be back.

Cebu Hash is close to 20 years old and is based in and around Cebu City (approximately half way up or down on the east coast of Cebu Island).

Cebu is a long thin island with a narrow coastal plain along each coast with a multitude of steep-sided hills running south to north along its central spine. For Hashers, this means that much of the flat land is built up or fenced in. This leaves the hilly interior for most of our Runs. Browse our website at <a href="http://cebuhash.org/index.php">http://cebuhash.org/index.php</a> to see the sort of places we regularly Hash.

Transporting a large numbers to some of our better run sites is not feasible. Therefore the main runs on the Saturday will all start and finish at the Kan Irag Nature Park close to halfway across the trans-central highway near to Ayala Heights. (Latitude 10°23'51.87"N and longitude 123°52'1.07"E on Google Earth).



Friday afternoon hikes and walks will be nearer the City. Sunday recovery runs will be on the coastal plane north of Cebu City.

Cebu City itself has many upmarket (expensive) hotels and a wide variety of lower cost (but OK) places to stay at. Those located along Gov Quenco Avenue and A.S. Fortuna Street are the best placed for access to our pick up point. We do not recommend staying on Mactan Island (Lapu Lapu) over a Hash weekend.

There are also a handful of large (expensive) beach resorts scattered around the island. Unfortunately, the more economical resorts are not very large. By the way, there is not a large red-light bar district as such in Cebu.

## About Angeles city Hashing

ashing in Angeles City first saw the light of day on the weekend of 19th and 20th August 1978. A pack of 25 hashers, including hashers from Manila, ran the inaugural run on Clark Air Base on Saturday 19th August and next day a second run was organised which ran through down-town Angeles.

The hares for run No 1 were Bill Booker and Walt Daniels. Bill Booker is credited with being the founder of the Clark Base Hash House Harriers - as the club was originally called - and Walt Daniels was the first Grand Master. Both these characters have long since departed the shores of the Philippines but a debt of gratitude must be given to them for starting the great Hashing tradition here in Angeles.

From our humble beginnings, hashing in Angeles has indeed become a way of life. Our regular run day is now a Sunday and we have not missed a Sunday run in years. Even the Pinatubo volcano did not stop the run although on one Sunday there were two hares and one hound.

Of course, there is not a single hound running today who was on that first run. One of the longest ACH3 harriers who is still in touch is Rob Denny who was Treasurer for the 1990 Manila Interhash. Unfortunately he left to live in Australia some years ago. He ran 665 runs before his departure.

The two longest running present members are probably Bob "Single Malt" Smith, and Mike "Induces Menstruation" XXX, both of whom have completed over 1000 runs with ACH3. A look on the ACH3 Web Site (accessed via "Bushranger Hash") shows there are 19 hares with over 500 runs including two who are unfortunately no longer with us.

Whereas many hashes change their GM every year, ACH3 has enjoyed the having Jack "Saput" Clayton as GM for quite a few years now. Saput in tagalog means 'uncircumcised", otherwise he is known as "a complete prick". Whereas some Asian hashes seem to run interminable circles run by blokes who like the sound of their own voice, the ACH3 circles are short, sharp and amusing, usually less than 20 minutes in length. We are usually on the transport and on the way to the "on home" before it is dark (i.e. 6 to 6.30 p.m. in this region).

ACH3 is a 'singing hash' with different songs for every down down, different songs for various nationalities and so on. Again a check on the ACH3 web site will give access to the songs, many of which have been written by ACH3 members over the years. Some songs emanate from other hash groups, also from Public School days and so on. Credit is given where the source is know. The songbook was assembled by Dave "Doggy" Runciman who was sadly murdered in Angeles City in 2014.

Apart from the weekly ACH3 mixed hash, there is a monthly Bushranger hash, longer and tougher than the norm, and men only. There is also a BEACH hash, again men only, that runs once a month, the full moon which is mixed, plus a weekly hiking group called the Mount Arayat Hash.

The term BEACH refers to "British Empire And Colonies Hash". It came about when the hashers who were not American were banned from the annual base cross-country race challenge because they kept winning. The BEACH was set up as a joke revenge.

We have stupendous countryside around Angeles, much of it accessible within a 30 minute road journey or less. Should you wish to come and visit us some time, you may be assured of a warm hash welcome.

### THE KICKABOUT

The English and German football associations have been fined by Fifa because the famous Christmas Day match between opposing World War One troops was "a political statement".

Fifa, a proud and squeaky-clean guardian of world football, caused a storm this week by banning England and Scotland players from wearing poppies on their shirts during the Armistice Day World Cup qualifier on November 11.

Despite the poppy being a symbol of remembering the fallen heroes of conflict, Fifa deemed it inappropriate on a football shirt - even though hundreds of thousands from both countries have perished side-by-side in battle.

Now Fifa has taken its tough stance even further with a retrospective £50,000 fine for England and Germany following events 102 years ago.

A Fifa spokesman said: "It has come to our attention that on Christmas Day in 1914 opposing allied and German troops on the front line put down their weapons, crossed into No Man's Land and enjoyed a game of football.

"This was not only an unsanctioned international match, but also it was clearly a politically motivated statement. This is simply not allowed, and such humanity and compassion goes against everything we stand for."

A spokesman for the English FA said: "The Christmas Truce match is one of those iconic moments in history, showing football can provide compassion and comradeship at a time when everything around it is going to hell.


