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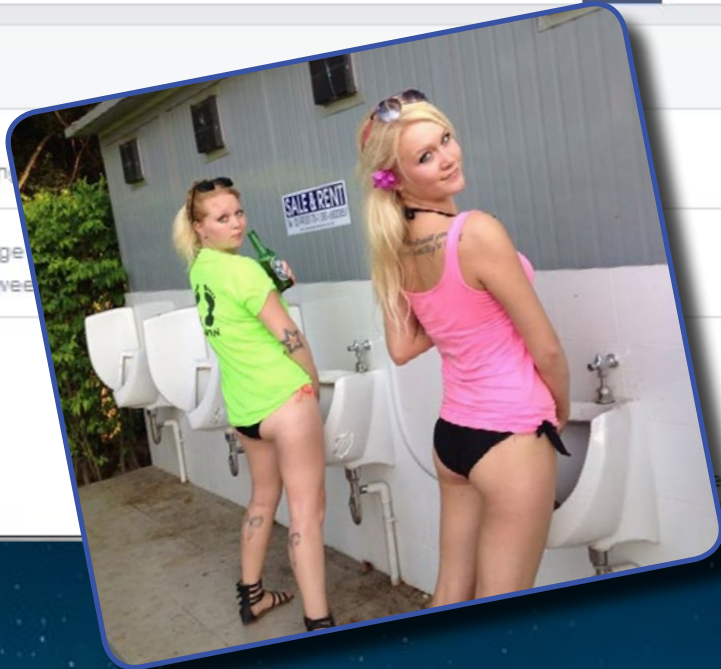
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SEATTLE HASH HOUSE HARRIERS PRESENT *Red Dress Run* 2017

Some would say that a good lesson to keep in mind when travel hashing is plain and simple: Keep your expectations low! Imagine if you will, a couple of San Diego hashers traveling outside their beloved hash community for the first time. Leaving their sandy beaches and sunshine to venture up to the Pacific Northwest ... in *February*. So there they were (*fan-tastic, in-credible, holy*), Creepy Cock Porker and Rush Hour Rubdown in Seattle to explore a new hash culture and experience how the rainy city gets down with their Red Dress Run. So of course there were some unknowns: How cold would it be? And would it rain the *entire* time they were on trail? Would there be a Yeti? Do they serve Fireball at drink checks (nobody likes that)? You get the picture.



We were unsure of what to expect but were fairly certain we would find good beer and the same breed of half minds we hold so near and dear in our hometown. In the end, we got much more than our low-bar expectations. In fact, we had a blast! Here's what happened:

We gathered at 88 Keys, a dueling piano bar in the heart of downtown and as we learned, a veteran On-In spot for the Seattle Red Dress Run. They were even kind enough to offer \$3 bottles of beer all night. We approached the sea of men and women in red dresses overflowing the bar and received a very warm greeting at the front door. As we got

ourselves registered, we also received gifts. Our "Seattle Red Dress Run 2017" swag included Red Dress Run shiggy socks featuring the Seattle Space Needle, a lovely addition to anyone's Hash sock collection. However, further investigation would find that these socks didn't have feet because they were, in fact, arm and leg warmers (also very nice to have). Our other swag was a Red Dress Run badge with song ideas for reference during circle. After about an hour-and-a-half of pre-lubing and seeing familiar faces from San Diego, Portland and meeting new friends, we were warmed up and ready for trail.



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The great red mob formed a circle outside and the hares provided us with the basics. Every hasher and harriette got a chance to introduce themselves. To ensure we were properly warmed up, we commenced hash calisthenics. Your authors were delighted to learn that local traditions included an old San Diego favorite, “Father Abraham.” It was the same tune but with some new lyrics we hadn’t heard before. What a treat!

Now for that trail. It was the perfect Tour de Seattle. Between 88 Keys and our first drink check, there were a couple YBFs which kept the pack together. We ran through some urban shiggy in the form of beautiful green parks with gardens, a waterfall and then for something unexpected, we hashed through a public library. We thought this odd because most of us can’t read and had never been in one before. Nevertheless, this library had an escalator which we lazily rode up a couple flights and found an exit door and trail markings at the top, guiding us along to more beer. Drink check #1 was at “The Elephant and Castle,” an English-style pub with a great beer selection and surprisingly great nachos (Yes, we decided to order nachos at the first drink check; no one complained). From there, we hashed our way to the Science Center/Space Needle area.

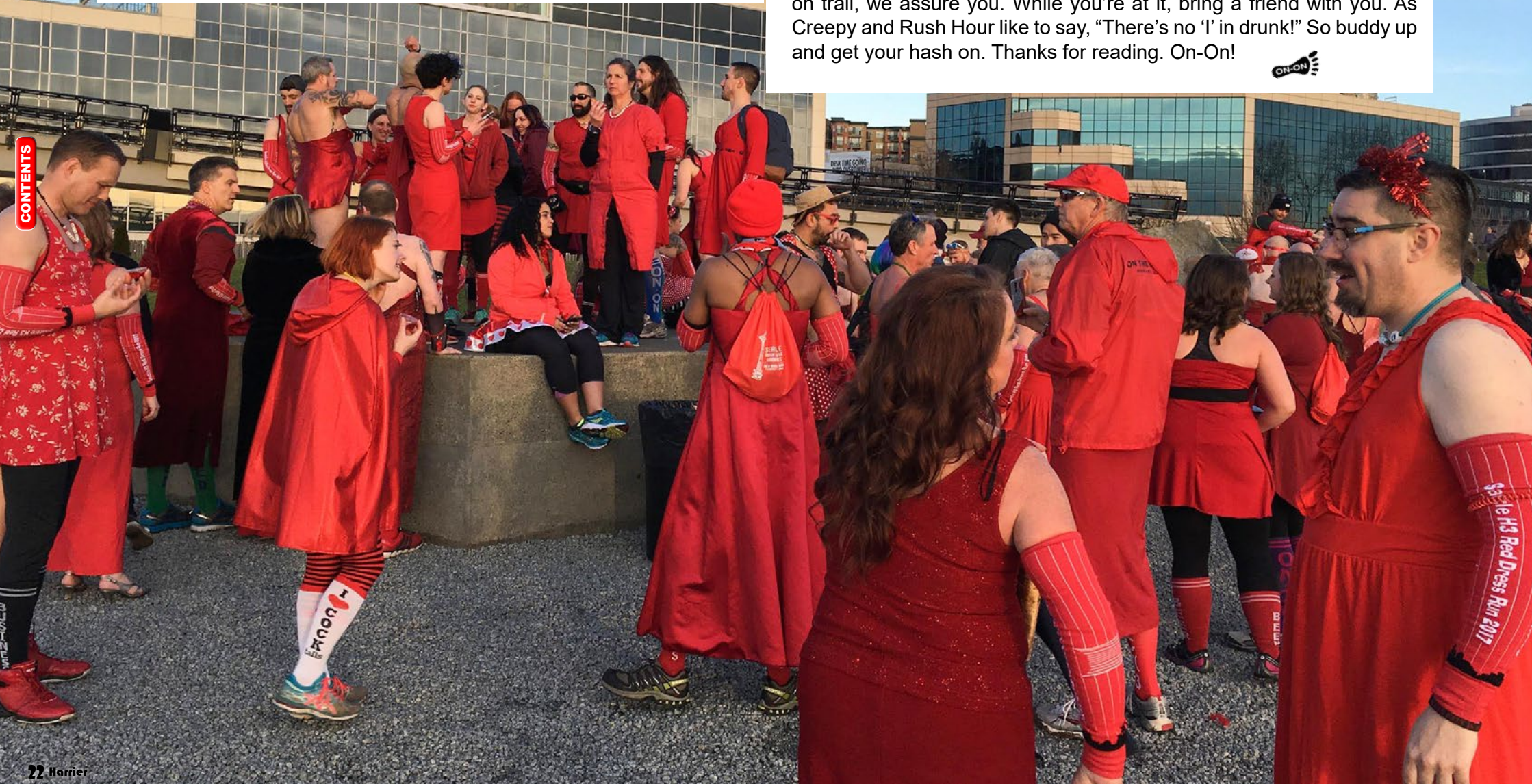


Visitors definitely enjoyed watching the sights in the park that day. Unfortunately for us and the DFLs r*nnng with us, we missed the mark for the second drink check but were able to join pack again shortly down the way. We made our way towards the waterfront and through a sculpture park, all the while taking in beautiful sights of Mt. Rainier and the surrounding mountains reflecting off the bay in front of us. We stumbled upon our third drink check in a picture-perfect spot by the water. As the sun was lowering in the sky, we slurped our Jell-O shots and gathered together for a couple of group photos before continuing. The hares lead us along the water to the wharf, past the iconic Gum Wall and into Pike Place Market. Fortunately, no one took a fish to the face in passing (because, “flying fish market”). The hares provided one more drink check before do-looping us back to the On-In. It was some delicious, boozy lemonade concoction. Cheers for that!



We found ourselves back at 88 Keys in typical A-to-A form, with hashers and harriettes drunker and hungrier than when we left. The establishment came to our aid with beer, chicken tenders, wings and burgers once we were all seated. Circle was great, short and sweet, paying homage to the virgins of whom there were many, and to the hares for their magnificently shitty trail. The pack promptly returned to celebrating in usual Red Dress Run fashion, continuing late into the night.

As we said earlier, we had a blast. All our previous doubts were quickly erased. No Yeti, no Fireball. It sprinkled a bit but for the most part, it was sunny, beautiful and just about as perfect as one could hope for in February. The temperature was in the 40s and yeah, that's chilly, but as long as you had your layers (red, of course), it was just fine. We absolutely recommend paying a visit to the Seattle Hash House Harriers for their Red Dress Run or for any hash event, for that matter. 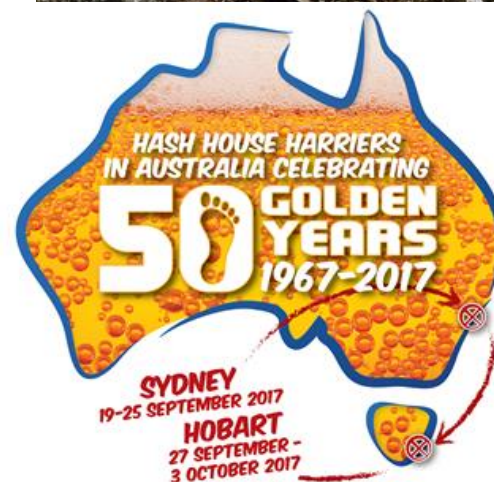

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Budapest

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The Budapest Hash meets every Sunday, 11:30 AM at Bathyaný Square, on the Buda side of the Danube river. This meeting point, on the upper riverbank parapet wall, directly above a M2 Metro line stop, is directly across the river, from the very picturesque Hungarian Parliament Building.

Early Sunday morning 26 March, Hungary and other parts of Europe converted to daylight saving time, by moving their clocks forward one hour. Possibly as a result of this, by 12 noon only 6 hashers had gathered for this Sunday hash. The assumption was made that other regulars may have failed to adjust their clocks or had possibly overindulged during or after watching the Saturday night soccer match between Hungary and Portugal. Unfortunately, the final score was not in Hungary's favor.

The former GM - Ference "Rabies" Domjan decided to set trail from the meeting point, for the benefit of any late arrivals and to keep things simple. The resulting pack of 5, consisting of another former Budapest GM - Jack "Bang Cock" Carlin, David "Incredible Hulk", Adam "Janos" (pronounced Yanosh = in English) "Horse's Dick", visitor "Just Richard" (my good friend residing in Germany) and myself proceeded to follow trail at approximately 12:30.



The first part of trail went directly up the nearest flight, of numerous steps named, Ilona Lepcso = Ilona Stairway, to the crest of the Buda castle hillside. That initial section definitely got the attention of "Horse's Dick" who was returning after a four-month absence and "Just Richard" who was not used to so many steps in his home area. Trail continued along the crest and around the colorful Matthias Church, in front of Fisherman's Bastion. It passed a bronze Horse and Rider statue, where it was rumored to result in good luck if one took time to rub the Horse's shiny testicles. None of the pack took advantage of this opportunity and of course a much higher and steeper hill was to be encountered later near trails end.



Trail passed directly in front of the Buda Castle, located on the southern tip of castle hill, down its far side and back to river level. It seems as if the Hare had either cleverly hidden his hash marks or had forgotten to put them down off a check at this point. After everyone searched in all directions, more than once, a phone call was made to the hare asking which direction we should concentrate our attention on. Marks were then located a good 400 yards from that check near a Queen Elisabeth statue – Sissi in Budapest. Very quickly trail crossed thru a pedestrian tunnel under the busy nearby intersection and the pack then wound its way up the imposing Mount Gellert hill (a World Heritage site), to its crest where the Budapest Citadel stands along with the Liberation Monument.



The Hare – “Rabies” met the less than speedy arrival of the small pack with cold Beer, water and snacks. “Incredible Hulk” served as Religious Advisor this day and did his duties in fine form. Everyone seemed to get honored with at least two or more down-downs and all traditional themes were covered. One particular back to back down-down involving “Rabies” and “Horse’s Dick” while holding hands, was referred to as - Canadian Style, since Canadian Hashers had previously introduced it to them. I prefer to refer to it simply as the “Hash Secret Handshake”!

Local tradition designates the last Budapest Hasher to finish trail as that weeks On-Sec. “Horse’s Dick” received this honor and became responsible for writing up the Hash Trash and bringing it to the following Sunday’s hash.

When Circle ended, the pack proceeded downhill and catching a bus, rode to the end of its line, in Moricz Zsigmond square, close to the river. The day’s activities concluded with everyone enjoying a tasty and very affordable meal, with more of Hungary’s good beer, in a local Bistro. Many thanks to “Rabies” and “Bang Cock” for their prior coordination and helpful information. I look forward to hashing with this fine group of hashers once again.

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Pan Africa Hash 2017

– The Final Countdown

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With Pan Africa 2017 being held in Lagos, Nigeria from Friday 26 May – 28 May 2017, Head Mistress, Africa Correspondent, decided to interview Slippery Corner, the host GM for the event to find out why you shouldn't miss the biggest event happening on the African continent this year and why it will be unforgettable, unlimited, unending fun and Ur best chance to visit!!!!



What do you think the final registration numbers will be when you close registration on 26th May?

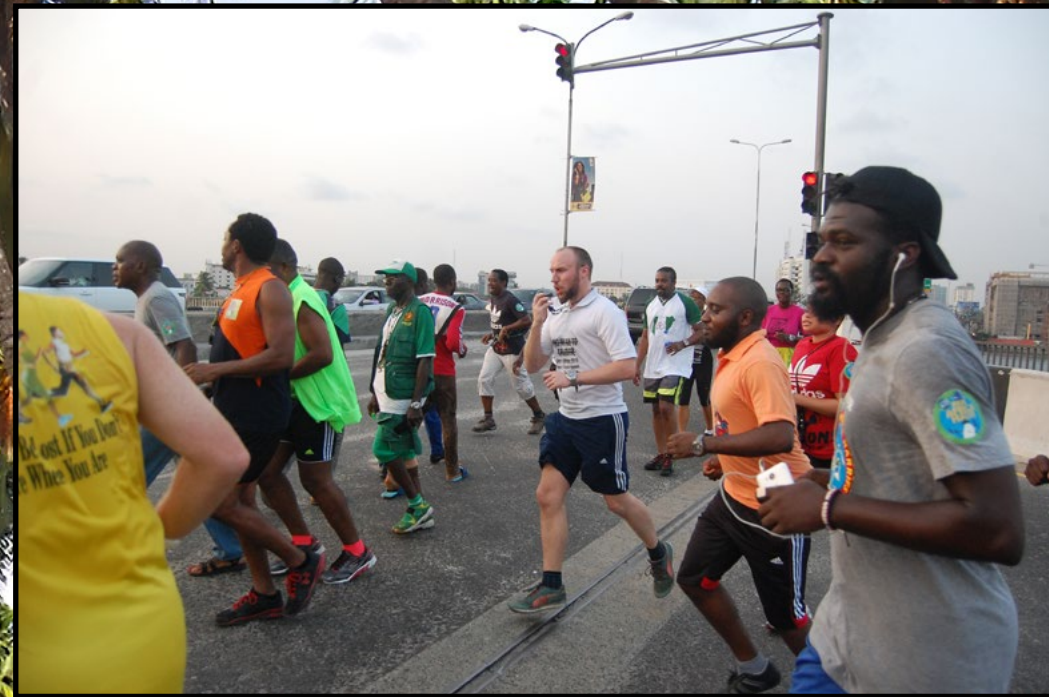
- We expect registration to hit about 750 but are planning for about 500 attendees.

Why should hashers sign up for the event?

- It promises 3 days of fun, running and partying. Lagos state (the host state in Nigeria) turns 50 that weekend so there is a host of activities - hash and non-hash related to keep you entertained. There will be concerts, talks, shows etc. all over the city.

How mismanaged will the event be?

- The event LOC is striving to beat records set at previous events by ensuring that this event is run in true hash spirit. Extremely cold beers chilled and delivered with military precision, exquisite Nigerian cuisine to challenge your palate, excellent location with free sea views and an ambience fit for hashing. It will be absolutely organised chaos with a good amount of drinking thrown in.



How can hashers travel from the airport to the venue? Will there be a meet and greet service?

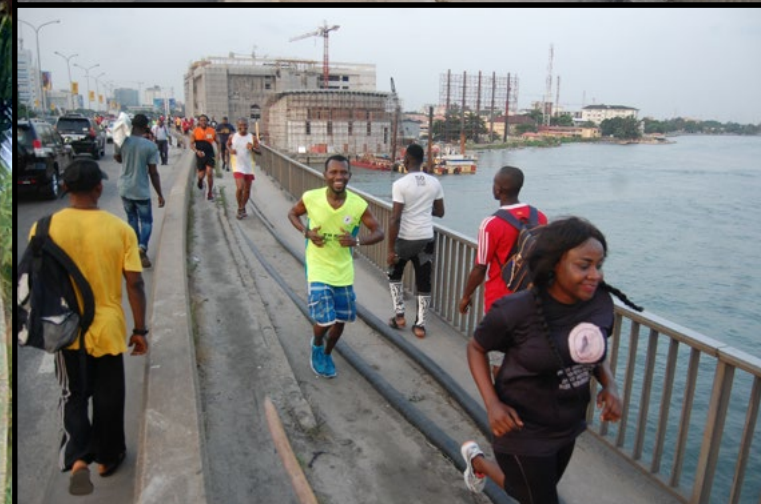
- There will be a bus service to and from the airport from Wed 24th of May. Hashers are required to provide their flight details for pick up. Visitors requiring visa on arrival are required to provide their names and may be required to pay a fee to the service provider.

What advice do you have to international hashers on staying safe in Lagos?

- Follow the rules as you would in any major city. Take only marked cabs e.g. Uber and stay at the event hotels for ease.

The event will offer choices of runs. What will be the maximum number of hashers on one run?

- We expect 60 hashers per run and there will be six runs each day on Saturday and Sunday. There will of course be the traditional Red Dress run to kick the event off.



At the heart of every successful hosting of a major hashing event are the Runs. Lagos being the host city will be taking the runs to different locations that will showcase its culture and tradition and its pride as being a “State of Aquatic Splendour”.

There will be 6 runs happening simultaneously at different locations in Lagos + The traditional Red Dress Run.

RED DRESS RUN

The Red Dress run will take off from the Best Western Hotel and take you in a fun fair style through the high-rise business district of the Lagos metropolis, showcasing the cities developed and developing landscapes. All funds raised from this run will be donated to two already selected charities. 1. The Lagos Old People’s Homes and 2. Child Life Line - A home for rehabilitating young boys taken off the Streets.

OLD FARTS RUN

The Old Farts run is fun fair run/walk for wankers who are not in any form interested in any form of athleticism but would rather satisfy their thirst in beer. This run will take off from a designated spot in the heart of Victoria Island, Lagos metropolis. The hashers will find designated bars along their route and stop in each bar, have a beer and move to the next bar till they either are passed out or finish visiting all the bars.

THE BALL BREAKER RUN

This run is strictly for those who are more athletics inclined, the run will take the hashers through one of West Africa longest bridge covering about 11.5km. The entire run covers a total of 22km.

THE TARKWA BAY RUN

Tarkwa Bay is an artificial sheltered beach located near the Lagos harbour. Due to its island status, it is only accessible by boat or water



taxis. The beach, popular with swimmers and water-sports enthusiasts, also has a welcoming resident community. The run will be commenced by a 20minutes boat ride from Fiki Marina to Tarkwa Bay Island. Come and enjoy this run while viewing Lagos city in its aquatic splendour.

THE EKO ATLANTIC RUN

Standing on 10million square metres of land reclaimed from the ocean and protected by an 8.5km long sea wall, Eko Atlantic which is the size of Manhattan’s skyscraper district is of the venue for this run spanning 9km around the new city. Come, behold Africa’s most luxurious real estate masterpiece while hashing.

THE GOSHEN BEACH RUN

This run is another interesting fun run as Hashers follow the trail along the beach line in the great coastal city of Lagos. Hear the roaring clap, feel the breeze on your face, enjoy this scenic view of the ocean while running and drinking beer...

THE URBAN SHIGGY RUN

This run is for hashers who love adventure and like to get dirty going through off road trail into tall grass path, small lakes, swamps, mud and even shit. Come have fun getting waist deep real dirty shiggy. This is only for the devil daring hashers.



Will the hares know the way?

- The hares will be guided by their bearing and that will not be an issue.

Apart from a red dress, what else should a hasher bring so they are fully prepared?

- Rego for the red dress run is set at \$10 or NGN3000 per hasher. Bring your rego for this run. And bring yourself.

Do you have any advice for hashers who are preparing hash acts?

- Keep it engaging and hash-active. There will be a mystery price for the winning act.

**Will you be providing warm Tusker beer for the East Africans?
What about other nationalities, what can they drink?**

- After a lengthy sampling process at the last Nigerian Nash Hash involving at least 20 East Africans, we are proud to offer extremely cold Star, Gulder and other local beers. The Ghanaian and West African hashers threatened to drink water if Star was not on the list and we would like to confirm that Star beer is the event beer. We are still making attempts to search for Tusker in the local market but were told that what is drank in East Africa- stays in East Africa.



Will hashers get a chance to fill themselves with Nigerian food or will there be more international food on offer?

- There will be the opportunity to sample a wide range of Nigerian dishes made with varying tolerances for spices. Hashers will be pleased to note that the LOC members personally sampled each meal and certified them.

As GM of Pan Africa 2017, do you have any final words of wisdom on the event?

- Cum - Lagos is waiting for you!

A LESSON IN GEOGRAPHY

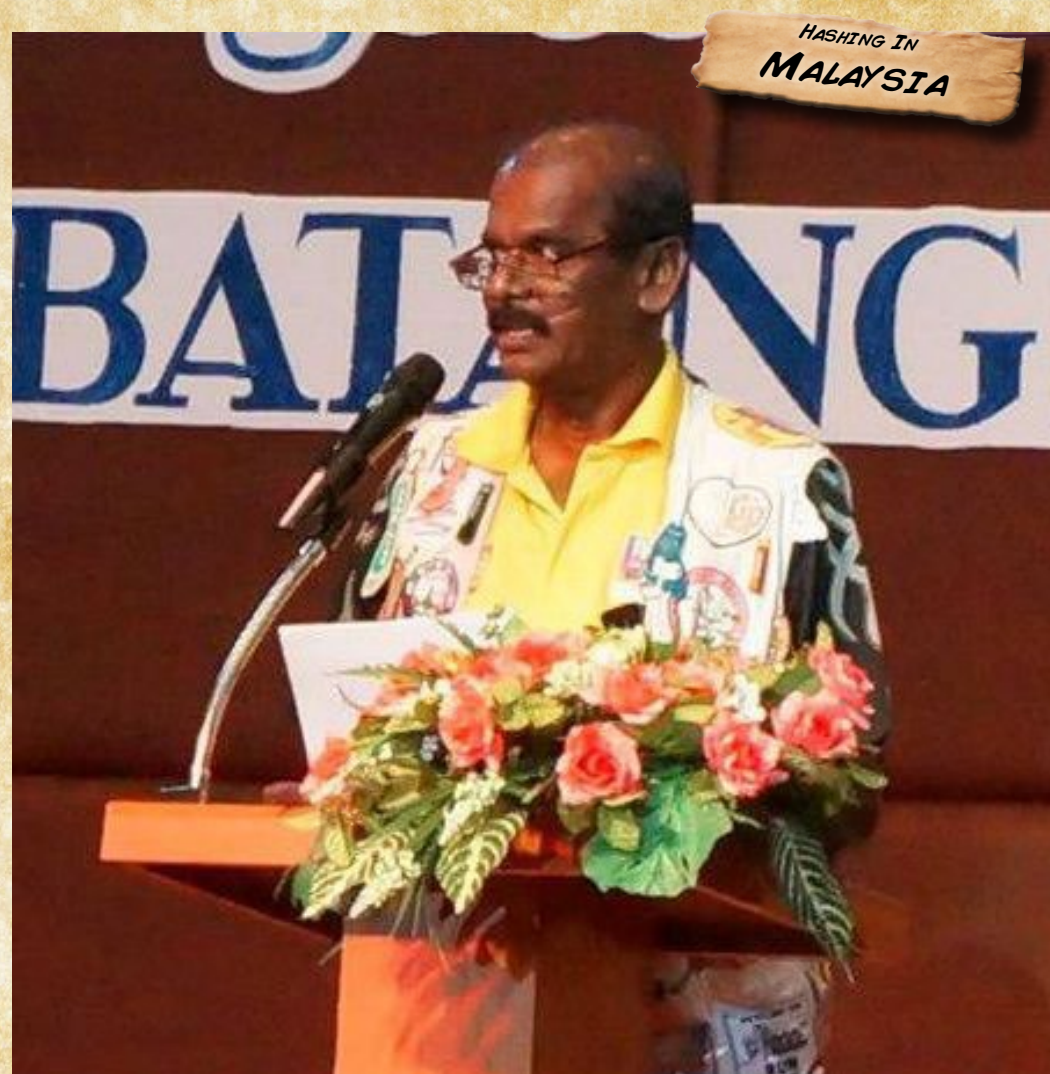
SELAMA HASH HOUSE HARRIERS, Perak

Tuesday, June 5, 2001 Run # 649

As a schoolboy philatelist, I was familiar with the names of the four States which formed the Federated States of Malaya, as each State issued its own postage stamp, usually with the picture of the Sultan. There was, of course, the British Resident to oversee. The first British Resident in Perak, J.W.W. Birch was apparently inept in British diplomacy (read duplicity) and had to lose his life in the hands of the then Maharaja named Lela. Even today, a small monument dedicated to the incident stands 'in a little village beside a slow river'

Ipoh, the capital of Perak, as elsewhere in Malaysia, has many keen hashers. The Ipoh chapter has the maximum number of registrants for IH2002 Goa. As such, as an IH Committee Member, I was interested in doing a run there and meeting them. When I expressed my desire to some of them in Langkawi, **Murugan "MGR – M.G. Ramachandran"**, GM of Selama H3, offered me the hospitality of his bungalow in a rubber and palm oil plantation in Ipoh, and to take me to their run on Tuesday. This day suited me very well. So, I took a bus South on Monday from Butterworth to Ipoh and he met me at the bus station.

It later transpired that Selama is a district town near the Perak/Kedah border, 100 km away from Ipoh. Murugan has been the GM of SH3 for the last nine years. He is also the Asstt. Treasurer at the Malaysian Hash Council. He became GM when he was posted as the Manager of an estate near Selama, and has continued to be re-elected even though he is now living so far. He travels every Tuesday afternoon to the run. *Orang gila, lah – mad guy.*



This week's run was in an estate near Selama, a smaller town in Kedah, opposite to our Selama, 140 km from Murugan's bungalow. Travelling 275 km to and from a 50-minute run, not in Ipoh, not even in Perak, was not something I had bargained for. Murugan had literally led me up a garden path. But, two days for the first time in a plantation, in the midst of the hills where once the C.T's (communist terrorists) held sway, was a wonderful experience.

Selama H3 was also a new experience for me. It is a small chapter with 26 members – 21 attended the last AGM held two weeks ago. It is a well-knit group of male runners. They have good runs in the hills and plantations and they also go in a group to outstation events. Last Sunday, some of them ran, along with 12,000 others, the annual half-marathon on the 11-km long Penang Bridge. There is no circle, no beer, and no ice, only chitchat and hash business after the run. The hares provide chilled fruit juice, snacks and food. They have been proudly this way for the last twenty years. I was the first foreign visitor in the history of Selama H3.

MGR passed away on 11th May 2016 in Ipoh, ten days after being re-elected uncontested as Chairman of the Malaysian Hash Council. This hash trash is being reproduced in his memory, on the occasion of a Memorial/Charity Run to be hosted by Selama H3 under the sponsorship of the Malaysian Hash Council, on Saturday, 13th May 2017.

After far too many Tsingdaos and Margaritas at the famed Mexican Wave in Beijing, Rick "Ratchucker" Head of the Beijing Hash suggested their upcoming 1,000th run be the Nash Hash to encourage participation from across China. An email was dispatched to Doug "White Trash" Barrett in Shanghai and John "Roomboy" Malins in Chengdu, and so the word was spread and the All China Nash Hash was born.

No 1 Beijing 18 - 19 May 2002

The 1st Nash Hash was combined with Beijing H3 1,000th run. Trails included: Fragrant Hills hared by Rugburn, Ratchucker, Prickly Nipples and Quick Draw, Great Wall hared by Wrong Way, Artsy Fartsy and Chris Fry, Ming Tombs hared by the Rat, Old Summer Palace hared by Rear Entry and Masturbaker, Houhai Lake hared by Chubby, OP and Don.

No 2 Shanghai 29 - 31 August 2003

The 2nd event was called the Pan China Hash. Trails were: Dong Shan hared by Boring English C@nt and Domestic Violence, Wu Jing hared by Wee Wullie and Spiderman, Qing Pu hared by Terminal Bottom Ailment and Pavarotten, She Shan hared by Body Shot and Raunchy Reverberation, The Bund hared by Octopussy and Empty Vessel, The French Concession hared by Two Dogs F@cking and Mayo Pijou. There was a run scheduled at Gao Qiao Pu Dong to be hared by No Balls, Ball & Chain and YMCA but this was cancelled due to ESHS (Early Start Hangover Syndrome) induced by the previous night's boat trip down the Huang Pu River.

No 3 Chengdu 1 - 2 May 2004

By this stage the name All China Nash Hash came into being. Four runs on the Saturday being Long Chuen Yi hared by Biggus Dickus and Pissing Down, Huang Long Xi Ancient Town hared by Wasabe, Pengshan, the sex museum and the giant carved stone Buddha hared by Dr Sleeze and Bai Ta Hu Lake, hared by Octopussy assisted by TBA. Sunday featured one mega Hash at the Panda base hared by Singapore Kernel and Pixie.

Hong Kong 11 - 13 March 2005 (The Forbidden Hash)

A group of Hong Kong based Hashers including Catch Of The Day, Haggis, Smallbone, Emma Royde and Caligula organised an unofficial China Nash Hash to celebrate 35 years of hashing in Hong Kong. A total of 8 runs were organised by Hares from the various Hong Kong based Hashes: Little Sai Wan, Kowloon, Royal South Side, Free China, Hash House Horrors, Sek Kong, Wanchai and Northern New Territories. One of the Hashes in Hong Kong refused to participate and threatened to "forbid" the event so, in typical hash spirit, it became known as the Forbidden Hash.



No 4 Hainan 22 - 24 April 2005

The 4th official ACNH was held in Sanya on Hainan Island, organized by Ma Hai. The weather was hot and because of the number of attendees the circles apparently ran out of beer. The long was very long and the short was also long. There were over 1,200 attendees, mainly overseas Chinese from Malaysia and Indonesia, some even managed to book 0.99c flights with a new low cost carrier as their promotion fare.

No 5 Guilin 21 - 13 April 2006

This event, organized by Acorn on behalf of the peripatetic Free China Hash, featured live hare A-B runs. The arrival run was through the city, then an early morning bus ride to Yangshuo for runs of differing lengths that ran along river banks, through paddy fields, irrigation canals, farmlands and bush and the circles were all held on river banks with swimming (voluntary and sometime involuntary).

No 6 Haikou 16 - 18 March 2007

The ACNH was again organised by Ma Hai, with down downs right on the beach front with lots of sitting on the ice! This time the attendance was reduced perhaps Ma Hai had pissed off so many of his 1,200 friends in Sanya 2 years earlier. Who knew he even had that many friends.

No 7 Tianjin 20 - 22 June 2008

Registration and Bash on the Friday was at Broadies Tavern in YouYi Lu Bar Street with live music inside and overflowing onto the street terrace outside. Saturdays run in the fields of Yang Liu Qin had 3 starts on differing lengths which culminated in the same finish point. No 15 Guangzhou 31 March - 4 April 2016

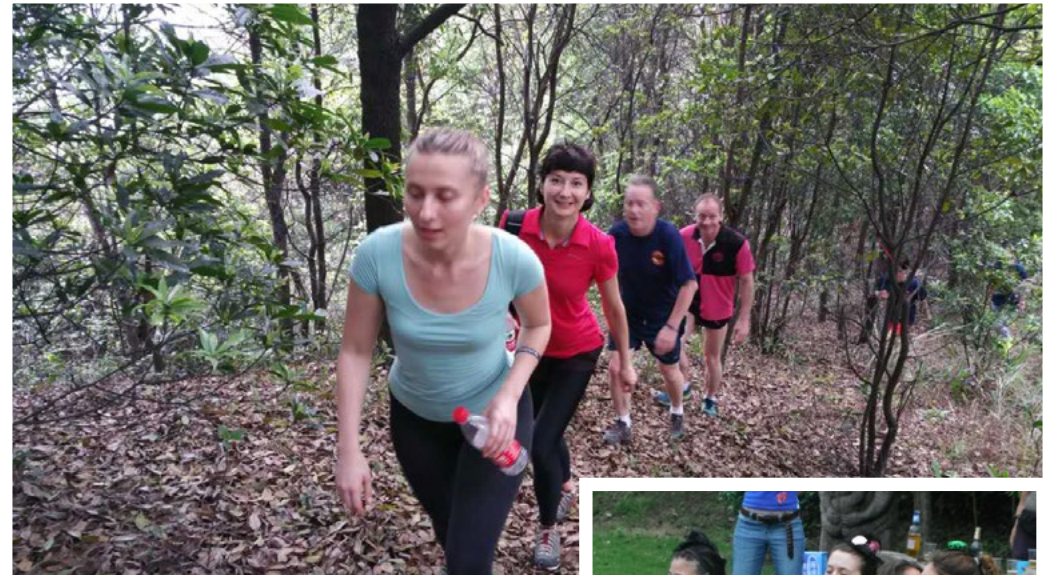

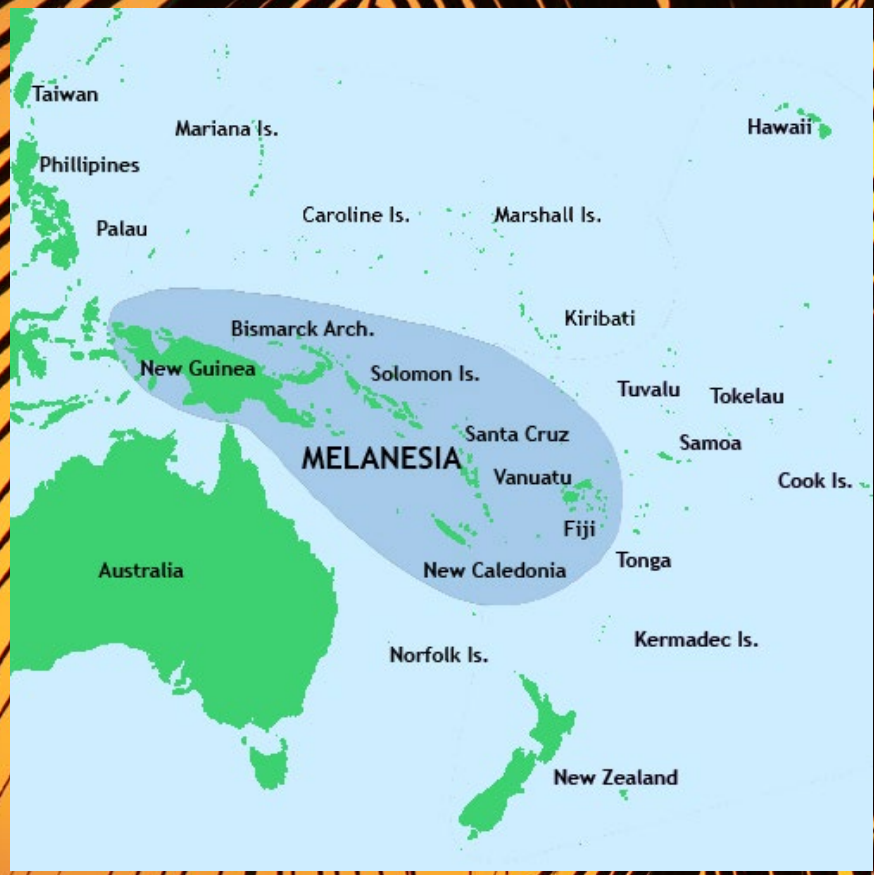
No 16 Chengdu 10 - 12 March 2017

'RED DRESS RUNS' ARE BECOMING A WORLDWIDE PHENOMENON

The Red Dress Run was established in 1988 and has become the signature event of the Hash House Harriers, the world's largest running club. KIM JONG-UN**

SCORED ALL NINE GOALS AS HIS COUNTRY CRUSHED VIETNAM IN A WORLD CUP QUALIFIER.

The official news agency for the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK) in Pyongyang reports today how the gifted striker ran the Vietnamese defence ragged and was easily the man of the match.

Playing in front of 250,000 fans packed into the national stadium, Jong-un bagged five goals in the first half before helping himself to four more in the second in the stunning 9-0 victory.

North Korea now tops its Asian World Cup qualifying group by 27 points, according to the North Korean Central News Agency.

"One goal was a 50-yard screamer, two more were headers from outside the box, while in another he picked up the ball from his own corner flag and dribbled past all eleven of the Vietnam players before blasting the ball into the empty net. The crowd loved it and were chanting his name all evening." Jong-un's heroics on the football pitch — he has now scored 176 goals for the national team in just 33 appearances — echo previous family sporting exploits.

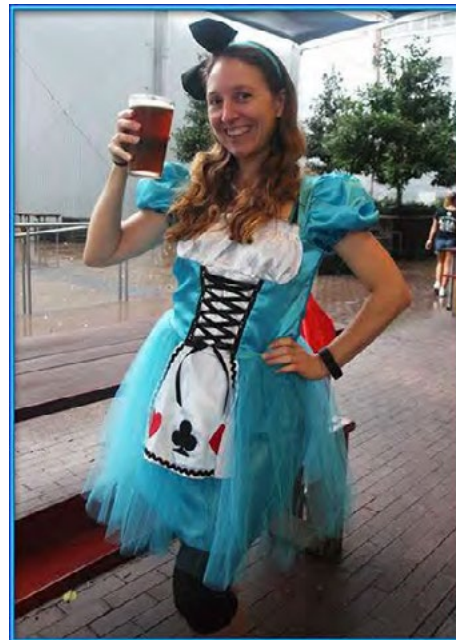
