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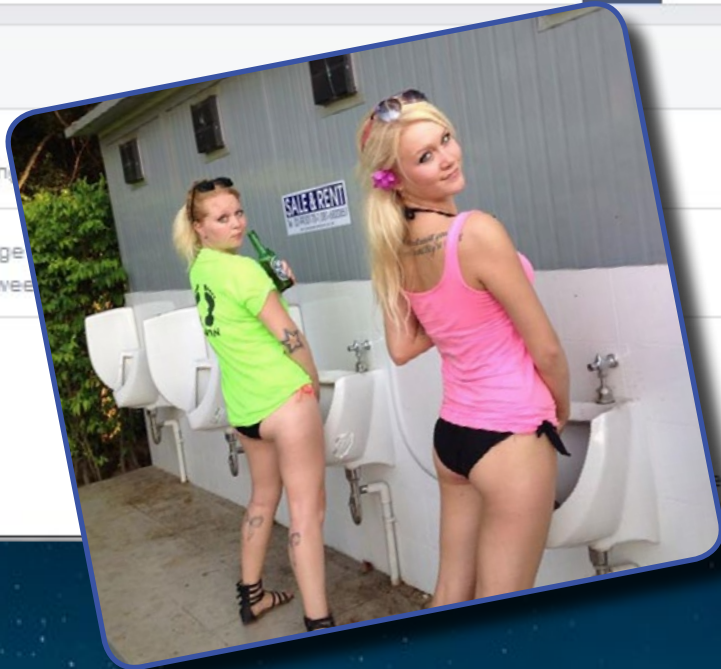

HASH LA VICTORIA SIEMPRE

Following the overthrow of the Fulgencio Batista dictatorship, the Cuban Revolution implemented agrarian land reform, redistributed wealth, improved literacy to 97%, set up a public health scheme that is the envy of the World, defended against a US backed invasion, survived a close-call nuclear crisis between Bobby Kennedy & Niki Khrushchev, and organised various away tours to the Congo, Ethiopia, Angola and Bolivia. However, none of the great heroes of the Revolution: Fidel Castro, Camilo Cienfuegos or Ernesto 'Che' Guevara ever got around to setting up a Hash.



Thankfully, following the recent relaxing of US sanctions the Cuban Government accepted the assistance of a team of Hash advisors from China including experts from the Royal South Side, Wanchai, Free China and Babes Hashes. This team of experts launched the Havana Hash House Harriers (H4) whose inaugural run took place in Havana Vieja on Saturday 15th April 2017. The Havana Hash is perhaps unique in that it has at last solved the age old issue of a Hash being a drinking club with a running problem. The inaugural run followed a 5km route through the Old Town with rum stops in each of Hemingway's favorite haunts ... as well as a few extra venues. Certainly there was no running problem!

The trail began at the Plaza Hotel with the Pack decked out in the new Havana H3 stash sporting the Bat and Che Guevara motifs as well as the Cuban flag sleeve and Hash logo, "Hash la Victoria Siempre" – Hash to victory always! The route headed south past the Jose Marti monument to the first rum stop at El Floridita.

This was Hemingway's number one bar for daiquiris. "My mojitos in La Bodeguita. My daiquiris in El Floridita." the great man once said. So the Pack followed suit and the rum stop was indeed daiquiris all round. At the far end of the bar the life sized bronze statue of Hemingway looked on approvingly. He is reputed to have drunk 13 daiquiris in one sitting and the Pack were certainly honoring that feat.

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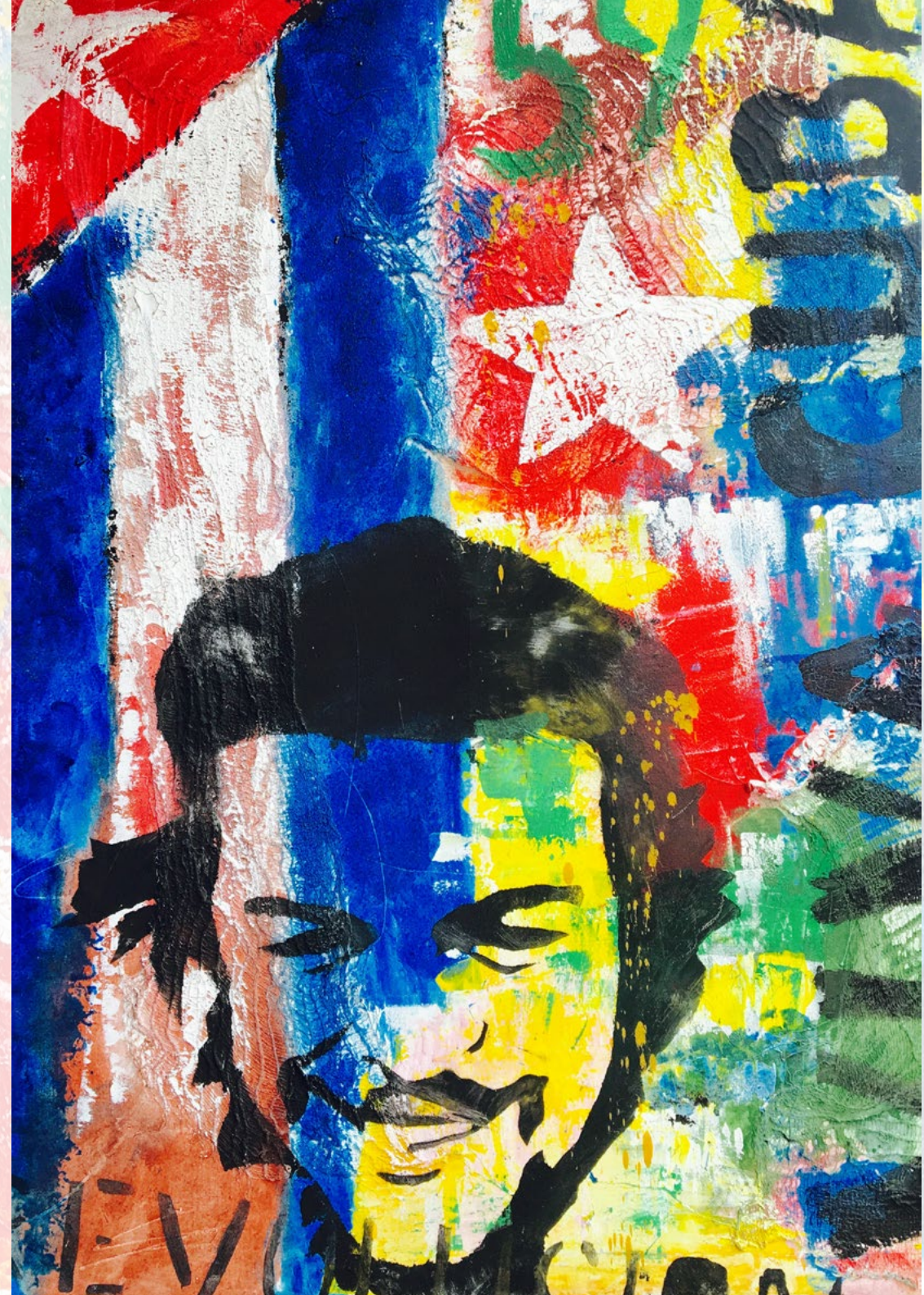
On our round the Capitolio Nacional, however, there was a lot of daiquiri induced short cutting to the next rum stop in Monserrate bar where the Pack refueled on mojitos. The trail then meandered through the cobbled lanes of the Old Town between tumbledown Spanish colonial casas, bright pink 1950's Cadillac convertibles and ancient bronze canon that mark the street corners. After a number of check backs and false trails the Pack arrived at El Chunchellero where thankfully rum was replaced by a cold, refreshing Bucanero beer.

There followed a long leg east to Havana Bay and the next rum stop in Dos Hermanos on the waterfront. A large sign proclaimed, "Hemingway did not drink here", however, the Pack did and a round of ice cold Cuba Libres was soon disposed of. On the harbor warehouse across the road a large fresco of Che looked gigantically down as the pack staggered northwards, skirting the Malecon and through the 3 plazas of the Old Town: Plaza Vieja, Plaza de San Francisco de Asis and Plaza de Catedral. No tour of the plazas would be complete without some refreshment which resulted in yet another rum stop in the huge colonial lobby of the Hotel Amos Mundos for a top up of Cuba Libre, as if one was needed. These were quickly dispatched around an ancient grand piano.



The trail veered west past the monument to Miguel de Cervantes y Saavedra and the final rum stop in the famous La Bodeguita del Medio for a round of mojitos. The Hares had been refused service in this bar on the recce as they were also recceing the rum stops and by this stage they were unable to walk or talk. Surprisingly, the Pack managed to get served with the assistance of some locals who were enthralled by the concept of Hashing. They thought it was a very revolutionary idea and well worthy of Cuban traditions.

The Pack Circed up next to the monument of Mayor Manuel Fernandez Supervielle, near the Edificio de Bacardi which aptly shares the Bat logo of the Havana Hash. Hash Master, Haggis and Religious Revolutionary Advisor, Emma Royde delivered numerous DownDowns and most of the Pack received their Havana Hash names. No Circle can truly be claimed a "great" Circle without the involvement of the police and sure enough once the Pack started mooning from the statue of the famous mayor the Policia Nacional de la Revolution were soon on site but using nothing more threatening than police whistles.



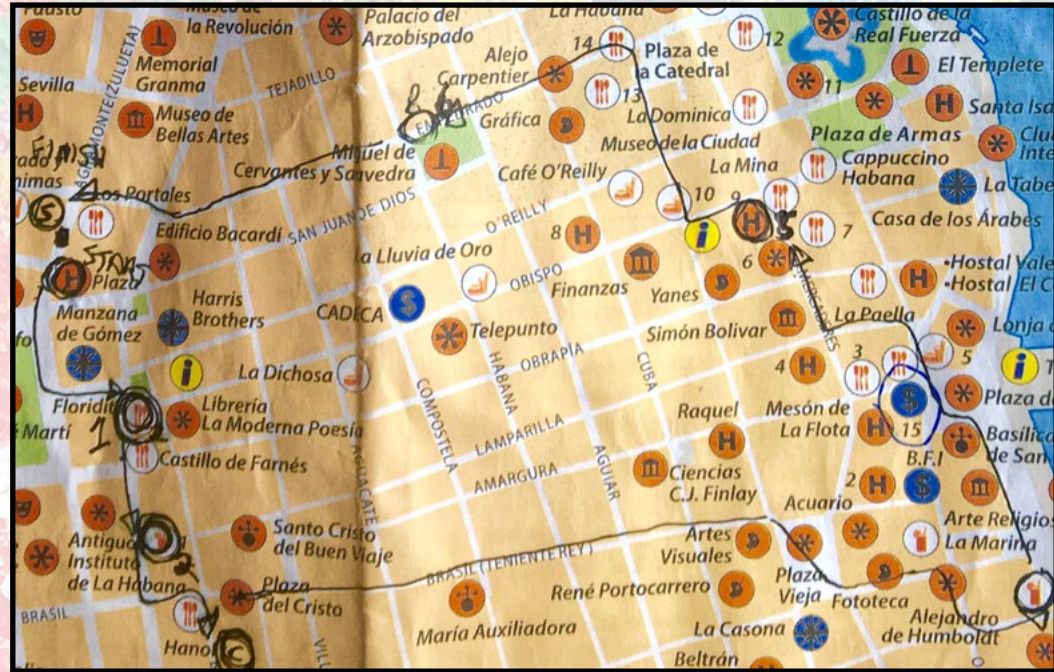


The arrival of the PNR chased the Pack to the OnOn location in Sloppy Joe's, perhaps the most famous pre-revolutionary bar in Cuba and reputedly a haunt of celebrities such as Frank Sinatra, Alec Guinness, John Wayne, Spencer Tracy and Clarke Gable. Sloppy Joe's has the world's longest bar top at 60 feet and is the inspiration for the deli sandwich of the same name. It also featured in the movie of the Graham Green classic, Our Man in Havana. So a perfect place to finish the first ever run of the Havana Hash House Harriers.

The Havana Hash ran again a few days later at the other end of the island in Santiago de Cuba but that is another story. Until then Hash la Victoria Siempre!

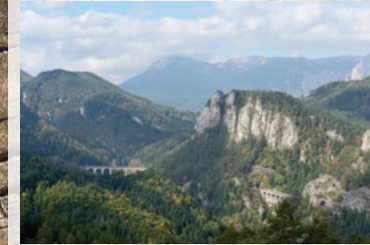

Semmering, Payerbach

Semmering/Payerbach: This is the nearest Alpine region to Vienna. Long and medium runs are planned – this will of course involve uphill and downhill sections. However, the views will make it well worth it.

Baden

South of Vienna this region is famous for its vineyards and beautiful countryside. 2 medium runs are planned here with the Ballbreaker in nearby Helental.



Hainburg

The Danube's medieval tax collecting post and stormed by the Turks (when beer was still drunk in monasteries) is wonderfully located on the Danube towards Bratislava. There is the hilltop castle or 'Schlossberg', which, by its nature, is on top of a hill. Both a medium and short run are planned.

Gablitz

This small town in lower Austria will host the infamous Bras and Pants run through the Vienna Woods and passes by the viewing point at Troppberg. Get ready Gablitz!

THE NEPTUNUS WEEKEND

APR. 28-30
NETHERLANDS

The final weekend of April witnessed an unusual gathering in the historic surroundings of Castle de Berckt at Baarlo in the south Netherlands province of Limburg. More than 150 Hashers came together to marvel at the fact that Neptunus, the sage of Hague H3, is not dead yet. The man himself preferred to think of the event as a celebration of his 25 years of Hashing and his 65th birthday; nobody had the heart to disillusion him.

Castle de Berckt

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The exploits of Neptunus are known worldwide, but he still somehow manages to slip through Customs. He has Hashed in 45 countries, many of them for a second time in order to apologise for what happened on the first occasion. As befits a man who has returned more-or-less intact from 9 Inter- and 8 Eurohashes, Neptunus has a wide circle of acquaintances, some of whom he claims are friends. They came from all corners of the globe, many still hoping to get their money back for previous fiascos.

When you register for a Neptunus event, you know what you'll get: first class accommodation, outstanding facilities and smooth organisation....are not expected. The Castle dates back to the 13th century and still has many of its original features, particularly the furniture and plumbing. Over the centuries, armies have clashed on and near this site. Towards the end of WW II, the retreating German army took cover in the cellars as the Allied forces approached. Anyone surveying the site today would conclude that a mighty battle must have ensued. This was the third collaboration of Neptunus and Castle de Berckt. A few optimists are still confident that sooner or later they'll get things right. Thus thwarted, the Machiavelli of Hash then ambushed Opee (Hague H3), who, unaware of previous Neptunus cockups, innocently offered to help out. Just before legging it to the airport, Ban The Cock handed over the details of his psychiatrist, lawyer and trail info to Opee. Now ~~conned~~ recruited as Chief Hare, Opee wisely opted to take the Saturday party back to the forests of the Meinweg, a Dutch National Park area bordering Germany. At 11 a.m. the call was "All board the buses".

Hashers had the choice of an A-B 8km walk, a 17km run and a 22km Ballbreaker, all in hilly terrain. It was dry underfoot. The weather was cool but sunny. The runs featured 3 beer stops and a spirit stop with all groups intending to meet for lunch around the halfway point at 1pm.

The Hague is home to hundreds of rocket scientists and other boffins of the European Space Agency. The city is proud of its association with these pioneers who managed to deliver the Huygens Lander onto Saturn's moon Titan. 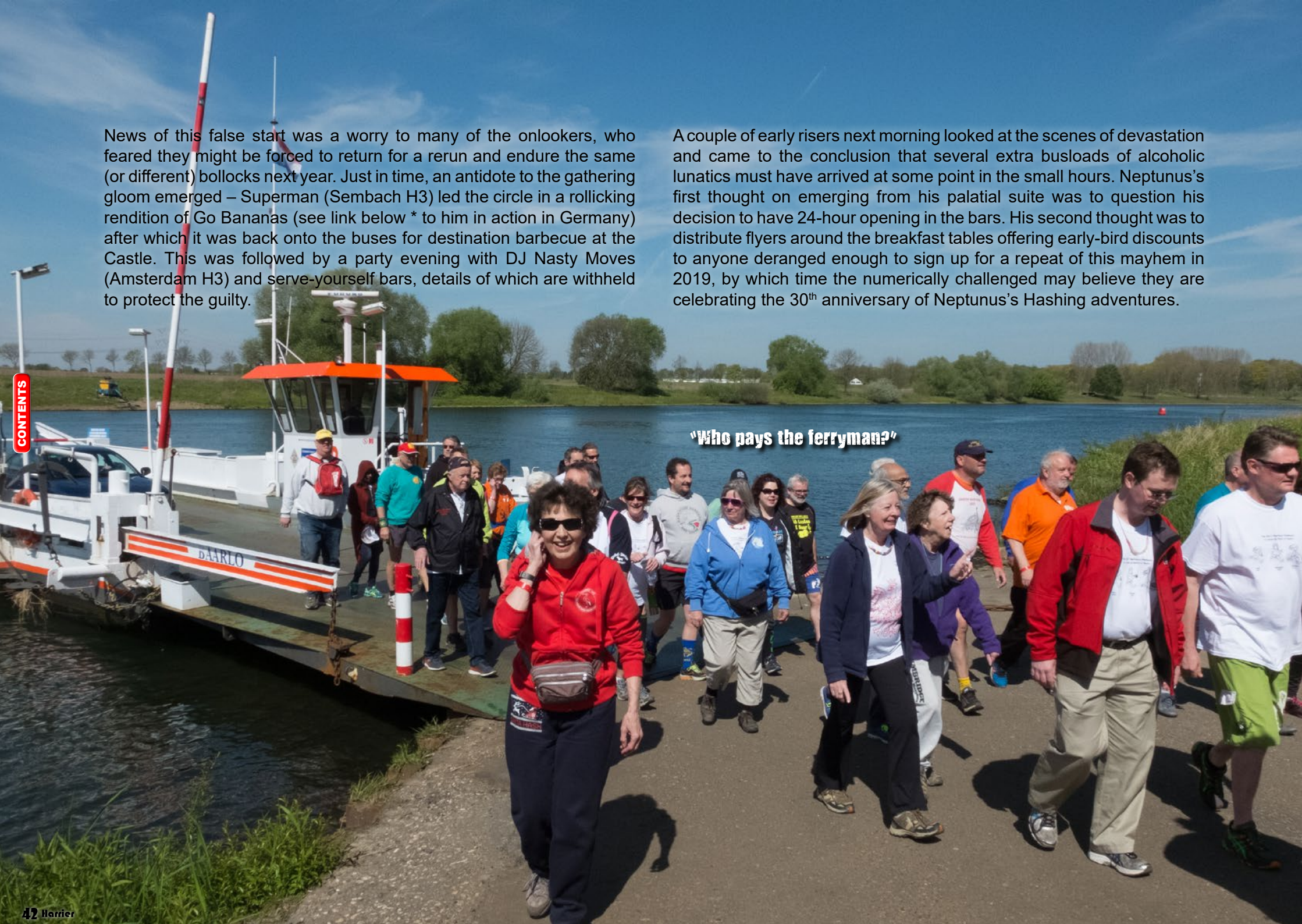


Neptunus in PUFFIN disguise

The event capped out at 150 hashers and with a wee bit of the Luck of the Irish this Harriett was one of the first to rego at the early price of 69.00. I can't think of a better way to spend a weekend than hashing in a desert oasis with half-minds.



Friday night's Green Dress Run was held on March 17th St. Paddy's Day and offered a mix of Palm Springs night life on the main drag, shiggy and other obstacles. A quick pack picture in our green garments by the pool and the Hare's were off. The pack took off like a green horde of thirsty hounds looking for a pub on St. Patrick's Day. We gingerly hiked up our green gown's and climbed through the shiggy and over the blarney stones where as luck would have it, the pack was greeted by a Leprechaun a top of a tiny hill holding bottle of Irish Whiskey and 12 oz Pots of Golden Nectar. He handed over the booze freely but no matter how many shots we gave him, he wouldn't give up the check. The hares trail took us on a tour running through downtown to a drink check at the Hair Of The Dog, ON OUT in to winding streets of desert modernism architectural homes, past art museums to a beer check where the pack quenched their thirst before trail gained elevation and hashers 1 by 1 hoofed up the rocky trails, sweating in the desert heat. Hashing in Rwanda

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This month Head Mistress reports on hashing in Rwanda, the land of 1000 hills.

Rwanda, a small landlocked county in East Africa is home to one hash, the Kigali Hash House Harriers based in the capital of the country. Runs are every Saturday afternoon meeting at various areas around the city to start driving to the start of the run. Clear announcements about the meeting place and the driving directions are clearly announced on Facebook a few days before giving the impression of a clearly mismanaged hash.

Rwanda is a landlocked East African country with a green, mountainous landscape. Its renowned Volcanoes National Park is home to mountain gorillas and golden monkeys.

The park encompasses 4,507m-tall Mt. Karisimbi and 4 other forested volcanoes. In the southwest is Nyungwe National Park, with ancient montane rainforest that's a habitat for chimpanzees and other primates.

Capital: Kigali

Population: 11.61 million

Official languages: Kinyarwanda, French, English



On the day I showed up, the meeting point was a church car park in the city centre. No prayers before hashing as the church was busy with a wedding with everyone smartly dressed with the ladies wearing something that looking like a sari in bright colours, their traditional dress. They couldn't have been to pleased to see the arrival of the Kigali hashers in their traditional hash dress. A mixed bunch of nationalities with around 50% local and 50% expats.

Anyway the hash didn't stay around too long spoiling the landscape and once lifts were sorted out we were off. The run was an hour out of town which is not usual for the hash and after going up and down many hills and around several hair pin bends with beautiful sweeping views of the valley below we arrived at.

On the lawns of the guest house there was a circle of chairs and the hashers sat down as they arrived waiting in turn to pay 2500 Rwandan francs for run fees and 3 beer coupons. Another brownie point for mismanagement. Some hashers immediately went to the bar to start drinking.



Eventually once everyone had arrived and paid hash cash, the hares announced the run of 7.5 km and a walk of 5km laid on shreddie. The muddy trail was very beautiful through farming land and countryside. The locals seemed very excited by the arrival of the hashers and joined in for some of the trail. At one point there was more locals running than hashers. There was one steep climb down and one climb up and eventually the On in was sited.

After some social drinking and more sitting and lying around, the GM called the circle to stand and circle proceeding were under way in traditional hash form until the sun set and the circle finished

The On On was at the bar of the guest house and with the sound system pumping out mainly Congolese music, the dance party began.

Rwanda is one of the countries listed to possibly host Pan Africa 2019 and with a well organised infrastructure and smooth visa on arrival system for most tourists and over 1000 green hills it could make a good destination for the next Pan Africa.

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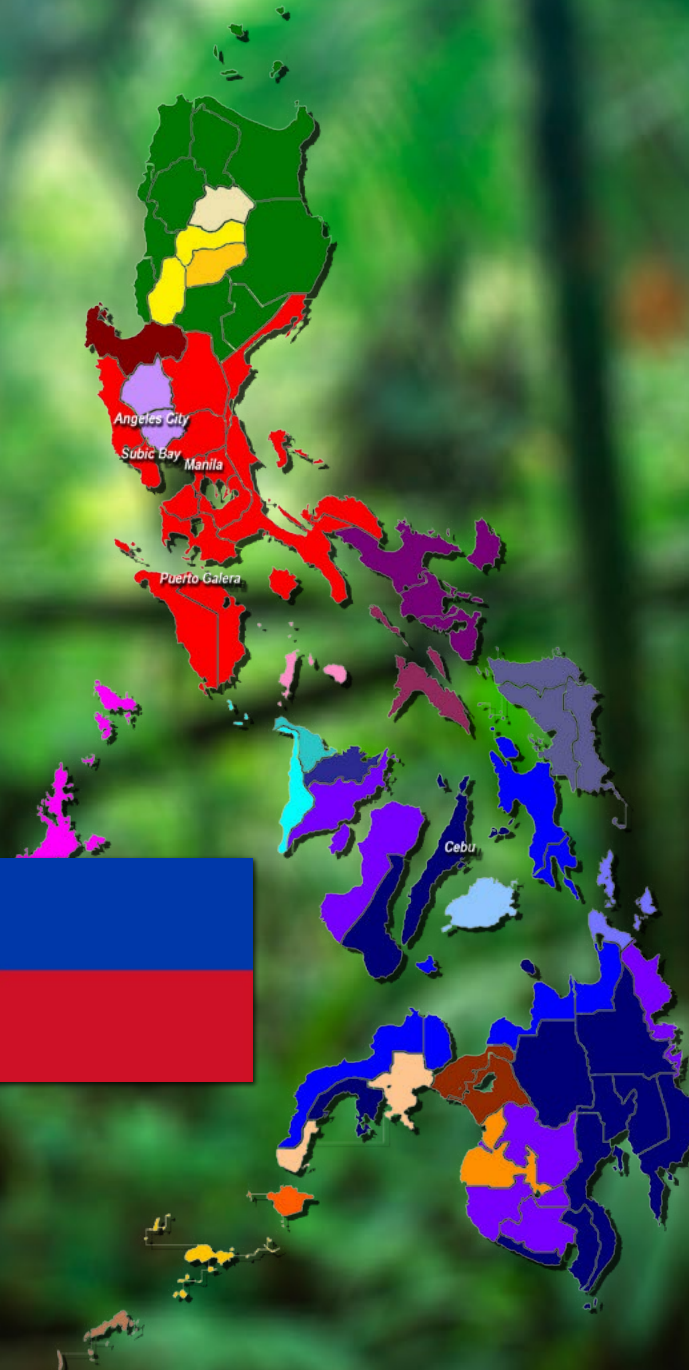

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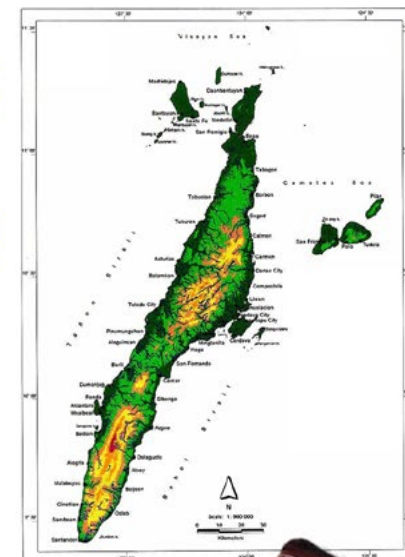

OUT OF CHAOS ON ON TO GOOD TIMES

Most Philippine Hash Groups are located in Luzon and Imperial Manila does consider us to be hicks in the boondocks down here in Cebu. We are somewhat insular and do not travel well but Luzon hashers have this image of Cebu being the home of short, easy, flat runs with a rest Halt every 500 metres. So it came as something of a surprise after our 1000TH Run in October 2015 that Cebu was asked to host the 2017 Nash Hash.

However, we did rise to the challenge and soon found out what lay ahead of us. In the main, Philippine Hashers are not indigenous to the Philippines and you would expect these ex-pats to be quite a savvy bunch. We began to wonder at the problems many of them had in filling in our simple online rego form and easy payment arrangements. With a lot of perseverance, we ended up with around 75 confirmed registrations.

Cebu has now overtaken much of Manila's traffic problem so even getting a small group of hashers to a run site can be somewhat fraught. Most of our normal Sunday runs involve from 5 to 30 km on main roads followed by narrow lanes which usually are rocky tracks – not suited for busing in 85 hashers (this restricted our choice of run areas). One way or another, we choose 3 separate areas for each day's runs and managed to find hares to give a choice of easy or hard routes each day; all starting with a drive out from our kennel (The SandTrap pub) at 2pm.

MAY 19TH TO 21ST IN CEBU

RE-VISITED



THE RUNS

DAY 1 – FRIDAY 19TH MAY

The 2 runs from the mountain Barangay of Budlaan got off to a mismanaged start when the vans ferrying the hashers decided it was better to follow our lead car by being in front and going to the wrong place! Eventually, all 5 vans were on the ridge-top at around 300 metre above sea level. 3 van loads disembarked and prepared for the easy walk to a scenic waterfall in the valley below. The other 2 continued up the track away to get out and commence the arduous hike.

EASY WALK

Mainly a gently sloping downhill footpath for a kilometre or so before a 40 metre rope assisted sharp descent to the bed of the Butuanon River and the Kabang Waterfalls. The biggest fall is around 25 metres and its pool is shallow, a deeper pool lies below the lower fall. At (or before) this point, some of the more elderly hashers had decided that Cebu HHH easy trails were a tad tough. And they still had to climb out and back for their awaiting beers. All in the run wasn't much more than 3 kilometres.

ARDUOUS HIKE

Classic mismanagement; the hares got lost setting it from around sea level up and over many ridges to finish at the walkers' trail site. To correct this, they decided to do it in reverse and drop down from a 300 metre height and finish at about 40 metres. As the crow flies this would be around 3 km BUT that does not include the many narrow valleys to go down into and then climb back up out of! Some of these ups and downs were in the order of 200 metres and the real paced out distance would have been in excess of 7 km – FOR ANYONE THAT MADE IT.

On the day, the only hare who knew the way chose to be the rear sweeper leaving it to a hare who only knew the first half of the route to be lead. Not a wise choice – in the event, the front party swung off route far too early and came out on the road back up to the top ridge. Not to



be deterred, they reached the start of the waterfall walk and proceeded to do that as well. One (who shall be nameless) even decided to run the 7 km back to the SandTrap for the free beer Meet & Greet.

All in all, the various delays resulted in no time for a Circle before the free beer started flowing at the SandTrap – prior to a (tame?) bar crawl around Cebu’s Mango district.

DAY 2 – SATURDAY 20TH MAY

The developers of a nature park, eco-friendly retirement village and organic farm on the other side of Cebu island (AmonSagana by Syntech Properties Inc) kindly sponsored a fleet of 7 people carrier vans (with drivers) to take all of us 25 km out of town - up over the central ridge, down again and then up to an area known as Ayala Heights at the edge of the Kan Irag nature park. All runs started from open ground alongside the Cebu Trans-central Highway.

COMBINED LONG AND NOT SO LONG RUNS

A big pack set off in the same direction since the shorter run branched back somewhere along the longer trail. There are many stories about what actually happened but the first hashers started returning to the car park muddied and riding motorbike taxis about an hour after the “Check It Out”. Over the next hour, the whole pack dribbled back in from various directions and all showing signs of shiggy stains. The area has a thick clay cover over limestone and we had experienced a bit of a downpour prior to the start of the runs. It is unclear if everyone found the isolated shack which formed the BEER HALT.

FLOWER POWER FOR WALKERS

Because of the early rain and something of a landslide along the cross country route to the 2 ornamental flower gardens located about 1 ½ km up the minor road from the car park, the walkers got to ride 3 vans up to the entry to the oldest flower farm (close to Barangay Sirao). The



walkers could then explore the gardens and sample the shiggy steps before climbing back to the lane and riding or walking the 1 ½ km back to our vehicles and loads of awaiting beer.

Once all three groups were back, we continued rehydrating ourselves while admiring the view down a valley to Cebu City and Mactan Island with the sea and Bohol on the horizon (we were around 600 m above sea level – Kan Irag peak is around 725).

As the sun sunk in the west behind Negros Island, we boarded our vans and headed back towards Cebu City. But not all the way down. We turned into a posh sub-division and up to its clubhouse overlooking the lights of the city below. There, we were greeted by giant blocks of ice that were placed together so as to resemble a queen size bed complete with headboard. The first circle of the weekend was about to commence. I think it is fair to say that it was a pretty good circle which only closed when the sounds of a local band drifted out of the open-sided clubhouse along with appetizing food aromas – dinner was served.

As we finished eating, a band made up of ex-pat rockers and a great local bass player took over the music and had most of us up and dancing the night away. During the band's intermission, that guy who has been nameless called for another circle to make up for the lost one on Friday. Big chunks were hacked off the ice bed and placed in the middle of the dance floor and we were away again with all those (seemingly logical at the time) things that mildly intoxicated Hashers get up to. Eventually, the music continued and we boogied down to midnight (when we had to vacate the clubhouse). I am told that one of the vans took hashers on a one hour tour of the complete sub-division before finding the exit gate.



DAY 3 – SUNDAY 21ST MAY

Another meet up at the SandTrap at 2pm but, this time, transport was in two fairly large coaster type buses for the 12 km drive to Tayud located on the border between Consolacion and Liloan to the north of Cebu City. A much easier drive and less traffic on a Sunday so we were all soon parked up in front of a smaller clubhouse (but this one had a swimming pool).

2 RUNS – A SHORTER AND THE LONGER

These were separate runs although they did overlap or cross each other at times – the only difference being in their lengths. The subdivision start point lies along a (narrow) main road and to the east of this is an area of rolling hills across to the shoreline. At present, there has not been too much development and the land is crossed with unpaved lanes, footpaths and open grassy spaces. The soil is only an inch or so thick so there is not a lot of undergrowth to force your way though. At the top of the largest hill there are good sea views to one side and the mountainous center of Cebu to the other.

A big difference between the runs was that the longer run had a beer wagon strategically placed about half way, but the shorter run only had a Gatorade wagon!

Mainly the shorter runners were first back to the clubhouse although some of the longer ones were not so far behind. This left us with plenty of time for the closing circle. This was somewhat dominated by our nameless hero but everyone had a good hashy time.

Towards the end of the circle, it was proposed, and greeted with mainly approval, that the 2019 Philippine Nash Hash should be hosted by Manila.

Again, a catered dinner buffet followed the circle and then many repaired to the pool's water to while away more beers before our departure time of 10pm.



CLOSING COMMENTS

All in all, I think everyone found the weekend to their liking. The worst complaints that I heard were:-

- A Cebu “easy” run is harder than expected.
- That waitress at the Meet & Great mixed my rum and cokes so strong that I had trouble going on the bar crawl afterwards.
- Bloody music on Saturday made me dance so much that my legs had trouble running on Sunday.

Thank you everyone who came along and thanks also to those who helped with haring and general organization.

"The Labrador is a working breed and has been Britain's most popular dog since 1990 when it took over from the Yorkshire Terrier, another great British dog.

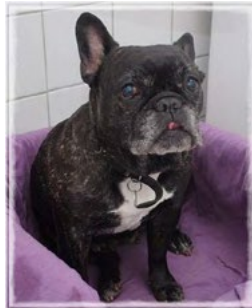

"I fought in two world wars and have worked and paid my taxes since I was eight, so this is all Europe's fault."

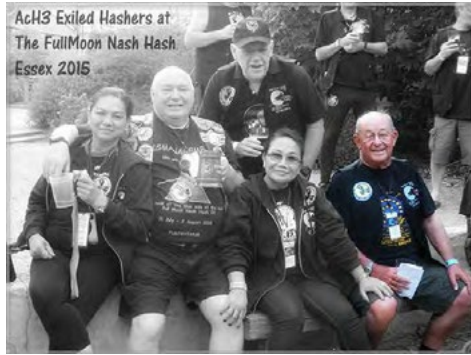
Gone but not forgotten

“I would certainly never deem it an important enough matter to issue a stone commandment one way or the other.

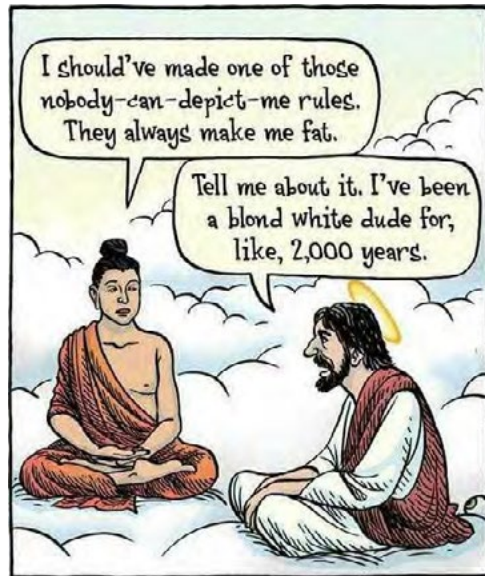
“In fact, the very fact that I gave you genitals and that they’re really rather fun should indicate that they’re at the more recreational end of the human spectrum.”

UK DENIES RESIDENCY TO BRITISH-BORN CHILDREN OF GREEK-GERMAN COUPLE

The Home Office have refused a Greek and German couple's post-referendum application to have their British-born children recognised as permanent residents of the UK.

The news, announced a month before Mr Windsor's 96th birthday, was a surprise to many, not least his wife who has been told to keep on working, even though she is 91.

The wonderful people at the weather station had prophesied an extremely cold day, to boot it was to be the coldest day in May in 70 years with temperatures ducking under the Zero point.

So, with an extra layer of padding we set off across the children's grassy playground leading along a wooded track, under the main road and delved into the first forest. By this time there were a few drops of snow in the air but nothing really to get worried about and they left as quietly as they came.

Leaving the forest down the first of three rock-strewn descents the trail plunged down to the gravel path with a couple of nasty checks leading to the horse stables and further to a dead end at the lake. 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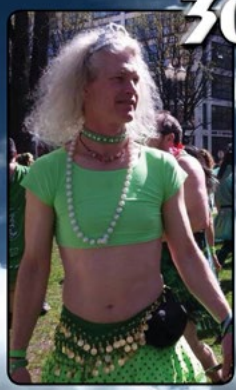
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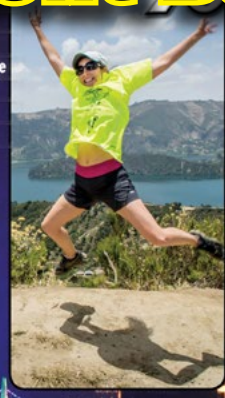
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
