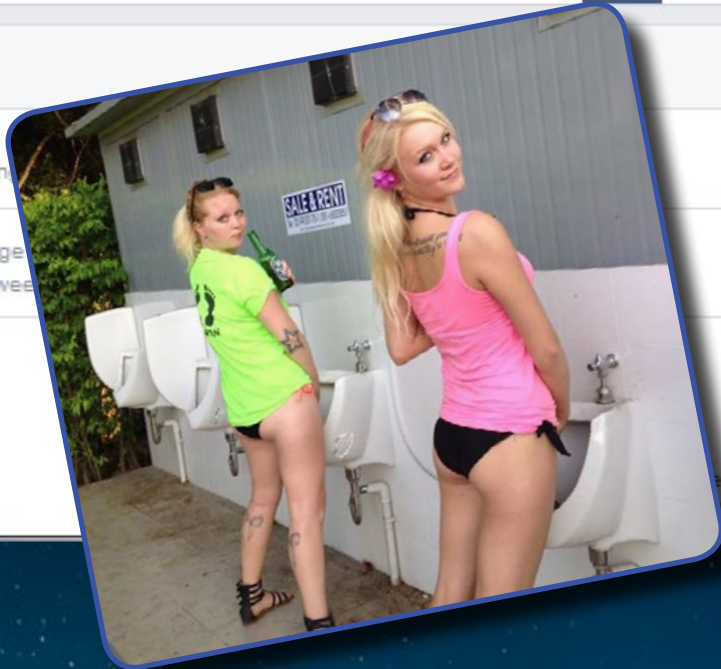

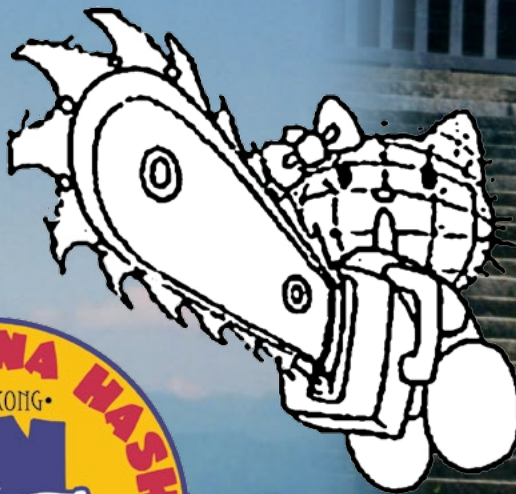

HELL KITTY TOUR IS 8-11 SEP.

GO TO HELL KITTY WITH THE FREE CHINA HASH

Founded in Hong Kong in February 1995 by ex Taiwan Hashers, the Free China Hash House Harriers has always had a penchant for away runs. In the early days, the focus was on exploring China, including the first several Hashes in Guilin, and returning to Taiwan (aka Free China) to run with their mother Hash.

By the late 1990s the Free China Hash had a significant coterie of 'Tama-gotchis' running regularly, together with a lot of wanna be partners in sleaze. An intrepid band of them, led by Emergency Services, Catch of the Day, Amah Moron and Coral Cock came up with the idea of bringing the Free China Hash to Japan to experience its many pleasures.



The first tour was to Hakone in 1999. Emergency Services took charge of logistics and made sure that the Hashers could get pissed at a reasonable price and experience the local culture without overly upsetting the natives while Coral Cock, Amah Moron and Catch of the Day set two quite glorious live-hare runs. Sake, beer, sake, hot spring baths, sake, food that tasted like fish, sake and even a drum show.

By the second tour Amah Moron had grown nauseated by the too-cute “Hello Kitty” culture of post-pubescent Japan and coined the term “Hell Kitty” for good pussy gone bad with the logo of a sleaze bag in a hot tub smoking a fag and drinking a beer. Since then all tours to Japan are called Hell Kitty Tours. Hell Kitty 2 went to Lake Biwa outside of Kyoto in April 2001. There was still a lot of snow on the mountains, which caused a few challenges for a Hash used to marking with white cooking flour. One highlight was a ‘hanami’, which consisted of sitting under a cherry blossom tree and getting drunk. The Hash was quite amenable to this Japanese ritual.



Hell Kitty 3 went to Kyushu in April 2003. We were greeted at Fukuoka Airport by TV crews eager to interview plague refugees escaping Hong Kong at the height of the SARS outbreak, and they seemed disappointed to hear that we are all in good health! The first night was spent in the sleazy district of Fukuoka and long time Hasher, BOF (then in his late 60s) enthused the next day that he had finally broken through the sleaze barrier in Japan. He was not as lucky

the next night in Yufuin as he got so drunk he spent the night sleeping on the heated toilet in his hotel room. However, at least he made it back to the hotel. Amah Moron spent the night passed out in a rice paddy. . Meanwhile back at the on-sen after the bash the ladies had invaded the gents side of the baths and we all enjoyed soaking in the hot water together and drinking cold beer in the pouring rain.

Hell Kitty 4 in April 2007 saw the Kawasaki team of Super Dry and KY Jelly joining the pantheon of Hares with a new location in Kobe and Amah Moron contributing an extra run in Nara trying to bugger the local deer. Catch of the Day invited some of her sleazy high school friends and as a result many of the pack spent the weekend trying to add Kobe High School to their tick list.

Hell Kitty 5 in November 2011 represented a radical departure. Though the formula of hot springs, copious quantities of alcohol and great runs was repeated, the location was actually on the Central Cross Island Highway town of Gu

Guan in Taiwan. Japan did colonize Taiwan for about 60 years and the mamasan who ran the 'onsen' spoke Japanese. So perhaps Hell Kitty is about vibe rather than passport jurisdictions. Catch of the Day, May Not Come and Comes By Herself were the major forces behind this run, as was Sleeps with Nerds, who was trying to get cunt-shy Amah Moron to give up the sausage.

Hell Kitty 6 took place back in Japan in Okayama in 2015 and was successful thanks to the efforts of Catch of the Day and Canto Pup Faggot Feltcher. Once again the runs were superb, the alcohol consumption off the charts and the hot tub shenanigans subject to tour disclosure rules. By this time only Catch of the Day and Acorn had managed to make all 6 tours. However, Catch of the Day was showing her mature years. The Free China hash is a 'Live Hare' run and Catch of the Day as Co-Hare with Crash Test Dummy was caught on both runs.

Hell Kitty 7 will take place over the long weekend of 8-11 September 2017 in the Unesco world heritage area of Nikko. Acorn found the runs while abandoning his family during a holiday and will set the ball buster run with fellow grass eater Down Below 'Ho and the recovery run with Catch of the Day. This trip will see Emergency Services returning to manage logistics for the first time since Hell Kitty 3 and will feature a Shinto Japanese wedding between One Fast Pussy and Big Banana Butt F*ck. Free China and Hell Kitty tour Hashers are coming from as far as the east coast of the US for this momentous event that sold out within 10 days of being announced.

The land of the rising sun continues to welcome and entice the Free China Hash and the Hell Kitty tradition lives on!

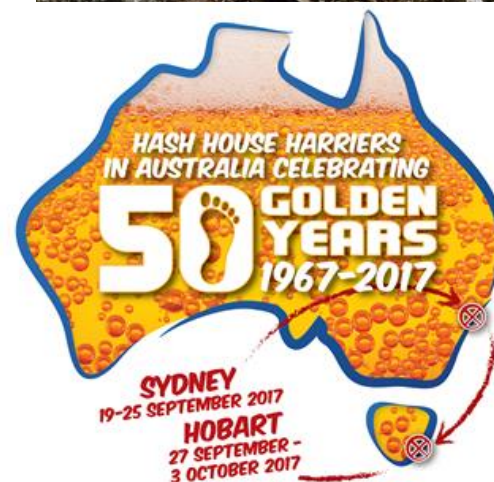

Transportation

Pinatubo Craft Beer

Engineers love to drink beer. Done mostly after taking exams or any important college milestone to celebrate about – heck, sometimes just casually – this not-so-healthy habit is a universal thing in engineering, regardless if you are a student or a professional. There is just a special relationship between engineers and beer. But there are few who take this relationship to a whole new level. While many of us order and drink beers at clubs or convenience stores, some engineers make them. For a living. One of these engineers is Michael Schitteck, a German specializing in

chemical engineering who is now based in Angeles City, Pampanga in the Philippines. He is making craft beer through his own brewery called the Pinatubo Craft Brewery. Pinatubo Craft Beer is so called because Mt. Pinatubo, one of the most destructive volcanoes in the Philippines, sits in Pampanga along with nearby provinces Zambales and Tarlac.

Located at the Friendship area in Angeles City, Schitteck's beer place offers the signature Pinatubo Craft Beer as well as authentic German dishes. All raw-materials are imported from Germany, equipment needed to handcraft his beer are Filipino made but of German knowledge.

That includes the stainless-steel vats manufactured in nearby Mabalacat City.

He started brewing in the area in 2015 just as he thought of retiring in the Philippines, putting up the first and only craft beer brewery in the province. This decision came after he and his wife Mildred, together with their 5-year-old son, lived in Switzerland for years.

Now they are living in Pampanga.



The first shop of the Pinatubo Brewing Point wasn't in the Friendship area but in a small space near the VFW restaurant in the Malabnias area. Since the business grew, it could not cater for more people so Schitteck opted to expand.

Note that he is not making beer that is usually sold in the groceries – instead he is brewing craft beer. As defined by the Brewer's Association in Boulder, Colorado, craft beer is a beer made by a brewer that is small, independent, and traditional. In other words, it is that kind of beer that is not brewed by mega-brewery corporations. In order for the German chemical engineer to serve good craft beer among locals and fellow expats in Angeles City, he has to understand the brewing process. And this he knows very well.



He says that if the beer is Pilsen or Lager, it needs to mature for about four weeks, but ales don't need much time to ferment and can be consumed two days after bottling.

Not only that: Schitteck is also well-versed about the history of beer. In the Business Mirror interview, he tells this by memory, "500 years ago, water was contaminated in Germany that is why Germans drank beer, which has 5% alcohol that kills the microorganisms. "That was how beer started in Germany. Water was not safe to drink; they did not know about boiling water, but knew that when you drink beer, you won't get sick," he said.

Schitteck added that the German government realized how important beer was and they



put a purity law in place to make sure manufacturers are not spoiling beer, which is mainly made up of water, malt and hops. Yeast, which transforms sugar into alcohol, was only added as an ingredient in 1860 because it was already known. That is why the German breweries are always close to bakeries because the baker makes the bread with yeast and then the brewer uses the yeast for beer,” he explains.

For 500 years now, the purity law is the basis of brewing German beer. There is now a wide variety of beers coming from Germany which are about 5,000 in all. Eleven of these beer variants are served in the Pinatubo Craft Brewery. Those are the Pinatubo Craft Dark Angel, Pinatubo Craft Dark Angel Special, Pinatubo Craft Crown Lager, Pinatubo Craft Golden Nectar, Pinatubo Craft Twister Ale, Pinatubo Craft Twister Ale Special, Pinatubo Craft Sunrise Wheat, Pinatubo Craft Brainstorm IPA, Magma Bock, Sunset Wheat and Sunset Wheat Special.

Craft beer lovers in Manila can check these beers out at the Fred’s Revolucion and Habanero Kitchen Bar in Cubao X, the Sigs Smokehouse in Maginhawa and the Food Centrale Park (beside PureGold Kalayaan) on Malamig Street, Quezon City.





The Pinatubo beers have a typical German flavor profile: Easy to drink, malty and with a low hop profile. The Golden Nectar Pilsner is their bestseller. It is a nice, dry beer with a round flavor profile that goes down well on a hot day in a tropical climate. Their Twister Ale has a very fruity aroma with a hint of pineapple. If you like hoppier beers, the Brainstorm IPA is your best bet. It has a nice piney aroma, but with 38 IBU's, it is still below the usual threshold for IPAs. I would call it a perfect «Beginner-IPA», and it has the advantage that it won't wreck your palate if you want to try some other beers after that.

If you like German beers, give Pinatubo Craft Beer a try and make sure you go hungry. Their Jägerschnitzel (pan-fried pork chop with a mushroom gravy and homemade noodles) is the best I've had outside of Germany! Absolutely delicious and the portions are huge!

I could go on forever with stories of our experiences on the road and what a great team we made. Our wives were always happy that we weren't doing all this alone. Sadly I'm back riding solo. But let me tell you, Paddy, on those future rides, in the evening when I sit with a beer in hand, I'll think about the days ride knowing your spirit was with me.

That first night when we met at the Vientiane Hash event, a local hasher said, "That Plastic Paddy is crazy!" And that 's what I loved about you. You were as crazy about riding your bicycle as I was.

Your spirit will ride on with me forever my friend. I'm thinking of you with fondness at this sad time.

COME RUN WITH THE HOLYLAND HASHERS

The Holyland H3 will be celebrating 25 years in May and is inviting one and all to a beer blast in Israel's Negev desert. Aside from the sand, it promises to be a wet weekend.

The Holyland H3 (or H4 for short) comprised a core group of locals, mostly long-time immigrants to Israel, along with an ever-changing itinerant population of diplomats, academics, contract workers and other expats. In our particular kennel, you are named after the group gets to know you a little bit and after you've set a trail yourself.

Established in 1993 by a group of temporary residents, the group gained a key member in 1997, Captain Caveman, who is today our longest-running Holyland Hasher, and the guiding spirit that keeps things going despite significant difficulties. Take, for example, the fact that a 500 ml. glass of beer in an Israeli bar costs 30 ILS (\$8 € 7, £ 6.5). Another challenge is the lack of public transportation on weekends; this forces all hounds and hares to limit themselves -- and the Down-Downs. Sad!



On the plus side, the party city of Tel Aviv is a great place to run, whether on the beach or along the pub-lined boulevards filled with curious onlookers. For a change of pace, as befits its name, the Holyland Hashers also run in the rarefied air of Jerusalem once every few weeks.

In 2013, H4 was very nearly accepted by the nerd mainstream society as [the Israel Ministry of Foreign Affairs](#) featured a clip about Run #999, a Red Dress Run in central Tel Aviv (see: <http://bit.ly/2xwEHMk>).

A passing photographer snapped two male members in their red dress finery pushing baby strollers and the photo later made the rounds on social media promoting Tel Aviv's gay-friendly reputation. Only problem – those particular Hashers aren't gay (not that there's anything wrong with that).

The H4 meets every Saturday afternoon at 4:00 pm in summer and 3:00 pm in winter, attracting anywhere from 5 to 50 Hashers of all ages. Our trails are 5km long on average. We're a family-friendly, dog-friendly Hash and all are welcome. Our markings are fairly easy to follow. I think.

Our main communication platform is a closed Facebook group – search FB for “**Holyland Hash House Harriers**”, ask for permission to join and you shall receive.

Over the years we've had several splinter groups: a long-defunct Jerusalem Hash, the Thirsty Knights which ran every other Thursday night, and a Jerusalem-based full moon hash, the “Looney Moon H3”. All are sleeping hashes nowadays, waiting for the one who'll stir them up. All are invited to contact us on FB if you're heading here and ready for the challenge.

Running the Jinja Relay with Kampala H3

The t-shirt said Run, Drink, Dance, Ride, Repeat for 89.5km.....But If you remember what happened on the Jinja Relay you were never there....

The Kampala to Jinja Relay is one of the biggest annual events on the African hash calendar organised by Kampala Hash House Harriers in Uganda. Julia Stanton aka Head Mistress decided to check out what it was all about so this is an attempt to remember how I ran, danced, drank, rode for 89.5km from Kampala to Jinja.



The day started early as the aim was to reach the start point on the edge of Kampala by 6am. Hashers compete in teams of at least 9 people who are seeded from 1 to 9 in terms of running ability or lack of it. Most teams have a lot more members than this and my team, Team mix was made up of around 17 members. Team mix because members are a mix of hashers from Kenya, Uganda and Ethiopia but the Ugandan members do all the organising. The team did not get off to a good start as one team member couldn't be woken

up due to too much drinking the night before, one didn't realise that we would be staying in Jinja that night and left all his luggage in the room. This meant we were late at the starting point and missed the next part as number 2 seed was still collecting his luggage. Both missing team members arrived on the back of a police truck 2 hours later.

The whole relay route from Kampala to Jinja was 89.5km with most of it being on small roads or off road. It was divided into 17 legs of different distances so the higher seeds could run a few sections of up to 10km at a stretch and the lower seeds could run, walk or crawl 3km when it came to their turn. The different teams making up around 300 hashers travelled in vehicles from small buses to safari vehicles to the finishing line of each leg and waited to cheer for their team members when they arrived. Each team was responsible for providing their own drinks and food. Each completed time by each team was carefully recorded.



There was also a big truck following blaring out loud music and this was known as the party truck and those who felt like it could dance and drink as the procession of vehicles went to the next finishing point. That was if you could hold on as the truck bounced its way along the uneven and potholed roads. There were clearly some party animals on the truck who looked like they hadn't run at all and were just out for the party.

The route was very scenic at times as we ran or travelled along the very red soil which makes up the roads. Villagers often came out and cheered hashers on as they went past and for some villages where we stopped there were notepads and pens for the local kids who lined up to be handed their gifts by one of the teams. The whole event did have a charity angle to it to raise money to build a new classroom for a school.

Around 5pm the first runners arrived in Jinja over the footbridge over the River Nile. Jinja is the source of the River Nile and the hotel where the relay finished was appropriately called this. A circle was held while the sun was setting over the river. Tables and chairs had been laid out on the vast lawn for a buffet and hashers tucked into a feast, drank more beer and then partied all night.



I'm not sure how many hashers ventured out the next morning on the 'hair of the dog run' I definitely didn't and certainly not any hashers that I knew. Evidently Kampala hash have grown soft over the years as they used to force hashers out of bed to run. The rest of the morning was for hash skits, performances and prizes with Team Mix winning the prize for the most mis-managed team. As well as missing two members at the start, we also missed a number of legs so we clearly deserved the prize. After a barbecue lunch and our bus full of alcohol including bottles of the local firewater, Waragi, we all made our way back gradually to Kampala on the main highway. What a fun hash weekend! On On to the Sese Island hash weekend, second weekend of December.

Kampala Hash House Harriers runs every Monday from various bars around town. Averaging between 150 - 200 hashers every weeks, it's got to be one of the largest hash chapters in the world.

Marilyn Monroe (born Norma Jeane Mortenson; Passed away 55 years ago on August 5, 1962) Marilyn was an American actress and model. Five-year-old girl left in tears as Tower Hamlets council officers shut down her lemonade stand and issue £150 fine. The little girl and her father were selling lemonade to revellers heading to Lovebox festival.

A five-year-old girl selling lemonade to revellers heading to a festival in east London had her stand shut down by council officers who slapped her and her father with a £150 fine. Andre Spicer said his daughter burst into tears and told him "I've done a bad thing" after enforcement officers read out a lengthy legal letter before issuing him the notice. The 5-year-old and Mr Spicer, a professor at City University, were given the fine for "trading without a permit" after they set up the make-shift stall near their home in Mile End.



He said: "It's not like she was trying to make a massive profit, this is just a five-year-old kid trying to sell lemonade. She sobbed all the way home and was telling me: 'Dad, I've done a bad thing'. She was very upset because she was proud of selling it, and this really soured the experience."

The same Council that fined girl, 5, for running lemonade stand slaps bike shop owners with penalty for offering a free pump. The same east London council that fined a girl of five for selling lemonade slapped the owners of a bike shop with a penalty for putting an air pump in the street for cyclists to use for free.



Sarah Breese, 30, and 34-year-old Timothy James said Tower Hamlets council officers ordered them to remove the pump which they set up on the pavement outside their store, Isambard's Cycles, in Shoreditch.

The couple said they were initially fined £100 by the council for leaving a bench with the pump attached to it outside the shop in Brick Lane.

They removed the bench and left the pump there but they said on Sunday a council enforcement officer threatened them with another fine and told them they would need a licence for it to remain there.

In response, Stuart Bunyan wrote: "Shouldn't you be out catching kids running lemonade stands."

Man employed to sit on Big Ben and shout 'BONG!' every hour

A man has been employed to sit at the top of Big Ben and shout "BONG!" very loudly while the bell is being repaired.

Jonathan Squires, 57, of Bury St Edmunds in Suffolk, has to live 24/7 in the clock tower and shout into a megaphone on the hour, every hour.

News that the traditional bell would be silent for four years was met with howls of protest by people with too much time on their hands.

Even Prime Minister Theresa May interrupted her work on important global crises to say it was wrong for Big Ben to be quiet during a lengthy restoration project.

Parliamentary officials decided the best compromise would be to employ a man to shout the "BONG!" chimes every hour.



This way tourists would still experience the charms of Big Ben.

Mr Squires, a former geography teacher, was selected after proving he emitted the loudest and most realistic "BONG!" out of all the candidates. He will be paid £24,000 a year, plus meals and accommodation in the 96-metre clock tower, which was built in 1850.

Speaking to journalists at a press conference to unveil him today, Mr Squires said: "I'm looking forward to keeping the nation abreast of the time. "It's a simple enough job – I just have to shout "BONG!" into my megaphone the required number of times, on the hour every hour.

"It is an honour to serve my country in this way, and I hope the Prime Minister is satisfied"

CYCLIST'S HORROR

A famous drug addict broke down in tears yesterday when he admitted to failing a sports test.

Darren Dee told a hushed news conference he had been caught playing tennis in Hove – despite it being a banned activity for drug users since the New Year.

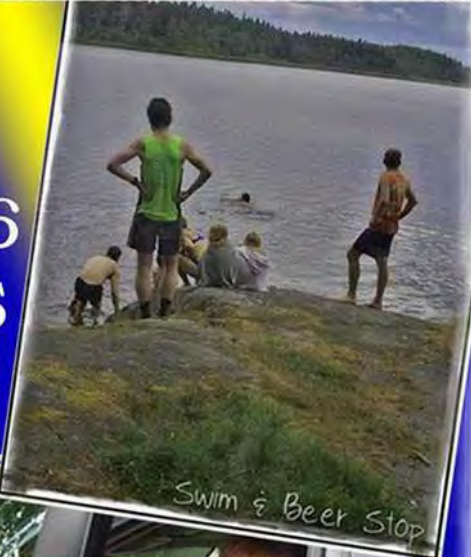
