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AN EVENT THAT WILL CHANGE THE FACE OF BEER DRINKING IN ANGELES CITY FOREVER 15 MICRO-BREWERIES OFFERING FESTIVAL GOERS OVER 100 VARIETIES OF BEER TO TASTE AND ENJOY.

ngeles City has always been a beer drinking kind of town but to be honest, the offerings for variety and quality in beer, like in the rest of the Philippines, have been limited to say the least.

That is all about to change for Angelenos and visitors in a big way as the city will play host to one of the most unique festivals to ever come to this region; the 1st Annual Angeles City Craft Beer Festival, which will take place at Marquee Park at Marquee Mall December 2-4.

For those unfamiliar with the term, craft beer refers to beer that is made by a brewery that is small, independent and that uses traditional methods of brewing. Craft beers are made by hand with no preservatives or chemicals and come in literally endless varieties with varying tastes and alcohol content.

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Craft beer has literally exploded in popularity in most parts of the world over the last decade and has, in the last three years, started to take hold in the Philippines. Several dozen micro-breweries have sprung up throughout the country, including one here in Angeles City, to service a fast growing demand for better quality beer. And these breweries are starting to consistently deliver some very good world class beers, from ales to lagers to the always popular IPA's.

The 1st Annual Angeles City Craft Beer Festival will give beer lovers the opportunity to taste and enjoy a large number of the latest Philippinebased craft beers in one place at one time. Organizers are planning on having around 15 micro-breweries on hand offering festival goers over 100 varieties of beer to taste and enjoy.

At the same time, festival goers will have the opportunity to enjoy their craft beers with a selection of gourmet international and local food provided by celebrity chefs and unique local food outlets, live jazz music, educational beer seminars and more.







The Angeles City Craft Beer Festival is the idea of American Ted Lerner, a long time resident of Angeles City, whose company TLC Promotions will be organizing the event. Lerner came up with the idea for a craft beer festival after tasting some local craft beers.

"Pinatubo Craft beer is the first micro-brewery in the Angeles area and I credit them with getting this idea going in my head. When I tasted their beer I said this kind of thing is the future of beer in this country.

"I absolutely love beer but for years I've been terminally bored with drinking beer in the Philippines because of the sheer lack of variety. But this has all started to change as the craft beer revolution which has swept the world has started to kick in here. There are small breweries popping up in every part of the Philippines and these folks are producing some quality beers. I've had the chance to taste a lot of them in the last few months while putting this festival together and I get more impressed each and every day."



Lerner said what most impresses him about craft beer is the effort and creativity that goes into making this level of quality of man's favorite beverage. And also, he says, drinking craft beer always means a good time will be had by all, especially in a party and entertainment town like Angeles City.

"All of the micro-breweries are small operations, with maybe five to ten employees. Craft beer is an art and a labor of love for these brewers. I want to showcase their efforts to the public because I know people these days are looking for new and unique drinking experiences that go beyond the ordinary.

"This is a chance for the beer drinking public in Angeles and Central Luzon to experience something new, to meet the very people who create this liquid gold and to have a lot fun. I've always loved the vibe that surrounds craft beer gatherings. It makes people happy and the scene is really cool. We are going to have breweries from Cebu, Manila, Sagada, Baguio, Palawan and right here in Angeles City all together in one place. Throw in the amazing food and music, and a spectacular outdoor venue at Marguee Mall and we have the ingredients for a legendary great time. In my opinion it can't get much better than that."

Tickets for the festival will cost P250 and include one free craft beer.

The 1st Annual Angeles City Craft Beer Festival is endorsed by the Philippine Department of Tourism and the Angeles City Tourism Office.

Gold Rush Nash Hash will be mixture of athleticism and sociability, hedonism and satisfying the thirsty with the amber fluid and more, a refreshing escape from the nine-to-five dweebs you're stuck with five days a week.


Hashing is an exhilaratingly fun combination of running, orienteering, and partying, where bands of harriers and harriettes chase a trail seven-to-ten kilometre long through town, country, fording raging rivers, scaling tall mountains and desert, all in search of exercise, camaraderie, and good times.



The Gold Rush Nash Hash Committee has been working hard to come up with runs that suit all comers, whether they be finely tuned athletes or causal runners/strollers/walkers. Central locations or Run Hubs have been selected which offer various runs culminating at a Hub. There will be variety of terrain, whence it be in the bush or around the town, with no Run Hub being more than 15 minutes from the Gold Rush Nash Hash venue.

The main venue for Gold Rush Nash Hash will be situated adjacent to the renowned Botanical Gardens at the North-Western side of Lake Wendouree located four kilometres west of the town centre.

Gold Rush Nash Hash is just not a Friday to Sunday event, there are various preambles/pre-lubes/post-lubes, leading up to and after the main event. The 2017 extravaganza will start with the internationally infamous Melbourne Chunder, Hashers who attended the 2000 Hobart Interhash, will have fond memories of this event.

Another prominent lead up event is the Red Dress Run. This event is traditionally held on the Thursday prior to the commencement of Nash Hash and is held as a charity event, with the 2017 event in aid of Ballarat White Ribbon Committee, Australia's campaign to stop violence against women.

Ballarat has a moderate oceanic climate with four seasons. Its elevation, at 435 metres (1,427 feet) above sea level, causes its mean monthly temperatures to tend to be on average 3 to 4 °C (5.4 to 7.2 °F) below those of Melbourne. The mean daily maximum temperature for February is 25.0 °C (77 °F), while the mean minimum is 11.4 °C (52.5 °F).

The best way to get to Ballarat is through Melbourne, the gateway to the State of Victoria, is readily available from any where in Australia, let alone the world, with all major international airlines having regular scheduled flights. Melbourne and Victoria have a lot to offer the international and local tourists.

Hashit across America The saya continues: Florida

t's been run, biked, paddleboarded, kayaked, surfed, swum, thrown up to a bridge, skateboarded, unicycled by Gumby (JaxH3), visited a strip club, been to a camp out, visited a tank, a dinosaur, several breweries, rode a bull, got eaten by an alligator, to mention some of the ways the brainstorm of visionary Donkey Fluffer has been moved - all for the benefit of **Make A Wish Foundation**.

DONKEY FLUFFER, THE VISIONARY WHO STARTED LUNAR AND NOW THE HASHIT ACROSS AMERICA PROJECT TO RAISE MONEY FOR THE MAKE-A-WISH FOUNDATION The Hashit arrived in Key West for Fantasy Fest 2015 and did the zombie bike ride on 25 Oct 2015 with over 7,500 zombies on bicycles. Then on 26 Oct the Hashit did the heroes and

villains 5K Run. On 27 Oct the Hashit did the tutu Tuesday run down Duval Street in Key West. Of course the bunny had its tutu on. On 29 Oct the hashit ran its first red dress run followed by the Fairvilla Masquerade March on 30 Oct. On 31 Oct the Hashit rode on a float in the Key West





Fantasy Fest Parade, and then finally departed Key West on 1 Nov 2015 starting at Mile Marker 0 on US Hwy 1 by running, bicycling, and then paddle boarding off the island from Coconut Mallory Resort on Key West to Hurricane Hole Marina on Stock Island. The Key West Hash was the first to move it and move it they did travelling 112 miles across 33 bridges to the mainland, where the Miami H3 took over. Such an event couldn't go unnoticed.

So...

Sacksquats made a sign from Walmart poster board with the Make A Wish Q code on it. By the time it travelled through Ft Lauderdale H3 (who still holds the record for most money raised), Palm Beach H3, Treasure Coast H3, Space Coast H3, Tampa Bay and Jolly Roger H3, the publicity that it was getting was tremendous and the donation's came pouring in. By the time it reached Daytona Beach H3, St Augustin H3, and Jacksonville H3 the Hashit sign was in rough shape. It is currently being laminated and will be presented to Donkey Fluffer as a three foot event tag (this will be a suprise). After riding about 15 miles thru a thunderstorm at night on some scary back roads of Florida, ShakesQueer GayGuys Cocks of Daytona Beach H3 decided a better sign/carrying device was needed and that it should be highly reflective to provide some safety to its carriers. This sign was made from a spare food grade plastic ceiling tile from a commercial kitchen project, the frame from an external frame camping backpack that he bought



at a thrift store a decade ago and had been used for two different hash costumes (shower guy from karate kid & a shark cage). On 13 Jan 2016 Daytona Beach H3 raised \$1398 in one night! On 15 Mar 2016 the Hashit ran into the Air Commando Ruckers! They were carrying 50lb rucksacks and an American flag from Tampa to Hurlburt Field. Finally on 28 Mar 2016 crossed the border from FL to GA by the Tallahassee & Area (T&A) H3 after the Florida Hashes raised over \$16,500 for Make A Wish Foundation. That set the bar pretty high for any state to beat!

Here are the HASHSHIT TRADITIONS and Guidelines

1. Protect the Hashshit. It must not be damaged, destroyed, vandalized, sharpied, castrated, sucked too deeply into ones anal cavity, or allowed to go dormant for too long. If your kennel breaks it, please fix it (most materials I found at Lowe's).

2. Respect the Hashshit. While it loves all the typical hash debauchery, it shouldn't be allowed to fall into the hands of muggles or otherwise lost.

3. The Hashshit can only move forward thru wanker-powered conveyance. It can move via walking, running, stumbling, crawling, swimming skateboarding, bicycling, kayaking, canoeing, paddleboarding, or human powered flight (good luck with that). The wanker can be virgin, no-name, or named.

4. The Hashshit can be moved via horse, mule, donkey, goat, dog ,cat, sheep, llama, elephant, cow, duck, or other bestiality worthy creatures, provided said animal is a named hasher.

5. No motorized or wind-powered vessel can be utilized for FORWARD progress of the Hashshit.

6. If a wanker decides he/she is done moving it for the day because of weather, darkness, fatigue, apathy, or drunkenness, they can mark the last spot with the appropriate chalk mark of their choosing, turn off the attached SPOT Beacon and move the Hashshit back to a place of safety via motorized whatever. When the weather clears, simply move the Hashshit back to the last chalk mark, turn it back on, and move out via any method described above.

7. The kennel currently in possession of the Hashshit determines it's pace, provided it doesn't sit idle for unreasonable periods of time. We at the Hashshit Project reserve the right to retrieve, or send those we designate to retrieve, an unreasonably idle Hashshit. Continuity will retain interest and bring in money for the Make-A-Wish Foundation. All we will dictate is which kennel to hand it off to. PLEASE DON'T PICK WHICH KENNEL YOU HAND IT OFF TO, EVEN IF YOU THINK



YOUR CHOICE MAKES MORE SENSE. We will listen to your advice, of course, but we have a general direction we must follow and we can't have kennels bypassed that wanted to participate. The designated kennels will coordinate with each other on when and where the handoff will take place. Your route will not be determined by us, only which kennel you hand it off to. Be advised that it is not legal to move on foot or bicycle on any highway in the U.S. Interstate system (i.e I-40).

8. The State Flag and all things that kennels have attached, but not the original accoutrements attached prior to launch by us here at the Hashshit Project, shall be removed upon crossing a State line into a new State. The new flag, provided by the Hashshit Project staff, will be attached and the Hashshit will be refreshed and lightened for the new State's wankers. The last kennel in a particular State will mail the flag and attachments to us, using the donation money they raised during their possession. Collected items from each state will be preserved and ultimately displayed at a future Hashing Museum.









9. Batteries for the SPOT Beacon and any items needing replacement will come from the funds a kennel has already raised, but if not yet received, the Hashshit Project will provide. I suggest each kennel test the beacon daily and make sure it shows on the SPOT app (free download for all Android and iPhone devices).

10. A patch for those that have carried the Hashshit, for any distance, will be available for purchase for \$10. You must be on a list submitted by your kennel to be eligible to purchase this unique patch. ALL profit from the patch sales will go to Make-A-Wish. The HASHSHIT REP-RESENTATIVE FOR YOUR KENNEL DETERMINES WHAT CONSTI-TUTES "CARRYING". This may include only carrying it forward towards the next kennel, or just for regular trail at your local event. A Hashshit Supporter patch is also available for those that couldn't help move it for various reasons, but still want to contribute. Special 69 and 100 mile patches are now available for those that have it documented. These



patches are being made in-between the orders that bring in profit for our patch maker, a hasher like you and I, so leaving her a bad review because you didn't receive your patch as fast as you wanted to is fucked up. These patches are not going to be mailed to you at the same speed as her profitable patch orders.

10. I leave it completely up to the possessing kennel to determine how they will raise money for Make-A-Wish other than the patch purchase described above. Get creative, involve muggles if you deem it useful, but bring in that money for the sick children. NO MONEY WILL BE TAKEN IN BY US AT THE HASHSHIT PROJECT DIRECTLY, it's all for the children. Complete transparency.

> he La Jolla Hash House Harriers originated 38 years ago when founder Joe Curray, Professor Emeritus (Geology) Scripps Institution of Oceanography, handed out invitations for a 'special event' to SIO staff, students, faculty and friends that were known to run at La Jolla Shores beach or body-surf near Scripps Pier.

> Prof. Curray had picked up the idea of forming a local Hash while in Asia where he had run with KLH3 the year before. The first few runs at Scripps, attended by several dozen 'recruits', took place on the UCSD campus located on the mesa above SIO and the picturesque Pacific-La Jolla coastline.

> The runs typically ended in a small campus police parking lot where the Hon-Sec or his co-hare's car was stocked with a cooler of cheap beer. Word of the next run was typically via inter-office correspondence. The Pack doubled in number over the initial five years. By the time of the 300th (first invitational run held Feb. '84) there were between 40 and 50 dues-paying members; fees being collected quarterly by a selfdesignated Hash Cash. Beer was supplied by a Honorary Purveyor (later Biermeister) possessing a key to the Mud Core locker (beer storage) room.

LJH3 Hare's have laid a run without interruption each and every Monday evening since May 15, 1978, thus making it one of several oldest continuously active Hashes in existence on the North American continent. As only Monday evening runs are numbered, Sept. 5, 2016 constitutes two thousand weeks from the first run, saving a great deal of effort in counting. Special runs, weekend functions, annual outings, etc. go numerically untallied but typically involve 3-4 additional hashing events a year. As the Pack numbers between 50 and 60 for the past several decades, each member willingly and eagerly volunteers to hare/host a Monday run once or twice a year (yeah, a joke). About half the Pack are (or may have been at one time or other) legally-wed to one another; 4 or 5 couples first met at a Hash. There's a six-decade range in membership (21-85); although the median age is probably like 65 plus. Several who attended the 'first run' are still FRB's while several other long-timers yet actively participate in Down-Downs. Over 75 percent of the Pack have been Hashing for more than 20 years, most have from 1200 to 1800 LJH3 runs to their credit although few keep track. Hares now attempt to lay three trails each Monday - Eagle, Turkey and Walkers. In southern California terms, the kennel is considered "older than dirt", although they pale in comparison to the Iron Rule Hash (another of over 15 active San Diego area Hashes).

LJH3 traditions developed similar to the Monday runs of Mother Hash, where Prof. Curray first encountered hashing in 1977. The significant exception was he wanted women included, rather than men only. The basic rules held: there will be Trail and there will be Beer. Trail marks used in KL (paper scraps - defined as litter in California) meant original markings were laid from jumbo bags of popcorn; soon replaced by chalk and flour after too many trails were lost to scavenging seagulls and ocean waves. Trails were intended to require approximately an hour to complete, irrespective of pace, so that most Hashers might finish within the same period of time (roughly). Checks were also KL-style - 100 meters in any direction, including before and after the check. As laying 'challenging' checks and difficult trails became 'standard', LJH3 added



an additional guideline - a check should be solved within three marks (especially after several FRBs were out, off-trail for 3.5 hours). Blowing whistles was (and yet is) considered a profoundly inane concept when a vocal 'ON-ON' will suffice. For supplemental audio enhancement, a totally useless Hash Horn was offered to anyone dumb enough to carry it or put it to their lips. A number of years and the slow infusion of members from other Hashes (local and abroad) were required to get around to designating various 'petty officers' like an AGM, RA, Hare Raiser, Hash Flash, etc. Hash Names were sometimes used, but seldom originally designated. Most monikers (with some notable exceptions) derived from other Hashes.

Several practices have changed since the early years. Post-run sustenance - originally only canned beer and popcorn, now involves numerous choices including appetizers, several fine craft beers, hand-selected wine (R&W), sodas (Reg. & Diet), all accompanying a complete meal (vegan & gluten-free provided regularly) AND desert. Down-downs evolved from guerrilla-style to quasi-pre-prepared (but never rehearsed) attempts at Pack entertainment with variable-results and mixed review. Meanwhile, the Hashshit has evolved into a highly revered object melding a classic motif with Native American artwork, 21st century high-tech LED illumination while retaining a whiff of stale beer. The 'merit-based' adornment is commonly and off-times awarded repetitively during Down-Downs. The 'Hebdomadal' (weekly newsletter) was initially mimeographed hand-written, later Xeroxed typed carboncopy, then finally mailed to anyone supplying a self-addressed prestamped envelope. Today, it is prepared digitally over the inter-web (for free thanks to Al Gore) using bytes, computers and keyboards, to be subsequently viewed on-line by the world, office co-workers and the random voyeur. It yet typically contains a smattering of humor injected with a plethora of photo-shopped tits & bums, together with missinformation and fantasies regarding last and next week's events. LJH3 also has its own world-renowned Internet website (LJH.com) and an actual (non-virtual) Webmaster. Fairly progressive, 'tech-heady' stuff for a Hash with a median age closing in on 70.

With the 2000th trail LJH3 Hashers will have run, walked, stumbled, tripped and fallen a collective distance of some 800,000 kilometers over the past two thousand Mondays – that's 20+ times around the world. In the process of accomplishing such effort, the Pack has consumed 25,000 Imperial pints of beer - one pint (U.S.) for every 2 miles on trail. One thing hasn't changed over this many runs; LJH3 Hashers are yet incapable of recalling the words, let alone tunes, to any but one Hash song introduced during its formative years. "Here's to _____, he's/she's true blue, they are...?" – sorry we forgot the rest.

REGISTRATIONS ABOUT TO OPEN

Cebu Hash is close to 20 years old and is based in and around Cebu City (approximately half way up or down on the east coast of Cebu Island).

Cebu is a longish, thin island with a narrow coastal plain along each coast with a multitude of steep-sided hills running south to north along its central spine. For Hashers, this means that much of the flat land is built up or fenced in. This leaves the hilly interior for most of our Runs. Browse our website at http://cebuhash.org/index.php to see the sort of places we regularly Hash.

Unfortunately, some of these places are a tad off the beaten track – they might not require a 4 wheel drive vehicle to get there but definitely need something with a high ground clearance (SUV, pickup, etc). Normally, we use our own vehicles to get to the start of our Runs. This can be problematical when we have a shit load of visitors to transport.

Cebu City itself has many upmarket (expensive) hotels and a wide variety of lower cost (but OK) places to stay at. There are also a handful of large (expensive) beach resorts scattered around the island. Unfortunately, the more economical resorts are not very large. We do not recommend staying on Mactan Island (Lapu Lapu) over a Hash weekend. By the way, there is not a large red-light bar district as such in Cebu.

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RUNNING IN AFRICA

The Great Ethiopian Run the biggest and highest 10k race in Africa

f you fancy running in the biggest road race in Africa and running in the land of runners on the roof of Africa, then the annual 10k Great Ethiopian run may be just your thing. Addis Ababa is 2500 metres above sea level and the third highest capital in the world so it might be your highest 10k run. The race will take place in Addis Ababa on Sunday 20th November 2016. Now in it's sixteenth year with 40, 000 participants the race is hailed by Brendan Forster, Chairman of NOVA International as 'the most exciting race in the world' with runners coming from all over the world to take part. Last year 600 overseas participants joined the run. As well as Africa's biggest road race, important social messages about health and fitness and the Millennium goals are also promoted.

For overseas participants, the run fee is 40 GBP which also includes entrance to the pre- race pasta party at the Hilton in Addis Ababa and the chance to meet Haile Gebreselassie, Ethiopia's legendary runner who has been a great promoter of the event since 2001. This year, registrants will need to decide whether they are red or green i.e what time they can run 10 kilometres in as there will be two race starts. Of course, you do not need to be a runner to participate, it's also possible to walk and join in the great carnival atmosphere of the race. Many different organisations encourage staff to sign up and form teams, some in fancy dress or brightly painted faces and some even on stilts. At various points there are water stations and music stations where those who are less serious about their finishing time stop to dance or rest.

The day before the race, hashers can warm up at the weekly hash run/ walk with the Addis Hash House Harriers where you will be taken up one of the surrounding hills of the city to follow trails of shreddie usually with sweeping views of the city below, the run site for the Great Ethiopian Run. If you still have any energy on Monday you can join the Abyssinia Howling Hyena Hash who run on Monday evenings before its gets dark and the hyenas come out.
