

ad Cows, Old Farts, Ball Breakers, Bra and Pants and the Red Dress run are all part of the Hashing lingo that 'Trinis' are gonna have to get used to, because its coming in 2020.

Although the Sad Cow, the Founders run, and even maybe an 'InterBash' are not officially part of the Interhash lineup, they all will be part of the total Interhash Trinidad experience. Hash kennels from across the globe have asked to join the fun. The Bra and Pants have made it on to the official Saturday itinerary, as they will be hosting their run at the Ricks Micro- Brewery on the Malabar Farms in Arima, alongside the 12 other run trails the Trini hares have chosen.

Beautiful, challenging trials have been chosen and 10 of them have already had their initial reccee. Trini teams are hard at work out there in the countryside every second Saturday putting things in place. The Bimbos have chosen the medium to easy run skirting the Chagaramas Golf Course and up into the foothills of the Nature Reserve there. The Cage Shakers have chosen the North Eastern Coastal Village of Rampanalgas, running through the rain forest, pass a waterfall and ending on the waters edge. The Big Dicks challenge you through the Arena Forest Reserve, a lush forested area populated with more wildlife than you can imagine. Natures best. The Rum Jumbies have gone to Central Trinidad for their trail in the Village of Piparo. As the excitement builds each team is challenging the others to create better runs.



With 9 months to go, 75 countries have already registered for the Interhash 2020. Mismanagement have been hard at work to ensure a seamless experience.

One innovative step is the launch of the Interhash Trinidad 2020 App in July, which has already been downloaded in 14 languages. Thank God for technology, now you misfits can have all the information needed at your finger tips, if you remember where you left your phone. GPS locations of runs, hotels, bars, restaurants, the Hash Hub and more, allow you to find out exactly where you are at all times and where to find those who have drifted off to one bar or the other. Don't waste time looking aimlessly for them just download the App from the Apple Store or Google Play sites and its easy.

The App gives you pop up reminders of bus and event schedules, the latest new bulletins, lost and found notices and even a DROP TAXI link, Pre Lube choices, as well as Tour operator information, for the adventurous who want to go out on the less beaten paths.

So what now? You've registered already, if not, time to get yourself sorted. The hotels are recording fantastic bookings and Caribbean Airlines have come on board as the Official Airline, offering you special Hash Prices. Checkout out official Website, use the Hash Code –**Hash20** for the specials to explore the rest of the Caribbean islands. OK So you need a VISA, What now?

Nationals who require visas to enter Trinidad and Tobago should submit an application to the nearest Trinidad and Tobago Embassies, High Commissions, Consulates and Honorary Consuls or British Embassy acting on behalf of the Government of Trinidad and Tobago.

Only if there is no Trinidad and Tobago office or British Embassy, some nationals can apply visa waivers. (Please contact Trinidad and Tobago Immigration Division, Visa Section to verify which nationals can apply for visa waivers).

Requirements for a visa waiver application:

All documents should be emailed to Immigration. Visas@gov.tt

• Visa Application form completed by the applicant (a current picture must be attached on the front page of form and signature of applicant below picture).

- Copy of the Bio-Data page of the applicant (picture page).
- If the applicant is not in his/her country, provide evidence of his/her status in the country he/she is currently in. (Example, evidence of work permit, student permit or residence).
- Invitation letter providing information about the purpose of visit, address in Trinidad and Tobago, anticipated period of stay, etc. (if applicable) (You should send your REGO form as proof of why you are comning to Trinidad and Tobvago
 Supporting documents required to be submitted:
 - flight itinerary
 - hotel accommodation confirmation (if applicable)
 - job letter stating salary (if applicable)
 - bank statement stating monthly transactions.

NB: All non-English documents submitted are required to be translated. All documents must be sent as an attachment as a PDF file

Please note: the visa waiver fee of \$400 TT is paid upon arrival at our Trinidad and Tobago airports.

Party Start – The Red Dress Run.



Taipei's China H3
Celebrating 25 Years ofBiking Brotherhood
in the Pyrenees

A WARM UP DOWN-HILL IN THE DESERT OF BARDENAS REALES DE NAVARRA t started in the early 90's when a group of sporty and fun loving expats living and working in Taipei regularly met to enjoy running with the 'China Hash House Harriers' along the scenic mountain trails in Taiwan. The motivation: 'Compensate the many long office hours with healthy outdoor activity followed by camaraderie and consuming lots of cold beer'.

From that, and a common interest in mountain biking, came the idea organizing a week of off-road biking somewhere outside the island in the region.

Kicking off with Sulawesi in 1993, a tradition was begun of a regular annual week of cycling in different Asian counties. This included, amongst others, a helicopter drop off in the snow in the Jomsom, Mustang area of Nepal in 1997 followed by cycling up the Kali Gandaki gorge to the Muktinath monastery and ending up along the lake in Pokara. 1998's ride led through Thailand's Chiang Dao National Park area. In 1999 and 2000, it involved the first-ever organized mountain bike groups cycling the Kingdom of Bhutan. 2002 saw speedy long-tail boats taking the group up the Mekong River and them following the Chinese border on Laos's jungle trails. In 2006 the African continent was approached the first time with the team spinning the pedals in the very mountainous Kingdom of Lesotho, while in 2007 Tanzania was explored. Costa Rica, in 2013, was the only location in the Americas so far.

On the last evening of each trip, proposals for the destination in the following year are heard and voted on. Volunteers usually step forward to offer to explore the preferred location and report early in the year on the outcome. If judged 'doable', the date, depending mainly on the most suitable weather conditions, is finalized in March and the announcement made. Strict rules apply as to who of the 30+ names on the list (boys only, because boys behave different when girls are around) may join as logistics generally only allow a maximum of 24 participants. Seniority (number of previous rides) as well as the earliest commitment documented with a transfer of nonrefundable fees are the criteria.

After almost a quarter of a century, predominantly covering the slopes in the Himalayans and the hills in Asia, the 25th anniversary ride was meant to be special one and the first time to Europe, exploring Spain's Basque Country of the Pyrenees under the slogan 'Making Basque Great Again'. The Basque country as it stands today is known as 'The Autonomous Unified Basque Country', consisting of the North and South Provinces. The North is controlled by the French and the South by the Spanish. Initially a little reserved towards foreigners, the locals are very proud of their identity and have their own Basque national flag. Basques have fought for their land, their culture, and their pride. Their traditions are alive and flourishing today. The widely spoken Basque language is a language with no known linguistic relatives as it is unrelated to any of the other languages of Europe.

ON SINGLE TRACKS THROUGH AUTUMN-COLOURED OAK TREE FORESTS Like on all the earlier rides the basic concept was simple: a daily good workout in beautiful surroundings, trying to avoid roads by preferably cycling single trails; simple accommodation and reasonable food. However, there is no compromise on the amber beverage: 'enough chilled beer for everybody every evening!' Attention to detailed logistics therefore is an absolute requirement. During the daily Hash Circle the day is reflected and Down Downs are granted to achievers, fu*#ups and other memorable events.

Only a few members of the original group presently still live in Taiwan since some have returned to their home countries, mainly the US, or have found new opportunities in China or the Asian region. Thus flights carrying the bikes touched down in the northern Spanish city of Bilbao from all over the world. In order to get acclimatized and check the equipment, a 'warm up ride' in the little known desert of 'Bardenas Reales de Navarra' was staged before getting into the mountains and onto the Basque highlands.

While altitude this time was no issue, the steep gradients still did require endurance (on the up) and technical skills (on the down). Usually starting in the morning on dirt roads up a valley, trails soon led into the lush woods mainly following single tracks through autumn-coloured oak tree forests. Living in the tropics for so many years and being accustomed to an almost continuous sight

of 'green nature' made experiencing the autumn season even more special for some. Above the tree line, open grasslands covered the slopes where healthy looking sheep, cattle, and horses were feeding on the juicy and nutritious highland grass. Alpine flowers added bright, colourful spots. Breathing the clean fresh air, no longer a given in many of Asia's cities, felt good.

On day 4 of the trip, a long valley ended at a very steep, grass-covered slope which was not rideable, requiring an ascent by serous pushing of the bikes uphill for almost 2 hours. Reaching the top of the ridge we were surprised by a low 2-wire fence indicating the Spanish/French border. After lifting the bikes over and enjoying the far view towards the French peaks, we enjoyed a long, bumpy downhill finally ending up at an asphalt road only to start a steep serpentine uphill to the Col de Larrau (one of the passes on the 2007 Tour de France) and returning back onto Spanish territory again. Weather can

change fast from calm and sparkling sunshine to heavy wind and horizontal rain. However, we were lucky most of the time as we got caught in the misty rain only once. The overall pleasant fall temperatures and the low humidity contributed to the enjoyment of the daily rides. The favorable climatic conditions, however, did not ease the pressure on some softer body part caused by the extended hours in the saddle.

> While the majority of the rides followed animal trails, we also came across some well-marked and popular walking trails with numerous enthusiastic trekkers. These were pilgrims on the 'Way of St. James', a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It leads from France through northern Spain to Santiago de Compostela over almost 1050 kilometers and thus is part of the 'First Cultural Route of Europe'. Many of the small villages we passed boasted churches and monasteries dating back many centuries. One is Roncesvalles, which offers a special daily pilgrim's mass. In addition, it is a symbolic place, whose fame crossed all Europe in the Middle Ages due, above all, to the songs about the deeds of the figure of Charlemagne and his nephew Roldan in the epic battle of Roncesvalles.

> Cobblestone pavements in the narrow alleys of the villages were lined with rustic houses decorated with beautiful flowers in front of their windows. Compared to earlier trips where simple homestays, dormitories, or tents hosted the group, this time cozy family guesthouses provided comfortable shelter during the nights. While the food on the previous rides was meant primarily to provide the required energy to compensate for the daily calorie consumption, this time

we felt really spoilt by local delicacies: Freshly brewed coffee with warm croissants for breakfast, baguettes with cured ham and air dried salami and fruit for lunch, tapas and olives, fresh salad, vegetables, and meat rounded off with tasty cheese accompanied by local wine made up dinner. The bottom line: Spanish food is a great treat with absolutely no danger of 'Delhi Belly', which in the lesser developed parts of the globe, is not an abnormal experience during similar adventures in earlier years.

Although the rides were a challenge, no bike breakdown was recorded. Even the number of punctures was below average. Most importantly, besides a few minor bruises caused by some spectacular stunts 'over the handle bars' no serious accident occurred.

The final day was a stunningly beautiful ride on the cliffs above the Atlantic. The far view into the Bay of Biscay with the white sands of the distant French city of Biarritz in the North, the contours of the Pyrenees towards the north east, and the dark blue waters with white crests washing the coast of northern Spain below us was overwhelming. Ending up in the old historic part of 'San Juan', a small fishing village outside San Sebastian, where the waiting beer was cold and plentiful, was like a 'grand finale'. While enjoying the local amber brew 'Keler' all reflected on another memorable week of physical workout and enjoyment in a very scenic, diversified, and interesting part of the world; celebrating unique brotherly friendship. ON ON to more foreign shores in the upcoming years!



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The event started on Thursday evening with welcome drinks at a local bar followed by dinner at a local lounge in the Grand Braie area in the north of the island. This was an opportunity to be reunited with familiar faces and meet new ones over a few beers and a meal.



The following afternoon, hashers met up again on the public beach of Grand Baie for the Red dress run which on the programme was supposed to be set by the Nairobi Sunday hash. That turned out not to be the case since the Kenyans couldn't pull it together to set a run and Hot Pants, a Mauritian hasher stepped in at the last minute with a live tour through the backstreets of Grand Baie mainly through narrow lanes where the locals lived but also the Grand market, a shopping street for tourists. On every corner heads were turned with the sight of everyone dressed in red dresses especially the Nairobi male hashers who had on some very sexy numbers. The group were delighted to find two statues welcoming tourists to a local market dressed in red. A drinks stop consisting of the local spiced rum helped to raise spirits even higher. The run concluded back at the beach with ice cool beers and a circle led by the Sunday Nairobi hashers where Kenyan GM 'Arthur' charged the Mauritian GM 'Dodo-Cop' for having less hashers than the overseas hashers.

The Welcome party was hosted by a local hasher known as Snow White in her villa where drinks, snacks and dinner flowed and the visiting hashers got to know the local hashers better. Snow White was one of the original hashers who had helped to build up Mauritius H3 from the early days when it was founded on 14 May 1988 by Charlie 'Bird' Mochan.



The 800th Run on Saturday started early afternoon at Bann Boeuf beach further along the northern coast. In fact it started rather late since the Trail Master, 'Hot Pants' went off to find some ice to cool the beer. The trail started with both the runners and walkers on the same trail but on approaching a boggy patch which would have involved wet and muddy feet, the walkers started to look around for alternatives which they found. Once on trail again, hitting another muddy patch, the walkers again protested and ended up finding their own trail back to the beer. Mauritian hashers evidently don't get their feet wet!

After a hash market where various hash chapters flogged their hash wares from Indian drinking vessels to Masai hash robes, the circle was called and led by Delhi H3 which was a lively event of charges and classic hash songs from the Nairobi hashers which many of the Mauritian hashers had never heard before.

The On On was at Azalee Beach club owned by a Hasher's sister. A good buffet of food was put on and there were plenty of drinks to be had. Dancing went well into the night and several after parties were held by the visiting hashers.





This meant the hangover run was truly a hangover run for many hashers starting at 10am (which is the normal run start for Mauritius H3) on another beach going further north around the island. (In fact the younger Mauritian hashers only showed up for the after party.) A trail of 10km for the runners (which turned out to be a ball breaker) and 6km for the walkers had been laid. The trail went inland through small bushy trails, into quiet roads and onto small coastal trails. It was indeed the best trail of the weekend. A circle followed led by the hosts who ended up getting upstaged by the Nairobi hashers as more songs were demanded including 'Singing in the Rain' when it wasn't raining which led the heavens to open at the end of the circle and a wet end to a great weekend of hashing in Mauritius.



019 Calendars show the date 20 March, as being a Full Moon event. by Neil Campbell "Tumbling" Bill Panton 1927 - 2019

Bill Panton, known more affectionately as 'Tumbling Bill', was first posted from United Kingdom to Kuala Lumpur in 1953 when Malaya (as it was then known) was under British Administration. Along with many other government servants, he was billeted in the bachelor's quarters behind the Selangor Club, known colloquially as the 'Hash House' as a result of the frequent appearance on the menu of 'Corned Beef Hash', a stew of salted beef and potatoes. He was naturally invited to run with the Hash House Harriers, amongst whom

was Cecil Lee, one of its original founders. He first ran with 'Mother Hash' in 1954, but subsequently joined as a full member in 1958.

Malaysia, as it became known after gaining independence from Britain in1956, began to reduce reliance upon her former colonial advisors and experts and eventually Bill took up an appointment with the World Bank in Washington DC where he founded the DC Hash on 23 May 1972. A spell with the World Bank on a posting in Thailand resulted in his founding the Bangkok Hash House Harriers on 11 June 1977.

Upon retirement in 1992, Bill returned to his former home in Kuala Lumpur with his wife, Raja Aishah, cousin of the late Sultan of Selangor. Unfortunately, Bill was not able to enjoy retirement to the full as his wife passed away shortly after their return. This caused him to focus his mind elsewhere – to the establishment of the Hash Genealogy Project, which he subsequently dedicated to Raja Aishah.

In early 1994, Bill could be seen with a large sheet of white paper laid on a glass topped table on his balcony, with a pencil, ruler and eraser, busy adding new hash chapters to an enormous family tree and constantly rubbing out and adding connecting lines to these chapters.

For the 60th Anniversary of the Hash House Harriers at Interhash 98 in Kuala Lumpur, the first publication of the Hash Family tree was presented to the world. It had been prepared with the assistance of Mike Lyons and his trusty 'Mac', and showed the relationship of some 1,000 Hash chapters to the original 'Mother' Hash in Kuala Lumpur.



At the same time, aware that making these data available for wider consumption would be essential, Bill enlisted the aid of Neil Campbell to adapt the genealogy data to a more friendly format for presentation. Consequently a lengthy roll of 'A0' plotter output was put on display in the Merdeka Stadium at Interhash '98. The display generated considerable interest, and lead to a flood of information being received from all over the Hash World. A later copy of this chart is still on display in the 'Hash Room' of the Royal Selangor Club in Kuala Lumpur. The last plotted version of the family tree was displayed at Interhash 2008 in Perth since with more than 2,500 Hash Chapters recorded, it became necessary to commit their details to the internet. A copy of the last printed version sits in a cannister in Kuala Lumpur, awaiting a suitable venue for display!

Another outcome of Interhash '98 was the formation of the 'Hash Heritage Foundation', established to: manage and develop hash archives; hold an exhibition for Interhash '98; and play a key role in rebuilding the Hash House. (The original Hash House was demolished to make way for a road). Bill was a keen promoter of the Heritage Foundation, which received a donation of land from the Malaysian Government on which to reconstruct a 'Hash House'. The picture above shows Bill with an architects drawing of one proposed structure. Right up to the end, Bill's prime ambition was to see the rebuilding of the Hash House, and a more fitting tribute to his memory could not be made than helping this become a reality.

Memorial runs for Bill have already been held in both Washington DC and Bangkok where donations have been received to this end, and a joint memorial run will be held on 29 September 2019 on the site of the proposed Hash House in Bukit Kiara, Kuala Lumpur. This event is being organised by Mother Hash; Petaling Hash; KL Harriettes; and the Royal Selangor Club Hash, all chapters in which Bill was a member. This will be administered by the Hash Heritage Foundation. An external, independent auditor has been appointed to ensure full accountability, with all details to be published on the website (thehashhouse.org) where further information can also be obtained.

Please contribute to these very worthy causes – both the rebuilding of the Hash House, and the continuing development of the Hash Chapter Family Tree (the 'Genealogy' page of the website) – as a tribute to 'Tumbling' Bill Panton's great achievements in the development and promotion of The Hash worldwide!


Mr Trump revealed recently how he liked to make his own models – of cardboard golf clubs.





A ustralia's cricket team has revealed it will take no chances when facing the fearsome fast bowling from England's Jofra Archer.


