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HASHING IN THE BLUEGRASS THE BOURBON STATE OF KENTUCKY

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The Bluegrass State

Kentucky's nickname is The Bluegrass State, based on the fact that bluegrass is found in many of the lawns and pastures throughout the state (particularly in the northern part of Kentucky - including the metropolitan areas of Lexington and Louisville).

"Bluegrass" is the common name for grass of the genus *Poa*, which is a favored lawn and pasture grass in the eastern United States from Tennessee northward. Bluegrass is actually green - but in the spring bluegrass produces bluish-purple buds that give a rich blue cast to the grass when seen in large fields. Hills are generally rolling, and the soil is highly fertile for growing pasture. The Bluegrass Region is famous for its horse farms and of course the Kentucky Derby (the thoroughbred is the official state horse of Kentucky).

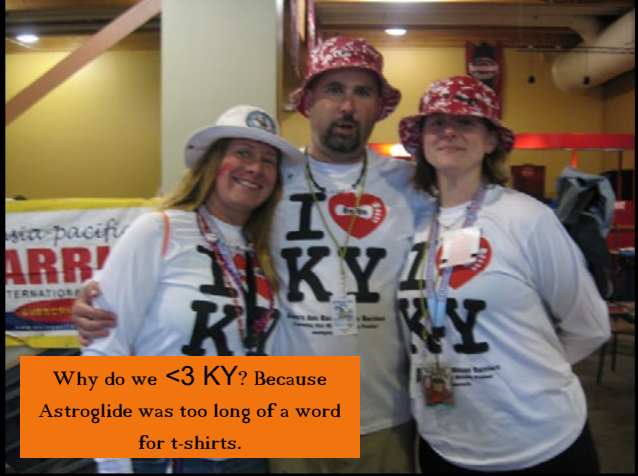
Most important of all about Kentucky, 95% of the world's bourbon comes from this state.

There are five active hashes in four Kentucky cities: Horse's Ass H3 and Lexington Lunatics H3 (Lexington), Louisville H3, Licking Valley H3 (Covington), and Governors H3 (Ft. Campbell- Shared border with Clarksville, TN). Let's have a glimpse of hashing each of these kennels.

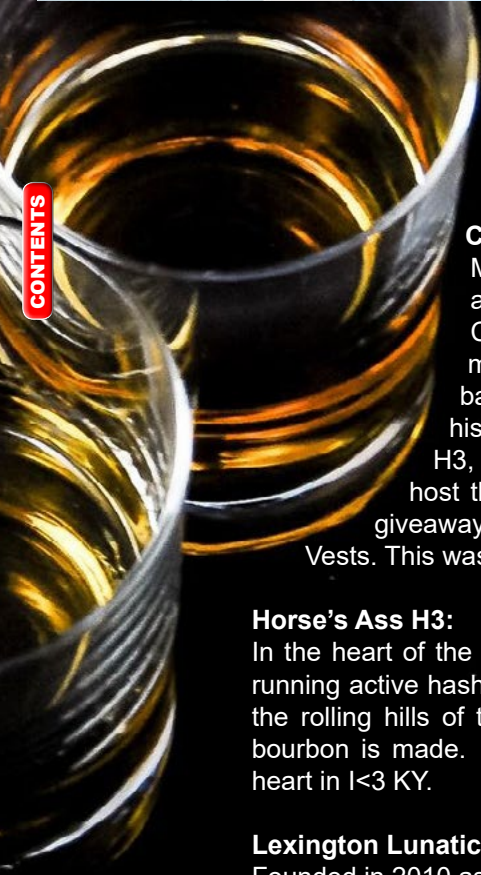

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Clarksville Governors H3:

May 2012 Clarksville Governors was Founded after Black Dog H3 and Beaver Creek H3 defunked. CGH3 hashes every 2nd and 4th Saturday of the month. and hashes in two states on consistent basis (KY, TN). This kennel draws its traditions and history from Okinawa H3, Sembach H3, San Antonio H3, Border Jumpers H3 and Carolina Trash H3. They host the annual TN/KY where a jar of moonshine is a giveaway. They are known for our Motorcycle like Happy Vests. This was due in fact to how our kennel was established.

Horse's Ass H3:

In the heart of the state and founded in 2005 is Kentucky's longest running active hash. They set trails on alternating Saturdays though the rolling hills of the bluegrass and the region of where delicious bourbon is made. We're known for our hashpitality and being the heart in I<3 KY.

Lexington Lunatics H3:

Founded in 2010 as another reason to hash in Lexington. This kennel puts on several themed runs such as pirate pub crawls, SantaCons, cheap beer tastings, and dirty Valentine's day card making and can make a special request for an impromptu hash for the visitors.

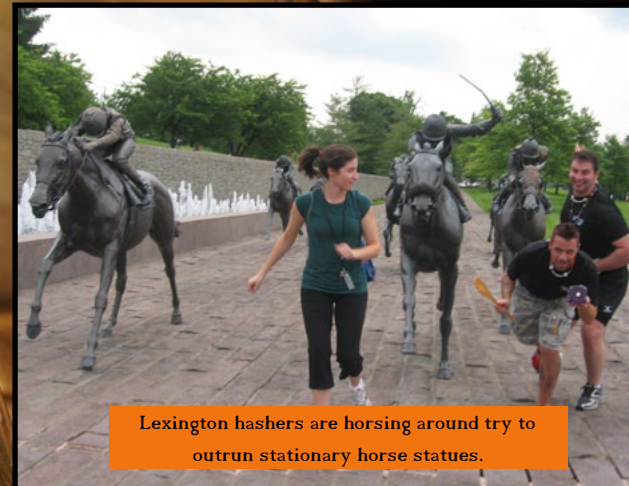

The northern most Kentucky hash is Licking Valley H3, founded in Jan 2006. The hash meets once per month. In 2015, they had a family hash where there were adult and child hares. Kids got root beer floats at the end. Repeated family hashes are held due to the re-productive nature of hashers and lack of babysitters.

Louisville H3:

Louisville is home of the Kentucky Derby and Home of Louisville H3, founded in 2009. They hash every other Saturday. Every year on Oaks Night, Louisville H3 hosts an annual Derby Dress Run. Everyone wears a dress and a gorgeous Derby hat on trail. They double our hash cash and donate the extra funds to a charity every year which is voted on by the kennel.

Bourbon Facts

Kentucky is the birthplace of Bourbon, crafting 95 percent of the world's supply. Only the Bluegrass State has the perfect natural mix of climate, conditions and pure limestone water necessary for producing the world's greatest Bourbon.

Bourbon is America's only native spirit, as declared by Congress in 1964. It must be made with a minimum of 51 percent corn, aged in charred new oak barrels, stored at no more than 125 proof and bottled no less than 80 proof.

Bourbon is an \$8.5 billion signature industry in Kentucky, generating 17,500 jobs with an annual payroll of \$800 million. Spirits production and consumption pours more than \$825 million in federal, state and local tax coffers every year.

More than \$1.1 billion in capital projects has been completed or is planned and underway in the past five years and the next five years, including new distilleries and aging warehouses to bottling facilities and tourism centers.

Kentucky's iconic Bourbon distilleries filled a whopping 1,886,821 barrels of amber nectar last year, breaking production records all the way back to 1967.

The previous all-time high was 1,922,009 barrels filled in 1967. Since the turn of the century, Kentucky Bourbon production has skyrocketed more than 315 percent (455,078 barrels were filled in 1999).



That gives the Commonwealth a total inventory of 6,657,063 barrels of Bourbon, the most since 1974 when 6,683,654 new charred oak casks were gently aging in Bluegrass warehouses.

There are now 1.5 barrels for every person living in Kentucky (census population 4,425,092).

The 2016 tax-assessed value of all barrels aging in Kentucky is \$2.4 billion – an increase of \$299 million from 2015 and a 135 percent increase over the last 10 years.

Nearly 60 percent of every bottle of spirits in Kentucky goes to taxes or fees, with seven different taxes on Bourbon – including an ad valorem tax on barrels each and every year it ages. Distillers also are paying \$17,814,134 in ad valorem barrel taxes this year, another all-time high. Revenue from this tax funds education, public safety, public health and other needs in local communities where barrels are stored.

U.S. distilled spirits exports topped \$1.5 billion in 2013. Kentucky Bourbon and Tennessee whiskey made up more than \$1 billion of that amount, making it the largest export category among all U.S. distilled spirits.

The KDA, a non-profit trade group founded in 1880, represents 33 member companies for the first time since Prohibition as its ranks have swelled with new distilleries, strengthening Kentucky's rightful place as the one, true, authentic home for Bourbon and spirits.

Getting There: There are a number of ways to get to Montenegro by plane. The cheapest and (currently) the only direct route from Amsterdam is via Dubrovnik with easyjet or Transavia. Take the bus from the airport to Du-

brovnik then Dubrovnik to Kotor (2 hours max) or arrange a transfer for under €50 per car.

You can also go via Vienna with Austrian Airlines (4.15hr with 1 stop) or Via Belgrade on Air Serbia with flights around 4.5-5hrs and slightly cheaper. Flights to Dubrovnik are currently around €100 and the others are €220 and €210 respectively.

It's our advice to book flights as soon as you register as although they do on occasion come down, they more regularly go up or sell out completely.

MONTENEGRO NASH HASH 2017 - RUN NOTES:

Thursday 25th May

Plane, train or automobile your way to Montenegro.

Registration at our hostel from 12:00 noon Thursday afternoon, All 40 spots were filled in the Hostel with hashers travelling from Beijing, India, Philippines and all over Europe.

Pub crawl was hastily arranged visiting some of the more noteworthy local establishments including the "Hole in the Wall Bar" which is the old Turkish prison that has had a hole knocked out of one wall & a handy beer establishment set up. Pizza's topped off the night with a few revellers pushing on to the early hours.

Friday 26th May

Registration ongoing until 12:00 noon at Montenegro Hostel

2:00pm – Started herding everyone up for the Red dress Run. This was the first time we have run a red dress in the capital Podgorica and I was not too sure how it would go. The pack set off around 2:40pm through the old Turkish quarter of town, a few strange looks from the locals but so far no violence. Following the river through the abandoned citadel we hit the main street to plenty of wolf whistles and blank starts (especially at the red light). By this time we had lost a few including Paprika Smiley and Glow Job. Run continued through the main park (which led to a trail mix-up instigated by a renegade group head-

ed by Swinging Tits & 4n20. After regrouping it was off to the beer stop for much needed refreshment. The circle was held back at the hostel with RA Missing Link from Amsterdam H3.

7:00pm – Dinner at local restaurant – free flow beer and wine!

Saturday 27th May

10:30am – Catch the train to the coast, after some last minute trail fixing by the hares we managed to round everyone up

11:30am – Start long run, trail led through the coastal town of Sutomore straight up the hill on an old donkey trail to the ruins of an Austro Hungarian barracks, back down through town where the trail joined the medium run.

12:30pm – Start short and Medium run. A good field turned out including a good showing from the local Boka Bay hash house. Trail wound around the back streets before leading up hill to the fortress of Haj Nehaj. Plenty of wildlife seen on trail including Glass Lizards, tortoises and snakes (the later halting the field until the offender was moved on). Some hashers headed off trail in search of a cool dip as the temperature climbed into the 30's. Last part of the trail wound around the coastline to finish at the ruins of another Austro-Hungarian fort. Some pre-planning by the hares ensured there was plenty of amber liquid to go around. Circle began when the last of the long runners came in.

18:00pm – Circle finished, time to catch the train back to the capital Podgorica

20:00pm – After a freshen up, we all met on the edge of town at a local restaurant for live music and a banquet fit for a king.

Sunday 28th May

10:00am – Recovery run and BBQ lunch. Opee from the F.I.L.T.H. hash volunteered to live hare the recovery run which was made even more interesting as his way around! After abandoning his original route (encouraged by a 6'6" Slavic Security guard) the trail wound around the city, cutting back on itself a few times before finding a great local bar for a much needed refreshment stop. Back at Hash Central, a BBQ lunch was served up and the remaining beer distributed. A small group kicked on after lunch with a visit to a local winery where there was much rejoicing...the end of a great weekend hashing!

Angeles City H3

Angeles City Hashing, Pampanga, Philippines

Many hashes are located near major cities and are relatively easy to access on your own, or often with the help of a very hospitable local hasher. The Angeles City Hash takes a little more time and effort to reach, due to its location two hours north of Manila. The former Clark U.S. Air Base, near Angeles City, now has about a dozen airlines (most are Asia based except Emirates and Qatar) with flights using its facilities. Many of the other major airlines, serving the Americas or Europe, continue their service into the Manila international airport.

Once you arrive here the hotels, restaurants and bars are numerous and very affordable. That is one of the main incentives for former service members and other tourists to return, along with the areas warm weather, golf courses and shopping.

The ACH3 meets every Sunday afternoon at the Premier Hotel, for their 3PM sharp departure (2PM in winter months), out into the surrounding countryside to Hash. Your hash fee will get you a traditional Jeepney ride to/from the hotel to the A-A hash site, along with all the cold beer, juice, soda, or water you care to drink. The current rainy season's threatening clouds thankfully spared the hash this Sunday, 17 September; but, they may have reduced today's attendance to only 60+ regulars and visitors!

Today's hare was "Bush Diver". ACH3 trails are pre-marked, so once hashers arrive at the run site (many regulars via personal vehicles) they are off with very little delay. Today's 7 K trail, located in the vicinity of the "bridge to

nowhere”, had everyone going up-hill out of the start and then along ridgeline winding paths and gravel roads. Trails always pass thru bountiful vegetation and numerous small village areas, with even more numerous youngsters to encourage you on your way. Back downhill and on-in at trails end, with the first refreshing ice-cold beverage in your hand is always a welcomed moment. Everyone then mills around of course, discussing the merits or demerits of the days trail until all are in, settled and then called to circle up.

“Saput” has been GM of this hash, for some time now, and always does a fine job of running an entertaining and efficient traditional circle. He is assisted by Song Meisters “Dances with Dogs” and “Cujo” who between them seem to know every possible hash song. With 6:30 PM approaching and the sun beginning to set, providing an amazing sunset, the circle concludes. Most hashers head back to the Premiere Hotel, for the ON ON, which includes 2-3 more coolers of cold Beer. Needless to say, you should not plan to do any driving after all this and I would not recommend visiting hashers to drive at any other time either! Local transport around town is cheap and always readily available.

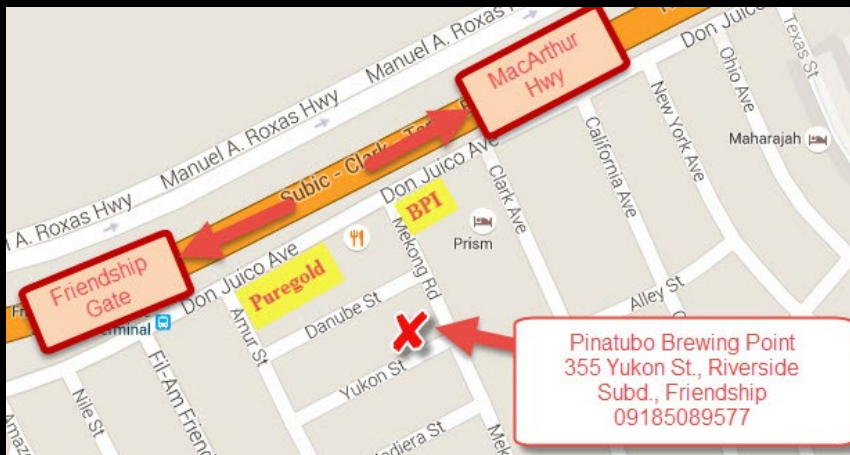
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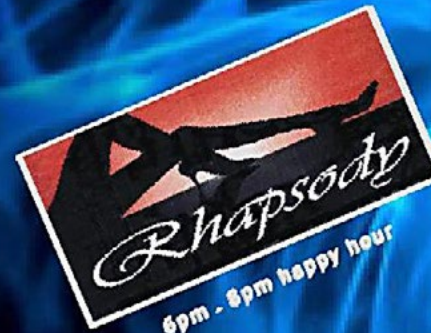


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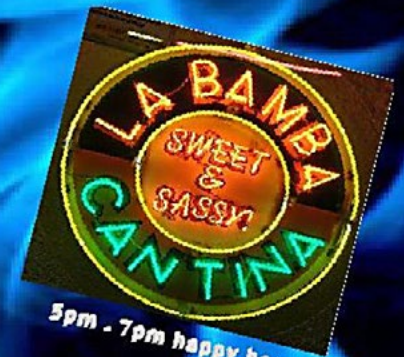
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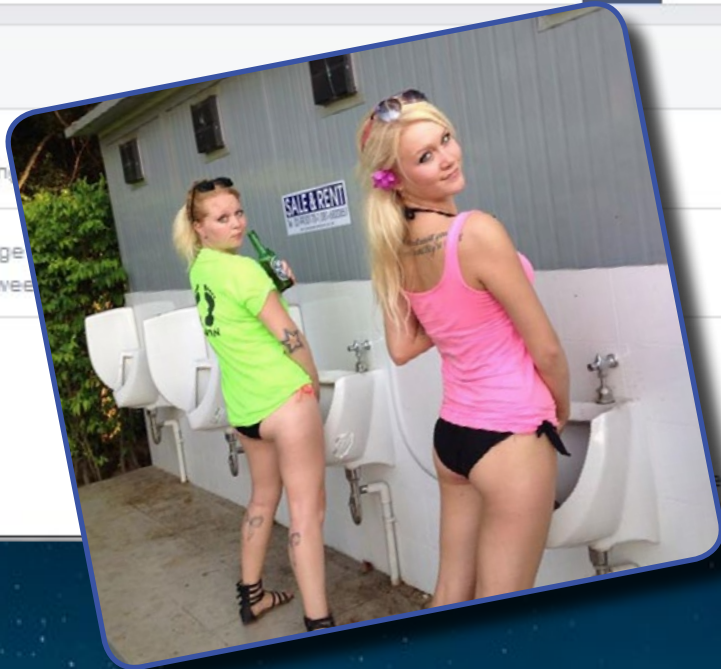
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Hash History

Pattaya 1986 Interhash

I was living in Hong Kong at the time of the first Interhash in 1978 but did not attend it. The event was the brainchild of a two members of the Kowloon Hash and I have contributed an earlier article on this. I did not start hashing until a year later, despite the repeated exhortations of several motocross mates who tried to get me along. My excuse was that I was in such an important and demanding job (ha ha) that it was impossible for me to make the 6 p.m. start time. I eventually got to a Hong Kong Hash run in April 1979 and, guess what?

Somehow I was able to make that 6 p.m. start almost every Monday.

By the way, when I joined H4, "Drainoil" aka Bob Leonard, was a member of this hash. He is one of the few remaining stalwarts who have attended every Interhash to date. At last count there were three remaining, Drainoil, Philthy Phil and Cheebye. In my early days with H4, few folks had hash names and for those who did, it was often just their surname reversed. I had been hashing for about ten years before I obtained a 'name' as a result of being bitten by a dog on a hash run. Now it seems obligatory.

Although I was aware of the other following Interhash events, I did not finally sign up for one until 1986. This was organized by the late Tim Hughes who ran one of the first Hash magazines called "International Harrier". As with this fine publication,

I contributed some articles to his magazine and I still have quite a few copies. Although I didn't meet Tim at the 1986 event I got to know him quite well following my discovery of the 'lost' Gispert family, an event that contributed quite a bit to the wonderful book he wrote on the history of the hash. Tim sadly passed away in 1998.

Almost all of the 1986 attendees arrived at Bangkok airport and Tim had arranged buses to take folks from Bangkok to Pattya, around a three hour trip. With a group of Kowloon hashers, I stayed at the *Charming Inn* on the seafront. It was a six story building and was, at the time, the tallest hotel on the seafront road. It is still there today, but is dwarfed by the modern monster hotels such as the "Hard Rock" next door.

There were still many old private houses on the seafront and some of them had been converted into bars and restaurant. We used to convene at a joint called "Wee Andy's". Not a single old house remains today, with the whole seafront road being taken up by massive hotels or shopping malls.

The bar area, which we now know as "Walking Street" was in full flight in those days and it really hasn't changed much over the years in my view. Two aspects stick in my mind from 1986, one was that in the Marine Bar, a large dance hall, you could easily pick out the lady boys as they were so stunningly beautiful compared to the real girls. The second thing, and again 'Katoy' related was the even-

ing I met up with a bunch of Hong Kong Ladies Hash, who said they were going watch a show at a gay bar. Thinking that I would be 'safe' with the girls, I joined them. As we sipped beer, a couple of 'lovelies' mimed and gyrated to popular songs. Being a bit drunk, I got up on the floor and joined the show. Big Mistake. The eyes of every gay in the place bored into me accompanied by the sound of licking lips. I drank up quickly and got out.

As is the norm with Interhash events, there was a Friday piss up and then another on Saturday. It was at the second evening that Tim Hughes introduced Horse Thompson, an original Hash committee member in 1938, to give a short speech. You can see a video recording of his speech on the video "*The Hash Story*", available on Youtube. I met Horse a few years later in Hong Kong and had a few beers with him. He was married to a Filipina lady and they jointly owned a coconut plantation in the Philippines. I am pretty sure that Horse has now passed away but I have no details. Maybe somebody can tell us?

Some folks said that "Horse" was so-named because of his face. In the above mentioned *Hash Story* video, Cecil Lee, another original office bearer, makes a humorous remark which suggests that the 'horse' moniker came from another physical attribute, a bit lower down.



Anybody who knows me well will know my views on long hash trails, so called 'ball breakers' and the like. These are not, in my view, what was ordained by the original 1938 founders who considered that a maximum of one hour to enable 'gentlemen to work up a thirst for beer' was the right length for a hash run. Given our advancing years, I will now accept 90 minutes for walkers. Anyway, in 1986 I was 40 years old and very fit so I took a bus to a 'medium' run site. I led the pack almost all the way, mainly because the hares had left distinctive footmarks in the sandy soil at every check. There was not a 'stick' of shade and no drinks were provided. It took me one and three quarter hours and many folks took much longer. The hares, of course, had provided much beer at the end but the soft drinks and water ran out. A young American girl staggered in after two hours and thirty minutes to find that there was only beer available. To put it very politely, she was not best pleased. This was a 'medium' run.

On the Sunday, I went to the bus assembly point to go on a 'short run'. Nearby I spotted a 'long run' bus. It had one single guy sitting on it.

I still have some of the 'stash' provided for the event and show here a picture of my hat plus one showing the front of the magazine, the song book and my precious beer mug, now 31 years old.

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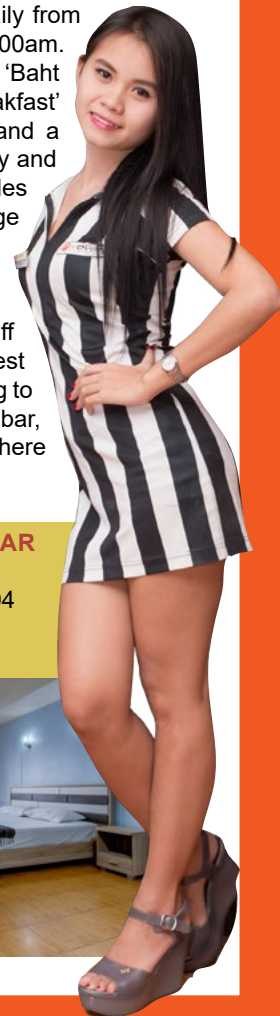

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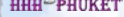

HASHING IN Mauritius

Last year Head Mistress while attending a conference on the African island of Mauritius, decided to return to the Mauritius Hash which she had first visited in 2010.

A circle followed led by GM Hudson and RA Isabelle with the usual run reports, charges and songs but this time unlike my last visit in 2010, the hashers had been trained to stand up and not bring their deckchairs into





the circle. There was some song training going on with lyrics to popular hash songs being distributed in the circle.

It was then time for Sunday lunch and out came the pots of food and eating utensils for the 'bring and share system' as everyone shared their food and drank the remaining beer before going home for a Sunday nap.

The Catamaran Hash

In this year's top 5 Hashing events in Africa I featured the Catamaran hash as one of the events of the year so I asked GM Hudson to write a short write upon it.

The Catamaran Hash held on January 14, 2018, was a special hash as it wasn't taking place on an official Hash date. The turn-up was amazing, considering it was during the perceived cyclone season. We paid a visit to the privately-owned island of Île aux Cerfs... Island of Deer. Unfortunately, we didn't get to see any deer...in hindsight, it must have been the beer and rum conceived. This unique hash was the brainchild of Isabelle Joseph (appropriately hash-tagged IS-IS...she might not be a terrorist).

Unfortunately, there is not much I remember but photographic evidence shows we had some great fun.

In The Spotlight

GoToTheHash.net Turns 20

This is the story of the Regional Hash Webmasters from back in the mid to late 1990s, and our effort to organize. Harken back to the day when E-Mail was king, E-Mail Lists were the social networks, and flame wars were abundant (not that they cannot be found on F-Book now). Created in January 1998 from primordial internet fudge, GoToTheHash.net (a.k.a. WORLD HASH LINKS), is now 20 years old. Originally, GoToTheHash.net started out as just a listing of a small group of hashers that managed websites containing links and contacts for the H3 clubs within a country or region.

Our merry band of hashmen back then included: AFRICA = Slumpy, ARABIAN GULF = Baldrick2Dogs, AUSTRALIA = D2HD, CANADA = Mr. PeeeeeNut, CHINA & HONG KONG = Geriatric, EUROPE 1 or EUROPE 2 = Floater or Prof, INDIA = Spiderman, INDOCHINA = Hanoi H3, JAPAN = Beerhead, SOUTH KOREA = Hazukashii, MALAYSIA = Sim Campbell, NEW ZEALAND = Wendy, PAPUA NEW GUINEA = Dimple, PHILIPPINES = Scar Face, SINGAPORE = Dirty Hacker, SOUTH PACIFIC = Web Head, THAILAND = Rottweiler, UNITED KINGDOM = Prof, and the USA, SOUTH & CENTRAL AMERICA, and CARIBBEAN = Flying Booger.

became a simple solution to the concern. In January 2001, GoToTheHash.net got its own domain name and has been there ever since. The site went through several color and design changes in the beginning, but for the past 15 years has settled into what you see today, and now only the information changes. It may look tired, but the information is normally up to date.

Over the ensuing years, various features have been added, including a digital hash T-shirt museum, a hash events calendar, Hash Songs, an extensive Hash History, a mailing list that provides monthly updates, and a Facebook page for announcements. Now that a significant majority of hashes have migrated to Facebook, the need for this old tired website may no longer exist. I'll keep it up and running as long as there is interest, we'll see what happens over the next year or so.

FAT CONTROLLER TO BE RENAMED BIG BONED TEAM LEADER

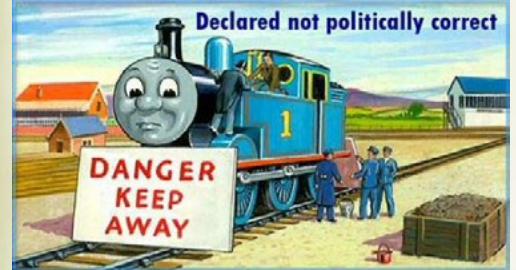
Anti-bullying & equality campaigners have praised plans by children's show Thomas the Tank Engine to highlight modern issues in the latest series of the classic show.

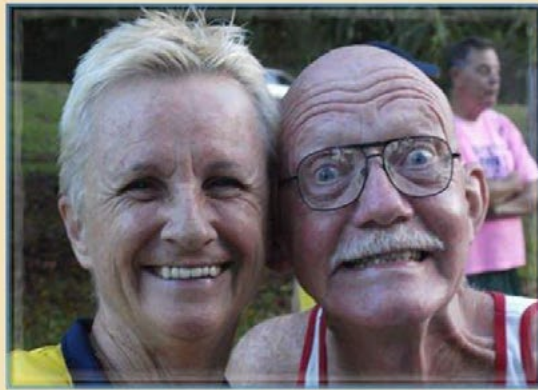

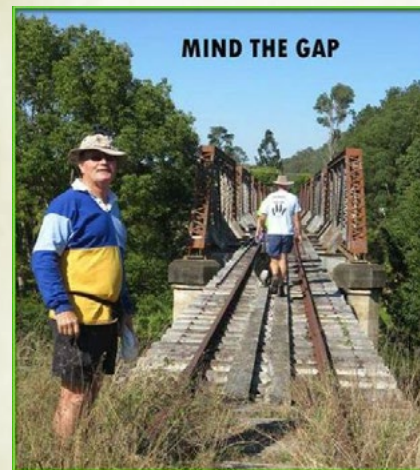

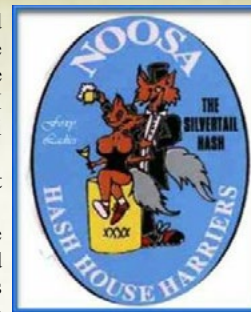
SOMETIMES THE NOOSA AND MAROOCHY HASHES GET TOGETHER FOR A RUN

THE OXFAM PROSTITUTE SCANDAL IS WORSE THAN FIRST FEARED WE CAN REVEAL

An undercover investigation by the Trash revealed vice girls are openly being used by the charity to boost funds. Our reporters watched in horror as a Brighton Oxfam charity shop opened its doors for business as a brothel. At 9.15am on Tuesday morning, volunteer staff turned up for work at the shop and lit up the window display where four scantily-clad ladies were offering their services.

Anti-vice campaigner Lorraine Fisher, 34, was horrified when we showed her our evidence. The charity has tried to claim the scandal following the 2010 Haiti earthquake, where its aid workers hired vulnerable local people for sex, was a one-off..

"But now we can see it is actually offering official Oxfam prostitute services to the general public. Ms Fisher called for the charity, which faces losing huge amounts of financial support following the revelations, to clean up its act. "Nobody out shopping in a Brighton high street wants to see this sort of thing. It's not as though they are even trying to hide it. These women are brazenly offering themselves from the window."

An Oxfam insider said: "We have indeed lost a lot of donations since the public was told our staff spent money on prostitutes. So nobody should be surprised we have been forced to extend the products we have on sale in our charity shops." Pensioner Derek Smith, 76, who popped into the shop to find some new shoes, was surprised by what he saw. "I didn't know which way to look," he said. "They keep moving the shoes around."
