

This is not surprising as Ethiopia is the only African country that has never been colonized and is home to the African Union. A2H3 is currently 35 years old and many of the locals have been hashing for years. Hash hangout 'Ride On' with a bag full of photos, emails, programmes and a DVD from Pan Africa 2007. In his most treasured possession, was the original programme from the first 'East African Interhash' as it was then called. Rather old with child scribbles on it, the two page document outlines the programme and costs with the option to pay to join single activities to encourage the local hashers to join.

The East Africa Interhash was conceived by Marty 'Garfied' Hanratty and Mike 'Sister Michael' Fotheringham over a beer at one of the hash pubs in Addis Ababa. Evidently Garfield, GM of Addis Ababa Hash asked 'Why the hell doesn't Africa have a Pan Africa Hash'. Sister Michael replied 'Why the hell not' and the idea was put forward to the rest of the hashers who all thought it sounded a good idea.

The first hash was held in Addis Ababa from 2nd - 5th May 1996 with 136 hashers from Addis Ababa and 6 other East African and Middle East hashes. The weekend started with a trip out to a local brewery with a 2 hour trip back as the hashers from Nairobi and Dar kept demanding piss stops. Next day, the first run was in the beautiful and scenic Entoto







mountains at 3000 metres, the tallest in Addis. The second was around a crater lake with tej, the traditional Ethiopian honey-based alcoholic beverage being introduced at the circle and before it was finished Nairobi Hash House Harriers had already put their hand up for the next one and the second East Africa Interhash.

1996 Addis Ababa The Original

1997 Machakos, Kenya

\Led by GM David 'Beer Slut, Muchane, in the land of Kenya's proverbial sex stars, Machakos. This time 220 hashers came from 8 countries to enjoy the Tusker the original founders, Garfield had beer.

1998 Dar es Salaam, Tanzania The third Pan Africa Hash was held in sweaty and humid Dar es Salaam, Tanzania with trails evidently lasting 2 hours with plenty of Safari Lager, the local beer which is considered by the Kenyans to be inferior to their Tusker beer and what was even worse it had been sitting in the sun for hours. According to Gun Slinger from Nairobi H3, one of the hashers was a pilot so some of the Nariobi hashers chartered a plane to Dar. The aisles were evidently

full of beer which of course was Tusker and plenty of hash songs were sung on the way.

1999, Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

After this Pan Africa became a biennial affair. By this time one of moved South and became GM of Harare hash in in Zimbabwe. He decided to inflict the event on hashers in the south and helped by Shawn 'Tinkerbell' Burges and Shelia 'Flier' Jacobs, they chose the mighty Victoria Falls as a location. The event had now grown to 470 hashers from 18 countries who were the first quests at Kingdom Hotel. Robert 'Bwana' Walker recalls setting a pre-ramble to the Vic Falls from Harare and Mbinga before hashers took a ferry the whole length of Lake Kariba. He also ran the circles in the bush where elephants and





buffalo were encountered on the hash trails. Due to plenty of Marula fruit, the elephants were just as drunk as the hashers. One hasher was evidently even collecting their dung as it was good for her garden.

2001, Durban, South Africa

Evidently Durban hash were coerced into hosting the next one and 300 hashers showed up. The biggest event was a train Hash organised by Bwana from Durban to Cape Town and a post ramble to the Natal game reserves and north to hash with Maputo H3.

2003, Mombasa, Kenya

Pan Africa moved back to Kenya and this time to the coast of Mombasa. Numbers were a little down due to recent terrorist activity in Kenya but nothing happened to the hashers who attended. This time Bwana organised a pre-ramble from Nairobi through to Tanzania for 80 international hashers. Highlights were hashing in the Rift Valley and Lake Manyara and Maputo Hash performing the "Hat Dance" on stage in Arusha and Mombasa which is still hailed as the best hash act Africa has ever seen.

2005, Cape Town, South Africa The hash moved back to South Africa. The highlight of this was the 9-day Africa X—press from Joburg to Cape Town led by Bwana. A 13 carriage train sleeping 150 hashers was hired for 8 days. The train had two bars and two diners and starting with a hash in Soweto hashers hardly slept as they partied on the train from Maputo to Swaziland, Durban, Fiksburg (Maseru H3) and onto Gareip Dam and Knysna before a triumphant arrival of nearly 50% of the participants in Cape Town. The legendary Nairobi hasher Father Hen evidently ended up running 9 hours of a ball breaker run since he got lost and went up a mountain forgetting his hotel was at sea level.

2007, Maputo, Mozambique

After the success of his train hash, Bwana moved the hash to Mozambique. Following the success of the Train hash, there was a fantastic support from international hashers with 60 countries, 3 of the 4 hashers in the world who had been to every Interhash and 49 Malaysians who had never been to Africa before. Care arranged a pre-lube trip for them to several of the offshore



islands and made himself world famous in Malaysian hash circles. The weekend went brilliantly, and ended with a post-ramble to the he deserted and wild Maputo elephant reserve. The biggest story from this was the explosion of left over bombs from the civil war as hashers were returning to the city which meant they were stuck for hours as the ferries were not working. This did not worry the hashers as there was plenty of beer and bars and they continued to party.

2009, Kampala, Uganda

KH3 moved the event back east in 2009 and hosted the first Red Dress Run during a Pan Africa event. This was flagged off by the Mayor wearing a huge red wig. The main run started from the source of the White Nile and the Addis hashers ended up being the front running bastards.

2011, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia

Pan Africa moved back to its birthplace and a second Red Dress Run was held with 250 hashers. This would have been revolutionary for the Addis hashers since they don't normally partake of Red Dress runs in the true hash sense.

2013 Cape Coast, Ghana

The first Pan Africa Hash to be held in West Africa attracting 300 hashers hosted by the late Eric 'Digit' McGaw, chariman and GM 'Highland Fling'. Short Cutting Bastard remembers setting a very wet and swampy trail with water up to the chest. Other highlights were the music, food, Digit's son's restaurant by the beach and the university accommodation catering to all budgets with the most expensive rooms being those belonging to professors.

2015 Malindi, Kenya

Pan Africa 2015 was originally won by Freetown Hash House Harriers, Sierre Leone and was well promoted with lots of registrations. Unfortunately due to the Ebola Crisis it had to be cancelled with the Nairobi Hash House Harriers stepping in to take it back to the Kenyan coast and this time, Malindi.

Hashers evidently had a lot of fun in Malindi with a full red dress run and lots of partying. In fact they had so much fun that many of them ended up extending their stay.

2017 Lagos, Nigeria

The original plan was for Sierre Leone to host it in 2017 but as the hash mismanagement were busy dealing with Ebola they were unable to attend Pan Africa in Kenya. This resulted in Lagos Hash House Harriers in the words of Sierre Leone hashers 'stealing' it for 2017. Lagos H3 are promising the best event ever so let's see if they live up to their words.

Brussels 2014 wrap-up (part 1) - Genesis

A long time ago in a Brussels bar, bar away I caressed the **idea** of hosting another large international Hash event in the capital of the European Union. This was **back in April 2004**, a mere 3 months before Cardiff World InterHash. My logic was if 4,500 hashers were willing to leave the sunny shores and beaches of the usual InterHash venues for Wales, Belgium was not such a far-stretched idea.

Local hashers immediately went into hiding, not wanting to be sucked into another EuroHash 1997-style enterprise (666 pax), yet **Yark Sucker** decided I should be temporarily renamed "H4" and given a personalised T-shirt just for the Cardiff trip instead. She had no budget but lots of idea - as usual -



so "recycled" an Air France T-shirt. Little did she know my dream would eventually become reality and she would be involved knee-deep in it.

Cardiff 2004 turned out a big success and after a "maturing" period of 2 years I decided to put some thoughts on paper, produced 5 slides and scheduled a meeting wth the Brussels city convention bureau. My idea was to finalise a **feasibility study** and check out what type of support we could possibly get from the local authorities, my expectations being very low at that time.



Yark Sucker was all for it looking at the prospect of a mega 4day party in Brussels while **Dr PP** was much more reserved to say the least, thinking there were nowhere enough hotels rooms to start with ("Where will all these hashers stay? Camping on the roof of Central Station!?"). The 21st of **August 2006** we met the Brussels convention bureau director who welcomed our project, confirmed feasibility during the summer holiday season and told us we'd probably need 2 years to organise such an event. We then revealed considering either 2012 or 2014 depending on which country would host the 2012 Olympics, prompting her to command our preparedness so many years in advance.

In typical hash fashion we immediately convened a quick debriefing in a bar, splurging on the sunny terrace of Le Roy d'Espagne on Grand Place. That's when Dr PP uttered those immortal words: "Oh shit, it's feasible and I'm already involved!".



Totally unrelated I discovered being in dire need of a pacemaker a few weeks later which my cardio decided to fast track so I could leave on time for **Chiang Mai 2006** - cool! That probably explains the high energy vibe when Mr X and myself

decided, slightly drunk and without any script, rehearsal or props, to improvise a skit announcing on stage the Brussels bid for InterHash 2014. Probably our best double act ever, complete with Belgian chocolates thrown in the crowd for good measure, and a great way to grab attention.



Since I didn't have any promotion material even for stage presence I **recycled** one of my many Cardiff 2004 **T-shirts** while attending the Cambodia pre-lube. I even managed to sell another one for \$1 to Termite who was expecting some quick high-quality local job. From there arose the idea of spending the money on the event and not on freebies for the bid, especially after the Wellington bid a few years back unfortunately proved that one hasher grabbing a free T-shirt would not necessarily convert into one vote for the same bid sad but true.

Teaming up with other seasoned hashers keen to reduce the piles of various hash T-shirts filling up their c u p b o a r d s we then accumulated enough free "promotional" material to last for 5 years.





Eventually we got **stencils** made so we could fasten the "production" process using spray paint instead of textile markers. We even organised a couple of recycling parties. Our goodies proved very popular and we made space in our cupboards for new hash T-shirts so everyone was a winner!



Moving swiftly along we decided to collect bid seed money by selling debentures then pledges the same way the Cardiff bid did but on a much larger scale. We sold **125 debentures** at €50 from August 2006 (my 42nd birthday) to 2008 for which signees eventually received an exclusive **Ambassador polo shirt** and **2014 foot patch**; then an overwhelming **2,000 pledges** ranging

from €25 to €45 from February 2011 (Aussie NH in Hobart) to May 2012 (World InterHash in Borobudur).

While the pledges were a good way to measure the actual interest for our event we also wanted to promote the fun factor. So we sold **450 raffle tickets** and made 9 hashers very happy to secure a registration for a mere \in 5 - beat that for a deal after the subprime crisis!





In terms of "brand recognition" our initial impromptu announcement on stage during Chiang Mai 2006 resulted in many hashers enquiring if it was a joke... or not. This prompted one sleeve of our blue Ambassador polo shirt to display "A <u>serious</u>

European bid". So serious that **Charlie Brown** printed 5,000 mailing labels sporting our **2014 foot logo** and handed these to his kids for having fun at Perth 2008 venue. Those **low-cost stickers** would be duplicated years after years.



For Kuching 2010 and beyond we upped our marketing game, now having an extensive reliable team of 200 Ambassadors. Being done with recycled T-shirts we produced **T-shirts** for sale at PanAsia 2011 and Borobudur 2012 (thanks to **Hardy Boy**, one of our top Ambassador) as well as **long-sleeve shirts** for sale at EuroHash 2013.

The only actual freebies ever produced were **Atomium patches** (thanks to **Neptunus**, our original Ambassador who introduced the concept), **drinking cups** given to visitors of our sponsored bar at EuroHash 2011, **headbands** and **wristbands** donated during the final week in Borobudur.



In retrospect I can proudly say we did the utmost to win the World InterHash 2014 bid. At least there was no acrimony between contenders and little known to anyone I had purchased an Early Bird for Hainan 2014 during PanAsia 2011 then Ma Hai bought a full rego for Brussels 2014 during the vote count, filling his form on top of the last unopened ballot box.




Following the proclamation of the vote results **VD Viking** sent a message mentioning myself bringing hashers to Brussels regardless for what would be **A beer odyssey**. I liked the sound of it and the rest is hhhistory...

he "grand old man of hashing" has been referred to as the Hash House Harriers' Christopher Columbus for bringing hashing to America in 1972. In many hashing circles around the world, he's called "Tumbling Bill." But the members of Washington's DCH3 men's hash affectionately refer to him as "The Founder."

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It was 1954 when young Bill Panton hailing from Yorkshire was sampling soil from the jungles of modern-day Malaysia when he was asked to join the Hash House Harriers, then the only club of its kind. The run through the jungles outside Kuala Lumpur were the first steps in his lifelong enthusiasm for the sport. "I enjoyed the camaraderie, of course, and I'd been a bit of a cross-country runner when I was in school," he said.

On May 22, a special celebration will be held near Washington, DC to commemorate both Panton's 90th birthday and the 45th anniversary of his founding of the Washington, DC Hash House Harriers (DCH3). The 1972 inaugural run consisted of just five men, all of them British.

Panton's work with the World Bank allowed him to hash everywhere his assignments took him, including Bangkok where he established a Hash in 1976. Not only did he help proliferate hashing around the world, but he documented the global expansion of hashing through his Hash Genealogy project (https://sites.google.com/site/hashhousefoundation/ home/hash-directory/genealogy).

Tumbling Bill Panton says he doesn't run anymore but adds, "I enjoy a beer with a hashman now and then." He is philosophical about the state of the hash today. "Individuals who start hashes may fade away like old soldiers, and sometimes something suddenly goes wrong within a hash and it expires." Despite that, he remains upbeat about the Hash House Harriers' future. "Every now and then a new hash starts. I think hashing is very well rooted in many places in the world now," he said." I can't see the Hash House Harriers disappearing as a sport. I think it will go on forever."

n 1994 at the New Zealand Interhash I made a presentation to bring the event back to Hong Kong before the final British handover. We were beaten by Cyprus. Nevertheless, we decided to put on our own special event, to be called the "Sunset on the Empire Hash". It was held in early 1997 and was attended by around 1,400. Many folks say to this day that it was one of the best large hash events they ever went to.

One of my jobs was to put together the event magazine and with an article in mind I met with four individuals who first came up with the idea of "Interhash" and who were instrumental in organizing the first event in 1978. I then wrote the article using the information they gave me. I thought it about time to air this again for the benefit of many hashers who, some 39 years after the first Interhash event, have no real knowledge of its origin. The original article as contained in the 1997 "Sunset" magazine (slightly abbreviated), follows:

Much has been written about the origins of the Interhash. Much is true, such as the fact that it originated in Hong Kong, however, as with the origins of the Motherhash, occasional inaccuracies creep in so I decided that I would have an evening of beer and curry with four of the original Interhash committee members, all still active hashers and living in Hong Kong, to hear the story at first hand. The

evening was arranged in February this year (1997) with Wes "Festering" Parfitt, Barry "O'Grief" Griffin and Stuart "McTool O'Tool" McDouall, all of the Kowloon Hash and members of Hong Kong's 'finest', together with Roger "Flacdem" Medcalf from the Hong Kong Hash.

Whose idea was it? Who started it? Well, as advised by these chaps, there is absolutely no doubt that these three Kowloon Hashmen came up with the original idea and then sent out the first invitation letters to invite overseas hashers to join them in the first Interhash held in April 1978. "Barry Griffin and I were sitting in the San Francisco Bar getting pissed," says Wes Parfitt, "when we came up with the name 'Interhash'. Being sensible fellows we reckoned we might forget the next day so we wrote it down on the white formica bar top. Sure enough, I phone O'Grief next day and asked if he could remember what we had called it? He couldn't so we had to go back to the bar that evening to find the name amongst the rest of the scrawl on the bar. It was still there and the name is still in use today, 'Interhash'."

"So how did you go about getting the hashes together?" I asked.

"Well, I had to buy a typewriter – no PC's in those days, and type every letter by hand," McDouall advised. "We got a snotty reply back from KL saying 'how dare we do such a thing – charge fees, commercialization, bah, humbug, etc..'. I wrote back a reply in which the capital letter of each paragraph on the left side read 'FUCK OFF KL' and signed it in HK Government style.... 'I remain your obedient servant'." Guffaws all round and we all swig a beer.

"What were the highlights of the organization of the event?"

"We lost the money," Barry Griffin noted. "We had HK\$32,000 from the sale of T-shirts and other items and Frank Tainsch, who was assistant treasurer, put it in his suit –pocket. He got pissed and arrived home to



slump on the sofa fully clothed. His dear wife undressed him, hanging the suit up in the wardrobe. Next day Frank couldn't remember a thing and nor could anyone else. Panic and blame flew around for a few days until Frank's wife took the suit to the dry-cleaners and was surprised to find HK\$32,000 in the pocket."

"Then there was "Wee Hig" parking in the Police Commissioners space at police HQ remembered Wes Parfitt. McDouall took up the story.

"Like many of the Kowloon Hash, Bob Higgins used the police HQ carpark in the evening whilst attending an Interhash meeting. Needless to say, usual refreshments were served liberally and Bob forgot where

he left his car, which in fact was a rusty pick-up painted like a "Nutty Nibble". Next morning the Commissioner arrived at 09.00 a.m. to find this heap in his space. The next thing, the Station Sergeant was phoning me to know if I could cast any light on this vehicle – which I denied all knowledge of. I then rushed outside to see, to my horror, the 'nutty nibble' vehicle in the Commissioners spot."

"Yes," piped in a grinning Parfitt, "and when we finally got hold of Higgy it seems that he had already been to Wanchai Police station up the road to report his car stolen." More guffaws and beer.

We chatted on about the various trials, trails and tribulations and events like the 500 cases of beer that were delivered without warning to Griffin's tiny bachelor police quarter, the hiring of vehicle ferries to take 900 hashers to Lantau, asking the girl guides to help with cooling the beer and so on.

"It was a great final night," remembered Griffin, "standing on the Sek Kong airstrip, looking at all those people, thinking 'We've done it'."

"So how did it go to Kuala Lumpur after that?" I asked.

"Unlike now where they have a vote," volunteered Medcalf, "we had a meeting of representatives and it was jointly agreed that KL should host the event two years later. Despite their original objections, and after slagging us off for 'charging' for the event, they had the audacity to send us an invoice for advance funds."

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"Actually, we had about HK\$40,000 surplus and sent it to KL by insured courier," Medcalfe went on. "KL to this day claim that it never arrived and no-one really knows where it went."

"And how do you chaps feel now about having started this monster?" I asked.

"I'm ashamed," Medcalfe offered, "Ashamed that we started the thing which has grown into a massive commercialized and over-organised event. Hashing should get back to basics, back to the bush, no commercialisations, drink piss, fuck off." Nodding of heads and more beer.

At this point we repaired to a curry house for a ring-stinger and more beer and finally finished off in the "Popeye" where we watched a little traditional Filipino folk dancing whilst we had a final few for the road.


"So," says I, "are you going to register for the Sunset Hash?"

Bottles are sucked and embarrassed looks are exchange followed by a slight curling of the mouths.

"I supposed so," Flacdem grudgingly admitted with his inimitable stupid grin.

Post script:

Roger Medcalf still lives in Hong Kong. Parfitt, McDouall and Griffin – all former Hong Kong police officers – all retired to the UK. I expect to meet up with them at a Kowloon Hash reunion in Oxford in July.

o there I was...






The Hash Darwin Awards



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
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
