
A good time was had by all.

Hashing in Brussels & the Belgian Nash Hash a month after the Bombings

Belgium is a country whose citizens are relaxed and welcoming. They are always up for a celebration. This coupled with the extensive expatriate community, produces an atmosphere in Brussels which is ripe for hashing. We were pleased to welcome 2700 hashers to Brussels in 2014 for the Beer Odyssey. The party culture in Brussels was one of the reasons the event was a great success. On 22 March, all this was interrupted with three bombs, two at the airport and one at the Maelbeek Metro station. Many of the participants of the Beer Odyssey stayed at hotels near the Maelbeek station and remember it well.



The Brussels Manneke Piss Hash (BMPH3) comes from all walks of life; however, a large percentage of the group works for the EU institutions and/or travels extensively for their work. Most of the kennel have a story of how they just missed the bombing on the Metro or at the airport. One hasher was on the Metro which ran two minutes prior to the one that exploded. By the end of the day, all of the BMPH3 was safe and accounted for.

Since 22 March, the citizens of Brussels have endured closed metros, the resulting traffic blockage and a disabled airport. The airport normally serves 23.5 million passengers per year. Business travelers and tourists have been cancelling trips to Belgium and the economy is suffering for it. However, Brusselonians, local Belgians and Expats alike, have shown a strong resolve through the crisis and stand even more firmly against terrorism. One could see it at the Place de la Bourse. The world came together to pay homage to the victims and simply hug each other. On the night after the attack, Higgins, as a long-time Brussels resident, Belgian citizen and simply a human being, reacted to this. He planned a social drink at a nearby pub, Little



Delirium, to celebrate life and promote World Peace Though Beer. Many of us had a toast to the hash. Hashing was uninterrupted in Brussels. That week, BMPH3 wore the colours of the Belgian flag as a statement of defiance to the terrorists.







The trick for some was returning home after the event. There is security for all road traffic entering the airport. Once one reaches the temporary airport entrance, there is still a 1.5 hour queue to pass the first security check. This is the reason that the airport officials are still recommending arriving THREE hours before a local flight, 2 hours more than before the attacks.



However, on Monday Morning, the Maelbeek Metro reopened with a ceremony for the victims. All metros are now running on a normal schedule. The Belgian law enforcement agencies are becoming more organized and sharing intelligence. People are now reporting that the airport security is moving faster, and the airport has announced that it will increase capacity again on 2 May. They are in the final phase of the departure lounge repair work and should reopen sometime in May. Things are looking up. The takeaway from this experience is that the resolve of the Belgians is strong and terror will not win. ONON to World Peace Through Belgian Beer!



Kampala Hash House Harriers

The Kampala to Jinja Relay Hash

frican correspondent Julia 'Head Mistress' Stanton asked Kampala's, RA, Alex 'Queenie' Roman about the upcoming Jinja Relay Hash, the first weekend of July 2016 and why the Kampala Hash House Harriers is worth a visit.

What is the annual Kampala to Jinja Relay Hash all about?



"The Kampala to Jinja Relay Hash is a copy and paste Hash event from Nairobi's Hash House Harriers, Naivasha annual Relay Hash in Kenya. In 2004 Kampala Hash sent a full team to run it and decide to start a homebased relay hash and the first Kampala to Jinja Relay Hash was organised in 2005 covering 87km of nice dirt trail."



It's now one of the biggest events in East Africa in terms of attendance as it brings over 360 Hashers mainly from Rwanda, Kenya and Uganda. The hash is very scenic taking in great landscapes of the Ugandan countryside, going through villages, the biggest forest in Uganda and crossing the River Nile using a foot bridge.

I must warn you that it's a competitive Hash-Run in the Hashy sense and each team must have at least 9 people/hashers on a team of which at least 3 must be opposite sex, must have at least a walker and there must be a Hasher with at least 25 runs with the Hash (Your hash handle/name is added advantage!)

Please note, in traditional hash fashion each team must be ready to drink beer and run in turn from 6:30am to about 7pm as it takes that long to cover the distance!! And after arriving to Jinja (Source of the Nile), there is a circle, dinner and a party till you drop with beer and entertainment.





Teams usually coordinate their logistics to do with lunches, water, extra beer since KH3 will only give you1- 2 cases (25 or 50 beers), driver for your cars and accommodation for your team members.

Why should people register?

"Because there is a lot of beer drinking, great hashing and you get to visit the Source of the Nile, the Longest River in Africa if not the world!"

How do you register and when will registration open?

"Registration usually opens in April/May and closes the last week in June. Team captains do the registration fees and they act as liaisons to Kampala Hash Mismanagement."









What else could visitors do in Kampala and Uganda besides hashing?

"You can do a lot in Uganda besides drinking and Hashing in Uganda such as rafting, safari trips, mountain biking, Hiking, visit the gorillas, etc There are so many travel agents and if you are very keen, you might consider consulting with Queenie to point you in the right direction!! "

What is a normal weekly hash run in Kampala like? When and where do you meet?

"Kampala Hash House Harriers is a drinking club with a running problem:) We run/walk for about an hour, with stops followed by some beer drinking, both traditional and contemporary - silliness and then dinner. Whatever happens after that it is your own business. We won't judge!!!

Kampala Hash meet every Monday evening in a different pub or night club and once a month (first weekend) of the month we go out of town meeting at the National Theatre. Kampala Hash house Harriers is one of the biggest Hash Chapters in world with an average of 200 hashers every Monday rain or shine!"

Hanyang Hash House Harriers & Harriettes (H5) of Korea is proud to offer itself as host of Pan Asia Hash 2017. The fact that there has never been any large scale hashing event in Korea means that, for most of the prospective participants, this Pan Asia will be a very refreshing hashing experience indeed.





We specifically chose Sokcho City as the event venue: on the fringe of this city is the world-renowned Seorak Mountain National Park which, for many Korean soap opera aficionados, has often been the surreal backdrop. Luang Prahang Half Marathon Sctober

Registration is now open for the 4th annual Luang Prabang Half Marathon on October 23rd, 2016. This unique, charity-focused race features a scenic loop course which participants can enter as a 7km, 14km, or 21km (half marathon) race through the town's historic UNESCO heritage area, passing golden temples while winding along the Mekong river. Early-bird registration is available through GoToRace until the 31st of May, with discounts of up to 20% on entry fees: http://www.gotorace.com/event/luang-prabang-half-marathon-2016/

The race was originally conceived with the local community in mind as runners, spectators, volunteers, and most importantly, beneficiaries of the race. In 2013, the first ever Luang Prabang Half Marathonnicknamed "La Procession" after the procession of monks to receive alms at dawn each morning—helped generate more than USD \$125,000 for non-profit Friends-International to open a new vocational training restaurant in Luang Prabang. The following two years of the race helped raise an additional \$140,000 for three different local charities focusing on children's causes.





In its 4th year, management of the race has been transferred to the Lao Friends Hospital for Children, one of the previous charity beneficiaries. Funds from the race in 2014 and 2015 helped sponsor construction costs and nearly a year's worth of medications and staffing for the hospital's pharmacy

through our Crowdfunding site."

Working with regional sports event management companies on course logistics and timing, the hospital will receive all revenue generated from this year's race, helping them continue to provide free pediatric medical care to children in Luang Prabang and surrounding areas. "After serving on the half marathon committee the past two years, we are excited to take on the event and help raise funding and awareness for our work in Laos" said the hospital's Deputy Director, Jennifer Brown. "We are collaborating with the same event partners as previous years to ensure the 'local flavor' of the race remains while refining some of the logistics. We have reduced entry fees to less than half the cost of last year and will refund the entry fee for any runner than independently raises USD \$250 for the hospital

With increased international flight access to Luang Prabang, the organizers are hoping that 2016's race will host 1,000 runners, approximately a 50/50 split of local and international participants. 
"My Beer, My Beer, My Kingdom for a Beer". From Richard




The circle was had on a slight hill which belongs to Charlottenbergsparken and former Gård.














