

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

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

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Laos through my eyes - Johnny Johnson

ving been in Laos over 47
years, both before, during & after
the Revolution in '75, I suppose
I must be one of the oldest
residents still around in a country that
one would expect to have changed a
great deal over this period but in reality,
it has only in the last ten or eleven years.

When I arrived in Vientiane in September 1966, Vientiane was completely submerged (as was Nongkhai & Udon Thani) with the exception of KM3 - Thadeua Road, That Luang and the Patouxay, then known as the Vertical Runway. British involvement in Laos was quite extensive at that time - Co-Chairman with the Russians of the Geneva Conference on the Neutrality of Laos - complete with a light aircraft for monitoring incidents breaking the ceasefire, it was a member of the five countries supporting the Lao currency, over 25 Voluntary Service Overseas workers working as teachers & engineers, the construction & personnel support under the Colombo Plan for Lao Radio in Vientiane, Luang Prabang, Savannakhet & Pakse. It also had an active Lao-British football club, participated in the rugby and had enthusiastic male & female boat racing teams.

The Embassy was housed in what is now the 'Save The Children' building, the Security Office was opposite, with the Ambassador's residence around the corner, currently occupied by the Australian Ambassador, there was a British Club with a tennis court & pool beside the embassy, with 'fish & chip' lunches on a Sunday with a movie at night.



My first job was as a barman at the Lane Xang Hotel, the staff were all Vietnamese who spoke only French and with the continuing influx of Americans & other English speakers, the director Michel Theodas required someone who spoke English – so as a Scouser, I felt that I might qualify. He had originally run the old Settha Palace Hotel and on the completion of the Lane Xang, the government asked him to take it over, incidentally he was the father of the current director of the revamped Settha Palace Hotel – Billy Theodas.

Over the period of the next ten years, I worked for a number of companies, the infamous Third Eye Bar & Restaurant, financed by a New York psychiatrist, who also opened the alternative American Embassy at That Dam, flying a black & white Stars & Stripes which was a must-see for Russian journalists amongst others.

Later, I was at the Settha Palace Hotel, both at Monty Banks's (a member of the UK's Magic Circle) little bar there & also then for the two Americans that ran it, leaving there to work at the first Vientiane International School as a jack-of-all-trades. Further on, I worked for a German owned packing & shipping company – Van Service Worldwide (VSW) at That Luang, whose principal owner had a picture of two vultures over his desk covered by curtains, however whenever a customer or other irritated him, he would press a button, the curtains would open on the vultures, with one saying to the other – "Patience my arse, I'm going to kill somebody!" The situation was diffused pretty quickly especially when he pressed a bell, which with the requisite rings, would inform the coffee shop next door to bring the required number of beers. It rang pretty often during the afternoon sessions.

After the sale of VSW to a Thai entity, I ran a shipping company in Samsenthai until after the coalition government was established












and on their pull-out from Laos, I joined Virachit Philanphandeth (ex secretary of the Lao British Association) in the take-over of his father's furniture manufacturing company at KM5, Road 13 North. His father started one of the oldest Lao companies after WWII and supported the Lao Issara in their fight for independence against the French.

Virachit had a contact for building the main camp for the Nam Ngum 1 Hydropower Plant Extension and we made the windows & doors for the project and furniture required for the revolutionary forces until he was sent for reeducation in 1976.

At that point the company was forced to close due to the lack of wood, the government having banned all logging. Having been arrested as a suspected saboteur, though subsequently released (I was also arrested by the previous government for being a suspected communist), my wife decided that we should take an extended holiday abroad, which included the UK, Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Cyprus & Thailand, during which time we visited Laos numerous times to see the family and check out the opportunities, eventually returning full time to Vientiane to work with Virachit again at Connell Bros (KP) Co., Ltd, the Lao distributor for Unilever, Kimberly Clark, SiamTyre & Bridgestone.

Since then, I worked at Sepon for Lane Xang Minerals, then Australian owned and Phu Bia Mining, also Australian and both times at the construction start-up—an excellent & fascinating intro into the beginnings of the Lao mining industry and learning to work at a very high level of modern industrial safety & productivity compared with the norm.

Finally for the last seven years, I have headed SPS Export – Import Co., Ltd, otherwise known as Specialized Products Supply, a wholesale & retail distribution company representing various companies in the Lao PDR – Cormix International (Construction Chemicals), Lohaprateep Industry (Shelving & Racking), Jenbunjerd Company (Materials Handling Equipment), Stihl (Power Tools), Dormer Engineering (Drilling Augers & Equipment), Pelican Products (Flashlights & Waterproof Cases), Pangolin (Safety Boots, Shoes & Equipment), plus Spill Control Absorbents and various other odds and sods.





beer along with Martin 'Ringpiece' Pooley. He had this idea that he wanted to start a weekly hash in the north Essex area. He had just relocated from Saudi, where he'd hashed quite a bit, and we'd got together to work it out. Always the positive one, I told him it wasn't going to work as there


were already many weekly hashes and we needed to think of

something different. 'Ok, smartarse,' he says, 'what have you got?' (Just a note here: this was not my hash name at this point.) He was calling my bluff. The full moon idea hit me when I ran in the States in July 1988. I ran with Boulder H3 and the sight of the moon rising over The Rockies that night was pretty amazing. The next week I hashed in San Diego, where The Original Full Moon Hash started in October 1987. It was Mr Spock, Manhandler and Van Go who were responsible for getting it all going. Spock tells me: "At InterHash 1986 VanGo heard tell of hashes held on the night of the full moon. Sounded like a good idea. There was only one Hash in San Diego we could go to and that was not

enough. So we invented a reason to hash more. Voila FHM3. About 30 of our friends agreed and we were off and running." I'd been hashing in Singapore in 1987 and heard the same thing, but it seemed to be regular hashes that were running on a full moon



rather than a dedicated hash doing it once a month. I decided to check with Horn-E. another luminary of the full moon world, who's been hashing in Chicago for many a year. He says: "I have always believed the Spock San Diego story. A hasher named Downwind, originally from Hawaii, came back from a business trip with the Full Moon story."



The theme was Hogwarts and Harry Potter which the school was perfect for decorating. Creamy Ring and HRT were in control here. We had Hufflehash, Slytherhash, Ravenhash, and Griffenhash. We had a little train and fireworks to open the weekend on the Friday.

FULL MOON HISTORY

"So we started ours in 1987. He and I were Co-Hares. It went well and we even had a mason jar with some Moonshine on a hill in a park. The next one was a total washout after laying trail in the rain. Unfortunately it was two years later before Downwind, Cosmo and myself restarted it."

"I took over as GM in 1991 and in the last year I finally passed it off to a young guy who was better able to bring in fresh bodies. When we started ours, there was only one hash in Chicago and we started it to just add some hashing." So it sounds like the same story, regular hashers looking for another opportunity

to hash. I tried to find out a bit more about these occasional chapters who were hashing on a full moon and talked to Hazukashi. He's been keeping us up to date with his Go To The Hash website for a number of years. The Singapore FM Hash seems to be the first recorded example on 31st Dec 1983. This was followed by Christchurch on 30th March 1984, then Chicago, 13th Feb 1987, and then the Original FM in San Diego.



Anyway as I was saying, I saw this advert in the local paper in 1989. We gath-

ered at a pub near Stansted airport, where he used to work, called The Ash in Burton End. It was our home for many years. All of the committee meetings were held there. We had a kind of unwritten rule saying that wherever we ran, we would be near enough to get to The Ash in time for last orders. It was ok until one day I'd ordered a beer for Little Ted, to be picked up when he finished his current pint, and they thought we were trying to short change them, or something. How many times had we been there and how many beers had we bought. Amazing. We never went back. So the first

r*n was in March 1990 and Martin wrote an article to go in the same local paper which read: **Hash Dash from The Ash**.

At the end of the verse, he said, they came out with the 'How Would, You Like' bit that you all know and love. Yes, that was us, and that's how it started. Not an original, as Likk'mm knows, but one we are majorly responsible for spreading. Actually, it was not going anywhere for a while. I'd be standing there in the circle asking you know what and the pack would be off into the pub until Flapper joined us from Cambridge. Not that we needed any encouraging, but his input helped us to take it to the next level.

So that's my bit about full moon hashes. A number of them started popping up in the UK and one day I was standing next to Borange at the Cheltenham & Cotswold Nash Hash and we got to talking about events and stuff. 'This nash hash thing is ok,' I say, 'but it's a shame we don't have one for us full mooners.' I guess he talks to Mad Dog, Martini or someone down that way because in 1999 what do we see: The First Full Moon Nash Hash organised by Ebley FMH3 from Painswick. This was June 1999 by the way. Maddog tells me that Ebley Full Moon Hash was conceived



in Malaysia. Phensic and Hollow Legs became regular runners with the Kuala Lumpur Full Moon Hash (which was started by two FUK Full Mooners as it happens) and immediately noticed the similarity between the climate and terrain surrounding KL and that of Ebley. Many nights they spent scheming and planning, planning and scheming and soon the plan was perfected, they must travel back to Ebley and put their plan into action.

They managed to escape from Malaysia posing as an eccentric British couple



who were returning to England to start a full moon hash, it was a perfect guise. After they had been strip searched several times for drugs and recreation, or was it recreational drugs they shared a joint with the customs official and winged their way home. On return to Blighty they were immediately strip searched, beaten with birch sticks and then rolled in snow, the traditional welcome at the Old Crown, which is where the plans were finalised.



Hashing existed on the Isle of Wight, but Awaydays were not enough and so it was mooted the idea of ANOTHER Hash. Fracas goes on to say,: "Good idea... Do It" is the time-honoured response to such ideas but, unlike others, P-Rick ('Pearson, Richard' in army parlance) did. The Vectis Lunatics Full Moon Hash was born. The VLFMH3 conventions (There are No Rules) were formed on the trainer. "I'm the GM" said P-Rick "and no Kommitee". Thus, a yearned-for status was acquired, commensurate with being an exarmy officer. The runs should be of one hour duration (changed after P-Rick's

initial two-hour Rickathon). Starts 18.30 prompt (changed to 19.00 prompt so that P-Rick didn't have to hurry home from work). Benign dictatorship works. The RA is chosen on the night. The venue promises to be excel-



lent will be a weekend to Remember. P-Rick said about if afterwards: 'On a personal note, Ticket to Ryde gave me a very proud sense of achievement particularly with the Summer Holiday Open Top Bus Red Dress R#n on the Friday. My team all came up with the goods, mainly because I let them express how they wanted it to be, not the way I



wanted it to be. To be honest with our average age group, the Beatles were always going to go down well. I was personally pleased to dispense with a goody bag and produce a jacket that is still worn today. To sum it up, it was bloody marvellous for myself and the hashers of the isle of Wight to host a National Hash as August Bank could never happen here.'

THE RETURN OF EBLEY

The weather improved by the time the Hash had run down to Norchard Station on the verdant & wet Dean Forest Railway, Lemming was among those who found had fun by jumping in the puddles at the Station! The Pack got to see an old steam shunting

engine called 'Charlie' & this led to many photos of Charlie & The Brewer having their picture taken before getting an old Diesel train along the line toward Lydney. The second part of the Run would be a tour around the local woodland. While the Pack ran around the beautiful Gloucestershire countryside a very

important, unscheduled, GMs meeting took place in The Fountain. A Pub that saw plenty of short-cutters pay it a visit, among the usual suspects was one PRick. The likes of Mr. X, Windsock, Twonk, Tops, MyLilSperm'ead all reminded P-Rick that he had once put a bid in to stage a Full Moon Nash Hash, before a failed attempt at emigrating Back at the site & the GMs meeting was a foregone conclusion after the meeting



in the Pub - P-Rick was volunteered and, even if he didn't want to give his consent, the drinks going around soon left him incapable of resisting.

FULL MOON NASH HASH NUMBER ONE

There would be two preliminary runs from The Crown. The first was on the 13th November, 1995, a newspaper advertisement was placed, a few friends were asked and the whole of the pub was invited, the landlord Stuart was one of the keenest. Nineteen turned up in trepidation, not many had ever hashed before, what the hell was it all about? Phensic and Hollow Legs had been out and laid a trail using flour and chalk. They very carefully explained the markings and rules of hashing and then told us there were no rules. All I remember of this is tearing around the surrounding housing estates before disappearing into some fields and returning to the pub, the markings were guite simple and we soon got the hang of them. I appeared to be deliberately looking for the false trails. I have since discovered

that I have a defective gene that makes me

do this regularly.



The official run number 1, January 16th 1995, was again from the Crown and again set by Phensic and Hollowlegs (known from now on as P&H), somehow I had managed to get lumped with the write-up, always been a sucker. We had 54 runners, of which 37 were from C2H3, many of which soon became regular EFMH3 runners. I have varied recollections of this evening, running up and over Doverrow Hill in pitch black, looking back to see a snake of lights following. The next run, Pebbles was coaxed into doing the write-up, was from the Kings Stanley Sports club and a meeting was arranged to vote in committee/coven members. As we all know power breeds corruption and here is the evidence of that,

the first coven: GM - Stormin Norman, RA - Phensic, Hon Sec/Hash Cash - Hollow Legs, Trailmaster - Borange, Hash Horn - Slugger, Beer Master - Crown Prince, Hash extras - Snowballs, FT, Badger. Runs 3 and 4 were both set from the Old Crown and there was a general feeling that the that although this was to be hash HQ we should make good use of the excellent pubs in the beautiful surrounding countryside.

THE 2ND FULL MOON HASH

We appreciated the support that the pub had given us, notice the name of the pub on the Hash T-Shirt, along with the other sponsor, Jonsrad Partner but if the hash was to survive we had to move on. So the hash left the Old Crown and haven't returned, yet.'

Ebley did a great job with the inaugural FM Nash Hash. Mr X recalls: 'One of the highlights was the excellent hand-painted T-shirt, designed by MadDog & Peb-

bles - it looked like something off of Blue Peter.

Action Man wears the glove!

In the goody bag there was a rubber monster hand that was to be worn on your drinking hand. If you were seen drinking without it vou were liable for a Down-Down!' Somehow Action Man was wearing it and still got a down down. Who's that with the helmet? The question now was, who was going to follow that? Well. no matter what we did to avoid it, somehow we were in the wrong place to be volunteered for number two which took place in 2001. We entitled it the Second UK Moon Extravaganza (aka SUK-ME) and it centred around Windsock's local pub—The Prince of Wales. Stow Maries. Essex. The highlight for me was the black dress r*n on the Friday night in Burnham on Crouch. Here's the scene: one hundred hashers, many of them men, wearing black dresses crossing the road opposite the station to the first pub. One woman driving

along could not believe it, forgot to brake, and ploughs into the car in front. Imagine the wording on her insurance form! So we wander along to pub number three. Sock and I are marking and setting up the beers ahead of the pack. Oh

yes, pub number three is a skinhead pub. Some of the skinheads aren't impressed with two (what could be) gays in dresses marching into their pub. One of them gets all aggressive and Sock offers to take him outside. Luckily, the other ninety eight hashers are arriving at this point and he decides to get out while the getting is good. The landlord, who was ok with us going there, is laughing at some loser who probably has never heard the last of it.




THE RETURN OF EBLEY

At the GMs meeting, one P-Rick announced that the Vectis Lunatics would stage the next Full Moon Nash Hash. As it happens, events over took him and Ebley got the nod. Before we hand over to Maddog, Borange and crew, I need to relate a conversation I was having with Vibrator about the formation of the Guernsey Full Moon. As with Ebley (who got the idea from KL—who got the idea from us!)

The Fifth Full Moon Nash Hash in 2007 saw Ebley back in charge. That's not all, it was a Blue Moon Weekend which began with a Blue Dress Pub Crawl Run around all of the two Pubs in the village, there could have been more controversy but it was sensibly dropped as this was village where three of the locals had only just been recently jailed for imprisoning a man in a garden shed & tortured him to death!

A plethora of Blue dresses hit the streets and, just to add a 'Blue Rinse' look, Lemming would add a special topping of spraying the

The Fourth Full Moon Nash Hash saw the event staged 'Over-Seas' for the first time, well out in the Channel Islands, on Guernsey. There were plenty of remarkable things to occur on this weekend, the joint Hashes who form the Full Moon Hash out there put on a great show - the only thing that they couldn't control was the weather - even all of the RA's could do nothing after the event had finished!



This FMNH was famed for being the one where the T-

shirts were white, it's still a bone-of-contention talking-point to this day!

Also, most memorable, for some, was how the Pack had to de-bus on their way out to the Saturday Run start, even then the poor tired old Routemaster needed a push up the steep incline, leaving those who volunteered out of breath, with dirty hand & stinking of diesel fumes, it was a struggle as it was pushed to the top of the hill, perhaps if Hyena had got off it would have been easier!

The Run itself took in a fair chunk of the island, allowing the Hash to view some great panoramas out

to sea, as well as looking at the fortifi-

The Friday 13th Trail took in a few of the Pubs in the town, the Whale seemed to be the favourite and, by Saturday afternoon, the rest had been done by the likes of the Herts Hash, how good was that? Saddlesniffer, Robocop & Mr. X told tales of gore & horror as the Friday 13th Stories were re-enacted with gusto.





The main event of the celebration will be a 7 day cruise with Norwegian Cruise Lines from 15-22 Oct 2016, sailing from Oahu, with port calls on Maui, Hawaii (the Big Island), and Kauai, before returning to Oahu. There will be hash runs and various other related events on each island, as well as a few hash events before and after the cruise on the island of Oahu.

In general terms, the Hawaiian Islands Chain consists of numerous volcanic islands that extend nearly 5000 miles (8000 Kms) across the middle of the Pacific Ocean, and were formed as the Pacific Plate passed over a single hotspot that has produced up to 100 individual volcanos, many are below sea level, dating back 65 million years. The eight islands that make up The Hawaii Islands (pictured below) are the most recent, and they formed just over the past 5 million years and extend approximately 500 miles (800 Kms). The following information is provided to help orient our visitor s to the islands we will visit.



Oahu: The cruise will set sail from the port of Honolulu on Oahu "the Gathering Place," and is the home of Waikiki, Diamond Head, Pearl Harbor, and infamous waves of the North Shore that support many annual surfing competitions. There are numerous other attractions



on Oahu, as well as the capitol city of Honolulu. Oahu was actually formed by two major volcanos (Waianae and Koolau), and several minor (including Punch Bowl, Diamond Head, and Koko Head) which erupted and eventually merged between 2.5 and 3.8 million years ago. If you take a close look at the island of Oahu, you can clearly see the

round bulge of Waianae to the west, and the long jagged line of the Koolau to the east, and how they are merged along the central plains that stretch from Haleiwa to Pearl Harbor.

Maui: The first port call will be in Kahului along the central north coastline of Maui, and this will be an overnight stay. Maui is the second largest and second most populated island, and gets the second highest number of tourists each year. Boasting the best whale watching and best beaches, Maui is home to nightlife in Lahaina, the remote town of Hana on the east coast, and the majestic Mount Haleakala that rises two miles into the sky. Much like Oahu, Maui was also formed by the merger of two volcanos (West Maui and Haleakala) and was formed between 750,000 and 1.3 million years ago. During the cruise, hashers will get a superb hash trail, followed by a trip to the Maui Brewing Company for a tour and some most anticipated libations.

Hawaii: Known as "The Big Island" to the locals (kama'aina), Hawaii is bigger than all the other islands combined. During the cruise we will have two port calls, one in Hilo on the east coast, and the next in Kailua-Kona on the west coast. Hilo is a major agricultural center, and has many historical sites. Hilo is just 30 miles from Volcanoes National Park which is home to the only currently erupting volcano, Mount Kilauea. Kona is more for the beach goers, and also has great opportunities for snorkeling and scuba diving. As the newest island

in the chain, the Big Island has been forming over the past 400,000 years, and is made up of 3 volcanoes; Loihi which has been inactive since 1996, Mauna Loa which has been inactive since 1984 but is potentially building for a future eruption, and Kilauea which has been actively erupting since 1983.

<u>Kauai</u>: The oldest island in the state of Hawaii, Kauai is known as the "Garden Isle" due to lush vegetation and tropical rainforests. We will make port in Nawiliwili Harbor in the city of Lihue on the south east coast and enjoy an overnight stay before returning to Oahu. Amongst the many waterfalls, cliffs, and valleys, Kauai is home to the amazing Waimea Canyon, also known as the "Grand Canyon of the Pacific" which rivals it namesake in Arizona in size, but surpasses it in sheer beauty. Kauai dates back 5 million years and was formed by the Kauai Volcano. If there is enough interest we can run two hash trails on this island, or everyone can take advantage of the extra time for sightseeing and relaxing.

Paul Coombes says he was astonished ceive a handdelivered letter from the local Ellesmere Park Residents' Association threatening to report him to the local authority if he didn't stop using his blower to blast leaves from his drive into the gutter.

"We have been advised that the action of depositing leaves from private property into the road/footpath is fly-tipping, and can attract a hefty fine," the letter read.

"If certain residents persist in blowing leaves from their gardens we will have no alternative other than to report them to the local authority for fly-tipping."

Mr Coombes tells the Manchester Evening News that he was staggered to receive the letter, which followed a previous complaint from one neighbour.

"I had been out with the blower removing leaves not just from my drive but also the pavement and kerb at the entrance to my home to make sure no one slips on them, as my home is opposite a school," he says.

"To suggest it was fly-tipping is ridiculous - does that mean when trees shed their leaves in the street they are also flytipping?"

The letter claimed that Mr Coombes could face a heavy fine from the council for leaving the leaves in the street - although the council dismisses this idea. "It's a load of rubbish... In a court it would not stand up to allege fly-tipping for blowing away leaves," says a spokesman.

This, though, hasn't stopped other, stricter councils from making that claim. Back in 2006, Torquay householder Sandra Pote was told by council workers that sweeping leaves from her driveway into the gutter amounted to flyttipping - despite the fact that the leaves had fallen from a council-owned tree in the first place.

And three years ago, 82-year-old Barbara Ray of Stratfordupon-Avon was also told the same - and threatened with a fine of up to £50,000 and/or 12 months' imprisonment if she didn't stop sweeping leaves into the street.

But no, it was back up the hill to cut round the horseshoe before dropping back down to the road.



For an après après some of us bundled into cars and made our ways to the 'Termite Stack' to avail ourselves with a bastu (sauna) and more beers.





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


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
