

ulia 'Head Mistress' Stanton's recent travels in Sub – Saharan Africa have just taken her to Tanzania in East Africa where she joined the Dar Es Salaam Hash House Harriers on their regular Monday evening hash.

Last month I found myself in Dar Es Salaam for work and naturally I looked up the local Hash House Harriers chapter. The website told me 'since everyone and there mother is on Facebook, we've decided to use our fb group to post updates for weekly hashes, we are entirely too lazy to post to more than one website'. So doing as instructed I joined their Facebook group and found an active hash with updates to the next hash meet up and location. (I wish more hash groups who are too lazy about their website would have such a message.)

Having found out the information about the run location, I then set off to find with the help of a driver. It seemed straightforward 'Olive restaurant' next to the South Africa butcher and there was a Google map provided showing the location. I was actually more concerned about getting stuck in the terrible traffic jams that everyone talked about that are common in many African cities mainly caused from too many cars on small roads. However, traffic was not a problem and finding the place became an issue as I discovered that the Google Map location and the prominent landmark of the South African butcher didn't work. We started driving around and I called the restaurant who gave directions. Even with that we seemed lost and even more lost when we asked some Masai tribesman who were hanging around on a street corner for directions. Finally through another phone call the restaurant was sighted just in front of us with a sign that you could barely read. After this they provided a much larger hash friendly sign so nobody else even the totally directionally challenged hasher could not get lost.






The hash started at $5.30\,\mathrm{pm}$ and eventually around 40 people were around to call a circle with the hares, Cum Streaming and Tiny Sausage giving the instructions and then the pack was off divided into running and walking trails of around $5-6\,\mathrm{km}$ with a beer stop towards the end. The trail was through the backstreets of a wealthy housing area with big houses on large compounds with dirt track roads outside in sweltering tropical heat.



Being an A to A run, hashers all met back at the Olive restaurant and were called to circle up by GM, Condom Man who was missing his RA so he decided to take both roles. What I recall, the highlights of the circle were a long rendition of some hash songs like the hare song, the tiniest blocks of ice that I had ever seen for hashers to sit on and the election of the hash sh**. Down Downs were done with warm Safari, a local beer with the slogan of the hash being 'We go down, down, down for warm Safari'. Legend has it when Dar Es Salaam hosted Pan Africa back in 1997, someone forgot to put the beer on ice and hashers were served warm Safari. They even have a special song which begins as follows:



After all this singing, visitors and virgins are invited first to have some food (a very good custom, other hashes should adopt) and more drinking and socialising continues until everyone starts drifting off leaving the die-hard drinkers behind.

On a final note, I was originally told by a Saigon hasher who shall remain nameless but frequently travels to Dar to work on World Bank water projects, that the Dar hash were very boring, hash around town and only sing one song. I found them to be a little more interesting than that.

The Bagamoyo Relay - to be held last weekend of May

Every year, the Dar Es Salaam Hash House Harriers hold a unique Hash event, called "The Bagamoyo Relay". It is a great fun packed weekend, with lots of Hashing, drinking and entertainment for all. As the name suggests it is a relay from Dar es Salaam to Bagamoyo. The route is approx. 52 km long and split into approx. 15 legs, which mixes walking and running legs. The route goes though tracks and small roads/paths towards Bagamoyo through streams and up some muddy hills (weather dependent on the mud of course). Hashers are split into approx. 20 teams of around 15 Hashers (depending on numbers attending) and each team members are assigned a section of the route to either run or walk.

The first team members selected to run the first leg joins the start line and the remaining team jump into their transport and follows, sometimes the same route or a route that takes them to the end of each leg, arriving in Bagamoyo before sunset.

On arrival, there is a quick drink and circle before shower and dinner. Sunday is followed by the Historic "Hair of the Dog hash" around Bagamoyo- followed by a circle, and prizes awarded from the day before.



4 DAYS = 4 HASHES

ai Kung Saturday H3, Jan 21st with a 4PM start, was the first time my travel dates had matched up with this monthly hash groups schedule. It was worth the wait. SKSH3 contact "GunpowderPlod" provided me with email instructions, to meet up with him, his trusty dog "Dougal" and a Virgin Harriette - "Just L", near the Tin Hau Temple in Sai Kung. Riding to the start, at the picturesque Tso Wo Hang Park, overlooking Sai Kung Harbor, and setting up drink coolers, it wasn't long before the Hares "Hungary Cock Climber" and "Hassan" came in, after pre-laying the Rambo and Wimp trails.

Note: At this point it's probably appropriate to advise that usage of the term "Wimps Trail", by the four various Hong Kong Hashes which I attended, in no way refers to a short flat easy going ya ya type trail. It's mostly just somewhat shorter! I'm guessing the term "Rambo Trail" does however give you an accurate description of what you should expect in that case! Also, everyone knows Hong Kong Island itself is not flat, nor is much of the Kowloon mainland portion of Hong Kong.

This and the other three attended hashes on this short visit, did the obvious - by starting out across the road and proceeding straight up the side of an imposing 1,000-foot type hill. The climb initially used a few hundred, long unused steps and then continued into unspoiled undergrowth, except for the portions enhanced by the hares with their machete's, allowing hashers to get through the denser portions. You get the idea. Once careful footing got the pack near the top of this rugged trail, it linked up with an existing, frequently used path, which wound around the side of this impressive hill and then headed back down while passing thru a couple traditional housing areas. Back at sea level along the harbor, the pack returned up thru the length of the park area to the starting point. Sorry I didn't get the 1-hour+ time for "Burning Lust" the first Rambo in; but, the first Wimp "GunpowderPlod" assisted by "Dougal", came in at the 1.5hour mark and the last wimp "Just L" came in somewhat later. Had I done the entire trail, I would have been behind her.

Considering Chinese New Year 2017 – Year of the Cock, was the following weekend, the turnout for this particular SKSH3 hash was much lighter than normal; but, the very personable hashers on hand, more than compensated for their reduced numbers.

Everyone - Rambo's and Wimps alike thoroughly enjoyed SKSH3 hash #123 and its traditional circle ran by the GMs "Pissed in Pink".

I was very pleased to have been able to meet and hash with the SKSH3 group and I hope to hash with them again, during another visit to Hong Kong.

Wanchai H3, Sunday Jan 22nd This was my 2nd hash during this short visit and the one with the largest pack, which I estimated to be approx. 70+. Their homepage states the WH3 is a hash of "Men and Goodlookers" and it lives up to that reputation. There is always a large number of Fine looking Harriette's in attendance and that may in turn encourage the good number of Harriers to turn out as well! It did this week.

Today's 1530-ish start was at the Quarry Bay Park area and most of the pack listened attentively to one of the Hare's - "Dr. Evil" with co-hare "Ball Breaker" (that should have been my first serious clues) and his comments on the days Rambo and Wimps trails. The other co-hare "Prickly Pussy" appeared the least intimidating of the three names.

Trail markings led the pack out of the park, at a brisk pace, and of course directly towards the imposing mountains behind the high-rise buildings, using most of the available semi-flat ground. The trail was well-marked for the most part as it rose straight up for the first 30 minutes until it reached a well-used natural path winding around the ridge line. This 3K+, Hong Pak Country Trail contour path, as it was called, was not very wide but typical in appearance and composition







to other rugged dirt & rock paths which offered occasional panoramic views of the Quarry Bay area well below. We reached the start of the reasonably steep descent portion and its 700+ stairs at approx. the 1.5-hour point. Bringing up the rear, I got back into the start area after a full 2 hours. My knees and legs were happy to finally be there. I learned the Rambo trail was a little over 7K, while the "Wimp" course being almost exactly the same, except for one loop, resulted in it being Slightly less.

I would normally equate that trail with one that might be experienced at an AGM weekend event or Interhash of sorts, where it could be enjoyed more leisurely over say a 2.5 or 3-hour period. There were few actual WH3 "Walkers" in attendance and I was challenged to keep those few in sight. As you know, when you are in the middle of no-where you don't want to be last or lost!

Everyone enjoyed themselves during the lively circle festivities conducted by GMs "Spinky McHu" and her assistant AGM's "Hopeless" and "Haggis Humper". The hares of course received their just rewards along with myself and a good number of others!

After dinner, the GM opened up the circle followed by the RA Bernie "Cupid Stunt" Yap and each executed their portion of evening duties in a timely and humorous manner. LADIES OF HORG KORG 114





THE RUN

The Hares are perhaps cursed. The last time **Shirt Climber** (as he then was) set a run, it was so sparsely attended that **The Widow Wanky** was first in. This time, the pack was marginally larger, though the Rambo trail was pretty much a private trail for **Burning Lust** and myself. The Joint route was virgin shiggy up San Ting Hang and behind Floral Villas and up the un-named murder mountain and down the other side to the split – Ed)



But what a trail it was! Despite it being a way out, the bright sunshine and thoughts of running where we don't usually hash made me determined to get to the start. It was just as well I was determined. BL in a desire for more exercise / to save money on bus fare decided we could walk from Sai Kung. He billed it as being a mile. I think it was closer to three. Never mind, we still made it to the start before 4pm. Not that we started on time as a hopeful HCC kept waving at passing buses in the hopes that a few more hashers might turn up late.

Underway, it was virgin **Elle** who led the pack to the first checkback with **Burning Lust** soon finding the way into the first bit of shiggy, slipping and sliding our way around behind Floral Villas.



Navigating our way over the rocks and out of the shiggy, we were surprised by HCC taking photos. BL bounded on ahead with only **Gunpowder Plod's** dog **Dougal** sharing BL's enthusiasm. Our visitor from Virginia, **Quick Drawers**, decided that he'd done enough for a while and was whizzed to the in trail by the hare. He later reported that the motorcycle ride was the best bit of the trail. The rest of us were going up, up and up. BL's cries were getting further in front of me and likewise, **Gunpowder Plod, Elle and Geriatric** were getting strung out behind. Half way up, I recalled that the hares are passionate rock climbers and was suitably thankful that this route, while requiring a certain dexterity (and possibly longer legs than I have) did not quite require harnesses and ropes. Not that they wouldn't have been useful. Gaining the top, though not the summit, I paused to admire the views which really were quite spectacular.



From this point, it was a case of following where BL had been – looking for kicked out checks and question marks. I did toy with the idea of doing the wimps, but decided the Rambo trail looked fairly inviting with

wide open paths which made a change after pushing my way through undergrowth. A fairly obvious route, though **Hassan** had put down a few checks to vary the markings.





Despite being more likely to meet a unicorn than a fellow hasher, or even another person, it was a great trail and it was with some disappointment when I found myself back on tarmac. Luckily, the hares had a few twists and kinks built into the trail, so it was not all running next to roads to get back to A. After going through a small village where I met most of the inhabitants' dogs, though still no people, it was back onto the main road and a mirage met my eyes. Was it some mischievous genie? No, it really was **Gunpowder Plod**, having done the Wimps, now making his way back to A! But what is the last km of a hash for, if not for racing? I soon whizzed past **Gunpowder Plod** (with **Dougal** pulling **Plod** in hot pursuit – Ed) and collapsed onto a bench at our A spot. A fabulous trail and all you who didn't do it should be kicking yourselves for missing a superb run (I use that advisedly as there was a large portion I had to walk)!

At A it was a rather jolly atmosphere, helped by **Hassan** who was drinking for two, as HCC had to stay sober to drive the bike, or at least that's the excuse **Hassan** gave for finishing a pack of Tiger before the pack even got back. Once all were in and sufficiently rested and loosened up with beer, and having been joined by the wonderful but wounded GMs, **Pissed in Pink**,, we were ready for the circle. 



Interview with Bad Dog: Reflections on 2500 runs with DC area hashes.

On February 19, 2017, hasher Bill "Bad Dog" Severe marked his 2,500th run with Washington, DC area hashes. A crowd of 300 hashers were on hand not only to help celebrate the occasion, but to celebrate the life of a their beloved friend nearing the end of his fight with cancer. In this interview, Bad Dog looks back on 21 years, which is as much about his love for his friends as it is for the sport that has been his passion.

Congratulations on 2,500 runs. What led you to hashing in the first place?


Well, a friend of mine, "Number Two," who runs with the local White House Hash, told me at a party that he had gotten into this activity known as "hashing." And I'd read an article about hashing in USA Today a few years before, but this was in the preinternet era and you had to know the secret number to dial in order to know where the hash was, off a recording and all that stuff. A few months later, I'm driving up the street in Alexandria, Virginia, and I see a bunch of people running down the sidewalk and



Number Two is in the pack. So I stopped my car in the middle of the street because there was no traffic and I said, "Hey, Pete. What are you doing?" He said, "Come on and join us." I was dressed in a suit and tie, but I only lived a few blocks away. He said, "Go home, get changed, meet us at this bar. You'll have a great time." And so I did. I came back the next week, which was Easter Sunday of 1996. I did the hash and had a great time. This crowd was right up my alley in terms of their antics, their songs and warped sense of humor. These were my kind of people, so I kept coming back.

Wasn't your start around the time of the Monica Lewinsky scandal?

Roughly. In fact, we did a run in which we all got in blue dresses with white spots all over them. We ran down to the courthouse where President Clinton was recording his deposition. All the television camera trucks were lined up along the curb. We ran out on the lawn of the courthouse, formed a group and sang hash songs in front of the TV trucks and they all filmed it. That was our contribution to the Monica Lewinsky scandal.

How did you get the hash name Bad Dog?

I had several odd encounters with dogs on trail. And there were other things. For example, I'd ask a harriette out on a date and she'd say, "Down! Bad Dog! Play dead!" There was the time Cyclops had an allergic reaction to a bee sting and Mud Muffin was trying to hold her dog "Gunner," whom we'd named "Gunnerrhea." She was a medical student and she was trying to treat him at the same time, and a dog was a distraction. It was a medium-size German Shepherd. So I came running along when she said, "Bill, will you take my dog, and I'll meet you at the beer check." Mud Muffin took Cyclops to her house in a taxi. So we went around the corner, and as soon as we were out of sight of Mud Muffin, the dog slammed on the brakes and wouldn't budge an inch. I'm tugging on his leash and he's backing up on all fours while other hashers are passing by and snickering. After 10 minutes, Gunnerrhea

finally saw things my way and we went to the beer check. But the official story behind my name is that we were at a beer check for the White House Hash, and I knew there was a creek in the direction that I thought we might go, so I wandered off into the woods and Gunner followed me there. We got to the water and he got down into the creek bed the way dogs do and finally, after about 10 minutes, I thought we'd better get back or the pack will go without us. So I went back into the clearing with Gunner at my heels, and the story was that we'd disappeared into the woods together, and that when we came back, we both had grins on our faces and scratch marks on my back. Since I got my name, I've helped resuscitate four dogs that collapsed on trail from heat exhaustion.

2,500 Runs. What led you to count them all?

I originally took up hashing because it was a fun way for me to get exercise. Quite honestly, I hate running by myself. Watching grass grow is about as entertaining. But misery loves company. I loved the obstacle course nature of hash runs. We were doing swamps and creeks and swimming rivers and storm tunnels. Hell, this is so much more fun than



regular running. I enjoyed it so much. I ran competitive track in high school and college [University of Delaware], and I figured it was a good way of getting back into shape. I started counting runs as a way of keeping score. I was never going to catch any of the FRBs with the highest run count in any of the hashes, but no one has tried to rack up the most hash runs for the aggregate total. I'll try to do that, and it will be a way to track my progress as to how much exercise I'm getting, how much distance I'm covering, how much progress I've made. I just wanted to get into better shape, so that's why I started keeping score for every hash I ran. My 2,500th run is also significant to me as my 10,000th mile with DC area hashes. That's 10,000 miles of cross-country everything. You name the obstacle and I've probably encountered it ... including the Mount Vernon Hash on Bastille Day with the runner at the head of the pack carrying a French *Tricolore*. We ran through Lorton Prison, which was still open for business back then.

That represents a lot of hash cash, doesn't it?

It goes out in small amounts so you don't notice it, but when you look back, you say, "Geez, that's a lot of money." Although, that's not as expensive as some of my other hobbies. This is a cheap way for me to get out and have fun. And there's always a hash, so if anything I'm planning to do gets canceled, I just go to the hash as a default backup.

Beyond the running, has camaraderie been a part of the motivation? Hashing is the most fun I've ever had in a pair of sneakers. Absolutely. The camaraderie, the politically incorrect nature of the humor really attracts me. I don't have to watch what I say or do. If I dish it out, I just have to be prepared to take it. And I do. And God, I love these people! They've been such great friends over the past 21 years.

What kennels have you run with in the Washington DC area?

Well, the DC area has 18 kennels and I've run with 17 of them. The only one I haven't run with is Charm City; it's way up in Baltimore and I just haven't driven to Baltimore much. But I've run with the rest of them, because it gave me a chance to meet new people, experience new hashing terrain and have new adventures. There is a whole different dynamic to running with 200 people in downtown Washington, DC, than there is in running with 20 people in Frederick, Maryland. The show-off factor when you run with the Every Day is Wednesday Hash is, "Wow! Look at us!" Everything stops when we go rumbling by. We make our own crosswalks, our own stoplights. Everything stops. People look at us, wondering, "Who are these people and why aren't they in jail?" With the Frederick Hash, 20 people is a lot more intimate. We have the circle, the bar ... you know we could sit there, drink beer and just have a great time rehashing the run.

Of my 2,518 lifetime runs, only seven are outside the DC area, and six of those I hared for the New Haven Hazmat hashes. The only real travel hash I've ever done was when I went with "Rear Area Security" to Dayton, Ohio. That was the coldest hash I've ever run in my life. It was minus 30 degrees Fahrenheit that day and everything was just frozen solid. But I had a good time. The Dayton Hash, they were real singers. We sang hash songs for two hours in someone's garage.

Speaking of show-off factors, have you ever done the Red Dress Run?

Many times. In fact, immediately after 9/11, we started up on Capitol Hill and a police officer gave us permission to use a government parking lot. We started the run and came tearing up East Capitol Street towards the Capitol [U.S. Capitol building], and we detoured around the Capitol and down to the beer check, which is underneath a nearby highway. After we left the beer check, we were jogging past a local police station

and a police officer pulls off to the side and steps onto the sidewalk, stopping the four of us. He said, "What are you people doing, are you fundraising?" And I said, "Yeah." And he said, "What for?" And I said, "For beer." He said, "And?" "That's it," I said. He said, "There's nothing else?" And I said "No," and he started laughing. He said, "I know a couple of rookie cops who are going to catch so much shit because they panicked, figuring you all were 'Reds' or anarchists, who are storming the Capitol and they tied up the airwaves for 10 minutes saying the Capitol was under attack."

Can you recount a favorite trail?

My favorite run was at a hash held at the height of Hurricane Isabel in 2003. The second and third followed by Hurricane Irene, and I think it was Hurricane Grace. Seventy-mile-per-hour winds, trees falling, mud slides, flooded creeks with the whole city shut down. Man, that was an adventure! The greatest hash I have ever done? Oh my God, I love hurricane and blizzard hashes. In fact, the only way the trail can get an A-plus rating on my Bad Dog's Trail Rating Scale is that adverse weather is involved. If it's a sunny day, the highest rating a hash can get in my book is an A.

There was a Full Moon Hash about 15 years ago in Baltimore that was hared by a harriette named "Well Drilled." As part of the hash, she had us run through the Inner Harbor and we got on to a water taxi big enough to hold all of us. As the water taxi started out for Fells Point where we were going to run some more, we started singing hash songs, one after another. The first mate and the captain were in tears, they were laughing so hard. The captain was at the helm, blocked off by a partition, so you had to sit up front on the starboard side to see what he was doing. We were in the middle of "What Do You Do with a Drunken Hasher?" when I saw his hands slide down to the radio mic and click it. He was broadcasting our singing to every water taxi in Baltimore Harbor, plus all their passengers. I saw him two weeks later just by coincidence in the same water taxi and I told him who I was. He said, "Oh yeah, you guys were great! We got together in a bar and all the captains were just howling with laughter. All their passengers loved it."



What was your longest trail?

There was a White House trail on which I've gotten the most lost ever. Longest trail, 24 miles! Biodegradable paint that was supposed to disappear after three days. It's still there. The second longest was Fister Roboto's Super Stupid II ball-buster trail, which was 21 miles. Then there was the Virginia Interhash trail ... I came in at 7 a.m. after starting at 9 p.m. on a four-mile trail.

What trends have you noticed during your time in the hash?

The hashes don't sing as much as they used to. We used to go in and take over a bar and sing Glorious Victorious and all the associated songs, 100 verses each. We don't do that anymore. In fact, we don't sing in bars at all anymore, and I miss that. That was our trademark, if you will, when we'd go into a bar. When we went in and took over a bar, we ... would ... take ... over ... a bar! It was a good time.

Another trend is that the hashes don't travel as much anymore. In DC, the two largest hashes have gotten tied to the Metro system. Every run starts from a Metro stop. It used to be, for example, that a hash would travel as far north and west as Frederick and as far south as Fredericksburg in order to have a run. We'd see a lot more terrain and more varied adventures. You don't have that anymore. You have to go to hashes that run in that area in order to do that. But having said that, there were only seven hashes in DC, and now there are 18. I have no idea how we're able to support them all without one or more of them failing. But they haven't, and that's great.

We seem to be getting a lot of people hashing for the first time, which is great. I think one of our problems is retention. A lot of the hashes I've seen get between one and five percent of the people who ever come back. I think we need to do some things to up that percentage or else we might run into a problem. I've heard it said that hashing is a one-generational, two-generational or three-generational fad. I don't think that's true. I certainly *hope* that's not true. As it gets more numerous, maybe more people will find out about it and you'll have a snowball effect in terms of membership and participation. I talked to somebody yesterday who had never heard of hashing and yet she's an avid runner. She's going to check it out. But there's a lot of that. The Frederick Hash almost died. There were three months in a row when I showed up and I was the pack, and there'd be like three hares. But now the Frederick Hash is routinely hitting 20 people. It's taken them years to get there, but finally they have that critical mass.

Craft breweries and brew pubs have grown expansively in our area. Some of them have started their own running clubs. Are we missing an opportunity, and what do you say to people who might be attracted to them?

Well, if they are running clubs, they're not nearly as much fun as hashing is. They're not running to have fun and they're not getting out to the woods, the creeks and the fields. We have a lot more fun. And a lot more camaraderie because misery loves company.



What about beer at the hash?

If someone hands me a beer to do a "down-down," I'll honor tradition. But on my own, well, if I bought a six-pack a year for myself, that would be a lot. The only way I can tell the difference between light beer and dark beer is one is light and one is dark. Some people drink water at the hash, some people drink soda and some drink beer. You can drink whatever you want and aren't forced to drink beer.

Gene Fox, or "Silver Fox" is here. Your families go back a bit, right? Gene graduated from Tokyo High School during the occupation of Japan with my mother in the same graduating class. Gene's father and my grandfather were assistant chiefs of staff to Gen. Douglas McArthur. My grandfather was MacArthur's G1 at the same time Gene's father, Gen. Pat Fox, was MacArthur's G3, G3 being chief of operations, G1 being administration.

Granddad was commander of the Third Army during the Korean War when Gen. Omar Bradley was Army Chief of Staff and Gen. Matthew Ridgeway commanding the Eighth Army. They were all from Missouri. He used to be Gen. Maxwell Taylor's commanding officer. He knew Gen. Jacob Devers. Over the years they would be dinner guests and I got to know them quite well. They called me "Billy" and I knew them as "General." They taught me how to hit golf balls, cast fishing lines and stuff like that. I had an unusual childhood, but I didn't even know it. I just thought they – including Gene's father -- were nice, elderly gentlemen who were friends with my grandfather.

Getting back to your 2,500th Run, were you surprised to see that 300 people there?

When we drove up to the start of the White House Hash at 3 p.m., I saw a sea of people and my reaction was, "Holy shit! Look at all the people! Where did they all come from?" I was astonished, speechless, choked up ...I can't even articulate what I felt. I was so moved by the fact that so many people took the time, money and effort to come to the hash and the party. I can't say how grateful I am to have friends like that and how honored I am that they would consider me worthy of their friendship. There were people I haven't seen in years. They've given me so much love and support, especially over the past couple of months when I've really needed it. I cannot say enough how much I love these people.

OTHER HASH RELATED NEWS Emergency Crews Suffer Smoke Inhalation At Cannabis Factory Blaze

E mergency services were treated for chronic smoke inhalation after a blaze at an illegal cannabis factory in Ipswich last month.

More than 30 firefighters, 22 police officers, seven paramedics and two members of the lifeboat service were all treated for inhaling fumes as more than 3,000 cannabis plants went up in smoke.

One brave police officer was detained in hospital after dashing back into the smouldering building 17 times, just to check no one was trapped inside.

He told startled medics he was "absolutely starving" and demanded some crisps and chocolate immediately.

A member of staff in the accident and emergency department at Ipswich Hospital said: "The poor man had the munchies and was talking complete gibberish very fast. And he kept laughing at everything."

Fire crews were first called to a house on Woodbridge Road at 7.30pm yesterday when neighbours reported a blaze in the attic of a house.

Firefighters established the building was being used as a cannabis factory, and despite the drama, were extremely relaxed having discarded their breathing apparatus while they brought the flames under control.

A police spokesman said: "We were called to a blaze in a house in Ipswich at 7.30pm. The building was being used as a cannabis factory. Several officers suffered from the effects of smoke inhalation, and one officer was detained in hospital.

"With no regard for his personal safety, he had gone into the building 17 times."

The spokesman added that the blaze was quite dramatic, and emergency services had pulled together. "It was great teamwork. Several ambulance services arrived on the scene some from as far as Essex and Norfolk.

Even the lifeboat service turned up to help out – despite the house being 11 miles from the coast."

Three people were arrested on suspicion of growing cannabis with the intention of supplying.

"We've already committed to


producing more scathing reports that feature words such as 'unacceptable' and 'crackdown'.





The Pope ccepted and during lunch, a puff of wind blew the Pontiff's hat off, right into the water.



"FIFA is committed to a new era without corruption," said FIFA head Gianni 'Razors' Infantino.

"As such, we would never suggest any sort of bribe. 
call it here," said shotputter Simonov Williamsovitch.
