There's a definite skip in the steps of everyone, the music is jamming and everyone has a smile on their face. There is great excitement in the air as people hurry to get their party tickets, sort out their outfits and pick up their costumes at the Mas Camps for the big days.

Everything else takes a back seat! Its all about the music, the parties, the Mas (Street Parades) and of course the alcohol!

Long before the two designated Carnival days of 2019 (Feb 4th & 5th) the celebrations begin. The tempo heats up . Weeks of none stop feting.

The signature events begin with all the promoters trying to get their event top of the billing alongside the standard events. The schools set their dates for the School parties with kids creating their own costumes and competing in their own carnival bands. The big name

parties all line up in their expected order as they have done for years, the Victoria Gardens fete, followed by Fatima College fete, Bishops fete, University Fete, even the Army has their won fete. These private fetes exist alongside the Calypso tents where the Calypsoians (Bards) sing their new tunes to their audiences and try to win the best Calypso of the year. As the season draws closer the more established fetes and official 'Carnival events' line up for their turns, The Dimarche Gras- the Kings and Queens costume competition, The Soca Monarch – the best Soca Artists of the year, kiddies Carnival, Panorama - the Steelband competition, the biggest and best event of the year when 60,000 patrons pack their coolers, make their way to the Savannah to enjoy hours of fantastic steelband music.

In the final week, that's when the big days begin with Jou'vert – or the 'Dawn of the day' street parade /party kicks off. From as early as 3am in the morning, Masqueraders dress in "dark costumes" depicting evil creatures, Bats, dragons, devils, politicians, Jab Jab, La Jablesse and other local folklore creatures, and parade and dance in the streets alongside music trucks or steelbands until the sun comes up. Recently many Jou'vert bands have become less sinister and they now soak the participants in mud, oil, paint or other material as they party in the streets, shocking many a tourist with glee. Sometime around 10am the

creatures recede into their dark hovels to reappear next year and that's when it all begins, the Bright colourful bands hit the streets.

Its **Pretty Mas** time, the feathers, the glitter, the bikinis, brilliant head pieces, capes and other beautiful costumes step on to the stage to take their place in the Carnival parade for two days of revelry.



Thousands & thousands of spectacular costumes take to the streets by 7am dancing to the music of steelbands, 'Live' music bands on trucks and Dj Music trucks till 7pm on Monday and then back again on Tuesday.

A band often consist of 3,000 participants decorated in a theme, dancing carelessly with their friends to music along with their the 'Alcohol carts' always an arms length away, all heading towards to the Savannah to cross the stage , each boasting of their unique beauty.

Port of Spain, the Capital City boasts 500,000+ masqueraders while other outlying towns host smaller but just as energy packed parades.

The God of Bacchus takes over the island, filling the cups of all with copious amount of alcohol and taking away most inhibitions. Not All!

We all wake up aching on Ash Wednesday for 45 days of Lent. Happy to stay away from the noise and alcohol as our battered livers beg for forgiveness, till Easter weekend throws us back in to the liming again. It never stops.

As you read this, know that 90% of all Trini hashers will be engaged in some Carnival celebration somewhere on the island, no matter the time of the day or night. Its what we do. Its what we love. As we prepare to host

the Interhash Trinidad and 2020 be assured that the Carnival bacchanal would be sprinkled across all aspects of your experience here. We couldn't leave you out could we?

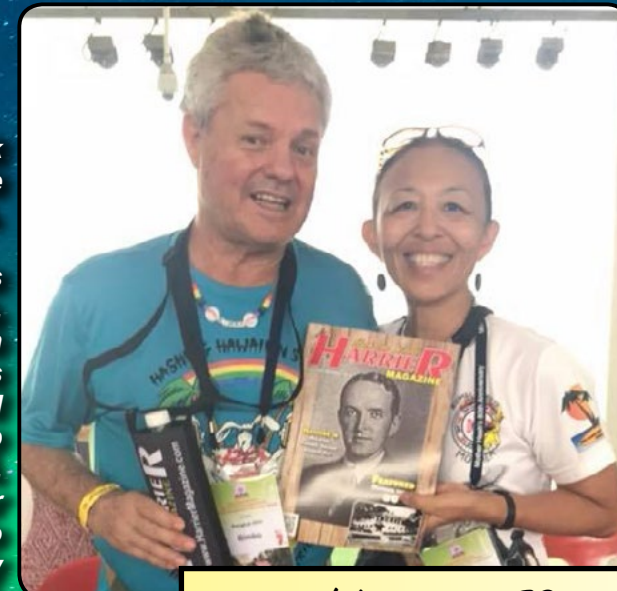

In Europe, the odd years bring EuroHash. In this odd year, even though EuroHash is sure to be a really good event, it is not included in this article since many hashers cannot afford a pricy weekend hash cruise. Instead, we will focus on some hashing off the beaten path, some events not to be missed and other events that giving back to their communities and organizing Red Dress Runs for charity.

OSLO H3, 30th ANNIVERSARY SKI HASH, 20-22 March, 2019

Oslo H3 was founded in March 1989, and they are celebrating their 30th anniversary. Oslo H3 is an active Hash with 30 – 50 member running weekly. Their celebration will be a traditional Oslo Ski Hash. The Ski Hash is an annual event, yet this year it will be a big one! The event will start in Oslo, and busses will transport hashers to the winter wonderland of Sjusjøen, where there is guaranteed good snow. The organizers are even nice enough to even stop by the airport to collect visitors.

Sjusjøen is gently undulating and crossed by miles of prepared cross country ski tracks. The accommodation is in modern cosy cabins, and skis can be hired nearby. The 2 trails will be set with the novice in mind. At the end of the trail there are snow games. There is nothing like a cold beer and a hot sauna after the trail. You can wear a swim suit or go butt-naked. OH3 boasts one of the most extensive collections of mankinis in the northern hemisphere. These will be on show as hashers enjoy the sauna and a good old jump in the snow. OH3 even has their own band, "Wrong Direction", who will be keeping the dancefloor full on Saturday evening. They have a good repertoire of popular songs and the more you drink, the better they sound. The registration is all inclusive Oslo return, accommodation, food and drinks. INTERSCANDI, 15-17 May, 2019

Whilst in Scandinavia, why not try out the 2019 edition of the Interscandic? It is hosted by WAGH3, with help from other Swedish hash groups, in Central Sweden at the SKANTZÖ CAMPING in HALLS-TAHAMMAR. This is approximately 90 minutes west of Stockholm by car. The hashing territory is well known, as this was the scene of their 100th run, a Prelude to Brussels 2014. Friday welcomes you with not one, but two Swedish Buffets. On Saturday hashers can enjoy all lengths of trail through the Swedish wilderness, yet one should definitely be on the lookout for Moose. After the run there will be a party with a live band.

In 1992, Mad Swede and Double Decker founded the Västerås H3, now known as the Westra Aros Gurka (WAG H3), or Pickle Hash. They started their hashing careers in New York and then Washington DC, and eventually decided to bring some hashing fun back to Central Sweden. Be careful as Mad Swede is known to lay a decoy trails for any over achievers who might want to prematurely go out early and look for trail. (Ask the NYCH3.)

MIJAS 30th ANNIVERSARY 15-17 May, 2019

If Scandinavia is too cold, another stellar event will be in Southern Europe on the same weekend in seaside town of Fuengirola, Spain, just outside Málaga. The Mijas H3, or the "Burro Hash", has been hashing on the Costa Del Sol since 1989. The weekend begins with a Red Dress Run on Thursday night in the famous pretty white village of Mijas Pueblo in the nearby mountains. Proceeds will go to the Children's Cancer Hospital in Malaga. The main part of the weekend will kick off on Friday night with live music. On Saturday hashers can enjoy all lengths of trail with a variety of terrains in the mountainous countryside or on the sea. Then it will be time for a spruce up, to be ready for the 30th Anniversary Hash Bash in the Las Palmeras ballroom. This includes a full sit-down 3 course meal with Cava, wine, beer. One can enjoy live music, a DJ, and of course, hash acts. The Sunday Hare of the Dog Run will end up at an amazing Spanish Hacienda with food and wine, plus Flamenco and a horse show. Continue the weekend until Tuesday, with a Malaga H3 run on Monday and a Rock of Gibraltar Run on Tuesday.

German Nash Hash, 30 August-1 September

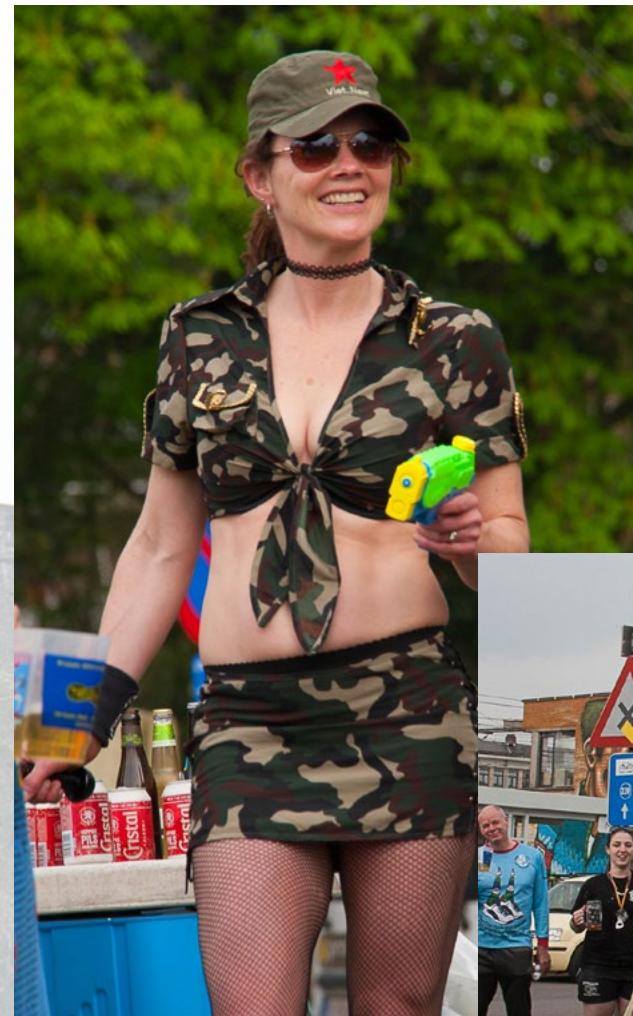

On this weekend, the Hannover Hash House Harriers will be celebrating their 35th anniversary. H4 was founded in 1984 and has been going strong ever since, running every second and last Sunday of the month. They will be celebrating in proper hash style in the heart of Hannover, close to the beautiful Maschsee. They have secured accommodation and a great party location just a few tumbles from the city lake. It will be hash central for the weekend. There will be runs accommodating each type of hasher, be it a ballbreaker that will leave you wishing you had packed more blister band aids or a walker trail that could qualify as a swim due to the amount of beer you

Every year there are a number of major hash events scheduled all over the world and 2019 is no exception. Many of these events are recurring and the host hash club rotates among the various hash clubs within a country or region. Most hash events are three day affairs and the event includes runs, circles, dinners and parties. The host hash clubs almost always set up a web site which describes what is being planned, the cost and who is attending. If you are interested you can go to the event web site and see if the event appeals to you. You can then sign up and make arrangements to pay. All hashers that have never attended a major hash event should consider attending at least one of the major hash events this year. You will not only have a great time but you will also make lots of new friends.

Pattaya Hash House Harriers 35th Anniversary January 4 to January 7

This is not really a nash hash level event but it will attract many participants so I am including it here. They are planning a full moon run on Friday January 4, a bar hop on Saturday, a Pattaya Jungle hash run on Sunday and an anniversary run on Monday. There will be meals included in the event as well as all the beer you can drink after the runs. Also included is a graphic design shirt. Mental Disorder, PH3 GM has been promoting the event and he expects in the area of 200 participants. Philippine Nash Hash 2019 Manila February 28 to March 3

The Philippine Nash Hash is held every two years and this year's event will be hosted by the Manila H3. The last Philippine Nash Hash was hosted by the Cebu H3 in March 2017. Everyone including myself that attended this event will testify that everyone had a great time. This year will be no exception. There will be an optional red dress run on Thursday Feb 28. A red dress run is a common feature of nash hash level events. All the hashers dress up in red dresses and other girl's attire and parade around some commercial area with many bars and restaurants. For this event it will be Burgos Avenue in Makati. There will be three sets of runs on Friday Saturday and Sunday. All of the hashers will be transported from Makati by bus to the mountains in Rizal Province. After the run they will be transported back to Makati for meals drinking and socializing.

The trails will start around midday and will be followed by several hours of drinking beer and dinners. The web site gives all of the details as to exactly what has been planned. All of Wild Wolf's hash events follow the same format so ask anyone that attended the last event in Puerta Galera in April 2018 or any of the previous events and they will fill you in. Deli H3 run 1,000 – Timor Leste March 16-18

I have included this event because of the unusual location and because the sponsors have done a great deal to promote the event. If you are a hasher that would like to visit an exotic location that no one else has ever been then this is the event for you. Deli is the capital of Timor Leste aka East Timor which is one of the newest countries in the world. Timor Leste achieved its independence from Indonesia in 2002. This country was a Portuguese colony at one time and the principal language is Portuguese. There will be a red dress



run on March 16 and trails on the 17th and 18th. All of these will be followed with circles, beer drinking and dinners. There are Daily flights from Bali to Deli on Srijaya Airlines. The Bali H3 has runs on Thursday and Mondays so you could combine this event with the Bali hash.

Pan Indo Nash Hash – Kupang Indonesia Aug 1 to 3

This is an annual event and last year's event was in Bandung West Java. This year the event will be in Kupang which is 945 kms east of Bali on the island of Timor. The hash venue is Swiss-Belinn Kristal resort. There are a number of run sites listed on the web page. Hashing is very popular in Indonesia and there are many hashers and hash clubs. Currently there are 1,200 hashers signed up for the event and they expect around 2,000. Unfortunately the web site is in Indonesian language (bahasa).

Borneo Nash Hash – Kota Kinabalu Malaysia September 13 to 15

The Borneo Nash Hash is an annual event and rotates with the various hash clubs in Borneo. The 2018 event was in Kuching in June . This will be a very large event and there are already over 500 hashers signed up. I expect there will be way more than 1,000. Unfortunately the web site does not give much information about the event but I expect there will be three days of rather difficult trails followed by the usual beer drinking, circles and meals. Malaysians are tough hashers. There will be short trails for the socialites. See the November 2018 edition of this magazine and read the articles about the Mother Hash 80th Anniversary. I expect this event will be similar. I love hashing in Malaysia and for me this will be the best event of the year. www.borneonashhash.com





Japan Nash Hash – Yamanakako Japan October 12 to 14

The Japan Nash Hash is an annual event and rotates with the various hash clubs in Japan. Last year's event was in Makino Japan. I attended this event and wrote a detailed article about it in the November edition of this magazine. The 2019 event will

follow the same format as in 2018; the hash will book an entire hotel and included in the hash event fee will be 2 nights in the hotel and all of the meals. The Sumo H3 will be the host club and they have booked a hotel in Yamankako which is a small town on Lake Yamanaka near Mount Fuji about 100 kms. southwest of Tokyo. Keep checking the internet for more details. They will set up a web site in January.

Pan Asia Hash - Zhangjiajie China November 7 to 10

The Pan Asia Hash is held every two years and it is the largest event in Asia. There are already thousands of hashers signed up. The last Pan Asia was in Sokchu City Korea and the event was covered in the May 2018 edition of this magazine. For this year there is a red dress run on November 7 a welcome party on the 8th, trail runs on the 9th and 10th. Of course there will be the usual circles beer and meals. Whenever there is a huge group like this they have multiple trails in many locations. They divide up the group into smaller groups and bus them to different trail locations. Each small group will have its own circle after the run. Be aware that China requires visas from almost everyone except citizens of Singapore, Brunei and Japan.

There are exemptions and loopholes.

Mekong Indochina Hash – Chiang Mai Thailand November 13 to 17

The Mekong Indochina Hash is an annual event and the sponsors must be hash clubs in Thailand, Burma, Cambodia, Laos and Viet Nam. The last event was in Nha Trang Viet Nam in November 2018. The event really starts on the 13th with a Charity Loy Kratong (Loy Kateoy) Run, basically a red dress run. On Thursday the 14th there are 3 runs, a Lanna Bush run for men only, a bunny, iron pussy run for the women, and a mixed Chiang Mai happy run for the socialites. On Friday there is a welcome party, the main runs are on Saturday and there is a hangover run on Sunday. If that is not enough there is a postlube full moon run on Monday. Be advised that Loy Kratong on the 13th is one of the main traditional festivals held annually in Chiang Mai. As a result there will be many visitors in town on that day and the hotels may fill up early.

Asia United Hash – Taoyuan. Taiwan November 21 to 24

This will be another major event this year with large attendance. The Taoyuan H3 made a bid for the Pan Asia Hash and lost out in the voting to China. Since they had already made big plans for the Pan Asia Hash they decided to hold their own event anyway. They have actively promoted this event and already have over 1,500 hashers signed up. 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Top 6 Hashing Events in Sub-Saharan Africa 2019

2019 is a mega year for African hashes as three reach the grand number of 2000 runs which goes to show how quickly hashing spread in the region in the 1980's. It's also a Pan Africa year and finally Sierra Leone gets to host it.

Cape Town 2000 Runs

Where: South Africa, Southern Africa

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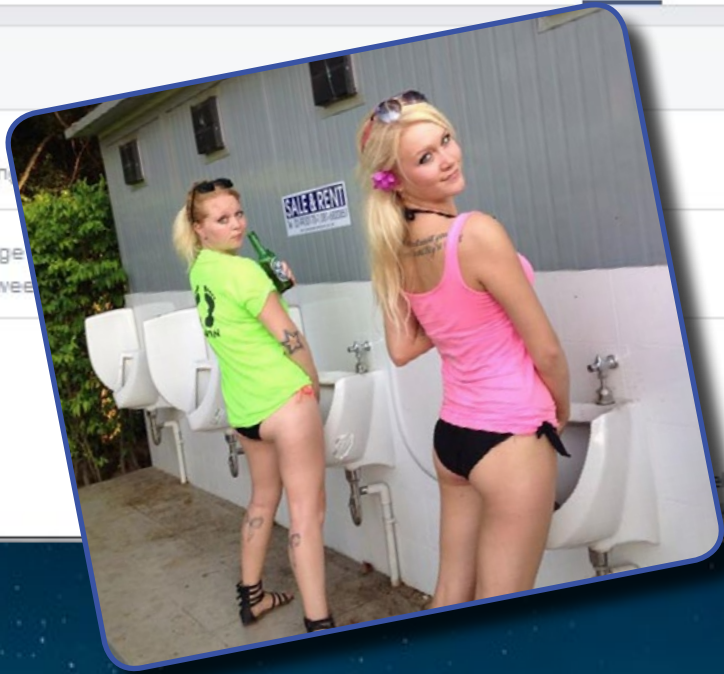

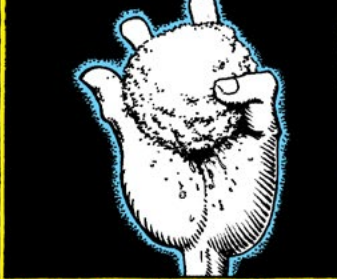
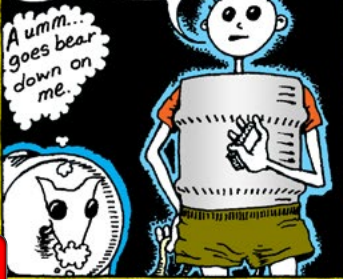


fig 2.1 "Rear back on yer haunches til you feel yer scrotum burn."

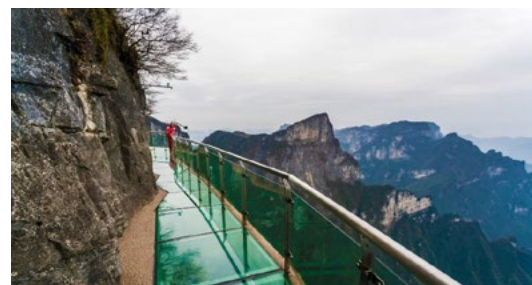

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Hashing in the Philippines

I have noticed that many Hash Clubs in the world are located in military or former military towns. The military promotes physical fitness and military members like to drink beer so hashing and the military are a natural fit. There are 6 hash cities in the Philippines and three of them are in former U.S. military towns. Actually the Philippine Hash started in Manila in 1972 with the Manila Hash House Harriers and that club may have been involved in the beginning of the second Philippine hash club which was the Angeles City H3 which was started on August 19, 1978.

Angeles City Hash House Harriers

Angeles City was the home of Clark Air Force Base which was the largest American military base in the world outside of the United States. No one currently a member of ACH3 today was around in 1978 when run number 1 took place. I have questioned many of the longtime members and unfortunately I have received much conflicting information as to exactly how the club was started. Everyone agrees that the original club was started on Clark Air Force Base. The first run was on Saturday August 19 and was on base. The second run was a town run in Angeles on the following day, August 20. Supposedly there were 25 people in attendance. Bill Booker and Walt Daniels were the hares for these runs and Daniels was the first GM for the club. These two people along with James Silver Fox Gillard are considered to be the founders of the club. The hash club was originally called the Clark Air Base H3. Maybe a year later (actual time unknown) the club moved off base and was renamed its Angeles City Hash House Harriers. The Manila Hashers claim that these two runs were actually an outpost run of the Manila Hash with the attendees being a combination of Manila hashers and some air force people. The air force people then carried on the club. No one today knows anything about the three founders. For sure they did not stay around for very long and their whereabouts today is unknown.



One of the leaders of the early Angeles hash club was Rob Denny (Malibog Kalbo) who was a long time GM of the club and was the owner of Bird of Paradise Bar on Fields Avenue which was the hash home during most of the early years until 2001. Bird of Paradise was located where Red Bar and Fields Hotel stands today. Bird of Paradise was torn down in 2001. Anchorage Inn was the Hash home from 2001 until 2012 when it was torn down. Premiere Hotel is currently the hash home.

The American leases on Clark and Subic were set to expire in 1992. Many Filipinos felt that the bases infringed on the sovereignty of the country and wanted them closed. However the governments were engaged in somewhat futile negotiations to extend the leases. The eruption of Mount Pinatubo, which is located near Angeles and Clark, completely settled the matter.

The second-largest volcanic eruption of the 20th century, and by far the largest eruption to affect a densely populated area, occurred at Mount Pinatubo on Saturday, June 15, 1991. The eruption produced high-speed avalanches of hot ash and gas, massive lahar floods and huge clouds of superheated volcanic material hundreds of kilometers across. Needless to say damages were massive and Clark Air Base was declared a total loss by the Americans. Immediately the Americans started evacuation of all their troops at Clark transferring them to other bases. Later in 1991 the Americans returned the base to the Philippine government.

Since at that time three quarters of all the Angeles City hashers were air force people the effect on the hash was devastating as well. Suddenly attendance at the Sunday hash runs dropped from 70 to 80 people down to 15. Thanks to the efforts of Rob Denny and several of the other expat hashers the club was kept together. Many of the military people stationed at Clark in the 70s and 80s had Filipino wives or girlfriends so after their military service they returned to Angeles to live.

Also over the years there were many people from the US Europe and Australia that came to visit Philippines and found the country to be a desirable place to live and a desirable place to retire. Over the years the Angeles Hash grew tremendously to become the largest hash club in the country. Today they get anywhere from 70 to over 100 hashers every Sunday.



The hash today meets up on or before 3:00 PM (2:00 in Nov. Dec. And Jan.) every Sunday at the hash home, Premiere Hotel. (The hash times is discussed and voted on at every AGM so it is subject to change). After signing up the hashers are transported by jeepney to the run site. The area around Angeles City is urbanized and flat but there are many mountains to the north of the city and it is in these areas where the runs take place. The hash also goes to areas around Porac and Mount Arayat. Many of the regular hashers have their own cars and they drive themselves to the run sites. The run site is posted on the AC3 web site before the run. Visitors and 1st timers are advised to use the jeepney because the run site may be hard to find for someone unfamiliar with the area. Most of the trails are from 5 to 8 kms. in length. Some of the trails are easy and some can be challenging. However all of the trails are in beautiful countryside. One thing you will see on the trails is many cows, caribou, goats and other farm animals. All of these animals are very timid and will not hurt anyone. They just make the runs more enjoyable and give an opportunity for pictures. Like all of the Philippine hash clubs all of the hashers are expats, wives or girlfriends of the expats or single Filipina girls. There are no Filipino men in the hash. The Expats are mostly English, American, Australian or from a few other European countries. The club gets many visitors and they could be from anywhere. The ACH3 is a very family friendly hash and some of the hashers do bring their children.

After the run there is the usual drinking and socializing at the run site followed by a circle. Jack Clayton aka Saput is the long time GM and he conducts the circle. After the circle the hashers return to the "on home" which usually is at Premiere Hotel. Sometimes the hare chooses to go somewhere else. Premiere has a big restaurant, swimming pool and places to sit and socialize. The hash goes on until many times after 9:00PM.



Subic Bay Hash House Harriers

Like Angeles Olongapo City which is located on Subic Bay was also a former military town. Subic Bay Naval Base was the second largest overseas American Military base. Actually the Subic Bay H3 was the second hash club in Subic Bay. The Hash House Harriers Olongapo (H3O) which was founded on May, 16, 1987 was the first club. Subic BayH3 was founded on July 26, 1993 after H3O had terminated operation. The two clubs really had nothing to do with each other which explain why SBH3 does not claim to be a continuation of H3O.

H3O was founded completely by active duty military members. They were most likely permanently stationed here. I have obtained copies of some of the H3O newsletters and have noted several interesting fast about this club. The turnover among hash members was very large. In 1989 there was one group running the hash and by 1991 most of these people were gone and another group was running the club. Also there were many harriettes (Girl Hashers). There were many first time hashers at every hash run. The Subic Naval Base had a large transit population. Many personal were sent here TAD or TDY for anywhere from 3 to 6 months at a time.

Whenever a battle group would pull into port, the military population would increase by at least fifteen thousand personnel for a period of anywhere from two to three weeks. The hash club attracted good attendance and for the 4th anniversary run they had 75 hashers.

Subic Bay Naval Base was affected exactly the same way as Clark Air Force Base with the eruption of Mount Pinatubo and the failure of the Americans and Filipinos to agree to terms on a lease extension. Subic Bay is also close to Pinatubo and the base suffered major damage. However the damage was much less than at Clark and the base was kept open until the end of the lease in 1992. As soon as Pinatubo erupted the Americans moved huge numbers of Navy personnel to other bases partly to make room for many air force personnel that were moved to Subic. All of that was fatal to H3O and their last run was July 13, 1991.



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The current Subic Bay Hash was founded in July 1993, two years after H3O terminated. The founders were Bob Reynolds and Dennis Oakley and the first run attracted 39 hashers. It appears that none or very few of these hashers had run with H3O. The Subic Bay Hash is located Barrio Barreto which is part of Olongapo City but in reality is a separate town. Barretto is more of a small resort town as opposed to Olongapo which is a larger commercial town. The first hash home was Fantasy Island which was later renamed Beachside Café. Many of the first hashers were frequent customers of

Midnight Rambler, a popular bar-restaurant in Barreto. The current hash club has run weekly ever since that first run.

Subic Bay H3 meets every Monday at 3:30 at their current hash home, Johansson's Lodge and Restaurant in Barreto. SBH3 is very fortunate because there are many mountains with very good trails directly behind the town of Barreto. Many of the hash runs start at Johanssens and the hashers walk or run straight into the mountains. The hash also owns a truck that is used to transport the hashers a few Kms. away so that the hashers can enjoy a bigger variety of trails. Nearly all of the hash runs end at one of several resorts or restaurants on the beach or in town. These "on home" places are currently: Treasure Island Resort, Johans Resort, Getaway Resort, Midnight Rambler, Hot Zone Bar and Johannsons. After the run the hashers can relax, drink beer and socialize at one of these places and wait for the circle.

Subic Bay H3 is more of an adult hash than ACH3. Children are not barred from the hash but parents are advised that their children might receive an education that the parents may not like. The hash slogan is "It's nice on ice" and the circle features a big block of ice that hashers sit on. Johannes Winter (HIV) has been GM of the hash club for about 5 or 6 years. There are between 25 to 40 hashers on every run.

Riot police had to be called to a Rochdale Asda today following a bout of civil disorder. Heavy discounts meant customers could purchase trolleys for £1. A Black Friday sale on trolleys saw customers fighting in the aisles. One told us, "I got here at 3am to get a space in the queue. There were already loads of people here by then. When the doors opened it was just chaos."



Another customer said, "I've just been in and it's like the end of Platoon. I beat an old man to death with his own false leg. What can you do? It's the law of Black Friday." Police Crime Commissioner, Orla Board said, "We are very critical of the minority of people who came to cause trouble. We were forced to deploy an entire riot squad to a branch of Asda this morning. 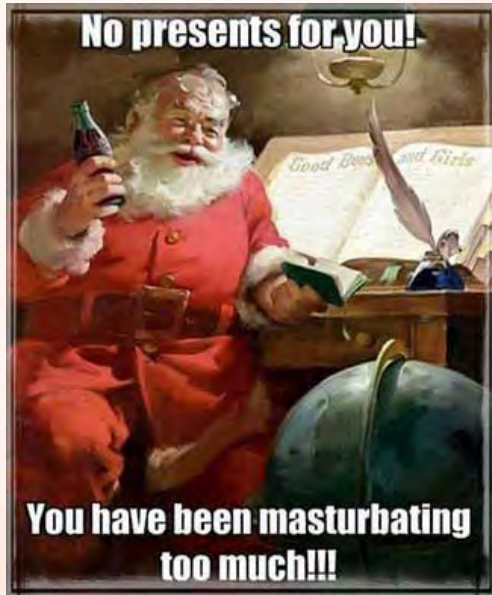
"What would you like for Christmas, little boy?"
