**Zone 1:** The St Ann's and Cascade area. - North of the Queens Park Savannah-Historical Living minutes walk away from the Hash Hotel



There you can find small businesses supporting the residents and the Tourism sector, with groceries, bars, restaurants, the Queens Hall, where many a local concert or play has been staged, as well as many historical buildings and sites, including the Prime Minsters House, the Presidents House, the Emperor Valley Zoo, the Botanical Gardens, and the Presidents Grounds where many an exciting rugby game has been played


**Zone 2:** The St Clair, Woodbrook and Ariapita Ave- West of the Queens Park Savannah – Guest House Living amid the Bars and Restaurants.

St Clair, is an upscale residential area, hosting some of the most beautiful historic homes and parks, including the Stollmeyer Castle and the Magnificent Seven.

Just behind these stately buildings, spread the Woodbrook and Newtown areas. Historically very quaint residential areas with the classic Trinidadian George Brown houses, they have become home to blocks of bars, restaurants and smaller quests houses littered along the famous Ariaptia Ave. Local pubs and Sports bars, restaurants and other notable sites can be found in this area, including sprawling Sports Bars like Trotters and All Out which are the largest, located near the Famous Queens Park Cricket Club. Standing tall and high above all is One Woodbrook Place residential towers, where many can sign up for Airbnb and live high above some of the most popular bars and restaurants below, minutes walk away from all things Hash.

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# Editor's Notes





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RESURRECTION RUN #1 & #2 23/24 FEBRUARY 2019

The BH3 has been resurrected by a group of hashers living in Bohol.

here have been a few hashes in Bohol, according to Honourable Hash Historian, Squatta, from Manila H3. The first known runs were organised at Alona Beach, Panglao Island, in 2002, by Junkyard, a resort owner, who had previously hashed at Puerto Galera and founded the Matabungkay hash.

In March 2011, Proposition, active Philippine hasher, arranged Philippine Hash Bash #4, attended by about 150 international and local hashers. Making use of new and unexplored hashing territory, the Cebu hash has had many outstation runs in Bohol, commencing in 2014.



With a number of keen hashers now residing in Panglao Island, the Resurrection Run was arranged in February, 2019, as a prelube to the Philippine Nash Hash. Organisers and hares were Cuntstubble Pantless, Check Your Pants, Flo Jo and OJ.



The weekend attracted 41 hashers, coming from Bohol, Cebu Hash, Manila Hash, Phuket, Vietnam and other international hashes, kicking off with Friday drinks and registration at the Biergarten pub in Alona Beach.

Run #1, hared by GM, Cuntstubble Pantless and Check Your Pants, was a jeepney ride to the east end of Panglao Island, where hashers chose between a bloody long, two hour run/walk and mild walk. Enthusiastic runners could join the two, but they didn't, after climbing to the top of Mt. Biking. Great trail and fantastic views. Following the circle it was On On to Alona Beach and a party at Rue de Premier with plenty of cold beer, great bands, cultural show and fire dancing. Terrific.





For those that got up the next morning for Flo Jo's and OJ's recovery Run #2, it was a jeepney ride across the causeway to Bohol Island and up to Mt Banat-i, for a photo op and then down down to the sea, cross the causeway, thru a mangrove swamp, around a cliff and circle by the sea.

What a great way to resurrect BH3 !!!!!! And thanks to our major sponsors - the Alturas Group of Companies, operating malls, hospitality venues and resorts in Bohol and the southern Philippines, and, the Department of Tourism.

All hashers were amazed at the friendliness and hospitality of the Boholana's, particularly the kids, welcoming us along the trail with hi fives, photo ops and water.

With a core of about 10/12 local runners, hashes will be held on the last Saturday of the month. Hash pub is Biergarten, Alona Beach. Meet 3pm.

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






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# God Knows

#### A Few Quiet Beers with God Knows

You are probably the longest continuously-serving Hasher in the WORLD!

#### When did you first discover you could Hash?

Representing a major British publishing house I was posted to several Asian locations in the '50s. Stationed in Kuala Lumpur in 1958 my local watering hole was the famous Selangor Club (The Dog). Several Hashers dragged me to a R\*n and I haven't stopped since—slowed, yes, but not stopped.

#### What led to your Hash handle?

In The Dog one night I was asked my Hash name. "God Knows," I spluttered, over several pints. Have used the name to great effect ever since.

#### What is the highlight of your Hash history?

Founding Kuching H3 in 1963 while stationed in Borneo.. and I'm delighted to note it is stronger than ever.

#### How did you find "people like us" to start Kuching H3?

Posted to that fine city for business, I was also an officer in the Royal Naval Volunteer Reserve, and our first Hash R\*nners were largely fellow officer types.

God Knows aka Harry Howell was born in Lincoln UK, February 18, 1934 and died in Sydney, Australia, April 15, 2019 aged 85.

#### You've Hashed in many places and made many friends? Stand-outs?

So many wonderful friends everywhere. In 1962 I r\*n with the very first Singapore Hash, "The Father Hash," on the island, started by Chris Verity, Tommy Voice, and Ian Cumming.

One other, John Gastrell whom I first met in Singapore, and who introduced me to "TinLegs" Bader, by the way, was a great mate and we continued in Sydney with The Posh (he was President in 1977). And, of course, Sydney Posh has been like a family to me for more than 40 years.

#### What has been your most Hashifying experience?

Probably r\*nning with the Los Angeles H3 up 1200ft, about as high as Gibraltar. Or maybe with Mother H3 in KL. We came upon a hidden Communist terrorist camp. Silently camping all night, we held ourselves close to keep warm! Next morning we found we were just ten minutes from home. After 15 years with my publishing firm, Boustead's I came job-hunting in Sydney. One Monday I Hashed in Sabah, and the next in Sydney..changed career and country, but didn't miss a Hash!

# You've entertained Hash troops widely (or is that wildly?) with The Ballad of the Death of Lord Nelson. Has his family sued?

Claiming responsibility for this particular theatre is a Naval Officer on HMS Glasgow. I have continued his mentorship oh, only about 50 times. But not recently. Apparently hosts object to the damage to furniture, crystal, limb and even life upon the climactic conclusion of this act. Do you want to see it?

# Of all the songs, anecdotes and gags God Knows so well, what is your favourite?

With a mind like a steal(!) trap, I have been fortunate to capture one or two, it's true. But don't start me "...And the hairs of her dickey di-do hung down to her knees,

One black one, one white one, and one with a little shite on...and one with a little light on to show us the way...".


### What advice would you offer to younger Hashers—those approaching middle age?

# Prelube

We are happy to announce that the Thinking Drinking Hash House Harriers (TDH3) will be arranging a special pre-lube hash bus/train and hash trip to the Mekong Indochina Hash in Chiang Mai followed by the TDH3 on Friday 15 November 2019.

#### The planned activities include:

TDH3 Pre-lube Itinerary (subject to change)

#### 12 November:

- 11:30: Departure by bus from Bangkok (the departure venue will be announced later) for trav-

el to Bang Pa-In Palace to take in the sites of the sumptuous Palace and related nearby architectural masterpieces.


- 15:00: Depart Bang Pa-In Palace for a short hash run in Ayutthaya's Historical Park.
- 16:00: Arrive and run hash with a start time of circa 16:15 with the circle at approximately 17:30. Beer, water, soft drinks and homemade snacks will be served at the circle. A shower facility may be available (this is not yet guaranteed but will try our best).
- 18:15: A short bus ride to a boat for an On On On dinner cruise along the local Ayutthaya river.
- 20:15: A short bus ride to the train station for a train departure at 21:07 SHARP !!!!.
- 21:07: Our train will be 2<sup>nd</sup> class sleeping air-conditioned train.

The trip is limited to no less than 80 pax and no more than 110 pax. The final confirmation for the trip will be announced when these numbers are confirmed.

#### 13 November:

- 08:40: Train arrives Chiang Mai. Transfer to individual hotels <u>are NOT part of this package.</u>

Cost: The cost is 3,900 Thai Baht and includes: the bus & train rides; beer, soft drink and snacks at the Ayutthaya hash run; the On On On hash cruise dinner; the Palace tour; a TDH3 prelude trip hash shirt; and breakfast on the train (sandwich, tea & coffee).



**Registration:** Opens 15 March 2019 via <a href="http://tdh3.gotothehash.net">http://tdh3.gotothehash.net</a> and closes 15 May 2019. Maximum is 110. As soon as the trip is confirmed (via reaching the minimum of 80 hashers and or 110 hasher), we will contact everyone with instructions on payment. The payment will be due in full by 7 June 2019 (this due date is necessitated by the date the train must be booked).


Everyone is individually responsible to arrive at the bus ride and for their own travel from the Chiang Mai train station to their hotel. The TDH3 will not be responsible of any transfer fees and fees that are charged to the TDH3 will be charged back to those responsible.

Note: Possible separate Special Train Ride Option for travel to Mekong Indochina Hash.

- For those who cannot make the Pre-lube hash trip but still want to party and travel up to Chiang Mai with other hashers, we are also looking at the possibility of arranging travel for others, via the same 2nd class air-condition sleeping train from Bangkok to Chiang Mai. This train leaves Bangkok on Tuesday 12 November at 19:35 with an eta in Chiang Mai on Wednesday 13 November at 08:40. If arranged, the cost will be approx. Thai Baht 2,700.-/pax. This will be a special train car where hashers will be able to drink on board; thus why the cost would be more than the normal rate. This rate would include the sleeping bunk, beer, drink, and breakfast.

As soon as the Rumble trip is confirmed (via reaching the minimum of 80 hashers), we will contact everyone with instructions on payment.

The special train car needs to be reserved by 15 June 2019. As of now the goal for this separate special train ride would require a minimum 40 pax, but if more people show interest this number can be increased, but must be full of 40 each car.



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



After getting no answer from Facebook Messenger, I then sent a message to someone who was regularly posting in 2017 and to my surprise, an answer came back from a hasher called Train Bleu that the Dakar hash met every week on Saturdays outside the Olympique Club at 5.30pm.





After about an hour, the group rejoined where it was decided to go to Mermoz Bar for a drink which was a short drive away. So I hopped in a car with my new Senegalese hashing friends to enjoy a cold La Gazelle at a local bar. So no typical hash traditions like a marked trail, a circle or down downs and after one drink at the On On bar everyone left for home.

Since my first visit to Dakar last October, I've joined the group twice again on follow-up work visits to Dakar but always find the same small group of hashers, the same run/walk from the Olympique club followed by a drink in the same bar. However, it's a good chance to get out and meet local people and a break from work.











On the second occasion, I met the GM of the Hash, Nameless Nomad who has been The Grand Master for years. He told me these days he thinks people are not so interested in hashing since there are many other things to do. However after observing all the people out exercising, the expat community and the enthusiasm for practicing English, if the club made more of an effort to advertise a live active presence in Dakar, they may find themselves picking up new members to bring some new life back into the club.

Visa can also be obtained online, which is reliable and convenient but comes with an extra fee (www.visitsierraleone.com).

Travel: There are several international carriers servicing Freetown: KLM/ Air France, Brussels, Kenya Airways, Royal Air Maroc, Asky, Air Cote d'Ivoire, Air Peace, Mauritania Airlines (not sure all of them can be recommended; maybe you pack an extra parachute with some of them). Once you reach Lungi International Airport you have to cross over to Freetown by Speedboat. There are two providers (Sea Coach and Sea Bird) and they are both reliable. You will have to checkin the luggage and collect the luggage at the other side. Tickets are 40 USD or SLL 320.000 one way; this includes the bus transfer from the Airport to the nearby boat terminal: so come with some \$-cash. We are currently negotiating for a reduced rate for the Hashers. Transfer from the Boat terminal in Freetown to the hotel will be arranged by the PAH and/or the hotel.

### The Hop Gardens Of Kent

Even in the Sixties for many East London area families it was their only holiday. The working and living conditions would have today's 'elf and safety police up in arms. But as one picker recalls, it's almost impossible to find anyone who didn't love hop-picking in the fields of Kent.

There were songs, laughs and happy days galore as one Canning Towner, who went from the age of nine months to nine years recalls. But it wasn't Strawberry Fields Forever for her. It was the hop fields, and all that entailed.



For many youngsters, the entire six weeks school holiday was spent in the fields. As our own **Sir Clever Dick** recalls.

I remember those days. Quite an adventure when I was 11 to 14 Hop-Picking. Families from the East-end were piled into lorries with a little furniture and driven down to the Hop Fields in Kent.

I remember Marden, Chislehurst etc. That's where I learned to snare rabbits and then cook them in an earth oven. We got paid as well, not much but it was a kind of holiday in the countryside away from smoky London. Used to help transport the hops to the Kilns to dry the hops.

They were called Oast Houses............On-on! Clever Hop Picker!

### The year commemorates 50 years since the last year of the Swinging Sixties

Our mums used to cut chicken, chop eggs and spread butter on bread on the same cutting board with the same knife and no bleach, but we didn't seem to get food poisoning. Our school sandwiches were wrapped in wax paper in a brown paper bag, not in ice pack coolers, but I can't remember getting e.Coli. Almost all of us would have rather gone swimming in the lake or at the beach instead of a pristine pool (talk about boring), no beach closures then.

We all took PE. And risked permanent injury with a pair of Dunlop plimsoles instead of having cross-training athletic shoes with air cushion soles and built in light reflectors that cost as much as a small car. I can't recall any injuries but they must have happened because they tell us how much safer we are now.

We played "King of the Hill" on piles of gravel left on vacant building sites and when we got hurt, mum pulled out the 2/6p bottle of iodine and then we got our backside spanked. 
Though it can be climbed from almost any direction, the hardest is from the south-west up the seemingly never ending zig-zagging rock steps.





kidnapped, tortured and crucified on Good Friday.


"Genuinely does that sound like a good Friday to you? If anything it should be called Bloody Awful Friday. I was feeling pretty bloody forsaken all day to be honest."
