

Not an easy task by anyone's measure. Head Mistress recommends a visit to Mauritius for the Catamaran Hash in January. Follow that up with the Swazi 2M Weekend, organised by the Maputo and Matola H3s in Swaziland this February, South Africa. An African favourite is the Ethiopian Mountain Challenge, starting in Addis Ababa on the 27th of April. Nigeria will have its Nash Hash in Cal this September. The Ssese Island Hash will be hosted by the Kampala H3 in Uganda, East Africa in December.

ASIA:

Start your 2018 Asia hashing at India Nash Hash this January in picturesque Karnataka, India. Cambodia Nash Hash will be hosted by the Phnom Penh Danger Hash with a train trip to Takeo this March. Wild Wolf takes Philippine Hash Bash back to Sebang Beach in Puerto Galera in April. A new twist to this year's event is a hash on Verde Island. Malaysia Nash Hash is scheduled for Raub, Pehang on Peninsular Malaysia this May.

The 80th Anniversary of Mother Hash is coming up 14-17 September in Kuala Lumpur. You can start the celebration early from 8-12 September on the Train Rumble to Mother traveling from Bangkok to Pattaya, Hua Hin, Hat Yai and Ipoh before joining up with the Mother Hash celebration in KL. The following week Mekong Indochina Hash will be hosted by the Saigon and Nha Trang Hashes, 21-23 September in Nha Trang, Vietnam.

AUSTRALIA, NZ, OCEANIA/Fiji:

World Interhash comes to the South Pacific Nation of Fiji 24-27 May. There will be a Pre-Lube Hash Cruise from Nadi to the Yasawa and Mamanuca Islands 15-22 May. Queensland will host a number of HHH events in 2018, starting with the Gold Coast 2000th Run in March. The Commonwealth Games Hash will take place this May in Burleigh Heads. Not to be left out, the Cutlery H3 will celebrate 1000 Runs in May. The combined Harriettes of Oz will host "Diamonds and Pearls" in October.

MIDDLE EAST:

Last, but certainly not least, special thanks to Douglas "White Trash" Barrett, for his advisory about Intergulf in Abu Dhabi, UAE this March.




DALMATIAN HASH CRUISE

ETHIOPIAN MOUNTAIN CHALLENGE 2018

Organised by Addis Ababa Hash House Harriers Ethiopia, East Africa 27th – 30th April 2018

The bi-annual Ethiopian Mountain Challenge is back with a new location in the Great Rift Valley lake area of Southern Ethiopia. After complaints from some of the Kenyan and Ugandan hashers, that the mountain challenge hashes are just too long and difficult, next year's event will be held in the South where the altitude is slightly lower and the land is a bit flatter. However, there will still be that ballbreaker trail for those who want the challenge as well as shorter and easier trails plus plenty of time to relax. Accommodation will be at one of the top lodges in the area by Lake Langano, the only lake declared safe to swim in hence it is Ethiopia's equivalent to a beach. Current early bird prices until 31st January are 300 USD based on room sharing or 450 USD for a single room. The price includes airport transfers, welcome drinks, 2 nights' accommodation in Addis Ababa, bus transfer to Lake Langano, 2 nights accommodation in lakeside resort and all meals for 2 days, beer and event t-shirt.

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

angkawi, officially known as Langkawi the Jewel of Kedah is a district and an archipelago of 104 islands in the Andaman Sea, some 30km off the mainland coast of north western Malaysia. The islands are a part of the state of Kedah, which is adjacent to the Thai border.

The name Langkawi is thought to have existed by the early 15th century, although in the 16th century the island of Langkawi was also marked on maps variously as Langa, Langka, Lansura, and Langapura.

There are many suggestions for the origin of the name of Langkawi. According to one interpretation, Langkawi means island of the reddish-brown eagle, a Brahminy Kite in colloquial Malay. The Malay word for eagle is helang – which is shortened to "lang", while kawi is the name of a red stone used as a chalk to mark goods. This interpretation was used to create the landmark sculpture of an eagle as the symbol of Langkawi at Dataran Helang (Eagle Square) in Kuah.

Langkawi, a cluster of 99 islands separated from mainland Malaysia by the Straits of Malacca, is a district of the state of Kedah in Northern Malaysia and lies approximately 51 km west of Kedah. The total land mass of the islands is 47,848 hectares. The main island spans about 25 km from north to south and slightly more for east and west. The coastal areas consist of flat, alluvial plains punctuated with limestone ridges. Two-thirds of the island is dominated by forest-covered mountains, hills and natural vegetation. On 1 June 2007, Langkawi Island was given a World Geopark status by UNE-SCO. Three of its main conservation areas in Langkawi Geopark are Machincang Cambrian Geoforest Park, Kilim Karst Geoforest Park and Dayang Bunting Marble Geoforest park (Island of the Pregnant Maiden Lake). These three parks are the most popular tourism area within Langkawi Geopark.

Tourists can enter the island via ferry from Kuala Kedah, Kuala Perlis and Penang. Or by domestic flight from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KUL) via Malaysia Airlines, AirAsia, Malindo Air, Rayani Air, or Subang Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport (SZB) via Malindo Air and Fireflyz providing budget connection to the island. International connection is available from Singapore via Tigerair and AirAsia, as well as from Guangzhou via AirAsia.

There are two main island areas: the Southern Islands, with a heavier tourist population and the islands to the north east which are more secluded with little tourist traffic. Langun Island has a fresh-water lake like Pregnant Maiden Lake only without the tourists and has Sand Spit Beach on its south-facing orientation. Dendang Island next to it forms a bay used by Langkawi sailing yacht tour operators

Some of the most popular beaches are Pantai Cenang, Pantai Tengah, Burau Bay, Pantai Kok, and Datai Bay. Pantai Cenang beach has long stretches of fine white sand. It has a number of restaurants and bars for evening entertainment, several hosting live music and for watching the sun set. The beach is lined with tall coconut and casuarina trees. Pantai Tengah is separated from Cenang by a small cape. It also faces the setting sun and has hotels and bars, making it less busy in the evening. Burau Bay, fringed by rocky outcrops, is visited by migratory birds. Pantai Kok a quiet beach has a backdrop of limestone hills. Datai Bay has a combination of forests and sea, its white sandy beach is backed by forest.

Langkawi is a duty-free island and a shopping paradise. It is the perfect venue for Inter Hash 2020.

Penang the Pearl of the Orient and areas surrounding this wonderful island will be superb locations to do a few pre & post rambles. Across the border on the Thai side where lots of "activities" happen will be another great location for pre & post rambles.

A Train Ramble beginning from Singapore to Sg Petani rambling through the entire South to North of the Peninsula making stops at various locations will certainly be organised.

Mew Orleans Policia

ew Orleans, Louisiana is hot in the summer. Some might even say damn hot! Or as one Harriette put it to me, "it's hot as balls here!" To which I responded, "and how exactly do you know that?".. She said "trust me, I know".. Too much information, perhaps? I decided I didn't need further details.

But she's right. It is hot as sweaty balls in August. But I digress.

The purpose of this missive isn't to discuss New Orleans weather or sweaty balls but rather an event which takes place the second weekend in August called the New Orleans red dress run. Now in its 23rd year, the event has morphed into a major spectacle that raises well over \$100,000 dollars for local New Orleans charities. Several thousand sign up to do this thing of which only a small fraction are hashers. This year, there were roughly 500 hashers (which makes it a major hash event) and 4000 non- hashers! There are also a significant number of so called bandits who pay nothing, but they put on a red dress and party in the French quarter.

Red dress run weekend has evolved over the years. In its first ten years, it was a small event and was just your typical hash event. That changed after hurricane Katrina. The event started growing and many charities began recognizing it for the contributions it provided them. Last year, approximately 70 local charities received donations. The city, of course, also benefits. Millions of dollars are pumped into the local economy and its now considered a mini Mardi Gras.

There are two parts to RDR weekend: the hash part (for registered hashers only) and the red dress run part (which takes place on Saturday). Many NO RDR veterans consider the party to start on Thursday when the voodoo hash puts on their annual red skirt run. This usually attracts over 100 hashers. The theme is wear a red skirt. This is an event that is low key compared to the rest of the weekend.



Friday is the official start to RDR weekend. The theme for the hashers only run is red lingerie. This is a real run, not a pub crawl. Location start varies from year to year, as does the finish, but lately it's been ending at the house of blues in the French quarter. Of course, there are lots of extra credit stops in the quarter with the party carrying on at various bars after it winds down at the house of blues.

Saturday is the big day: the red dress run..it actually is a real run though few people run it. It starts around 11 am. The course is about a mile and a half. The route varies from year to year as the event has evolved. For the last few years, the venue has been Armstrong park with the course going into the French quarter down bourbon street and back along Esplanade. This year, the venue changed to crescent park which is on the edge of the French quarter along the Mississippi River. I like the new venue. Access to the park is via a bridge above the railroad tracks which helps keep the bandits (non registrants) out. It also has a large open air roof structure which can handle a few thousand people. This is really good as it's normally quite hot in NOLA this time of year.

Due to the new venue, the course changed yet again. This year, the route went down esplanade, then rampart, (big beer stop on rampart!) and then into the French quarter. It did not go down bourbon street this year but it did cross it. Of course, lots of people do their own thing stopping at numerous bars along the way. Even with a lengthy beer stop, you can finish the course in an hour.

Afterwards, the venue is split into two areas: one for hashers which can be viewed as a VIP section, and the other area for non hashers. The hasher section has its own beer stand, portable toilets, and food section. So this is where you want to be to avoid long lines.

At the far end of the venue is a stage for live musical entertainment. They always have two local bands playing.. one year they had cowboy mouth which is nationally known.


By late afternoon the event is officially over but this is New Orleans, so the party never ends. Wherever you go, you see lots of people wearing red dresses. I saw people in red dresses at the casino sitting at blackjack tables.




For hashers, the weekend isn't over yet. There is still Sunday! This is when the hangover run occurs which is basically a short stumble around the venue. Beignets, Bloody Marys, and mimosas are served. Plus lots of leftover beer from Saturday. It's a mellow event but they usually have a good circle.

So that summarizes New Orleans red dress run. It's a very well run event which has the full support of the city of New Orleans, the tourism board, and so forth. It is by far, the largest red dress run in the world and attracts hashers and non hashers from around the world. I met some people (not hashers) from Europe who traveled to New Orleans specifically for this event. Check it out! You won't be disappointed..

The new venue, by the way, will be the venue for the next two years, so keep that in mind for hotel planning.

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
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
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
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
ON THE ICE



The Hash Darwin Awards

Old Chaz, the chap on the right, in one of his sober moments, put forward the notion of "survival of the fittest", a concept that implies that the removal from the gene pool (usually by death) of its weaker members, thereby strengthens the survival chances of the remainder. However, here at OTI, we do not encourage the extermination of the less able, the feeble, or the intellectually challenged. Rather, we encourage them to become hashers! Further, this column aims to be a forum where the moronic misdeeds of hashers might be chronicled in pursuit of that noblest of pastimes, namely, having cheap laughs at other people's expense. With that in mind, I offer the following:





Charles Darwin

he title of this latest column comes from the poem by Charles Baudelaire, as I'm sure many of you know, since if you are reading this you are obviously among the more literate of hashers - a relatively select group to be sure. I'm not even persuaded that the editor of this magazine can read, for example, but I digress.

Baudelaire writes:

"Be always drunken. Nothing else matters: that is the only question. If you would not feel the horrible burden of Time weighing on your shoulders and crushing you to the earth, be drunken continually. Drunken with what? With wine, with poetry, or with virtue, as you will. But be drunken."

Now this is a sentiment most hashers can get behind. And if there is little poetry and less virtue at a hash there is almost certainly wine and most definitely beer. Indeed it is the shared love of getting on the grog that is probably the one unifying element of the hash. It certainly isn't

the running, which any visit to the Bangkok Hash can confirm. In fact, some of the gentlemen of the BH3 can barely walk much less run but they can, as a rule, put away a fair amount of blizzard-cold piss at the circle and afterwards.

In its fondness for alcoholic fluids the Hash is merely a microcosm of human society. From our earliest times humans have demonstrated a pronounced tendency to enjoy getting smashed. There is actually some suggestion that alcohol is the main driving force behind human evolution, in that we felt compelled to come down out of the trees and onto the ground because that's where the rotting fermented fruit was. Our love of getting a few drinks in is something we share not only with our human ancestors but also with our cousins the monkeys. This was something Charles Darwin, an intellectual hero of mine and one whose picture adorns the masthead of this page – he's the chap on the right - noted as part of his research into what would become his book "The Descent of Man" – a great title by the way and a path I am attempting to follow in my own life, all too successfully.

Darwin began by observing that "man is liable to receive from the lower animals, and to communicate to them, certain diseases, as hydrophobia, variola, the glanders, syphilis, cholera, herpes, etc." This is indisputable as many a hashman could attest but would perhaps prefer not to publicly. He went on to note, "many kinds of monkeys have a strong taste for tea, coffee, and spiritous liquors: they will also, as I have myself seen, smoke tobacco with pleasure". Again the similarities with many hashmen, only a rung or two higher on the evolutionary ladder, ought to be apparent. He goes on to acknowledge that "the same tastes are common to some animals much lower in the scale. Mr. A. Nichols informs me that he kept in Queensland, in Australia, three individuals of the Phaseolarctus cinereus; and that, without having been taught in any way, they acquired a strong taste for rum, and for smoking tobacco".

For those of you whose days in the science classroom are a long way behind you, the Phaseolarctus cinereus is, of course, the koala. And



is it just me or is it unsurprising that our man with the smoking and drinking koalas hailed from Queensland?

Darwin also noted that a fellow scientist in Africa had caught baboons and got them drunk (anything in the name of science, I guess) and that "on the following morning they were very cross and dismal; they held their aching heads with both hands, and wore a most pitiable expression: when beer or wine was offered them, they turned away with disgust". Now in this regard, I can definitely say that, as humans, we are more evolved than baboons in at least one sense; we have invented the Bloody Mary. Imagine how much more baboons might have accomplished if they had? Planet of the Apes, anyone?

Our love of drinking is clearly deeply ingrained but in some parts of the world there is a concern that people are being drawn away from the good, wholesome pastime of drinking beer and towards smoking a joint or two in places where it is legal. In the US, a report from Cowen and Company, found that legalized recreational weed was associated with decreased beer sales in the three historically strong beer markets of Colorado, Washington, and Oregon. This is a worrying trend, for while I have nothing against marijuana, particularly when it used as an ingredient in a steaming hot bowl of noodle soup as it still is in certain places in the Lao PDR, I still am, first and foremost, a beer and gin man, and the thought of pubs closing in places like Boulder,



Colorado and their being replaced by weed dispensaries is depressing. In general, every time a pub closes, even if just for the night in some cases, a little piece of me dies.

That said, I cannot endorse the action taken by The Beer Distributors of Massachusetts and the Wine & Spirits Wholesalers of Massachusetts who have, as reported by the Boston Globe, apparently chipped in \$75,000 toward the anti-marijuana-legalization campaign in that state. If you live in Massachusetts drive across the border and buy your beer in some neighboring state. That'll show 'em. Whatever you do though, don't give up drinking; it is the social lubricant that holds society together and probably prevents us killing each other in even greater numbers than we do.

So always remember, as Baudelaire concludes his poem,

"And if sometimes, on the stairs of a palace, or on the green side of a ditch, or in the dreary solitude of your own room, you should awaken and the drunkenness be half or wholly slipped away from you, ask of the wind, or of the wave, or of the star, or of the bird, or of the clock, of whatever flies, or sighs, or rocks, or sings, or speaks, ask what hour it is; and the wind, wave, star, bird, clock, will answer you: 'It is the hour to be drunken!'"

olice are hunting an elderly woman who allegedly stole a distinctive classic blue Wedgwood plate from a pottery

yey say the well-spoken pensioner popped into the Norfolk tery Emporium near Sandringham last Tuesday.

e browsed the shelves and was seen to put the plate on her d before running out of the store without paying.

TV cameras caught the woman – said to be around 90 years old - on camera, and now Norfolk Police have released the photograph above.

We hope someone is able to recognise the culprit, who was caught on film red-handed with the Wedgwood plate on her head, a spokesman said. She is well dressed and has a classy British accent and is around 5ft 2ins tall.

Officers believe the woman made off in a dark blue Range Rover in the direction of the nearby Sandringham Estate.

Store owner Daphne Spuckler, 56, said the mystery woman tried to disguise the classic Jasperware-style Wedgwood design by popping it on her head. She than calmly walked out of the store without paying.

"She wore it a little bit like a crown. It's very odd – I wonder who she was?"

The distinctive plate is made of traditional blue Wedgwood porcelain with its trademark white patterned design across the top. Police say anyone with information about the woman, or of the stolen plate, which is valued at around £50, should call Crimestoppers. GROUP OF NIGHT JOGGERS LOSE CONTROL KILLING 16 PEDESTRIANS

► IXTEEN pedestrians were killed and another 24 injured this evening in Brighton after a large group of joggers lost control on the coast road between Hove and Portslade. Emergency services arrived on the scene at 6pm to find one of

the worst running accidents the country has ever seen.

"Many of the emergency response team are being treated for shock, such was the carnage they witnessed," Fred Holden told the Brighton Gazzette, "Not only that, but the group of joggers destroyed several buildings in the crash. Two dogs were also killed".

It is believed the joggers lost control after trying to avoid a street bin, swerving before then losing control of the back end

We understand the back end of the group then collided with oncoming pedestrians, knocking them down like skittles, before colliding with a number of houses situated on the side of the busy road," added Holden, "Several joggers had to be cut out of the buildings by the fire brigade".

The latest incident has yet again brought up the question about dangerously large groups running together on the footpaths and roads, with already 78 people being killed in jogger crashes so far this year.

"They have no brakes, no lights and zero respect for the people walking on the footpaths," voiced local man Derek DeVine, "I've been warning people for years about this. Now look what happened. Hopefully something will be done about it now". Police person Enda Kenny later offered his condolences to the victims of today's crash, and promised to introduce a ban on jogging on public walkways and roads. He then proposed a nationwide footpath tax from 2018 for anyone wishing to use them, and discussed the possibility of walking licences being

introduced next year.
