

Thankfully times have changed and now Lake Toba is Indonesia's second most popular tourist destination and visitors can be sure that they will get a much nicer welcome than those earlier unfortunate men of God. Not only will they find that the natives are now extremely friendly and the scenery exceptionally spectacular. They will also find themselves able to join one of the best boutique hashing events on the calendar - **The Horas Hash**.

THE HORAS HASH HASHING WITH THE CANNIBALS






The area around Lake Toba is characterised by volcanic peaks and pine forests and is cooler and less humid than the lower areas of North Sumatra. Thus it is an ideal area for hashing. The lake itself is at 900 metres elevation and the volcanic caldera that surround the lake is some 300 metres higher. The lake was formed by a massive volcanic eruption back in the mists of time which resulted in the extinction of the first dinosaurs and the evolution of the a second species of the same - hashers!

The Horas Hash first ran in 2005 and was specifically set up to give Medan hashers the opportunity to run in and around Lake Toba on a regular basis. Toba had been the location for special runs in the past but it was decided that the area was such a good out of town location that a regular schedule of runs was warranted. Initially runs were on a yearly basis but are they now two yearly. <image>

The founders of the Hash were Rudy "Lagger" Lie and myself Dave "Stainless" Steel. It was Lagger's idea but I was more than willing to give him my full support. We decided that the event would be be held over four days, Friday to Monday, and that cruising on Lake Toba would be one off the features of the event.




The Lake is the largest and deepest in South East Asia and the awesome alpine like scenery makes for a memorable experience.But much as hashers appreciate the beauty of their surroundings we were also very aware that the other key hashing ingredients had to be part of the mix.

Hence good trails and ample beer were a must. Traditionally we have had three runs over the weekend. A TGIF opener to allow our finely tuned hashing athletes to acclimatise to the altitude, as the area around the Lake is at over 2000 metres. The main run on the Saturday, which would involve a cruise on the lake, and a "Hare of the dog" run on the Sunday. We also decided that we would maintain the Medan tradition for special events of "free flow beer." This latter requirement has meant that the the Saturday run features a "booze cruise" with all that that may result in. Fortunately we have not to date had any "man overboard" incidents but there is photographic evidence of a serious incident of mass moonings by notable hashing luminaries at one of the early events. No names , no pack drill!

Hash clubs like to have their own logo just like branded goods suppliers and the Horas Hash is no different in that respect. We chose the Gecko as our logo because it plays a part in the local culture. The gecko, is


considered to be a lucky reptile by the Batak people, and we thought we could do with all the luck we could get. When you visit North Sumatra keep a look out for the gecko on the carvings around the eves of houses, both on the inside and outside. You will also see the real thing on walls and ceilings cleaning up the mosquito population - great little fellas!

Before I forget I should explain why we are the HORAS Hash. Horas is the word the Batak people of Lake Toba use to greet each other. It's their hello, howdy, ciao, bonjour, gruss gott, or whatever. Although "Horas " actually means "Lord protect you", I like to think of it as "welcome", because that makes Horas Hash the Welcome Hash, which is exactly what we want it to be.

Mind you , we all know that a bit of protection can always be handy when it's needed.

Although the Horas Hash was initially aimed at Medan Hashers we very soon found that other Asian hashers were keen to join in the fun. So much so that visiting hashers now generally outnumber our local hashers. We like to limit the number of hashers to around 200 as that gives everyone the opportunity to meet everyone else and it makes for more interactive "down down" circles.

This year's Horas Hash will be the 8th and will run from the 19th to the 21st of August. The full itinerary can be found on the Horas Hash website but a few of the important aspects are as follows. The opening party on Friday night will be held at the OH5 hash cafe in Permatang Siantar. It will follow the street party format which was so successful at the last Horas Hash in 2014. OH5 are one of the Permatang Siantar Hash chapters and have proved to be outstanding hosts of visiting hashers. We will stay at the Prapat Inn on the shore of Lake Toba on Saturday and Sunday and cruise from there to the run site for the Saturday run. The Sunday "Hare of the dog" run will be pleasant stroll around Prapat itself. Finally, the beer kegs will open on Friday and not close until Monday.

Hashing in Kenya

The Naivasha Relay – 1st October 2016

This month African correspondent, Julia Stanton aka Head Mistress writes about Kenya's biggest yearly hashing event, the Naivasha Relay with the help of Nairobi hasher, Timothy Githugu aka Muguu (photos by Timothy Githugu aka Muguu)

he annual Naivasha Relay, organised by the Nairobi Hash House Harriers is one of the biggest yearly hash events in Kenya with other hash teams from other countries also joining in and is claimed to be one of the best hashing adventures in East Africa.

It involves teams of 9 runners taking it in turns to run a relay route starting at Dagoretti in Nairobi away from the busy highway and off to a dirt-road track through the Rift Valley escarpment passing through the through the the foot of Mt. Suswa and ending at the gate of Hell's Gate National Park in Naivasha, a trail of approximately 83 kilometres. Each team member is seeded with regards to their running ability or lack of it from seed 1 to 9. Each team member runs a certain distance of the trail at a given time with some running two or more stages of the relay. The trail is very picturesque full of hills some with crater rimmed tops. The relay is an all-day event starting early in the morning and finishing with a circle for victory or losers dances and Downs Downs before a shower at the hotel or campsite before partying all night.

The first Naivasha Relay was run in 1982 which was very successful but too long finishing well after dark. After this all sorts of reccies were done to shorten it both in 4-wheel drives and in an aircraft belonging to an engineering consultancy. The final route devised is very similar to the one run these days.



The trail is very picturesque, traversing several hills some with crater tops gracefully lining the horizon, but also through flat dusty savannah terrain and , if it rains through tough muddy conditions. In some years, it is possible to go through a chilly early morning weather, blazing mid-day heat, rain in the hills and dusky sunset through the park. Runners have the privilege of running in an environment that know little if any interference and those looking for adventure should make it part of their

annual hashing calendars.

This year, the Naivasha Relay will be held on the 1st October. I asked Timothy Githugu aka Muguu from Nairobi Hash House Harriers for more information on the event.

How do the teams work?

Like noted above, 9 people per team, at least 2 must be ladies. Seed 1s run 3 legs totalling about 2km whilst Seed 9s run 1 leg of about 4km, with the rest running 2 legs with distances varying in between 16 and 4.

How does a team register?

What about an individual or a few individual who want to join? If there are not enough people to form a complete team, we can team up individuals with already established teams.

Any details of this year's event yet?

Not yet but the date is Saturday 1st October 2016. Hopefully information will be on the NH3 Facebook page by the beginning of August.

What about regular hashes in Kenya? How many chapters are there, when do they run ?

There are four regular hashes in Kenya, these being Nairobi H3 and Original H3 (both run on Monday evenings), Sunday H3 (runs on Sunday evenings) and the Coast H3 based in Mombassa/Dianii (run on Saturdays).

If you are still not convinced about hashing in Kenya, I will leave you with the words of the legendary African hasher Bwanda who said during Mombasa's bid for Interhash 2012.

'Can a hasher claim he is fully evolved until he has scaped elephant dung off his shoes on a bush trail or sipped an Ice Cold Tusker*?'

*A brand of Kenyan beer – George Hurst, the company's founder was killed in an elephant hunting accident and in his memory, his brother Charles decided to name the first beer brewed "Tusker".

HASHSH#T ACROSS AMERICA

f you're a hashing in the USA, you likely know Donkey Fluffer from the Fort Eustis H3, the longest continuous hash in the U.S. (1971). He's been hashing since his virgin trail in Baghdad Iraq in 2004, where the incoming rocket fire seemed like the ultimate shiggy. He won't tell you how he got his name, but he did say he really needed the money. He was the creator of the online hashing sensation of Lunar H3 which claims there's a hash on the Moon in 2030 and proclaiming, "We're going to the f*cking moon!" He inspired and led this group of half-minds, raising some \$20,000, before passing the torch in October 2015 to focus on another hash community driven project: Hashshit Across America. Both of these groups raised money for Make-A-Wish Foundation of America while connecting hashers and their kennels.



The idea for this extended hasher relay event first started in May of 2015, when he'd noticed a thread on the Lunar H3 Facebook page discussing how hashers have brought a lot of dissimilar people together. A DC hasher, The Empire Strikes

Black, from the Over the Hump H3 mentioned how it would be great if we could do even more as an entire hashing community, like maybe even running a hashshit across the country. Donkey Fluffer immediately proposed that we do exactly that and formed a committee of geniuses, well, as genius as one could find within the ranks of hashers. Despite plenty of naysaying, the Hashshit Across America Project launched with the Key West H3 in late October 2015. Donkey and his half-minded crew decided that just crossing the enough wasn't good enough, because it didn't involve enough hashers to truly make it a unified effort of all American kennels. It was decided that ANY kennel that wished to

participate would be allowed to take part. To date, approximately 200 kennels have signed up.

Many were stepping forward for their area wanting to be representatives for their kennel and already connecting with neighboring kennels whenever it approaches them. The Hashshit is not to be carried by motor vehicle, but rather by human-hasher power. In the first state of Florida, it has traveled by foot, bicycle, kayak, unicycle, stilts, paddleboard, swimming and recently went repelling. The Hashshit has also motor-boated many harriettes as it turns out he's quite the ladies' man. He's attended Fantasy Fest, Tampa Naked, and many other hash

events, and had been known to sport a little black tutu when he's in party mode. There's a transponder attached to it so the exact location is known, that's if the hasher remembers to turn it on and has remembered to charge it the evening before.



As of mid-June 2016, the Hashshit has journeyed to every kennel wanting to participate in Florida and now entered Georgia so far raising over \$17,000. The project has no timeline and is dependent on hashers using their imagination from getting it to each location while suggesting donations. There's no minimum donation and every hasher and kennel who wants to be a part of this connective event will be included for the continental USA. There's even a collectible patch available for those participants!




Letters

I am sorry to be a bit slow catching up with your editorial and article by the late Digit in the June issue. Firstly, as you will realize, I do not dance with Wolves, but with Dogs. I was bitten on a hash run about the time the movie Dances with Wolves came out, hence the name. The long time T shirt designer of Wanchai Hash, Bruce "Shirley Temple" Fletcher, did a humorous cartoon rendition of the incident for the 1989 Hash magazine as indicated.

On the article by Digit, whilst I might appear to be a boring anorak, I feel it is right to correct some things. Errors can become 'gospel' in the long term and can be repeated to the end of time.

The late Tim "Magic" Hughes had nothing to do with getting Simon Gispert to Interhash in Phuket in 1992. Simon's airfare and other costs were paid by me and my business partner (and great hasher), the late Rowland




Hastings. Tim Hughes did indeed meet Simon in Phuket and I attach a photograph of the three of us at that 1992 event. The Expat hotel in Phuket provided accommodation for Simon.

Tim Hughes, as some may know, published an earlier hash magazine called International Harrier and I alerted him to the discovery of the Gispert family. At the time, Tim was about to publish a book on hash history and he was able to include the story before he went to print. As a result, at the front of the book there are four pictures, one of G, one of Simon G, one of Charles G and one of me, my only claim to Warhole type hash fame. Simon also designed the front cover for the book as per the attached.


Around the time of the G discovery, a film maker who drank in my bar The Wanch, set out to make a documentary on the hash, an edited version of which was sold to Cathay Pacific for inflight entertainment. An unexpurgated version was also made and it can be found on Youtube under "The history of the Hash House Harriers". In it, Simon Gispert is interviewed in The Wanch. The producers also located Cecil Lee in the UK and interviewed him. Possibly the rarest of all is some footage of Horse Thomson taken at the 1986 Interhash in Pattaya. I met Horse a couple of times in Hong Kong and shared a few beers with him. For those that don't know, Horse and Cecil were office bearers on the first committee of the Hash.

Simon Gispert is a graphic artist by profession and as noted he designed the cover for Tim Hughe's book, also for some T shirts for the Wanchai and other hashes. A group of Aussie hashers also sponsored him to travel to Australia the following year.



Neither Simon nor Charles Gispert followed in "G's" athletic footsteps but they were both drinkers of prodigious quantity. Whilst in Phuket at the Interhash I met Simon at a bar one day, drinking an early morning beer. He told me that he had gone to cash some travellers cheques but had come back for a few beers so that he could steady his hand to sign them.

A couple of years later I went to visit Simon in Dorset and we went out to the pub. I was a pretty good drinker in those days but I struggled to keep up with Simon who sank pints of Guinness like they were 'shots'. I stayed overnight at his house and he surprised me at breakfast by asking if I wanted a beer. I guess he presumed that all those who worked in the tropics were beer soaked wowzers. I politely declined and he said, "Well, I will have one".



Finally, I was a bit surprised by Digit's article when he said he had been unable to get in touch with me in recent times. I had seen him at least twice in the year preceding his death but I have to say he didn't seem to recognize me. He certainly did not look his old self in those final months. RIP to a great hasher.

At this point, let me make mention of John Duncan and Bill Panton. John D is now sadly dead but he was a hasher from the days of yore. He famously appears in the hash video I mentioned, firstly being interviewed, secondly setting a trail and finally singing "The Lobster" song at the on home. Bill Panton started the first hash (arguably) in the USA, the Washington DC hash. I was amused some years ago when he was interviewed in a hash blog when asked what he didn't like about the hash these days. He replied, "I don't like the way that it has developed in many places to interminable circles run by foul mouthed men who like the sound of their own voice". Amen to that.

Anyway, moving on, I had a beery lunch with John and Bill in the Selengor Chambers about ten years ago. I asked John where was the "G" pewter mug that Simon had donated. John smiled and said, "You don't think I would trust that with them here, do you?" That suggests that John took it into his own safe keeping. Now that he is sadly dead, I wonder what happened to that mug? Perhaps if you publish this little piece, one of the KL hashers might be able to tell us.



91-year-old woman fills in crossword at museum - only to discover it was a £60,000 artwork

A 91-year-old woman has been questioned by police in Germany — after she filled in the blanks in a piece of modern art based on a crossword puzzle.

The pensioner, who has not been named under German privacy law, was questioned under caution after she filled in the work valued at (\$0,000) (£67,000) with a biro.

"Reading-work-piece", a 1977 work by Arthur Köpcke of the Fluxus movement, essentially looks like an empty crossword puzzle.

Next to the work is a sign which reads: "Insert words". The hapless pensioner explained to police that she was simply following the instructions.

"The lady told us she had taken the notes as an invitation to complete the crossword," a police spokesman said.

The elderly lady was part of a group visit to Nuremberg's Neues Museum, where the work is displayed.

If the Museum didn't want people to follow the artist's instructions, they should put up a sign to make that clear, she told police.

Eva Kraus, the museum director said the damage was not permanent and would probably be relatively easy to repair. "We do realize that the old lady didn't mean any harm," she said. "Nevertheless, as a state museum couldn't avoid making a criminal complaint. Also for insurance reasons we had to report the incident to the police."

The private collector who presented the work to the Museum took the incident in good humour, she said.

Restoring the work is expected to cost a few hundred euros and the Museum will bear the expense, she said.

"We will let the lady know that the collector took the damage to the work in good humour, so she doesn't have a sleepless night," Ms Kraus said.

The Museum said that in future it would alter the label for the work to make it clear visitors were not permitted to fill in the blanks.




