News

Covid

Barbados

Peru

Fresno Clovis H3 (USA)

Joined **Fresno Clovis H3** early in their history and her enthusiasm has helped the kennel grow from single figures to 40 plus runners. A keen FRB, she found promotion to hash flash forced her to stay with the pack. Her competitiveness shows in a very impressive 7:03 for a Beer Mile.

A1 & A2

Ray & Jenny Miller

Rotorura H3 (New Zealand)

Key members of the 1994 InterHash Committee taking responsibility transport, food and drinks .

Abominator

Finn Haldorsen

Bergen H3 (Norway)

Was introduced to hashing in Indonesia by his father-in-law (the legendary *Balloon Balls*) and went on to found both **Newcastle H3** and **Bergen H3**. For several years he topped the Bergen all-time run list, being the first to 333 and 666 runs before being overtaken by *Foggy Glasses* who has crept 100 runs ahead in the race to 1500 hashes.

Accidental Tourist

Michael Chevalier

Los Angeles and Long Beach H3 (USA)

Born in Los Angeles, *Accidental Tourist* worked in cinematography and was involved in movie classics such as the 'Rocky' movies, 'Superman' and 'Heart-break Ridge'. He was a restorer of classic cars and a world traveller who joined numerous hash events throughout Southern California and the world. He died on trail in June 2006. *On On Accidental Tourist*

Ace

Howard Smythe

Port Moresby H3/Perth H3 (Papua New Guinea/Australia)

A veteran hasher who joined **Port Moresby H3** around the end of 1980. He later joined **Perth H3** and was their Joint Master in 1988. Cardiff was his 8th InterHash and he has been a regular at Pan-Asian since 1987. The PNG yearbook actually lists him as *Ace-Ankles*.

Acko

Craig Atkins

Hamersley H3 (Australia)

Achieved 1400 plus runs with **Hamersley H3**, where he served as GM in 1991.

Adams, William

Mother Hash (Malaysia)

Was On-sec of Mother Hash in 1953 and Joint Master in 1955. When not hashing he was noted for his long jungle hikes. Bill was killed on active service in Sabah. *On On Bill*

African Mule

Jimmy Leggett

Petaling H3 (Malaysia)

An American who started Hashing in Indonesia with **Soroako H3** 'many decades ago' and has been around the Asian Hash scene ever since. His hash positions include On-Sec of **Mother Hash** in 2002 and GM of **Petaling H3** in 2004.

Again

Estienne Amdt

Jo'burg H3 (South Africa)

Was co-founder and long serving GM of **Jo'burg H3**. Was also on the first ever **Jacaranda H3** run in nearby Pretoria.

Ah Pek

Michael lee

Mother Hash (Malaysia)

A long term member of **Mother Hash** and considered one of their best ever short cutters.

Ahmed, Aji?

Brunei H3

One of the first locals to join the Brunei hash. He was on his 453rd hash by the time of the kennel celebrated its 1000th run (ranking 6th at the time). He set the famous 563 hash, 'the run itself was not so unreasonable except for the fact that the entire hash got lost.'

AhPisto

Ian Browning

Creek H3 (UAE)

An Australian and long term veteran of the Dubai hash scene. Before leaving the country he had clocked up a record 1200 runs with **Creek H3** (placing him second in their all-time chart) and over 800 with **Desert H3**. He avoided being GM of either hash due to work commitments but was the Creek Hash Cash for many years. A sign of his sharp Australian wit was the habit of wearing a Creek t-shirt in Desert circles. Now hashing with **Gold Coast H3**.

AIDS

Adrian White

Perth H3 (Australia)

Has been running with **Perth H3** since 1978 and was Joint Master in 1997, On-Sec in 2000 and finally GM in 2002. His hobbies include an interest in vintage motorcycles. The name comes from his work as a funeral director.

Aint Ze Bush (Bushy)

Aruna Gunawardena

Colombo H3/ Lilongwe H3 (Sri Lanka/Malawi)

Started hashing with **Colombo H3** and was also GM of the Harriets. From there he went on to be Joint Master of **Yangon H3**. Most recently Grand Master of **Lilongwe H3**. Works in business development.

AKU

Alfred-Kurt Zuber

BaghdadH3/Frankfurt H3 (Iraq/Germany)

A hash veteran who started running in Esfahan, Iran in the days when the Shah of Iran was still the Shah of Iran. After a short break in Taipei, AKU returned to the Middle East, spending the next seven years in Iraq. After running with **Baghdad H3** and **Babylon H3**, his work as a project manager and railway engineer took him to the more remote area of Baiji where he founded the **Ashur H3**. Returning to Germany in 1987, he was joint founder of **Frankfurt H3**. Within a year AKU was back overseas, hashing in **Dar es Salaam** from 1988-1993 and **Korea** from 1996 to 2001.

Alex the Arse

Haikou H3 (China)

A founder of **Haikou H3**. He was present at the initial founding meeting in the Windmill Bar and headed the first committee.

Ali Wank Bonk

Richard de Wit

Stockholm Absolut(Sweden)

Ali Wank Bonk is one of those traditional development practitioners who has done 100+ runs through long-term postings in Dhaka, Hanoi, Harare, and Dar es Salaam. His name was acquired in Dar es Salaam and is pronounced to sound like the mosque call. He has been settled in Stockholm for several years and has recently been elected GM of the **Stockholm Absolut H3** (considered the senior hash in the city).

Alice

North Hants H3

A regular **North Hants** hasher and a great traveller who is approaching 80 countries and ranks in the top ten of *Where Have you Hashed*.

Alouette

Neva Higgins

Fire and Ash H3 (Iceland)

Alouette and her husband *Wild Bill* Higgins started the Icelandic **Fire and Ash H3** around 1995. It was based on the US Air Base and the kennel folded after a short lifespan.

Alum, John

Brunei H3

On April 28th 1979 John Alum became a Hash legend when awarded the world's very first hash shit for setting a particularly poor trail with **Brunei H3**.

Ambler, Jim

Kota Kinabalu H3

Co-founder and hare on the first run of the **Kota Kinabalu H3**.

Amblin, Anna and Geoff

Surrey H3/Nassau H3

Were early members of **Surrey H3** but employment as a water engineer meant they were soon off on their travels never to return. First stop was Bahamas, on an 18-month water project, where they founded **Nassau H3**. They now live in Australia and run/walk with the **Sydney Thirsty Hash**.

Ambrose

Tony Erswell

Bangkok H3 (Thailand)

Tony came to Thailand, from Indonesia, in 1973, arriving on a motorbike. According to the local magazine *Outpost* 'Tony is in managerial research and likes a glass of beer or two.' He joined **Bangkok H3** on Run 8 and is now on 1300 plus runs. In his younger days he regularly topped the yearly run and/or haring totals. He first joined the committee in 1988-89 as On-Sex and was the Grand Master in 1990-91. He is still remembered for a trail in 1986, when he arranged a boat to take the pack across a river to the start off the run. When no boat turned up the pack asked, 'please tell us you didn't pay the boatman in advance?'

Amnesia

Iain Belton

Bicester H3 (England)

Has hashed with **Bicester H3** since 1976, holding all the mismanagement positions at least once, and 'at various times, cocking them all up!' A noted Hash historian, he hunted down Gispert's birth certificate and exposed the Bordighera hoax. He has also been a central figure in Bicester's fund raising projects for troops returning from Afghanistan.

Anapurna

Megan Magee

Dhaka Mixed, Taipa Macau H3 (Bangladesh)

A Canadian and a teacher with a powerful personality who in a short hash career has been GM of both the **Dhaka Mixed Hash** and **Macau H3**. She also arranged and fought in the first ever female boxing bout to be staged in Macau. She acquired her hash



name of **Anapurna** on an away trip to Nepal where her silhouette was thought to resemble the distant mountain range.

Animal

Gary Joyce

Jebel H3 (Oman)

Joint founder of the **Jebel H3** in Oman and later a member of **Dharan H3**.

Anthrax

Paul Marshall

Broken Hill H3 (Australia)

Completed 21 years Hashing with **Broken Hill H3**.

Antonie, Valerie

KL Harriettes (Malaysia)

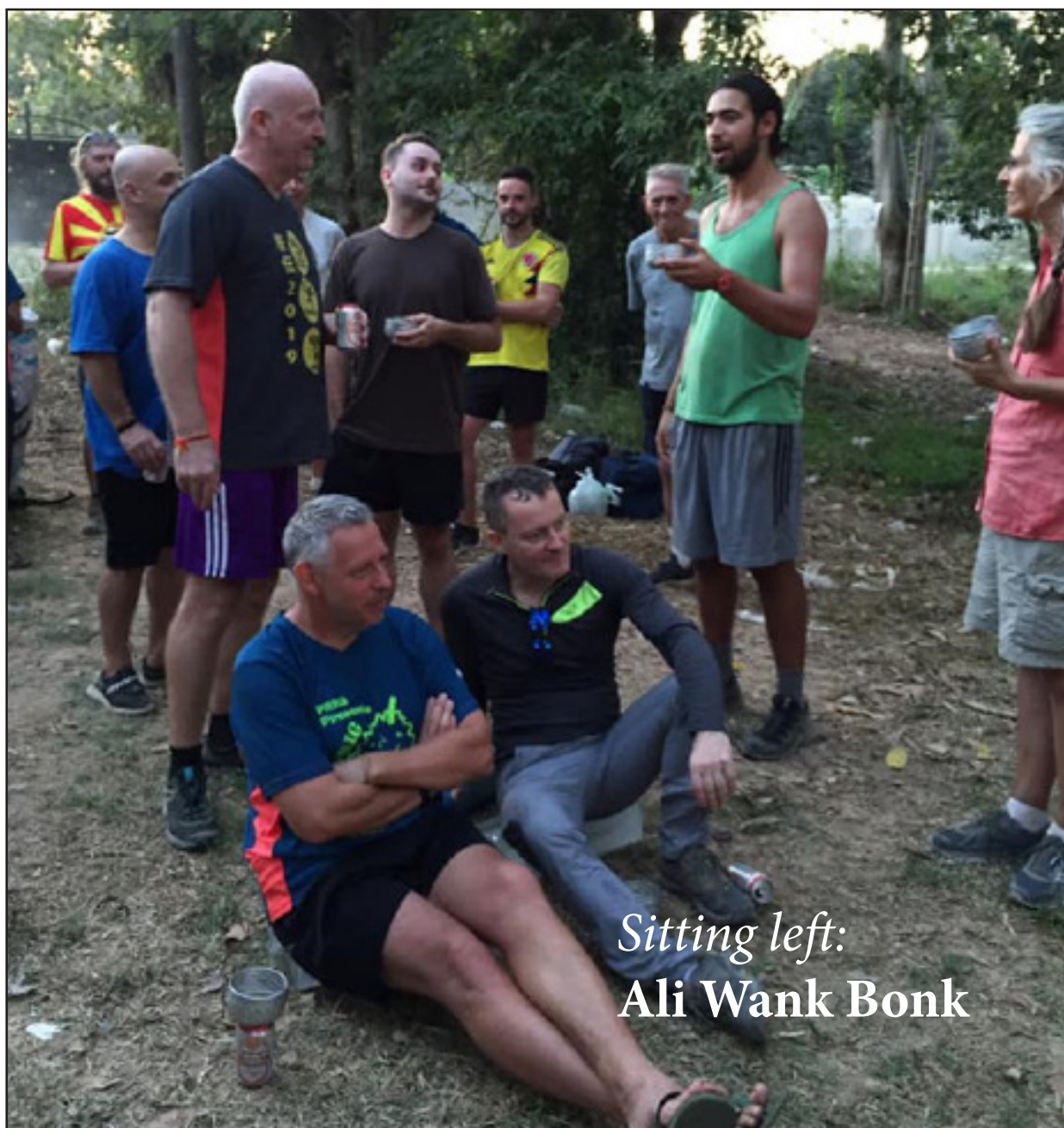
One of the few Harriette's at the early InterHashes. She continued to hash for many years and was On-Sex at 1996 Nash Hash and a member of the 1998 InterHash committee.

Arfa*uck

Nick Storr

Manila H3, Bicester H3 (Philippines/England)

Nick discovered hashing in Manila in the early 80's and was one of the led hares when InterHash was held there in 1990. He returned to the UK, becoming a regular with **Bicester H3**, although his work as a consultant gave him the opportunity to hash around

the world. He was persuaded to write his memoirs, which were published under the title of 'Ten Times the Price of a Haircut' *'a typically spicy and irreverent view of the expat life in the third world.'* The book contained a few references to Hashing. Long before he became a Hasher, Nick won a place in the Guinness Book of Records for visiting all the stations on the London Underground in a record time. Ar-fa-*uck died in June 2002, aged 57. *Thanks to Bicester H3 website.*

Argue

Wayne Quarrell

Hobart H4 (Australia)

One of four Hobart hashers with over 2000 runs and a veteran of the Hobart InterHash committee of 2000. He was an enthusiastic hare and between 2000 and 2004 the trio of *Bibby, Dicky* and *Argue* were 4-time consecutive winners of the Best Hard Trail

Award. He has taken on various committee positions over the years but managed to avoid a spell as GM until 2004-5.

Arn-Arn

Wayne Dyas

Hobart H3 (Australia)

Completed 1500 runs with **Hobart H3** in 2016. He has held numerous committee positions including Grand Master, On-sec and Cash.

ASH

Bryan Stringer

Madrid H3 (Spain)

ASH joined the **Madrid H3** in 1994, and clocked up 760 runs with a commendable 194 Hares. Over the years he served as GMH, RA, Scribe, MOM. He was the inventor of the Gorilla Run (19 kms waist-deep through rivers anyone?) and co-organiser of several

Pan-Iberian Hashes. *‘Perhaps more importantly, he was the standard-bearer for the traditional Hashing values of yore and was the mentor of many of our past and present Hashers. He was and remains a MH3 legend.’* On 12 March 2017 ASH collapsed while on a shortcut while just 100 meters from a beer stop. *On On ASH*

Armadillo Dundee

Barry Jarvis

San Antonio H3 (USA)

Founder of the **San Antonio H3** and GM of the 1991 American InterHash. The Hash Founders website notes that Barry passed away in 2013.

On on Armadillo.

Arnold, Frank

Fort Eustis H3 (USA)

A British army officer who hashed with Ray Thornton at Longmoor. He went to Fort Eustis where he helped found the first Hash in the USA.

Artis, Warwick

Hong Kong H4

Hong Kong GM in 1972/7. Described in the year book as *‘oversexed for an Australian’*.

Automatic Balls

Jürgen Schreiter

Frankfurt H3/Vineyard H3 (Germany)

After many years as a serious runner, AB stumbled across hashing in 1999. One run with **Frankfurt H3** was enough to convince him that he had found a new life-style. He became a steward member of the German hash scene and in 2000 set the first **Vineyard Hash**. He also organized the infamous **Vodka Train Hash**, a journey from Moscow to Beijing with hashes at every stop.

Awful Evil

Tony Whitbread

Broken Hill H3 (Australia)

Completed 23 years Hashing with **Broken Hill H3**.

Babe Thruster

Hash Cruises

Babe Thruster started hashing in 1992 with the **Gold Coast H3** in Mobile, Alabama. He has combined his love of hashing with a taste for cruise holidays to organize several Hash Cruises.

Babylon

Geoff Cook

Hobart H3 (Australia)

Has clocked up 1500 runs with **Hobart H3**. This included a spell of 650 consecutive runs. That is about 12 years without missing a hash!

Bad Bastard

Bob Williams

Port Harcourt H3 (Nigeria)

One of the founders of **Port Harcourt H3** back in 1986. He had previously hashed in Asia, possibly with **Miri H3**.

Bad Mouth

Mike Gilby

Cheshire/High Wycombe (England)

Clocked up some 200 hashes with **Cheshire H3** before moving south, where he and Gill Bossy Gilby founded **High Wycombe H3** (March 1991). *Bad Mouth* was still the High Wycombe’s GM when he died while on trail in April 2004. *On On Bad Mouth*.

Bad Penny

Emila Hopgood

Buenos Aires H3 (Argentina)

Emilia *Bad Penny* Hopgood and John *Hopeless* Hopgood restarted the **Buenos Aires H3** in April 1993.

Bad Pitt

Lennart Svensson

Stockholm H3 (Sweden)

Lennart *Bad Pitt* Svensson is a regular hasher with **Stockholm H3** and professional actor who has appeared in numerous films and TV series as well as spending 30 years working in Stockholm’s City Theatre. You can, for example, see him in ‘The Bridge’ and he gets his own page on the Swedish Wikipedia!

Badger

Mark Erwin

Prague H3 (Czechoslovakia)

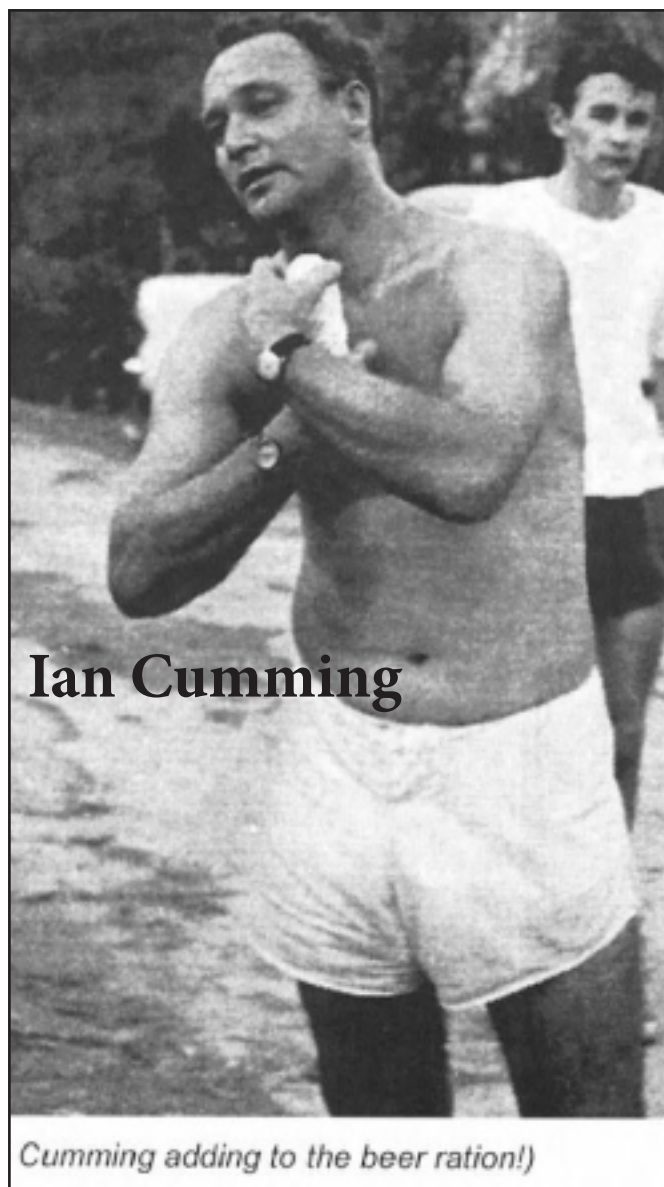
Badger worked for the American Embassy and was one of the key members of the early days of the **Prague H3**. He was one of the organizers of the 100th run and has been described as *‘the ultimate Prague mega-Hasher’*.

Bags

Bill Hetherington

Jamacia H3

Bags joined *Nut Case* in founding **Jamaica H3**, setting the first run from the Caymans Golf Course.



Ian Cumming

Cumming adding to the beer ration!)

Bald Eagle

Yangon H3 (Burma)

A key member of the **Yangon H3** in the 'bad old days'. *Bald Eagle* was out reconnoitring a trail when he had a 'confrontation' with one of his military intelligence 'minders'. Rumours are sketchy, but a hash dog might have been intimidated, and this might have led to some mild (mild?) pushing and shoving. The hash that week was postponed.

Baldrick2Dogs/Balders

Alan Holden

Various Arabian hashes

Manchester born, Alan studied electrical engineering and mechanical engineering. He moved to Kuwait in 1995 and spent most of his working life in Arabia. He was joint founder of the **Kuwait Full Moon H3** in 1996 and the **Doha Nightcrawlers**. He is known by numerous other canine variations of the Baldrick name. Recently retired to Penang.

Balloon Balls

Stein Lundeby

Bahrain H3/Washington H3 (Bahrain/USA)

Balloon Balls is one of the all-time great hashers. He started with **Bahrain H3**, where he was GM (1978-80). He played a major part in organizing the first Intergulf Hash and designed the famous Bahrain logo. *Balloon Balls* went on to found **Kalahari H3** in Botswana. He then hashed in Java with **Semarang H3** and **Bandung H3**. In 1990 he moved to the USA, and is still a member of **DCH3**. *Balloon Balls* has started a hash dynasty, with his daughter and son-in-law founding **Newcastle H3** and **Bergen H3**.

Ballpoint

Central Coast H3 (Australia)

One of the 'magnificent five' who has attended every Australian Nash Hash. He is the author of an excellent history of this event. A member of **Central Coast H3**, where he has clocked up 1300 runs.

Ball Wrinkle

Various USA hashes

Was raised in Ohio and first hashed in the summer of 1992, in Rochester. After hashing with **Flour City H3** and **Buffalo H3** for 5 years he moved to New York state where he hashed with **Ithaca H3**. *'The runs were stunningly beautiful. Stony gorges cascading with water, wet, lush, verdant foliage, and wild flowers'*. By 2008 he was in the San Francisco Bay Area, where he hashed with various kennels.

Bambie

Bill Barbee

San Jose H3(Costa Rica)

In February 1979 Bill *Bambie* Barbee joined Ian Hung Young in founding **San Jose H3**. He helped to organize the 1995 Inter-Americas, where the programme listed him as having competed 249 of San Jose's first 313 hashes. He was one of the few veterans who rejoined the committee when Inter-Americas returned to Costa Rica in 2003.

Band-on-Bob

Bob Browning

Cape Town H3 (South Africa)

Founded **Cape Town H3** in 1980

Banger

Ken Darn

Hobart H3 (Australia)

Completed 1000 runs with **Hobart H3** in 2002, 1500 2012 and added another 70 plus with the **Full Moon H3**. Was Hobart GM 1988-89 and sat on the Hobart InterHash committee. Is recognized as the official

hash historian of the kennel.

Bankrupt

Adian Baron

Budapest H3 (Hungary)

First hashed in 1979 in the jungles of Brunei when the hash gave him the chance to escape the closed world of the Shell community. Since then his work as a banker (hence the hash name) has taken him around the world including Oman, Hong Kong (1982-84) Al Ain (then a remote corner of the UAE), Cittagong in Bangladesh, Semarang in Indonesia, Bahrain, Qatar and Egypt. There was a long spell in St Lucia where there was no hash but *Bankrupt* managed a few regional visits. In recent years he has settled in Hungary where he is a long term RA on the **Budapest H3**, a spell that has seen the average pack size increase from 4-5 to 25-30.

Ban The Cock

Le Hague (Netherlands)

A Dutch hasher who has hashed in 49 countries.

Barbee Doll

By 1997 *Barbee Doll* was one of five hashers who had attended every American interhash.

Barefoot

Jim Palmer

Medan H3 (Indonesia)

A key member of **Medan H3** in the kennel's early days. He organized the first of their famous anniversary runs at Lake Toba. *Barefoot* was killed in a plane crash. *On On*

Barnacle Bill

Guernsey H3 (Channel Islands)

A Guernsey hasher credited with being the first to use the Crapaund name. (It means donkey and became the symbol of the kennel).

Barnard, Paul

Mother Hash (Malaya)

Secretary of Mother Hash in 1967 and Joint Master in 1968.

Barratt, John

Mother Hash (Malaya)

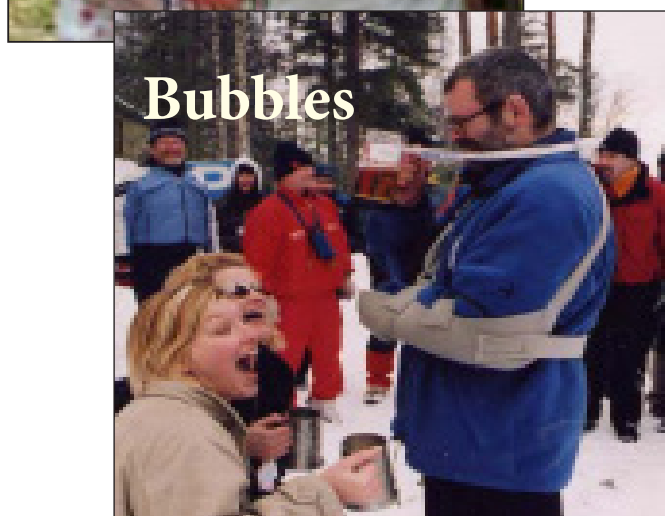
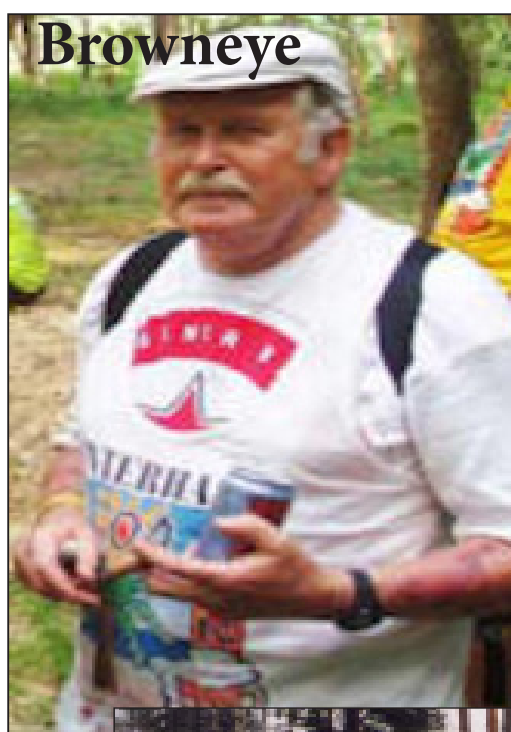
An accountant in KL before the war and one of the handful of hashers on Mother Hash Run Number 1.

Barrel

John Ford

Istanbul H3/Ordu Karadeniz H3 (Turkey)

Barrell and wife Ayse *Noddy* Ford made a big con-



tribution to the early day of **Istanbul H3** with *Barrel* running 258 of the first 444 runs and setting 41 of them. His trials were noted for being long and hilly. He was a talented quiz master and an expert on Istanbul pubs. The couple later retired to the Black Sea where they formed **Ordu Karadeniz H3**.

Barrell

Graham Farrell

Hobart H3 (Australia)

Was co-hare on the very first run set on Australian soil. Went on to serve as GM, Joint Master and RA. A year book described him as 'a professional Welsh-man.'

Beancounter

Kampala H3 (Uganda)

Between 1994 and 1995 *Beancounter* recorded 100 consecutive runs with Kampala H3.

Bear, The

Alex Thomas

Petaling Jaya H3, PJ Hazards (Malaysia)

The Bear was a legend in Malaysian hashing. Alex

started hashing in Penang H3 in the early 70's when *Nick the Turd* was the Grandmaster. That first experience got him hooked on hashing. He then moved to Kuala Lumpur and since **KL Hash House Harriers** was not taking new membership, joined **Seremban H3**. After a couple of years his enthusiasm started to fade but in 1977, together with Toda and Allan Chee he founded the **PJ Hash House Harriers Animales**. *'Bear came into full bloom where he shone as its first and long serving GM. He was a star on the box with his wit. His life then centred around hash.'* The Animales runs got tougher and longer, Bear's attendance declined but in 1991, he became a reborn hashman when he founded **PJ Hash House Hazards**. He was the first Grand Hazard and today the Hazard movement has become international, having expanded to 13 chapters in Malaysia, Indonesia and China. In 1996, he was instrumental in forming the Malaysian Hash Council and was elected Chairman. Bear innovated hash circle rituals, created many hilarious punishments. His early demise robbed the Hashing world of a 'true blue' hasher. *On On The Bear*.

Bearpark, Andy

Harare H3, Baghdad H3 (Zimbawe/Iraq)

One of three hashers who completed the first Harare hash back in 1984. Founder Sue Swain described him as *'portly but carrying jogging shoes'* when she first saw him in the British High Commission. He went on to have a distinguished career, including serving as Private Secretary to Margaret Thatcher. Later in his career Andy was Director of Operations and Infrastructure for the Coalition Provisional Authority (CPA) in Iraq. He is listed as a founder of **Baghdad H3**.

Beaver Bam Bam Balls

Scott Kanzelmyer

Nittany Valley H3 (USA)

While in college he performed with the Penn State Blue Band, marching with the band during football games in front of over 100,000 people and once at the Sugar Bowl. He also run track and cross country in high school and first hashed with **Nittany Valley H3** in October 1988. The hash helped him rediscover the fun in running and he has now hashed on every continent with the exception of Antarctica. His achievements include performing a solo skit in front of 6,000 hashers at the KL InterHash and meeting his wife, *Low Beams* on the hash.

Beavon, John

Hong Kong H4

Started hashing with **Singapore H3** and was an

important figure in taking hashing to Hong Kong. He laid the first **Hong Kong H4** trail and served as their second GM. Sometimes known as 'Mr Puberty' (the First Hare. Geddit?). Ran a local company called Outboard.

Beckerley, David

Yaoundé H3 (Cameroun)

Was the founder of **Yaoundé H3** (Cameroun) in 1986.

Beddows, Chris

Mother Hash (Malaya)

One of three hashers, along with John Duncan and Guinness Khoo, who were out all night on Run 3002.

Bedsore

North Shore Hussies (New Zealand)

Clocked up over 1322 runs with the **North Shore Hussies**.

Beep Beep

Vinod Reddy

Madras H3 (India)

One of the senior Indian hashers whose hash CV includes being a founder of **Madras H3** and the last 'survivor' to have attended every Indian Nash Hash.

Beep Beep

Christchurch H3 (New Zealand)

Number 2 on the **Christchurch H3** (New Zealand) run list with 1010 hashes to his credit. Currently serving as hash dray and still doing his share of setting trails.

Beer Bra

German hashes

Beer Bra comes from a hash family and was handing out the beers on **Munich H3** long before she was old enough to drink one herself. She has matured into a senior member of the German hash community and was still handing out the beers, whether at her local hash or at German Nash hashes. Was joint founder of **Rhine Neckar H3**.

Beerhound

Paul Gallagher

N'Djamena H3 (Chad)

Started his hash career in Lagos in 1999, where he clocked up a hundred or so runs and was most noted for being Deputy Master of Music. He returned to the USA as a teacher and American Football coach and ran occasionally with the various DC Hashes. In 2003 he arrived in Chad, where he founded the **N'Djamena H3**.

Belgrano

John Baron

Old Coulsdon H3 (England)

Veteran of the **Old Coulsdon H3** with a record 920 runs to his credit.

Bell, Terrance

Hetero Hash (Brunei)

In 1985 Terrance Bell, who had just arrived from Malaysia, decided that Brunei hashing needed a mixed kennel. He hared, or co-hared, 5 of the first 20 runs and was to influence the **Hetero H3** throughout their early years. He had spells as Joint Master, RA and was the first Grandmaster when that post was created.

For many years the Terrance Bell Award was presented for the worst run of the year.

Belukar (Secondary Jungle)

Arthur Broome

Mother Hash (Malaya)

'The Colonel' records that Arthur Broome was nicknamed 'Belukar' or 'Secondary Jungle' in the 1950's. This might be the first record of a hash name, although it was more likely linked to his non-hashing hiking expeditions.

Bennett, Roland

Mother Hash (Malaya)

Roland *Torch* Bennett should be considered one of the four founders of hashing (along with Lee, Gispert and *Horse* Thomson). He worked as an accountant and is known to have travelled from KL to Ma-

lacca to visit his friend Gispert. While in Malacca he joined Gispert on some of the **Springett Harrier** runs, an experience believed to have inspired the founding of **Mother Hash**. *Torch* was on leave when the first Mother Hash runs took place, but on his return is credited with getting the group better organized. After the war he famously put in the war-damage claim for mugs and a tin bath. *Torch* left KL in the fifties and settled in Durban (South Africa). There is a note of him being guest of honour at the **Durban H3** 10th anniversary party but no record of him ever running with them.

Bent One

Gordon Benton

Brunei H3/Jakarta H3 (Brunei/Indonesia)

Gordon Benton was in Kuala Lumpur in the early sixties but his first love was rugby and he doesn't seem to have tried hashing until arriving in Brunei around 1965. He helped get the kennel restarted after it had closed during a period of political unrest and became the first **Brunei H3** hasher to reach 100 runs. He once got lost while reconnoitring a trail and was out in the jungle all night. It didn't help that his maid was informing anxious friends that he had left for Singapore! A financial turn down saw him posted to Jakarta, where he jointly founded **Jakarta H3**. He spent a further spell hashing in Singapore before returning to Jakarta on, in his own words, 'a dodgy visa status'. *Bent One* finally retired in 2008.

Berwick, Colin

Brunei H3

Colin joined **Singapore H3** on some of their very first runs. In December 1962 rebels attacked police stations and other institutions around Brunei and he was part of the military contingent rushed across to the island. By the New Year the rebellion was over and the boys were looking for entertainment, so Colin Berwick, supported by 'Pip' Furse and David Hobby decided to set a hash. Berwick only managed three runs in Brunei before being posted back to Singapore. He might well be the man who thought up the H3 abbreviation. He later retired to Berkshire.

Biddy

Robert Badenuch

Hobart H3 (Australia)

A key member of **Hobart H3** since the early days, reaching 1500 runs in 2010 and still going. Was Joint Master in 1975-76 and GM 1985-86. Biddy has the honour of winning the 'worst run of year' award in 3 different decades and has on at least two occasions set trails that lost hashers. There are numerous firsts credited to him, including setting the first Partridge Island Run. Outside of hashing he was made a Member of the Order of Australia (AM) for his service to yachting and Australian Rules football.

Bif

Kate Glanville

Tamar Valley H3 (England)

A Tamar Valley hasher with 1288 runs to her credit. Was Joint Master back in 2001 and GM in 2016.

Big Bill

Bill Luekenhausen

Brunei H3

When *Big Bill* arrived in Brunei in 1980 he was already a veteran of the Jakarta and Singapore Hash scenes. He put in another twenty years of loyal running and drinking with **Brunei H3**, during which time he had a spell as both RA and Joint Master. When *Big Bill* died on trail, in September 2001, it was probably the way he would wish to have gone. *On On Big Bill!*

Big Brother

Göran Karnfält

Stockholm H3 (Sweden)

The elder of two hashing brothers, Göran started hashing in Lusaka (Zambia) in 1995 and on his return to Sweden joined the **Stockholm** hash. He has now completed over 900 hashes. While his younger brother (hash name: *Little Brother*) was the more noted

athlete, a 2.42 marathon runner, *Big Brother* became an equally enthusiastic runner, attending both hashes and races throughout Europe as he tried to break the three hour barrier for the marathon (best time 3.03.13 in Berlin). He and wife *Big Mouth* were always generous hosts to the hash and the annual hash from the family summer house in the Stockholm Archipelago is a popular event on the Stockholm hash calendar.

Big Country

Rich Roesing

Calgary H3/New Chisinau H3 (Canada/Moldova)

Big Country started the second part of his life in his early thirties when he was posted to Bulgaria with the American Embassy. It was not until he was transferred to Zagreb that he actually tried hashing. A move to Abuja – the new capital of Nigeria – followed and by the time the family reached Calgary they had all become fanatical hashers, with *Big Country* severing a spell as GM. A posting to Moldova in 2009 allowed *Big Country* to become a founding member of **New Chisinau H3**. He is noted for his height - tall people go up to him and say, 'you're very tall' - and his repertoire of hash songs. He continues to work for the US Department of State but has done little hashing since leaving Conakry in Guinea back in 2015.

Big Joe

Joe Kamau

Nairobi H3 (Kenya)

Big Joe recorded 800 runs plus with **Nairobi H3** including a successful spell as GM.

Big Mac

Walter Jamieson

Various Indonesian hashes

A former civil engineering consultant and later hotel owner on the Indonesian island of Lombok. His working and hashing life in Indonesia started with **Surabaya** (1981-1985). 1989 was spent in Jakarta and proved to be a remarkable hashing year with *Big Mac* clocking up 150 runs with the various hashes in just 12 months. He was one of the founders of **TGIF H3** and on the committee organising the first of the legendary Jungle Runs. After 209 runs in **Bangladesh** *Big Mac* was back in Indonesia, this time with **Malang H3**. In 1994 he moved to Lombok, where he founded the **Senggigi Old Boys H3** and was made Honourable Grand Master of **Lombok H3**.

Big Old Fart

Graeme Gibson

Nairobi H3 (Kenya)

Big Old Fart worked for the British High Commission. He already had postings to Nigeria, Zaire, Bulgaria, Bangladesh, the Netherlands, and Swaziland on his CV before being posted to Kenya. *Digit* once gave an account of a wild night out in Nairobi with BOF as guide. A shooting incident in 1996 left Graeme paralysed and he died in Stoke Manderville Hospital the following year. *On On BOF*

Big Shaker

Arnt Breivik

Oslo H3 (Norway)

Big Shaker is rumoured to have started his hashing in Mozambique and then arrived in Oslo via Rome. He was a very active hasher, who once went through a hash year with a 100% record of 52 runs. He also had 66 countries clocked on 'Where Have You Hashed'. *Big Shaker* passed away in March 2019, after doing 561 runs with **Oslo H3**. *On On Big Shaker*

Biggles

Trevor Wright

Bicester H3 (England)

Joined **Bicester H3** in the late 1970's, whilst a long haul pilot for British Airways. Once flew a plane load of Bicester hashers to Eurohash in Madrid. Was accused of having laid a trail by throwing the chalk from the rear of a 747. Since his retirement has moved out of the area and now only hashes occasionally.

Biggles

Wellington H3 (New Zealand)

Has clocked up an impressive 1900 plus runs with **Wellington H3**.

Biggles

Peter Flick

Teign Valley H3/Ashburton H3 (England)

By the 1980's Biggles was already a well established member of **Teign Valley H3** and '*the hashing guru who everybody looked up to*'. His name probably came from wearing an RAF style flying helmet in the circle. He was a founding member of **Ashburton H3** and was on the first **Otter Valley H3** run. In his younger days Biggles had run the London Marathon and later became involved in local orienteering. Biggles passed away on 3rd May 2017. *On On Biggles*

Biggles

Peter Goodwin

Kuwait H3

Was already a veteran of ten years in Kuwait, where

he was a pilot, when Iraq launched their invasion. He took part in the last Kuwait hash set a few days *after* the invasion and was then taken hostage. After the war he and wife Dorothy returned to Kuwait for two more years before retiring to the English village of Amersham.

Biggles

Palle Zych

Copenhagen H3 (Denmark)

Has clocked up 800 plus runs with **Copenhagen H3**, including being one of the few Danish hashers with 100 harings to their credit. Was co-founder of **Lyngby H3**.

Biggus Dickus

Dick Watts

Hong Kong

Known variously as *Biggus Dickus*, *Watt-a-Dick* and *Cranium*. He was one of the Hong Kong 'wanker-banker crowd' and held the prestigious position of GM of **Hong Kong H4** for the 1986/87 hash year.

Biggus Dickus

Dino Moreno

Chengdu H3 (China)

Chengdu H3 hasher who has helped organize several China Nash Hashes.

Bilo

Lyall Traynor

Melbourne H3

Started hashing in 1991 and has reached 970 runs with **Melbourne H3**. Was GM in 2002 and the only Melbourne hasher to be awarded the Jack Salmons Award (for undetected cock-ups in advancement of MH3 interests) twice.

Bimbo

Bruce Marks

Muscat Full Moon H3 (Oman)

After completing a few runs with **Wessex H3** he sailed on the HMS Exeter for her 1985 world tour. On leaving the navy Bruce found employment in Oman where he hashed with **Jebel H3** for the next two decades. He was also the driving force of the **Full Moon H3**, being the undisputed *Dick-tator* for 15 years. Bruce was a reasonable runner who was also a keen member of Muscat Road Runners. He spent his holidays heading to Asia for various hash events.

Bimbo

Jim Edens

Hash Publisher and World Hasher

Started Hashing mid-1980's in San Diego and be-

came a hash world traveller and publisher. For many years *Bimbo* based himself in South-East Asia. He launched the Harrier Magazine at Goa InterHash (2002) and continued publication for seventeen years, the record for any hash magazine. Now living in Hawaii.

Binks, Roger

Himalayan H3 (Nepal)

Roger Binks and Keith Robinson laid the first two Kathmandu trails in 1979. They remained active members of the hash through its early years with Roger acting as Joint Master for the first 75 runs.

Binny

Michael Kirkman

Launceston H3 (Australia)

Was one of the first 5 hashers to completed 1450 runs with **Launceston H3**. Was their GM in 1988.

Birdbrain

Brian Flint

Tornado Alley H3/ Munich H3 (USA/Germany)

A Canadian hash now based in Germany. In 1991 he moved to Toronto and discovered the hash via his gym. Got his name when he tried to make the trail more visible in the rain by mixing birdseed with the flour. In 1997 his work on Learjets took him to Wichita where he founded **Tornado Alley H3**. He is now based in Germany and is Hair Razor for **Munich H3**.

Birdman

George Scott

Boulder H3 (USA)

A key member of **Boulder H3** for many years and one of 5 hashers who was on every American Inter hash up until 1997.

Birdman

David Free

Tokyo H3 (Japan)

Birdman came to Tokyo via Kluang and although he missed Run Number One was on most of the first hundred runs. He continued hashing in Singapore and then Australia.

Birdman

Barney Bruce

Happy Valley H3 (Cyprus)

A former RAF man and a regular on various Cypriot hashes. Perhaps best known for his 500 runs with **Happy Valley H3** where he was the 12th GM.

Birdman of Oz

S. Perret

Hong Kong H4

Hong Kong GM 2006/07. *'An Aussie fighter pilot (or was that tailgunner? Ed), or so he claimed.'*

Birdtable

Auckland H3 (New Zealand)

The 2000 Interhash Ladies Drinking Champion. The current, and recently appointed NZGM who runs with the Auckland based **Woefull H3**.

BJ

Brian Tudor

Wirral and Chester (England)

Founder of **Wirral and Chester H3** where he clocked up (at least) 560 runs and 113 harings. Later moved to Sonthofen in Germany where he staged occasional weekend hashes to make up for the lack of a regular Kennel.

Black Head Clark

Clark, Gordon

Abu Dhabi Mainland H3 (UAR)/Bahrain H3

One of the founders of the **Abu Dhabi Mainland Hash** that broke away from the original **Island Hash**. Ironically the Island hash had just named him and his wife their hashers of the year! Gordon was later involved in the split in the Bahrain hash and became known as *Black Head Clark* on the **Bahrain Black Hash**.

Black Mail

Ted Lutley

Bahrain Black Hash

Co-founded **Bahrain Black Hash**. He hared the first two runs and completed 42 of first 50 hashes.

Mark Blacker

Manila H3 (Philippines)

Was a driving force behind Manila's initial bid to stage InterHash. As President of the American Chamber of Commerce in the Philippines he was an important figure in the expat community.

Black Peter

Olivier Van Lieshout

El Salvador

A founding father of the 3rd edition of the **Salvadoran Hash** in 1993.

Blackbollocks

Rohan Fernando

Colombo H3 (Sri Lanka)

Has clocked up 1300 runs on the **Colombo Men's Hash** where he is regularly on the committee, most

recently as GM and deputy RA. He has also clocked up another 300 runs on the Mixed Hash. Between runs *Blackbollocks* has found the time to build up a successful business career.

Bland, David

Baghdad H3 (Iraq)

A pioneer on the original **Baghdad H3** clocking up 82 of their first 150 runs.

Blessed Saint Stromin Norman

Norman Randall

Vindobona H3 (Austria)

A veteran of 1400 plus runs in Vienna where he has been given the honouree title '*GM Retired and Retarded*'. His achievement included 5 hashes in five days over the 2007 25th anniversary, setting several anniversary trials and organizing away weekends.

Blimey

Cor Schouten

Manniken Piss H3/ Helsinki H4 (Belgium/Finland)

Cor *Blimey* Schouten was once described as 'a Dutch diplomat of great Hash presence'. He has certainly made a major impact on European hashing, founding both **Manniken Piss H3** and later the **Helsinki Harriers & Harriettes**. *Blimy* also took hashing into Estonia for the first time by arranging weekend trips for the Helsinki Hash in 1993 and 1996.

Blind Pew

Nick Barrable

Stockholm Underground H3 (Sweden)

Blind Pew was a regular runner with **Stockholm H3** between 2000 and 2004. As a member of the British Orienteering Team, and with a best marathon time of 2.33, he was a nifty lad who was noted for setting long live trails from a couple of minutes head start. He spent a year and a half in Brno, Czech Republic, doing the odd hash in Vienna and Bratislava before returning to Kent and dabbling with the **East Grinstead H3**. By 2009 he had returned to his mother hash in Stockholm. In the autumn of 2009 he travelled to Australia where he won the Over 35's World Orienteering Sprint Race Championship.

Blitzkrieg

Wilmar Blick

Assen H3 (Netherlands)

An important pioneer of hashing in Holland. He joined **Assen H3** early after their foundation and be-came their 2nd GM. He climbed rapidly up the all-time run table, reaching 2nd place with 116 runs (out of 193) by the 5th anniversary of the kennel.

Bloating Bladder

Athens H3 (Greece)

In 2003 *Bloating Bladder* proposed to *The Dyke* on a hash coach. The following day **Athens H3** held an engagement ceremony in the circle on the beach.

Blob of Silverkin

Bob Silver

Kowloon H3 (Hong Kong)

GM in the early days of **Kowloon H3** and a regular on their first 150 runs.

Blobby

Adrian Ewart

Scarborough H3 (England)

First ran with **Scarborough H3** in 1963 from the Nags Head. *Blobby* is now on 1658 plus runs. He is a talented photographer.



William Scholl

Hasher and sub 2.15 marathon runner

Blocki, Jacek

Epsikopi H3 (Cyprus)

Jack fled Poland after the German invasion and served with honour in the RAF where he flew Wellingtons. He was awarded the Polish equivalent of the Victoria Cross for bringing his damaged aircraft home. He stayed in the RAF after the war, moving from flying to Air Traffic Control. His final posting was Cyprus where he took up hashing for the first time. Although already at the age where most hashers are thinking of retiring, he went on to complete 1585 runs with **Epsikopi H3**.

Bloodnok

Chris Lawrence-King

Tamar Valley H3 (England)

Bloodnok was a founder of **Tamar Valley H3**, one of England's senior hashes. He was a military man who discovered hashing in the Far East, 'Apart from saving us all from the ravages of the invading Mongol hordes, he embarked on a personal campaign to win the hearts and minds of the locals through Hashing and supporting the local economy by consuming industrial quantities of beer'. On returning to England he hired a hall and set up 100 chairs to hold a meeting that would found a local hash group. Only seven turned up but Tamer went from strength to strength and *Bloodnok* and his faithful Jack Russell, *Paxo*, continued to hash in their new home. *Bloodnok* was made a 'Life Peer' of Hashing' and made his last appearance on the committee in 1981. Now hashing in the great trail in the sky. *On On Bloodnok*

Bloody Ha Nai Hanoi (Vietnam)

A Swede based in Hanoi, he set the first run in the city back in 1987. The event brought the attention of the police and it was several years before anybody attempted a second run.

Blooper David Bloomer Bahrain H3

A hash veteran of Bahrain. *Blooper's* CV includes being curate way back in 1985 and GM as late as 2002. He got his name for making numerous mistakes on the local radio.

Blow Hard Asaf Boke Ankara H3 (Turkey)

Asif and wife *Twinkle Toes* have been members of **Ankara H3** for several decades. He is a noted hash horn and leader of the group singing of Father Abraham. Both have enjoyed distinguished non-hash careers, *Blow Hard* as an architect and artist, *Twinkle Toes* as a ballerina.

Blowfly Wayne Ogonoski Pattaya H3 (Thailand)

A Canadian born oil worker who first came to Pattaya in the late 80's and made it his home. He was a passionate golfer and an active member of the hash for many years with 300 plus runs to his credit.

Bob Funny Name for A Girl Bob Spencer Baku H3 (Azerbaijan)

Most recently running with Baku having previously hashed in Port Harcourt and Kuwait. He was hash cash in Kuwait and set up the KSHHH mail list. This was also where he was given his name.

Bold Fokker, Sir Hugo Le Hague H3

A senior Netherlands hasher who has clocked up over 1000 hashes with **Le Hague H3**. Also ranks in the top fifty of 'Where Have You Hashed'.

Boner Ron Haywood Melbourne H3

Has been running on the Melbourne Hash scene since 1981, with **Western Suburbs H3** his home Hash. He was GM in 1993 and has been on the committee 'on and off' for much of the last ten years. He

is also a familiar face on the **Lakeside H3** and **Melbourne Ladies H3**, reaching a lifetime total of 987 runs by April 2005.

Bonkers Colin Cracknell Zambia/Dar es Salaam

Trained as an engineer and then went to work for the European Union. His postings included Sudan, Zimbabwe and Tanzania. In Zimbabwe he was instrumental in establishing the Zim-Zam Hash and he finished his working (and possibly hashing career) as RA of **Dar es Salaam H4**. In Dar his EU mansion was venue to many a wild hash party. Wife *Delilah* has supported him through his working and hash career. His brother *Pete the Pilot* was corrupted into hash ways while visiting in Khartoum and is now a distinguished hasher in his own right.

Boob a Lube KC Marshment Thailand

Now settled into the Thailand hash scene after a hash career that started in 1988 and included Korea, Hawaii, Thailand, Singapore and the Philippines. Was GM of the **Yongsan Kimchi H3** in Seoul and the **Aloha H3** in Honolulu, and founder and ex GM of the **Makati Metro Manila H3** in Manila. His lifetime number of hash runs stands at around 4000 plus is the highest *confirmed* total in Hashingdom.

Boof Craig Robertson Hamersley H3

Has recorded 1,800 plus runs with **Hamersley H3**. Regularly on the committee since 1982 and GM in 2009/10.

Bookmaker Athens H3 (Greece)

Number two in the **Athens H3** rankings with 700 plus runs. Noted for setting long and complicated trials.

Boomer Gavin Graham Hobart H3 (Australia)

Passed 1000 runs with **Hobart H3** in 1999 and 1500 runs in 2010. By the 50th Anniversary he and Alan *Easy Rider* were the only survivors from year one. Had a popular hash dog called Ralph who has now sadly passed away.

Garry Russell

Launceston H3 (Australia)

Has completed 1200 plus hashes with *Launceston H3*. Was GM way back in 1984 and was still on the 2016 committee as hash cash.

Boots

Victor Bursa

Casuarina H3 (Australia)

Has a 1000 runs plus with the **Casuarina H3**.

Boskett, Dave

Bangkok H3 (Thailand)

Was on the first **Bangkok H3** run and continued to turn out with them for several years during which time he was On Sec and Joint Master. Was also on the committee of the British Club, who gave him a farewell dinner in February 1981.

Bouncing Cheque

Irene Brichta

Prague H3

Bouncing Cheque joined *Prague H3* in 1994 soon after east Europe started to open up. For many years she was a pillar of the Prague kennel and was founder of the **Once in a Blue Moon H3**. After 2014 her work for the Rotary Club started to curtail her hash activities.

Boweltrowl

Richard Holmes

Creek H3 (UAE)

A veteran of the Dubai hash scene primarily with the men's only **Creek Hash** where he has clocked up a record 1400 runs. Over the years he has fought an endless struggle to retain the traditional men only traditions of the kennel. He is hashing less these days but still turns up for the occasional run or the big occasions.

Boxkite

Darryl Kite

Sydney H3 (Australia)

Sydney H3 trail master in 1990-91 who was noted for setting 'interesting' runs. In 1990 he was winner of both the 'worse run of winter' and the 'worse run of summer' awards. Remembered for when he *'single handedly caused a ban on buses for hash runs.'*

Boy Blunder

Bahrain

Started hashing in Bahrain around 1986, where his parents *Long March* and *Short March* were hashers. He was originally named *Mummy's Boy*. He was one of the few Bahrain hashers to run with both groups during the period of animosity following the founding of the **Black Hash**. Rediscovered hashing in London, where he became GM of **West London H3** and was on the Eurohash committee.

Boyd, Chris

Mother Hash (Malaysia)

Chris Boyd is a long term resident of KL and was **Mother Hash** On Sec in 1978 and 1979 and a committee member for InterHash 1980. He worked as an architect and is now retired (or possibly semi-retired?). Was instrumental in coming up with the blue prints for the Hash Heritage House Museum.

Brechin, Graeme

Hong Kong

Hong Kong H4 GM for the year 2007/08. Described in their hash magazine as *'Our own Dear Leader who with his bouffant perm, boyish botox-enhanced looks, tailored running suits and elevated plimsolls is justly held as a living god throughout North Korea.'*

Bretag, Gorodn

Jebel H3 (Oman)

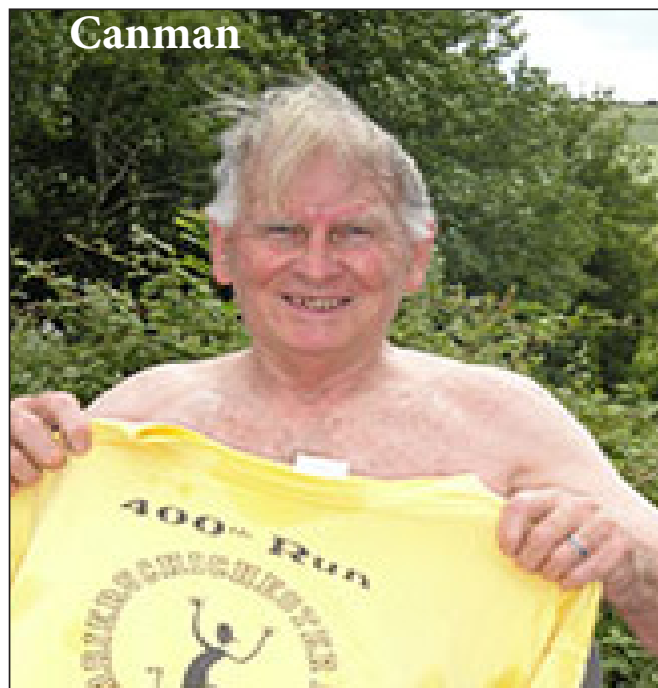
GM for **Jebel H3** between runs 350-400 when he was noted for giving out *'more hashshits than any other GM'*. He introduced ideas such as barbecues and bonfires which helped to bring a period of growth to the hash. Moved on to Perth.

Brewer

John Chew

Seletar H3 (Singapore)

One of the small group of hashers who founded **Seletar H3** in 1980. He completed 256 of the first 297 hashes (which ranked him 2nd in the run total at the time). Was long term beer master who pioneered the idea of a beer wagon.



Brewer, The

Charlie Tucker

Edinburgh H3 (Scotland)

A Scottish hash legend, having clocked up over 2000 runs with both **Edinburgh H3** and **TNT H3**. Has also laid more runs than any other Edinburgh Hasher. Created and manages the Edinburgh website. His hash name was given when he brewed 30 gallons of 6 different beers (as well as Slow Gin for the Harriets) for a New Year hash party.

Brig, The

Ray Thornton

Bicester/Dhekelia (England/Cyprus)

Ray Thornton was a high-ranking military officer and one of the great founders of modern hashing. He was introduced to hashing in Singapore in 1962 and over the next few years his military career took him to many of the world's trouble spots. In Borneo he co-founded **Kuching H3** and then moved to Cyprus, helping to found **Dhekelia H3** as the first Hash in Europe. Back in England he founded the **Commando Forces H3**, believing this to be the first Hash on British soil, although in fact *Mountain Rescue* had just beaten him to it. Although the Commando Hash faded out, 'The Brig' went on to found Bicester H3, now one of the strongest of the UK Hashes.

Brigadier The

Dhaka Mixed hash (Bangladesh)

The Brigadier, was a senior military figure in the Bangladesh army and a hero of the struggle for independence. He was also a passionate hasher completing a record 1336 runs with the **Dhaka Men's Hash**. He has sadly passed away but his family still invite

the hash to enjoy food with them at the end of the annual Victory Day Run.

Brigadier, The

John Breen

Hong Kong

A former HKH4 GM. The hash year book described him as *'A warm, kind, gentle soul to his friends (both), if also a loud-mouthed Irish xxxx to the rest of humanity. Banned from Ireland (which says it all, really).'*

Brinsden, Jim

Bangkok H3 (Thailand)

Set the first Bangkok hash way back in 1974.

Bristow, Alan and Joan

Aman H3 (Jordan)/Kuwait H3

Hash veterans of the Middle East. Contributed to the early days of hashing in Jordan and then moved to Kuwait where Alan was an early GM.

Bromfiets, Lord

Peter Rijnvis

The Hague H3 (Netherlands)

Recorded a record 1270 runs with **The Hague** where he was the GM from 2006-2009.

Bromley, Peter

Mother Hash (Malaya)

Mother Hash On Sec in 1972 and Joint Master the following year. Was hare on the 1500th run.

Brown Sugar

Rhona Imre

Ankara H3 (Turkey)

A long serving member of **Ankara H3**. In 2009 she became the first Ankara hasher to be voted GM for the second time. She now saves most of her energy for the circle and late night partying.

Browneye

Ian Brown

Casuarina H3 (Australia)

Has achieved over 1000 runs plus with **Casuarina H3**.

Browneye

David Ives

Indonesian hashes

After a military career that saw him reach the rank of Lieutenant-colonel, Browneye went into development work. He became a senior member of the Asian Hashing community, running with distinction in Borneo, Colombo, Jakarta and Dili (East Timor) as well as serving as a member of the Goa

InterHash committee. David will always be linked with Indonesia, where he ran with every kennel and was co-founder of **TGIF H3**. While in Indonesia his son, Duncan, was involved in a serious car accident. *'It was largely due to his fathers energy and love that Duncan made as much of a recovery as he did.'* Father and son retired to Geraldine, on the South Island of New Zealand. *Browneye* had a love for beer, whisky, cigars and sport and was always willing to give his time to help new hares set trails. *David Ives died in January 2007. On On Browneye*

Brrr

Austin H3 (USA)

First hashed in Dallas in 1995. This was on a very hot Texas evening with a run that went through a cactus littered landscape and it was a few months before she attended her second run. She then became a central figure on the **Dallas H3**. Now with **Austin H3**. A great hash traveller, her hash adventures include Chile, Europe and Mexico.

Brutus

Jim Ingram

Perth H3 (Australia)

Joined **Perth H3** on their 181st run and achieved 21 years of hashing with them in 1994.

Bubbles

Andreas Christiansen

Bergen (Norway) and Drifters H3

A maths teacher in real life, he runs with **Bergen H3** and is a regular traveller around the European hash scene. RA described him as *'the most recognizable hasher because has not changed in 40 years'*. Bubbles actually started hashing in Saudi with **Ryidada H3** in 1980. By 1998 he was in Bergen where he was given his hash name because he doesn't like bubbles in his beer. Remembered for requiring hospital attention at three different hash events. There was a fall at the Hole in the Ice Run in 2004 (a Norwegian who didn't realise snow was slippery). He then managed to break bones falling at EuroHash 2007 and with Mother Hash.

Buffalo

Bill Sutcliffe

Ankara H3 (Turkey) and others

Buffalo started his hashing way back in 1978 with the

Night Runners of Bengal (Bangladesh). His consultancy work took him around the world for the next four decades, including initial spells in Mali, Saudi and Malaya. In 1998 he moved to Ghana where he hashed with **Accra H3** and founded **Kumasi H3**. A short spell in England did not interrupt his hashing and Buffalo turned out with **Oxford** and **Bicester** before heading for Windhoek and a long spell of hashing in Turkey.

Bugs Bunny

Lennox Butler

Antigua H3

Founder and long term member of **Antigua H3**.

Bugs passed away in 2009 and was describe by friends as *'a human dynamo of energy and a dear friend.'* On On Bunny. Quote taken from Flying Booger's website

Bullett

Bob Boulter

Bangkok hashes (Thailand)

A major player in the Bangkok hash scene with 2196

runs (**Bangkok 1524, Bangkok Monday 672**). He was a noted Hash Music and GM of the Men's Hash in 1984. Also founder of the **Monday Hash** and co-founder of the bike hash. A noted squash player in his youth.

Bumble

Neil Thompson

Surrey H3 (England)

Considered 'hash royalty' with **Surrey H3** who he joined on Run Number 2. At the time he seemed more interested in the beer than the running but *'in more recent years undertook a Damascus conversion to a fairly upright member of society.'*

Bunbasher

Tony Baker

Porto H3 (Potugual)

Bunbasher became the fourth GM of **Porto H3** in 1999. Under his guidance Run 150 was celebrated by a weekend away trip, an experience repeated every 25 runs.

Bunter

Terrance Kavanagh

Cambridge H3 (England) IndoNostalgia H3

After 4 years in the RAF, *Bunter* undertook his first over-land trip, touring Asia. Further trips to other parts of the world followed but he was back in England in 1978 in time to help found **Cambridge H3**.

Soon afterwards he returned to Asia and spent a period managing the Beggar's Bush – the famous hash bar on Bali. In 1992 he went to work in the Falkland Islands, where he founded **Falkland H3**. On returning to England Bunter settled down and managed the St Radegund's Public House for the next 17 years. This tiny bar was full of character and became home to the **Cantabrigensis H3**. Bunter also restarted the famous King Street Run and was an enthusiastic member of the **IndoNostalgia Hash**. He was not always easy to get along with, but with a kind heart to those who got to know him. Bunter passed away in 2012. There will never be another hasher like him.

Burgess, Clive

Colombo H3 (Sri Lanka)

Started hashing in Hong Kong and went on to found **Colombo H3 (Sri Lanka)** in 1980.

Burnt Lips

Scott Lee

Oregon H3 (USA)

Lee's hashing career started at the age of 17 years. *'I was in Penang, Malaysia with my parents. Some colleagues of my fathers at the university where he taught asked my father to join the hash but he was physically unable to run so he suggested his son (me) to go'.* After 6 months of hashing in Malaysia Scott returned

home and in 1987 became a founding member of **Oregon H3**. He hashed with them for 20 years, including 10 years as GM. He has been awarded the title of Tyrant Emeritus.

Burnt Sox

Steve Royster

Mexico City H3 (Mexico)

Still fondly remembered for his spell as GM of the **Mexico City H3**. Moved to Washington, where his name regularly came up as organiser of Red Dress Runs. *Burnt Sox* had a distinguished professional career in areas of Diplomacy, Immigration and Law.

Burung

Jeremy Pigeon

Jakarta H3 (Indonesia)

Jeremy was co-founder of **Jakarta H3**, along with the more hash experienced Gordon *Bent One* Benton. Originally named *Bird Brain* he was later renamed *Burung* which means 'bird' in the Indonesian language. *'Burung went on to become a great hasher who could hold a circle in awe by his wonderful songs and stories.'* He held various mismanagement positions (his favourite being Master of Musique) and *'was a true gentleman well supported by his mug of beer and his pipe'*. Burung died at a very young age (40/41 years old in 1981/82?) and in his memory Jakarta Hash created an award called the "Jeremy Pidgeon Award" usually given to the last to leave the circle.

Bushbasher

Ian Mackay

Australian Hashes

Bushbasher completed 25 years of hashing in 2002. He was the founder of **Gladstone H3**, **Bribie H3**, **Son of Nigel** and **Noleen's Noggy H3**.

Buzby

Mark Haydon

Teign Valley/ Isca H3 (England)

A veteran of UK Hashing. He was a key figure behind **Teign Valley H3** staging Nash Hash '97, was on the Cardiff InterHash committee and acted as GM of the SouthWest Post-Ramble. His hash CV also includes being SouthWest On-Sec, GM of **Isca H3**, founder of the South Of Devon Anti-Lunar Light H3.

Bwana

Robert Martin

Abidjan H3 (Ivory Coast)

A three time GM of **Abidjan H3** during their golden spell of the late 1980's. He was a skilled organizer of events such as the annual Hash Ball. A newsletter of



the time described him as having 'overcome public outcry' to take up the position.

Bwana

Robert Walker

Nairobi H3/Matola H3 (Kenya/Mozambique)

Bwana had strong ties with Africa - he went to school in Zimbabwe - and enjoyed a distinguished career as a chartered accountant. He first hashed with **Mombasa H3** in Kenya and was then transferred to Italy where he founded **Milan H3**. While there, he investigated the story (myth?) of the Bordighera Hash. Bwana returned to Africa and by 2000 was in Mozambique, where he would become a long term resident. He founded **Matola H3** in 2003 and was their guiding light for many years. *Bwana died of malaria in May 2019. On on Bwana*

Letter C

Camel Jockey

Gani Maksud

Dhaka H3 (Bangladesh)

For many years *Camel Jockey* was a central figure on the Bangladesh hash scene where he ran with both the men and the mixed hashes. He was a long-term trail master who was probably a little too nice to do the job, as he ended up setting most of the runs himself! Has now relocated to Malaysia.

Campbell, Neil

Petaling H3 (Malaysia)

One of the declining numbers of foreigners still hashing in Malaysia. In 2017 he became **Petaling H3's** 40th GM.

Campbell, Tony

Hong Kong

Was on the first ever Hong Kong hash and set their 4th run.

Candyfloss

Jason Dyer

Yorkshire H3 (England)

Candyfloss has been present at numerous big hash events over the last two decades, often serving on the committee and usually offering his computer skills. In addition to his world travels (at one point he was 11th in the 'Where Have You Hashed' rankings) he has clocked up 500 plus runs with **Yorkshire H3**.

Canman

Robin Low

Chichester H3 (England)

Rob was born in Fife and studied at Aberdeen University, where he captained the boxing team. He then completed his national service on submarines and from there joined the colonial service. He started hashing on the Solomon Islands around 1973. On returning to England in 1983 his wife started a doctor's practise in East Sussex and Rob became one of the founders of **Chichester H3**. He spent four spells as joint Hash Master and was elected President for Life in 2015. An update from Spiderman noted that, '*Robin is still joining the hash but is not so agile these days.*'

Cans

Peter Edwards

Perth H3 (Australia)

Peter Edwards was present on **Perth H3's** Run Number 1 and was still running with them 30 years later.

After several years on the committee he became GM in 2003.

Can't Hound

Bill and Ubol Brenneman

Aruba H3

Co-founders of **Aruba H3** in 1981

Captain Condom

Basil Fraser

Hobart H3 (Australia)

Captain Condom started hashing with **Hobart H5** in 1997, finding the combination of beer and running the perfect mix. From September 1999 he was also regularly hashing with the newly formed **Chardon-nay H3**. InterHash 2000 was staged in Hobart and Basil helped to set one of the trails. He continued to hash with both clubs and achieved 1,000 runs with Hobart in September 2018, and 1,000 runs at Chardon-nay in September 2019. He is believed to be the first Tasmanian hasher to achieve 1,000 hashes at two different clubs. He has added InterHash in Chang Mai and Kuching to his hash record and was a hare at Nash Hash Australia in 2011. He continues to hash, but at 60 confesses to be slowing down a little.

Captain Crash

Charlie Cobb

Phoenix H3 (USA)

One of the original Phoenix Hashers. He loved flying and was known for his maverick style in the cockpit, receiving his hash name after surviving a plane crash. In May 1992, Captain Crash was taking off from the Arizona Municipal Airport when his aircraft malfunctioned and crashed just outside the airport fence. There were no survivors. Every year the Phoenix Hash honours his memory with a Memorial Hash starting from the impact site.

Captain Haddock

John Baber

Ikeja H (Nigeria)

An enthusiastic member of **Ikeja H3** during their early days. He joined them on run 67 and then completed 110 of their first 200 runs. In the same spell he was hare or co-hare on 18 occasions.

Captain Haddock

Richard Gard

Kirton H3 (England)

Has completed 1500 runs with **Kirton H3** in Devon. Kirton, by the way, is the local name for the town of Crediton.

Captain Kirk**Colin Frost****World hasher**

English born, but has spent most of his life travelling the world as an engineer in the oil industry. He started hashing in Indonesia around 1984 and went on to spend six years hashing in Brunei. A year running in Brisbane with the **Heterosexual Hash** was followed by four years of postgraduate work, when his hashing was limited to holidays. From there he moved to Maryland and he still has a particular fondness for the US style of hashing with the regular weekend trips into the countryside. He was Saudi based from 2003 and served as GM of **Jubail H3**. An InterHash regular since Tasmania 2000.

Captain Knockers**Nolene Shepherd****Sydney (Australia)**

A veteran of the hash circuit and, during the 1980s, one of the most famous Harriettes in Hashingdom. Called *Captain Knockers* for obvious reasons, she will always be remembered for her contribution to Sydney InterHash 1984, where she was the On-Sec. She is still hashing nearly 30 years later and now a member of the **Adelaide Harriettes**.

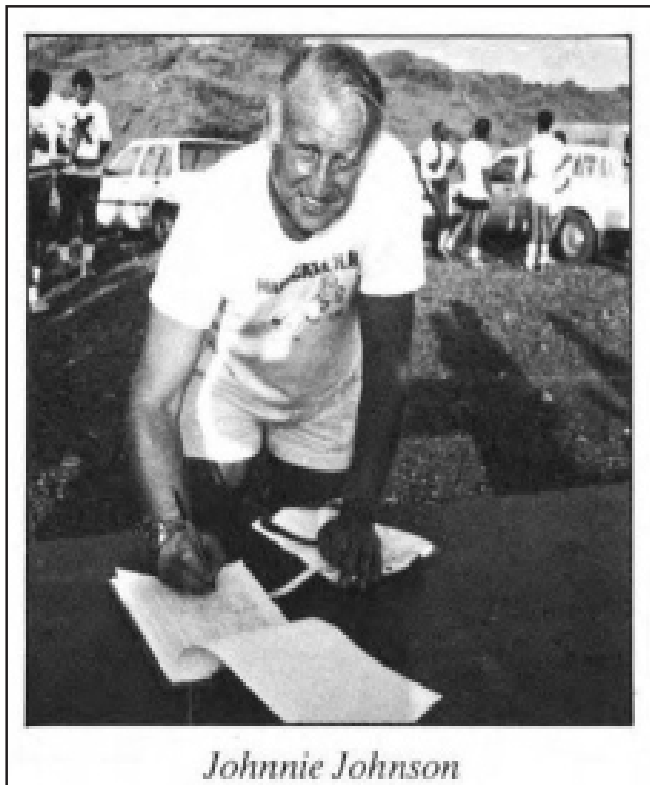
Captain Oates**George Whiteman****Scarborough (England) Larnca (Cyprus)**

Learnt his hashing in Hong Kong where he was founder of **Little Sai Wan**. On returning to England he founded **Scarborough H3**. He later moved to Cyprus where he founded **Larnaca H3** and later **Kiton H3**. Larnaca was initially dependent on staff from a large software project and when that closed down George *'carried Larnaca pretty well on his shoulders for some years until they built up a community of their own.'* On on Captain Oates!

Cap'n'Hook**Taipei H3 (Taiwan)**

A core member of the **Taipei H3**. Most famous for organizing the last hash through the red-light district of Peitou before it was closed down by the government. *'The organizer and hare was Cap'n'Hook, survivor of a thousand forays through every Red Light district known to man and sailor, from Birkenhead to Brisbane.'* According to the yearbook he was once said to have got into an argument with a Hong Kong bar girl because she wanted 150HK\$ and he insisted the price should be 200 HK\$. (Ed: Not sure I believe that story!)

Johnnie Johnson

Cap't Lewd

Jay Gore

USA Hashes

Jay *Captain Lewd* Gore, is a major figure in US hashing. He was a former **Washington DC** hasher who moved to Philadelphia where he helped to found **Philadelphia H3** in 1977. On moving to Houston he founded **Houston H3** (1979) and then **Pittsburgh** in 1980. Jay was a keen Rugby player, which helped bring in numerous new boots.

Cardinal Monk

Arthur Munkenbeck

Vindobona H3 (Austria)

A central figure on the **Vindobona** hash with over 1400 plus runs to his credit, which places him third on their all-time table. A flamboyant character, he once dressed in the full cardinal robes for a circle in the main square of Radtstadt. *Munk* is credited with initiating the idea of combining the Red Dress Run with the city's annual New Years Eve run around the Ringstraße.

Cardinal Sinner

Hugh Martin

Brighton H7 (England)

Has clocked up just over a thousand runs with **Brighton H7**. The name came from wearing a red cassock to a hash Christmas party and then being chosen to sit on a harriette's lap for a party act. A hasher who knows him well suggested that '*at one point he did a psychology course in an effort to understand women, but he failed the course!*'

Careless

Hursley H3 (England)

A total of 885 hashes puts him at the top of the **Hursley H3** run total list.

Carloss the Sex Tourist

Martin Clifford

Cheltenham and Cotswold H3 (England)

Started hashing in February 1992 with **Cheltenham and Cotswold H3** from the Fox Pub in Broadwell. Was named *Googlies* after 100 runs, but in 1993 switched alliance to **Gloucestershire Gourmets H3** and around 1995 was renamed Carloss. Is also a keen member of the monthly **MOH3**. He regularly hashes in Thailand and in 2001 it was decided that Carloss was too boring so he became **Carlos the Sex Tourist**. His lifetime total of hashes includes 500 with C2H3, over 1,000 with GGH3, approximately 175 with different Thailand hashes and some 150 with MOH3.

Carr, John

Hong Kong

Has the distinction of being on Hong Kong's Number 1 Run after which he disappears from the hash record.

Carter, Tim

Brighton H7 (England)

Tim was killed after being struck by a car while on a hash in May 2004. He was a local doctor and father of six. Outside of hashing he was a founder member of Lewes Athletic Club and a member of Lewes Squash Club. *On On Tim*

Catweaszle

John Meudell

Assen H3 (Netherlands)

Arrived in the Netherlands from **Kuala Belait H3** (Brunei) and was founder of **Assen H3**, the first hash in the country. Completed 28 runs before departing.

Catwoman

Sandi Power

Dayton H3 (USA)

Started hashing with **Emerald Coast H3**, Florida, in 1990 and then with **Dayton H3** from 1993. Now has 450 plus runs, placing her 9th on the Dayton run total list. Well known for her singing of bawdy and original songs at big hash events. In her non-hashing life she actually sings in a barbershop style accapella chorus.

Chai, KC

Mother Hash

A Mother hasher since 1969 and Joint Master way back in 1972.

Chairman Pastit

Wes Parfitt

Kowloon H3(Hong Kong)

Although Barrie Griffin is credited with being the man who came up with the idea of organizing a gathering of the world's Hashers in Hong Kong in 1978, it was Wes Parfitt who is considered the main organiser. He was already well established with **Kowloon H3** where he was a regular hare. The 1973/74 Yearbook describes him as '*sleeps ad lib, drinks ad hock and copulates ad naus – a genuine hasher*'.

Chalmers, John

Brunei

One of the central characters in the golden age of **Brunei H3**. Around 1974 he fell on a run and returned to the circle with thorns in his flesh. The wounds wouldn't heal and Chalmers eventually needed to go to UK for medical treatment. On his return he missed his connection in Dubai – according to hash legend because the airport bar stocked Tiger

Beer. The plane he missed (presumably flight G-AS-GR) was high-jacked and flown to Libya!

Champ, The

Seletar H3 (Malaysia)

The first Men's InterHash drinking champion in 1982. A member of **Seletar H3** who was on their organizing committee for the 25th Anniversary in 2005.

Chapman, Rex

Hong Kong H3

Was present on Hong Kong's first run.

Cheah, Charlie

Mother Hash (Malaysia)

Started hashing in 1979. Was Mother Hash On Sec in 1988 and Joint Master the following year. Was a noted good runner in the early days but slowed down after getting a pace maker fitted.

Cheap Bastard

Carl Broadman

Kuwait H3

An Australian of dry wit and wonderful beer brewing ability and a central figure on the Kuwait hash scene during their last golden period around 2000. The use



of his seafront apartment helped to make the southern neighbourhood of Mandraf a popular venue for hashes. Now back in Australia.

The wit of Cheap Bastard

'I hated 2nd grade, the worst three years of my life'

'My favourite sexual position is 68. That's when you get a blowjob and you say, thanks darling, I owe you one'

Checkpoint

Su Larque

Cambridge H3 (England)

A long-term member of **Cambridge H3** with 877 runs. Was grand mattress in 1995 and is credited with compiling many of the kennel's records.

Chee Bye

Allan Chee

PJ Hazards (Malaysia)

Allan Chee Bye Chee started hashing in Penang (1969?) and from there moved to Kuala Lumpur, where he joined **Mother Hash**, before finding that the slower pace of **Seremban H3** suited him better. With his belly growing as fast as his age he joined with *Bear* and *Toda* to form the **PJ Animals H3** in 1977. He later became the religious adviser of the **PJ HHHazards** and occasionally golfed with the **Hash House Hackers**. This long career has left him two main claims to fame: (1) He is one of three InterHash survivors who had attended every world gathering since the beginning. (2) He was a pioneer of breaking down barriers between expats and locals on the Malaysian hash scene. On retirement Chee Bye became heavily involved in mismanaging the Hash Heritage Foundation. (Chee Bye, by the way, is Mandarin for the female genitalia!) *On On Chee Bye*.

Chesney, Bob

Ras Al Khaimah H3 (UAE)

Bob Chesney is credited with being the founder of **Ras Al Khaimah H3**. Based to the north of the UAE it was the oldest kennel in the country.

Chesty

Rod Lovibond

Jakarta/Adelaide (Indonesia/Australia)

Started hashing in Assen in 1984 while working for Shell. He moved on to Jakarta, where he clocked up 300 runs over six years, including being on the infamous Hitler's Birthday Run. Moved back to Adelaide in South Australia in 1991 where he is currently on over 1100 runs with **Adelaide H3**. Was GM of the Adelaide Nash Hash that has been postponed to November 2021.

Chicken Fucker

Aminur Rahim

Night Runners of Bengal (Bangladesh)

A former merchant navy seaman and a long term member of the Bangladesh hash scene. Has clocked up over 600 runs with both the Men and the Mixed Hash.

Chicken Legs

David Currie

Brunei/ Kuwait/Bangladesh

Chicken Legs is a veteran hasher who is still a very fine runner. He started hashing in Brunei around 1977. From there he went on to hash in Kuwait, Bangladesh and various other places, as well as taking the opportunity to join **Sanaa H3** (Yemen) as a visitor. His favourite hash events include The Abu Dhabi Annual Rehydration Run.

Chickenman

Philadelphia H3 (USA)

Chickenman is a well known figure on the US hash scene, running with **Philadelphia H3** from 1979 to 1997. He had spells as On Sec and Joint Master before stepping up to the GM role in 1996. He attended 12 of the first 13 American InterHash events and was on the organising committee in 1987. He continued running with **Sir Walter's H3** (Raleigh, NC) where he was Joint Master between 2002-2006.

Chin, Joseph

Brunei H3

A senior member of the Brunei hash scene. He joined the men's hash in 1975 and clocked up over 2000 runs with them. Was listed in 'Half a Mind', as one of 24 Hashers who had attended every Interhash between 1978 and 1986.

Chin Yew

Mother Hash (Malaysia)

Joint Master 1987. He was a hiking enthusiastic, noted for making regular climbs of Mount Kinabalu.

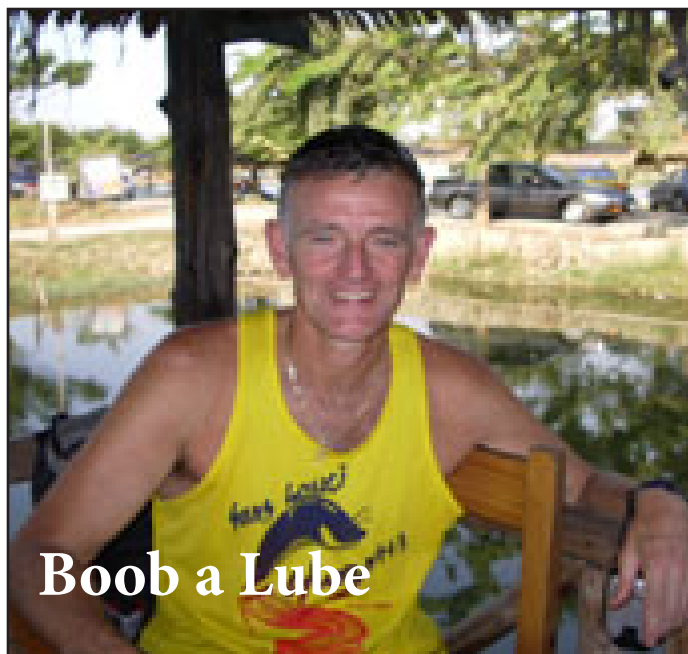
China Brush

Francie J. Ammon

Barbados H3

Started hashing in 1996. She was based in New Hampshire but had to travel to Boston to find the nearest hash. When she took her turn to set a Boston trail it might have been the first ever hash to take place in New Hampshire. A Trini (Trinidad) by birth she moved to Barbados and was renamed China Brush (a herbal mixture to help improve sexual performance). Started the **Moon Over Barbados Hash** and a local BASH.

Chips

Wellington Ladies (New Zealand)

Chips was founder of the **Wellington Ladies** in 1978 and completed 1500 runs just about the same time that the kennel reached 2000 runs. Is still on the committee, most recently as Hashdasery, and now has over 1650 runs to her credit.

Chippendale

Aberdeen H3/Daytona Beach H3 (Scotland/USA)

Started hashing in Aberdeen in 1991 and became immediately hooked despite not being much of a runner. Named at a Nash Hash where he was one of the youngest hashers and did a Chippendale impersonation. Moved to London where he hashed with various kennels as well as joining **Surrey H3** at the weekends. In 2001 moved to the USA, hashing with **Daytona Beach** and then **Orlando**. A good hash traveller with some 20 countries under his belt.

Choo Yon Kit

Mother Hash (Malaysia)

He was Mother Hash On Sec in 1997 and Joint Master in 1998. Was also Chairman of the 70th Anniversary event.

Choporian, Gero

Dhekelia H3 (Cyprus)

An Armenian t-shirt maker who joined the **Dhekelia Hash** 'pretty well from its inception'. At one point he had a good claim to being the longest continuous Hasher in Europe.

Chopper

Phil Mutton

Brighton H7 (England)

Chopper was on the first BH7 hash which involved a

2 mile stroll from Devils Dyke. BH7 has never had an official committee as such, but Phil was hash cash for many years. 'Possessing an enormously dry sense of humour he languishes as a joint GM/lifetime president type, dispensing wisdom when it fits the moment.' He worked as an accountant and one of his last jobs was working at a mushroom farm, 'he provided some class *Portobello's* for hash barbecues'. Recorded 1614 hashes with Brighton.

Chorizo

Stefan Rohlaender

Curitiba H3 (Brazil)

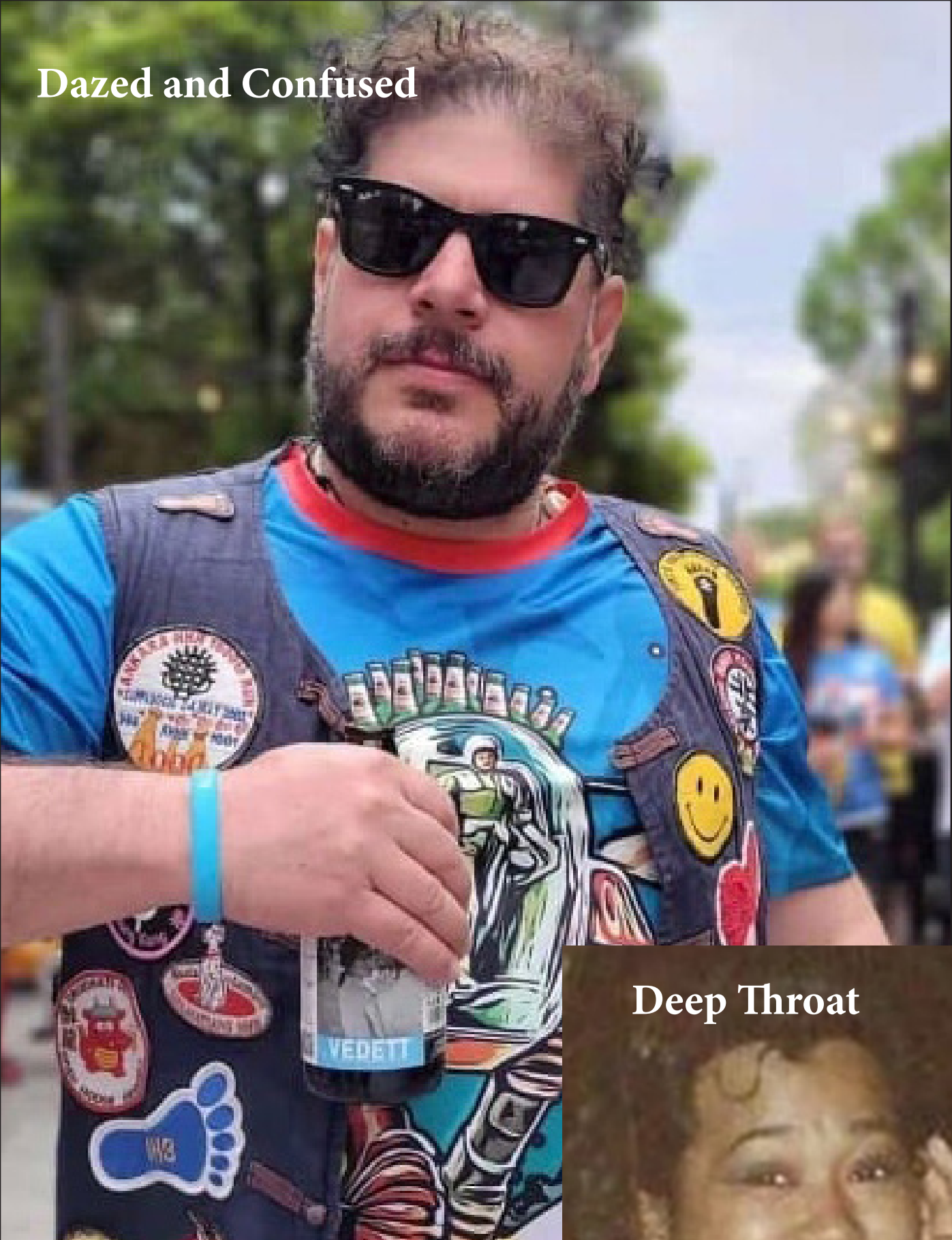
Started hashing with **Warsaw H3** in April 1989 and got named the following year at the Dia de la Raza weekend in Mexico. Co-founded **Curitiba H3** (Brazil) in 1992 and helped organize the first Latin American Interhash in 1994. He then resurrected the **Bangui H3** (Central African Republic) in 1996. The kennel died out after one run because rebels took over the only brewery. Since then he has hashed in Berlin (1999-2000 and 2008-2013), Saigon (2000- 2004), Bangkok and Vientiane. He was hare on a Saigon run that saw the whole pack arrested. More recently he has been working in the Balkans where he started the **Podgorica Lunartić H3** in 2014. Currently describes himself as Hash Homeless in Sarajevo.

Chuck Wo

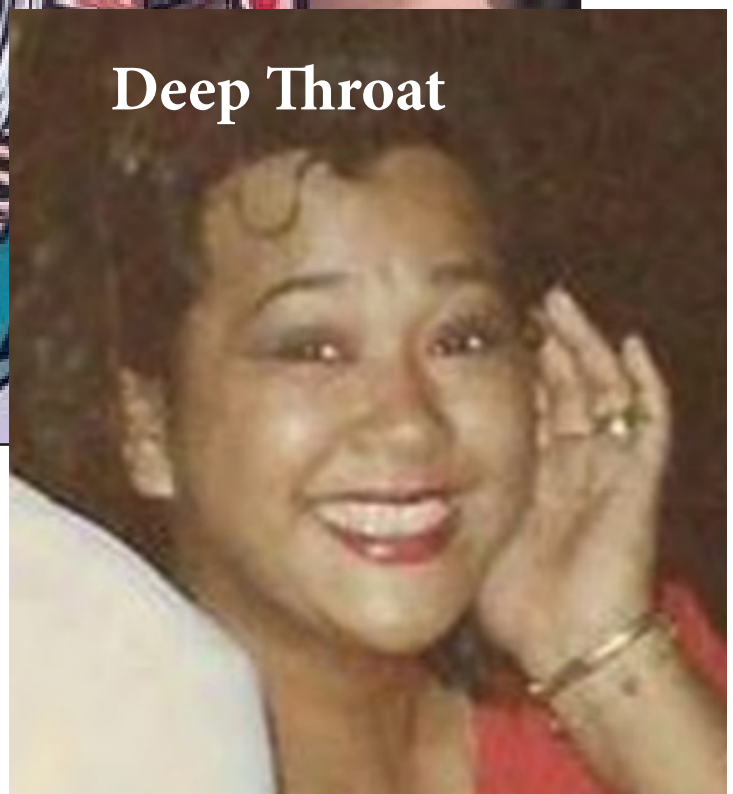
Chiang Mai Hashes (Thailand)

A well known hasher on the Chiang Mai hash scene with a total of over 1168 runs with the various kennels. Hash trashes make numerous references to him being a FRB.

Hong Kong

One of the first Chinese runners to join **Hong Kong H4**. He took to hashing with a passion and in 1976 was nominated as *'the most regular SCB'*. (Ed: Short Cutting Bastard). In 2003 he became the first Chinese hasher to be elected GM of the kennel. The Hong Kong Yearbook describes him as *'A true local Hero. Laid runs in trails of his own vomit....Probably broken Hash history by attending every bloody week'*.

CIA

John Walsh

Houston H3

Born in New York and worked in Houston for Schlumberger from 1980 to November 2015. Ranks in the top 10 of 'Where Have You Hashed' with over 60 countries and 30 states to his credit.

Clark, Douggie

Kuching H3 (Malaysia)

A pioneer of early hashing and a founder member of **Kuching H3**, the 4th oldest hash in the world. He was held up as a wonderful example of what a hasher should be, the first Kuching Hash Trash pointing out that *'we are not catering for would be Roger Bannisters - far more for the panting Douggie Clark's of the world'*.

Claude

Cairo H3 (Egypt)

A Belgium citizen running with the **Cairo Hash** in the mid eighties, where his performance as RA was unique and legendary. When not hashing Claude could be found propping up the bar at the Holiday Inn, causing some concern when the hotel was burnt down in the police riots of 1985. After leaving Cairo around 1989 (?) he seems to have disappeared and is presumably not hashing anymore.

Clepto

Bourne Valley H3 (England)

A Bourne Valley Hasher and early pioneer of hash videos, a hobby that stretched back at least as far as the 1991 Berlin 500th run.

Clever Dick, Sir

Richard Holroyd

Stockholm (Sweden)

An Englishman living in Stockholm, Richard drank with the Stockholm hashers for some time before agreeing to run with them. Since then he has been a central figure on the various Stockholm Hashes and over the years has taken his turn as RA and GM as well as being the long term de-virginiser of the

Absolut Hash. After retiring from a life as a high level insurer of oil rigs and Heathrow Terminal 5, he devoted his time to hashing and boating. He is noted for falling off the stage at Eurohash and for adding the Royal title to the Stockholm bicycle hash. (This after he wandered over to chat to the Crown Princess who happened to be in the palace gardens as the hash cycled by).

Clit

Kevin Kitteringham

Melbourne H3 (Australia)

Joined **Melbourne H3** in 1985 and passed 1000 runs in 2015. Was GM in 2007 and has held most other committee positions over the years including being a long-term Grog Master. Was still running in 2019.

Clitoria

Athens H3 (Greece)

Has 600 plus runs to her credit ranking her 3rd on the **Athens H3** run table. There was a great moment on the hash when *Clitoria* first realized her hash name had a double meaning – she thought it was because she came from the village of Klitoria.

Cloth Balls

Carlos Coene

Dhaka H3 (Bangladesh)

A long term Bangladesh resident who worked in the garment trade at a high management level. He was GM of the men's hash and had 380 plus runs with the Mixed Hash. Was noted for staging great parties and keeping immaculate hash records.

Clugs, Sir

Malcolm Lawrie

World Hash Traveller

A world hasher whose Mother Hash was Beijing in 1984. Was GM in Lagos, Accra and in Cairo. While in Cairo he performed an amusing double act with the RA *For- ever Dumb F*ck*. 2005-2008 saw Clugs in Riyadh where he had spells as both GM and JM.

CoDpiece

Ian Potter

Bangkok

A Bangkok resident who turns out with most of the kennels. Was recently voted in as both Joint Master and Trail Master of the Monday hash.

Codpiece

Eyðbjörn Augustinussen

Copenhagen H3 (Denmark)

A key member of **Copenhagen H3** with 1000 hashes (which only ranks him 7th in their all time run ta-

ble!) One yearbook notes that, *'If someone sets a mid-night run in freezing cold weather and a howling wind he will be there'*. In 2013 he was the first Copenhagen hasher to hare 100 runs and has held numerous hash positions including Master of Ceremonies in 1997, Hash Sec in 2001 and Grand Master in 2006.

Colonel, The Stu Lloyd Hash Publisher

It is unclear if *The Colonel* is a regular hasher, or just somebody who attended hashes while researching his book, *'Hare of the Dog- History, Humour and Hell-raising from the Hash House Harriers'*. If it is the latter, then at least he took part in the correct sprint. Born in Zimbabwe, he moved to South Africa and then Australia. He seems to have had a successful business career before turning to self publishing with his 'Hardship Posting' series.

Columbus, B Mother Hash (Malaysia)

Treasurer of **Mother Hash** 1946-1947 and again from 1958-1965. A noted FRB who was ashamed to have to once getting so lost that he had to return to the circle on the back of a motor bike.

Commercial Whale Brian Simpson North Hants H3 (England)

Started hashing in 1993 with **North Hants H3**, *'my life changed for ever'*. He has filled most committee position including GM and RA. Was RA and Catering for the 1995 UK Nash Hash. *'When the caterers let us down, myself and another hasher raided the kitchen and cooked burgers and chicken on a BBQ for 600 people'*. He also arranged transport for the 2015 Eurohash in Krakow, *'there were 18 coaches and only one driver spoke English'*. As an aircraft engineer for British Airways (now retired) he has been able to hash in 95 countries.

Comes Every Time Bergen H3

A popular member of **Bergen H3** who, despite a late start, seldom misses a hash (hence the name) and has rapidly climbed up the run table. Last count was 940 hashes, putting him nicely placed to become the 3rd or 4th Bergen hasher to go past the 1000 run landmark.

Commando Bandar Seri Begawan H3 (Brunei)

One of first locals to join the Bandar hash.

Compressed Fart John Pye Dubai Desert H3 (UAE)

Started his hash career in **Jeddah** and, having been offered a bucket of home-brew in the circle, decided hashing was for him. Unfortunately his company changed their working week, so he only managed that one run. A move to Cairo allowed him to return to hashing and he was noted for organizing the British Bar on the Rehydration Run. A spell in Bahrain saw him run with the **Monday Hash**, but at this stage he was still playing cricket so missed the Saturday hash. It was then on to the UAE where he turned out with both **Creek** and **Desert** hashes, including a long spell as GM of the **Dubai Desert H3**. His duties included the immaculate organisation of both Inter-Gulf and the 2000th Run. When occasionally in England CF might run with **Essex H3**.

Condom Johnny Johnson Vientiane H3 (Laos)

Originally from Liverpool, Johnson arrived in Vientiane in September 1966 and took his first job as a barman at the Lane Xang Hotel. It was difficult times, and over years he was arrested as both a suspected communist and a suspected saboteur. At one point he had to take an extended holiday abroad, which included spells in the UK, Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Cyprus & Thailand. While in Kuwait he famously turned up for the hash set just two days *after* the Iraqi invasion. (He arrived complaining of traffic - i.e. tanks.) When happier days returned he headed back to Laos, becoming one of the central pillars of the hash. He was a committee member of the **Vientiane H3**, a founder of the **Bush Hash** and is credited with inspiring the formation of **Sepon H3**. In 2006, he served on the Chiang Mai InterHash Mismanagement Committee. *Condom passed away in 2015. On On!*

Condom Johnnie Johnson Muscat H3 (Oman)

A Middle East hasher who ran a family motorboat business. He was GM of the **Muscat H3** for runs 150-300, by which time he was already a senior hasher (old fart) noted for getting the youngsters to do all the work for him.

Condom Man Duncan Rhind Dar es Salaam H3/Milton Keynes H3 (Tanzania/ England)



**Dildo Dan (left) Baldrick (right)
LLAH center**

Has a long hash CV that started with **Mogadishu H3** in 1987. Then hashed in Cairo, where he was founding hare (along with *Erect R*nner* and *Molotov*) of the 1st International Rehydration R*n. He was named in Cairo in 1992, after showing the circle how to blow up a condom and place it over his head! *Condom Man* then hashed in Donnington, Malvern, Milton Keynes, Lusaka and Dar es Salaam H4. Was GM in both Lusaka and Dar. He has travelled to various InterHashes (Cyprus, KL, Tasmania and Cardiff) and was part of the MKH3 team which put on the infamous Bond-themed 2007 UK Nash Hash. Although he left the UK 12 years ago, he is still regularly voted in as MKH3 Music Master.

Container

Lawrence Lee

TGIS (Indonesia)

An important figure on the Jakarta hash scene, particularly with **TGIS** where he was On Sec 2007-8 and GM 2013-14.

Cookie

Greg Heylen

Hamersley (Australia)

Joined **Hamersley** in 1990 and has completed 700 runs and 28 hares with them. Was GM in 2011. A construction manager by profession, he hashed with **Kowloon H3** (Hong Kong) between 1992-98.

Coops

Graeme Cooper

Hamersley (Australia)

A veteran hasher with 35 years and over 1600 runs to his credit. A regular committee member, including

taking the role of GM in 1990. Was a contributor to the **Hamersley** song books and attended a number of international events.

Cope, B V

Mother Hash (Malaya)

Secretary of **Mother Hash** from 1951 to 1952.

Cosmo

Pittsburgh H3 (USA)

Described by RA as '*big and hairy but not on top*'. A military man, in 1995 he was stationed in St Louis and on Christmas leave in Pittsburgh when he met a girl in a bar who invited him to a hash. He started running with Seattle and Rain City and other local hashes, often doing two runs a week. A year in Korea was hash free as he worked 7 days a week but a posting to Germany (1999-2002) gave him the chance to hash with **Munich H3**. The next few years were spent working and hashing between the states and Germany. Now retired from the military.

Coughmixture

Ian Galloway

Kowloon H3 (Hong Kong)

A regular member of **Kowloon H3** in their early years, clocking up 194 runs by 1994. Had a spell as Joint Master.

Counterfeit

Newcastle H3 (England)

Has clocked up 1042 runs with **Newcastle H3**.

Cowier, Roy

Bangkok H3 (Thailand)

Bangkok GM 1988-89 and Joint Master 1987-88. He

worked in the pharmaceutical industry and was a keen tennis player.

Coy Boy/Tractor

John MacDonald

Auckland (New Zealand)

Is believed to be the only hasher in New Zealand with two names, being *Tractor* on the **Auckland Hash** (Mondays) and *Coy Boy* on the Auckland Hussies. He has clocked up over a 1000 runs with the Hussies and a slightly less, but still impressive number, with the **Monday hash**. He is a retired motelier, and now an avid sailor, hasher and traveller.

Coyle, Patrick

Mother Hash (Malaysia)

An extremely good runner who regularly set the St Patrick Day Run. Spent 25 years hashing, including turning out with the **Petaling Jaya Harriettes** and **Full Moon H3**. Also a noted scuba diver.

Cracker

Graham Baker

Sofia H3 (Bulgaria)

Was introduced to hashing by a work colleague and ran a few times with **Doddington H3** back in 1981. However, it wasn't until his work as a British Railway consultant took him to Indonesia in 1991-92 that he started hashing regularly. Returning to England he clocked up 345 runs with **Essex H3** and was an enthusiastic member of the Indonesian Reunion runs. Life takes unexpected turns and Cracker was last heard of living in Sofia with his Bulgarian wife, where he was a central member of **Sofia H3**. His hash name was given to him by an American. Apparently Graham Crackers are a famous brand of biscuits. As his surname is Baker, Americans found this hilarious.

Crackers

Steve Haynes

Tirana H3 (Albania)

One of the founders of **Tirana H3** in August 1993.

Craig, David

Tehran H3 (Iran)

Joined **Tehran H3** around 1977/78 and made quite an impact, being voted 'Pig of the Year', which might have been something to do with him finding items for the hash barbecue. He also laid Run 110 which was voted the run of the year. Later hashed in **Abu Dhabi** and then became founder of **Barbados H3**.

Crash Test Dummy

Norm Klaus

Edmonton H3 (Canada)

Was a long-standing member of the Canadian Hash scene and has left many memories, such as always having a Rainer beer in one hand. *"Cheap beer meant better to him. He always showed up at runs with it."* In his mid forties Norm faced a battle with a recurring brain tumour that resulted in a major operation and the hash name *Crash Test Dummy*. Just out of surgery and determined to get on with life he headed for InterHash in Tasmania. Towards the end of a five-week tour, medical problems forced him home early. Hospitalised in Vancouver, he came out of a coma to phone the pack who were just finishing a run. The hash hired a Learjet to bring him home to spend his last days surrounded by his Hash friends. *On On Crash Test!*

Creamy Nuts

Phil Kraemer

Jakarta hashes (Indonesia)

Worked in the oil industry and spent several years in Jakarta during the 1990s during which time he hashed several times a week. Mainly associated with the men's hash, but turned out with most groups and was an important figure in the founding of **TGIF**. Phil loved to drive out at the weekends to search for virgin countryside. His wife Pat was a popular figure on the **Pussy Hash** and sadly died while they were in Jakarta. Jakarta old hands inform me that Phil has also passed away 'some time ago'. *On On Phil and Pat!*

Croenendyk, Peter

El Salvador H3

Peter Croenendyke and David Rodgers founded the El Salvador hash in August 1984. With the outbreak of civil war, and a real fear of terrorism, the kennel had to shut down.

Crotch Thumper

Auman, Heather

Horse's Ass H3 (USA)

An extremely enthusiastic hasher, world traveller, and spokeswoman for the **Horse's Ass H3** where she is currently listed a GM. She has hashed with over 230 different kennels in 45 countries, and all 50 USA states! *Thumper* is known for her Kentucky Hashpitality and has welcomed and lodged over 250 hashers in her Lexington homes. Received her hash name from her one cylinder motorcycle (called a thumper). She has founded three kennels in Kentucky, **Horse's Ass**, **Lexington Lunatics** and **Louisville H3**.

Crusader

Christopher Lewis

Tokyo H3 (Japan)

Crusader recently celebrated 40 years of Hashing, having started in 1980. Was GM of **Tokyo H3** in 1987-88 and again from 2003 to 2019. Suspects he has hashed at least 3000 times in at least 32 different countries. (He has 2112 confirmed runs since 2005 - early years are only an estimation). Currently a regular runner on the **Tokyo, Tokyo Ladies, Friday Fukov** and **Hayama Hashes**. Married the lovely *Jelly Mouth* (herself a 25-year Hasher) on a Hash run.

Cuckoo

Karl Sauter

Ikeja H3 (Nigeria)

Cuckoo was a central figure in the **Ikeja Hash** and, amongst his numerous businesses, was owner of the Crocodile Hash bar. Doing business in Nigeria at the time was not easy and his amazing career is described online and certainly worth a read. He was badly injured in the June 2000 road accident (several hashers were involved) and flew for long-term treatment in Switzerland.

Cueball

Bill Corless

Ankara H3 (Turkey)

A central figure in the early history of the **Ankara Hash** and his spell as GM and then RA set the 'traditional hash tone' that continues today.

Cumby

William Scholl

Rumson H3 (USA)

A competitive runner who did a respectable 4:08 mile in high school. He later won the Philadelphia Marathon in 2 14 59, a record time of that stood for many years. While on a training run he came across **Rumson H3** and was instantly corrupted. Works as a park ranger.

Cumin Numb

Munich H3/Winnipeg H3 (Germany/Canada)

Delightful harriette of Canadian heritage. While running with the **Munich H3** she was a regular visitor at European events. She was joint founder of **Winnipeg H3** during a short spell back in Canada.

Cumming, Ian

Singapore H/New York H3 (USA)

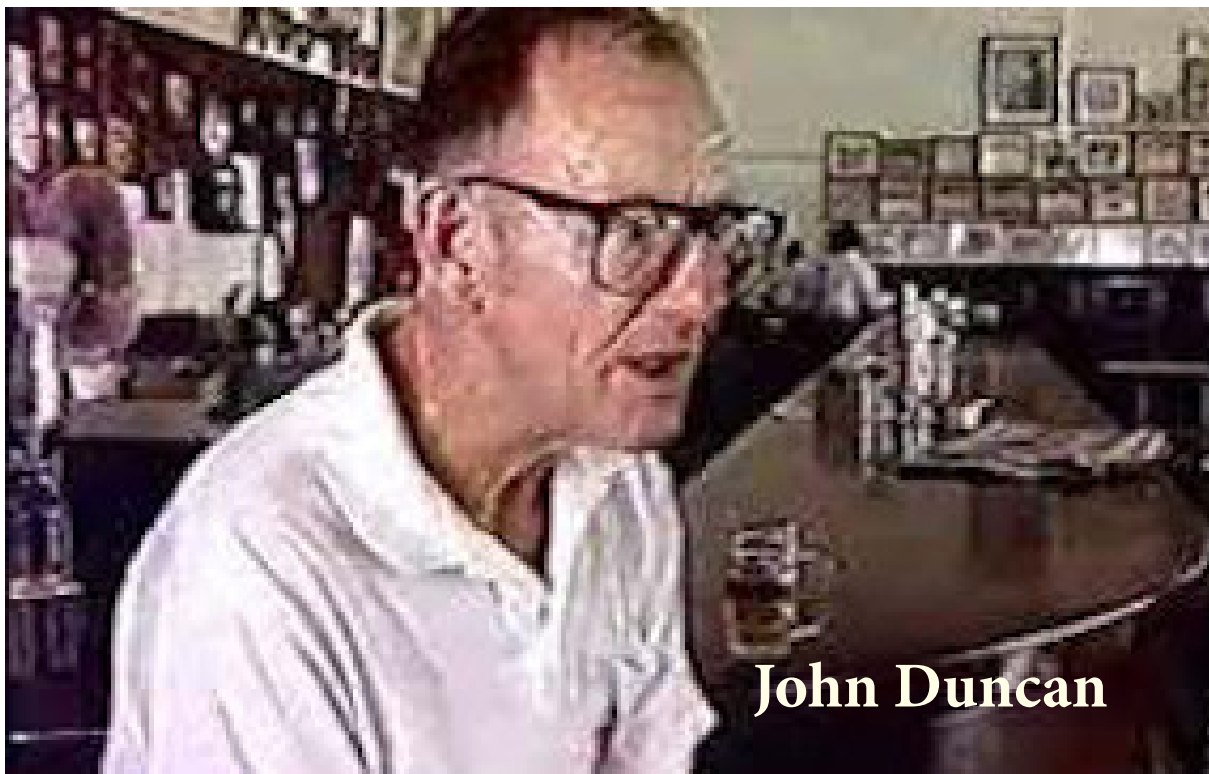
A true hash legend. Ian joined **Mother Hash** in the late fifties and was still hashing in New York sixty years later. Ian was born in London in 1930. In

Disneyland - diplomat and

GM of Mexico City H3



1940 he and his sister were evacuated to Canada. Ian returned to the UK in 1944 and joined the British Army, becoming a full Lieutenant in the Royal Artillery Airborne Regiment. He also played for Esher Rugby Club, and it was rugby that introduced him to the singing traditions that he would help introduce to hashing. In 1952, he left the army and joined Gestetner, who he worked for until 1992, becoming Vice President and Corporate secretary. In 1956 he was posted to Indonesia where he met his future wife, Jane. After a 3-year stint in Nairobi he was appointed Country Manager in Kuala Lumpur where he and Jane joined the local drama society. It was here that he met David Scourse who took him along to his first hash. In 1962 Ian was transferred to Singapore where he founded the first hash outside of Malaya. In 1966 he immigrated to the US but it wasn't until 1978 that he and Charles Woodhouse (also ex Singapore), founded the **New York Hash House Harriers**. He became a great hash traveller and was treated as a Hash VIP wherever he went. Ian died in 2015 at the age of eighty-four. *'Ian was our most unforgettable character and his decline over recent years and eventual loss has been a great blow. He will be sorely missed, but we enjoyed extraordinary experiences and created unforgettable memories that have changed our lives and enabled us to look back with immense pleasure and gratitude'*.

John Duncan

Culture Vulture **Colin Crabbe**

Various Turkish kennels

A road building engineer by profession, it was the Istanbul-Ankara highway project that brought him to Turkey in the nineties, where he became a key member of the **Ankara Hash**. He was involved in organising joint runs with Istanbul, often at Cappadoccia, and it was on one of these trips that he met his wife *Virgin*. *Culture Vulture* went on to hash in Cyprus and by 1995 was in the UK, hashing with **Surrey H3**. By 2000 the Greeks were building a major road system and *Culture Vulture* hashed in Thessalonica. His final posting was Libya, where he turned out with the struggling **Benghazi H3** before retiring to Bodrum in Turkey. A chance meeting with old hash friend *Seaman* led to the founding of **Bodrum H3**. With *Culture Vulture* as GM they staged their inaugural run in March 2009, a great two day event attended by nearly a hundred hash visitors.

Curry, Joe **La Jolla H3 (USA)**

Joe Curry founded **La Jolla H3** in 1978 and at one point was the oldest active hasher in the state.

Cushion, Peter **Mother Hash (Malaysia)**

A great character on **Mother Hash**. He owned a car upholstery business and was noted for his long pig tail.

Letter **D**

D2HD

David Newman

Canberra H3 (Australia)

Ran with **Canberra H3** and **Capital H3**, where he was the hash historian. Also made frequent hash travels. He mismanaged the excellent Aussie Hash website and was the official compiler/coordinator of the World Hash Directory hard copy and websites. *D2HD passed away in April 2021. On On!*

Dagy

Dag Guest

Garden City H3 (New Zealand)

Known as the '*Horrible Hobbit*', Dagy has been a central figure in New Zealand hashing for many years. He started hashing in Cairns while in the Royal Navy, later joining **Christchurch H3** and becoming co-founder of **Garden City H3**. His hash career also involved a spell as GM of **Marlborough H3** when they had the reputation of '*out singing out drinking out grossing and out running any other hash*.' He served as New Zealand GM between 1987 and 1989 and was involved in the unsuccessful New Zealand bids for Interhash '90 and '92. Continues to hash and is listed as hash cash with Garden City.

Dame Edna **David Crump** **Antigua H3**

Dame Edna was co-founder of the **Antigua H3** back in 1991. His names still appears as Hare Raiser.

Damien the Antichrist Long Beach H3 (USA)

A noted world traveller who ranks just outside the top one hundred on the 'Where Have You Hashed' website. His name comes up on various west coast hashes, including **Long Beach** and **San Diego**. In 2006 he completed a beer mile in 10.43, a respectable time for a 50 year old. Wife *Pot Ho* is also a hasher.

Dancing Dan Dan Schlesinger Seoul H3 (Korea)

Dan was born in New York in 1955. He first came to attention as a runner in his first year at Yale, when he set a college freshman record for six miles. Considering that Olympic medallist Frank Shorter had set the previous record, this was a remarkable achievement. However, Dan's college running career never fulfilled its potential, partly because of pressure from his studies. An outstanding student of oriental languages – he speaks both Korean and Japanese - he was awarded a Marshall Scholarship and spent 1980-82 at Oxford University. After Oxford Dan moved to Korea where he translated Korean legal documents. Dan was now running seriously once again and as part of his training regularly turned out with **Seoul H3**. He is remembered in Seoul for jogging out to the venue, usually some distance away in the suburbs, before running the actually hash. Despite taking his running so seriously, Dan was adopted by the pack and was given the Hash name *Dancing Dan*. He in turn never let his training interfere with the fun of the circle and *Captain Marvel* reports that when he first came to the Hash *Dancing Dan* couldn't chug a beer to save his life, 'but soon we had him swilling them out of our ceremonial bedpan right along with the best of them'. *Dancing Dan* returning to the States sometime in 1982 and entered that year's New York Marathon, finishing third in a world-class time of 2 hour 11 minute 36 seconds. This is probably the most impressive feat of running ever recorded by an active hasher. Four years later he was 9th in the Boston Marathon in 2:16:29. Dan returned to school, this time to Harvard to train as a lawyer and by 1995 he was working as an attorney in Japan. During the second half of the nineties he started to build a reputation as an artist and became a cult figure in Japan when selected to design the front cover of the Japanese edition of Harry Potter. *With thanks to Captain Marvel and Hops.*

Dancing with Dogs Howard Mackay Wanchai H3 (Hong Kong)

Born in Derby in 1946, Howard came through a tough childhood to work as an engineer specialising in railway projects. He moved to Hong Kong, where he would remain for the next 27 years, working mostly on rail infrastructure projects. A keen musician, he played gigs at pubs and social events and opened his own bar, The Wanch, that became a centre of both music and hashing. Along with Bruce *Shirley Temple* Fletcher, Howard saw the need for a mixed hash and formed **Wanchai H3**. Howard led Hong Kong's 1996 InterHash bid and was a major inspiration behind the Sunset On the Empire weekend. He also enjoyed squash, football and off-road motorcycling. Howard finally left Hong Kong for retirement in the Philippines.

Danials, Bernard Los Angeles H3 (USA)

Having learnt his hashing in Singapore, Danials returned to the USA where he founded **Los Angeles H3**.

Daniel Ortega Anthony Sandeen Hong Kong H4

A keen jogger and successful businessman who has worked in Asia for several years, including postings in Shanghai, Tokyo and most recently Hong Kong. His name of Sandeen led to Sandeenista, and from there *Daniel Ortega*. Was only the second American to be appointed GM of **Hong Kong H4**. According to their yearbook, 'This one was a true POTUS (Prick Of The US). Like his doppelganger orange mate in Washington: slim, athletic, articulate, witty, in all a very stable genius.'

Darwin Don Don Grenville Sydney H3 (Australia)

A legend in Australian hashing. Born in 1923, he started hashing in 1975 (when already middle-aged). The 2007 Aussie Nash Hash programme identifies him as the oldest Australian hasher and he continued to hash for another 12 years. He became recognised as the oldest regular hasher in the world and **Sydney H3** made him 'World President of all Hashdom'. In 2015 he had to be hospitalised with heart pains but made a rapid return to hashing after a heart valve operation. Having completed his last run on September 23rd, 2019, Darwin Don went on to the great Hash in the sky a few days later. *On On,*

Darshan Singh

Sungai Petani Hazards (Malaysia)

A hash veteran with **Sungai Petani Hazards**, who list him as 'midwife' in acknowledgement of his role in their founding. Now in his sixties, and with a knee-cap replacement, but still hashing. He is an advisor on the Malaysian Hash Council.

Davidson, Llew

Mother Hash (Malaysia)

After a few years working on rubber plantations, Llew Davidson was transferred to KL and joined the Hash just before their 100th run. During the war he was captured by the Japanese, spending time in Changi Prison and then being sent to work on the Burma Railway. Davidson returned to Malaya after the war and was Joint Master in 1948 and 1951-52. This was a period of declining numbers when six was a big turnout and his willingness to regularly set runs played a considerable part in keeping the Hash going. He had a third spell as Joint Master between 1955-57 and recorded his last run in 1960. Davidson returned to England where he took up farming in Shropshire. Llew entertained many visiting hashers until he died in 1980 at the age of 90. *On On*.

Davidson, Maurice

Bandar Seri Begawan H3

Completed 808 of the first 1000 **Bandar Seri Begawan H3** runs.

Davis, Susan

Bahrain H3

An important member of **Bahrain H3** in the early days with 300 runs to her credit.

Davis-Scourfield, Brigadier

Dhekelia H3/ Episkopi H3 (Cyprus)

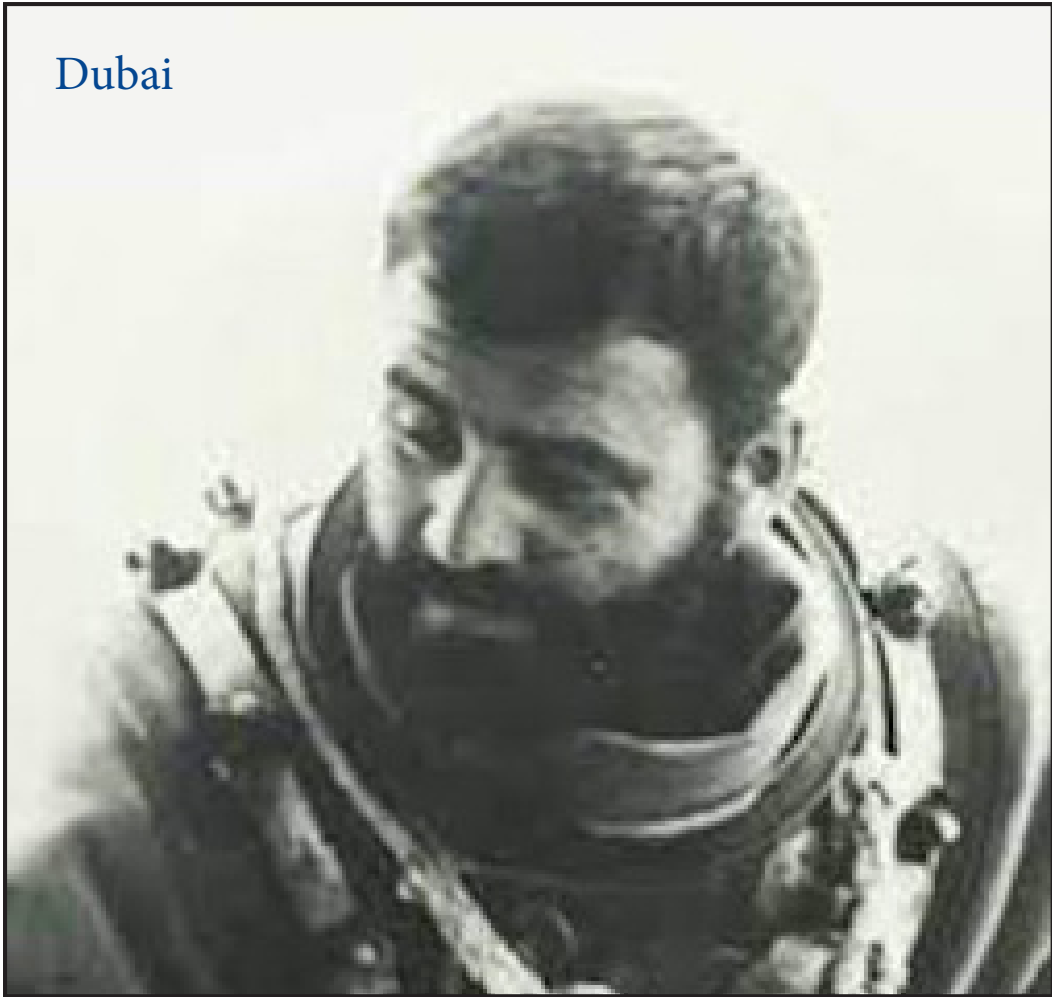
Brigadier Gris Davis-Scourfield had a distinguished military career being awarded the Military Cross and a CBE. His war memoirs, *In Presence of My Foes: A Memoir of Calais, Colditz, and Wartime Escape Adventures* was published in 1991. He was also a keen hasher, co-founding **Dhekelia H3** with Ray Thornton and then founding the **Episkopi H3**. Having a senior officer take an interest in hashing removed many of the problems the early military hashes might have otherwise encountered. Gris Davies-Scourfield died on 20 November 2006 in Alton. *On On Brigadier*.

Daya

Kampala H3 (Uganda)

In 1994/95 Daya became the first Ugandan hasher to record a 100 runs.

Mike Callaghan

Vientiane H3 (Laos)

Dayak has a hash pedigree that goes back to the late 1960s when he completed a handful of runs in Singapore. He became a founder member of the **Johore Bahru H3**, staying on for some 30 runs before heading for Indonesia and then Papua New Guinea. By the early nineties he was back in Malaysia, clocking up 700 plus runs with **Kuching H3** (where he had a spell as GM) **Kuching City** and **Kuching Harriettes**. Around 1993 *Dayak* headed to Laos, where he has been one of the central figures in the development of hashing in this beautiful Southeast Asian backwater. His Laos record includes 500 plus runs with **Vientiane H3**, where he was GM in 1995 and 2003. He was also co-founder and GM of the **Bush Hash** and trail master for the **8th Indochina-Mekong Hash** in 2005.

Dazed and Confused

Andres Vargas

Beijing H3 (China)

Born in Colombia, he founded **Medellín H3** and by 2004 was running with **Ankara H3** (Turkey). He moved on to China, where he would make a major impact on the hash scene. He is the longest serving committee member on the **Beijing H3** including

regularly being voted in as GM. He was also founder of the **Beijing Full Moon Hash**. He works in digital marketing and his hash publications include the *All China Hash House Harriers Official Directory*. He is also an accomplished scuba diver. Dazed was arrested by the Chinese police right before the Beijing Olympics, initially for spreading a suspicious substance (flour... of course), then for “contaminating” the clean city of Beijing (with flour), then for wasting food (once again.. flour). The charges were dropped the same night.

DBII

Geoff Thomas

Hobart H3 (Australia)

Completed 1500 hashes in 2009 and 2000 in 2018.

Dead Animal

Ian Hepher

Madrid/Montreal (Spain/Canada)

Ian *Dead Animal* Hepher started hashing in **Madrid** where he clocked up over 200 runs. On moving to Canada in 1994 he and *Foxy Lady* founded **Montreal H3**. He was a long term GM and by the time he moved back to the UK in 2012 had 755 hashes to his credit (4th on the Montreal all-time rankings). During 2008 he clocked up 35 consecutive runs. Return-

ing to the UK he founded **Evesham Summer Sundays Hash** and joined **Warwick H3** on Run Number One. 2013 brought a return to Spain where he helped found the **Costa Blanca H3**. His hash world travels have taken him to Americas InterHash and the KL 60th and 80th anniversaries. In his working career he was an aerodynamicist, working with military aircraft. *Dead Animal* is now back in the UK where he continues to hash.

Dead End

Mary Moore

Hogs Town (Canada)

Originally from Dublin but now Canada based.

Ranks just outside the top 100 on Where Have you Hashed.

Deadloss

Magda Los

World hasher

A Belgian expat who has been hashing since Moscow in 1988. One of the most distinguished female GMs, she has held that role in Moscow, Canberra and Dar es Salaam. Was also founder of **Bujumbura H3**. *Deadloss* is a fine drinker and was Aussie Nash Hash Ladies down-down champion and runner-up in the 1996 InterHash contest.

Dean, David

Mother Hash (Malaysia)

David Dean was Joint Master of Mother Hash in 1953. He worked for the US Information Service and might well have been the first diplomat to take up hashing. He might also be the first American to do so.

Debby

Wes Harry

Dubai Desert/Brunei (UAE/Brunei)

Wes started hashing in Brunei in 1982. He might well have joined **Bandar Seri Begawan H3** on their first run, but that was the week he was finally offered a place with the original men's hash. Claims to have only once missed a hash when in country, although because of his frequent travels it took 27 years and 2 postings to complete 100 runs. Once set a check under a tree where a bear had built a nest. Work took him to Saudi and then to Dubai, which was followed by a stay in Glasgow where he completed his Ph.D. studies. He then hashed in Kuwait before making a return to Dubai. After three decades of hashing he was finally given the hash name *Debby*. (His surname is Harry, therefore Debbie Harry! (Ed: can older hashers explain Blondie to younger hashers?) Now

in his seventies, Debby continues to be active on the Dubai Hash scene.

Deep Throat

Alan Seerup

Wellington H3 (New Zealand)

Deep Throat was introduced to the wider world of Hashing in Melbourne in the 1980's. '*His trusting kiwi nature was sometimes taken advantage of by local legends such as Steamshoes and Herpes who used him as a fall guy at away events*'. Having been introduced to hashing *Deep Throat* went on to clock up over 3,600 runs, both in New Zealand and around the world. He has passed the 1000 mark with 2 local Wellington hashes, as well as completing over 400 runs in his 2nd Hash home of Melbourne. DT has been co-hare with *Bluevain* for the last 4 Red Dress runs at the New Zealand Nash Hash. Over the years his University drinking training has stood him in good stead for InterHash down-down events and he has 5 titles to his credit, including the most recent victory in Fiji. He is also webmaster for the NZHHH website, despite having, in true Hash fashion, almost no skills in Websites. Wife *Fire N Da Ho* is also a hasher. (Ed: *Deep Throat* has been a great supporter of On ON Magazine - many thanks!)

Deep Throat

Pe Chanthong

Bangkok Harriettes (Thailand)

Pe was (possibly) the original *Deep Throat*. She was the first Bangkok Harriettes past 600 runs and was also credited for all of the Men's Saturday Hash runs where she and husband, Pitak, supplied the beer. Her work in supplying beer to several Bangkok hashes meant she was widely addressed as *Hash Piss*. She won the ladies down-down competition in Inter-hash Phuket and was runner up in Rotorua. She was also an original member of the **Thinking Drinking Hash** where her diplomatic skills were occasionally required to calm down suspicious policemen. Pe was killed on 12 June 1995 while driving home from Hash duties. A down-down mug was donated to InterHash by **Bangkok Harriettes** and is used every 2 years in her memory.

Deep Throat

Terry Mechan

Hong Kong/Wirral (Hong Kong/England)

Was a founder member of the **Royal South Side H3** in Hong Kong, where he was Hash Minstrel from 1977 - 1980. Returning to England he was founder of the **Wirral and Chester Hash** in February 1987 and **MOH3 Hash** (Cheltenham) in 1997. In 1996



he started the Global Hash Founders Hash which is a 'Club' for people who have founded a Hash. Each Founder has a uniquely numbered Founders Hat (www.hash-foundershash.com). *Deep Throat* also writes hash songs which can found online.

Delhi Boy

Simon Batty

R2D2H3 and Bourne Valley H3 (England)

Delhi Boy got his Hash name when he joined **Barnes H3** in the UK after three years running with **Delhi H3**, and immediately found himself one of the youngest members of the Barnes pack. His impressive hash CV includes notching up 100 plus runs in each of India, Greece, Egypt as well as with Barnes.

He has been GM in Athens, Twin Cheeks and Bogotá, and Joint Master of Delhi and Cairo. Following a ten- year Hash hiatus (no Hashes in Iraq or Afghanistan) he started to hit the shiggy again a couple of years ago with **R2D2H3** and **Bourne Valley H3** in the UK. Has hashed in over twenty countries and still runs internationally when work, travel and COVID-19 permits.

Demon Dave

Dave Ronson

Auckland H3 (New Zealand)

A long-time **Auckland H3** hasher, Dave Ronson, aka *Demon Dave* is approaching his 2000th run with Auckland. At that point he will become only the third Kiwi Hasher to achieve 2000 runs with the

same kennel. *Demon Dave* arrived in New Zealand from Preston in the UK in 1973 on a two-year work visa and never returned. Put off by some of the fitter members of the group (Ed: it was a long time ago and we were all younger) Dave didn't hash until *Animal* took him along in 1979, 'we haven't been able to get rid of him since'. He has missed only a handful of Annual General Piss-Ups and has built up an impressive list of Inter-Hashes and Nash-Hash visits. His most infamous hash exploit was getting caught by a rising tide in a mid-winter run across the mudflats off Point Chevalier. The rest of the pack swam for it, but *Demon* and *Bananas* (RIP), not being strong swimmers, took refuge on a patch of mangroves where they waited to be rescued by the Coast Guard. The incident made the local newspapers complete with some embarrassing pictures. *Thanks to Captain.*

Der Tulip Eater

Kaj Petersen

Copenhagen H3 (Denmark)

Kaj Petersen caught the hash bug in Hong Kong and went on to hash for the rest of his life, clocking up runs in over 40 countries. His greatest claim to fame is being one of the three founders of Copenhagen H3. He spent most of his life working for A. P. Møller. The Tulip Eater died on trail in Cambodia while taking part in the 2018 Cambodian Nash Hash. His life was beautifully summed up by this Facebook tribute from Jim Edens: 'Kaj died doing what he loved and lived for. I was with him in his final few days in Phnom Penh at Cambodia Nash Hash, and he was his jovial self, laughing and having a drink with friends. He will be missed by all who knew and loved this man'. *RIP Der Tulip Eater.*

Designer Bush

Nancy West

Washington Hashes (USA)

Was GM of the **DC Full Moon Hash** and hashed with most of the DC area hashes at some time or another. She was famous for her Lingerie Run and pool parties. *Designer Bush* passed away in May 2010. *On On Designer.*

Detmann, Wolfgang

Bangkok H3 (Thailand)

A key figure in with the **Bangkok Men's Hash** from 1989 to around 1995. He regularly sat on the committee including being GM in 1993. When not hashing he was a managing director in the health industry.

Disaster

Ron McPhail

Medan H3 (Indonesia)

Disaster was a **Medan H3** hasher in the mid 1980's to early 1990's. He was a mechanical engineer and like a lot of the lads worked for Mobil Oil. *Disaster* was a great host and close friends often gathered at his home to sit around his famous bamboo bar. 'His hash name was quite apt as he was always moving from one disaster to another. On one particular InterHash he almost drowned crossing a river, he was rescued by fellow MH3 members.' After Indonesia, Disaster returned to live in the UK and passed away in the early 90's. His 3rd wife (*Princess Dianne*) survived him, as did his eldest daughter by his 1st wife, and 2 more children from his 2nd wife. *On on Disaster!* With thanks to Wombat.

Dickhead

Richard Hughes

Hobart H3 (Australia)

First ran in the 1976-77 hash year and completed 1000 runs with **Hobart Hash** in 1999. 2003 was the first time he did not turn out regularly after which **Dickhead** only completed a couple of more runs. He is affectionately mentioned in the Hobart Hall of shame, 'Richard (Dickhead) Hughes for attempting to set a hash run on a five acre block, blaming H4 when he was breathalysed on a Monday night and for being Hughesy.' His (final?) run total with Hobart is listed as 1226.

Dickspeare

Lost Lakes H3 (Iraq)

Co-founder of **Lost Lakes H3**, a military hash in Iraq.

Dick Van Wrinkle

David Dixon

Fort Lee H3 (USA)

Dick Van Wrinkle started hashing with the **Tidewater H3** (Virginia Beach, Virginia) in the late 90s. He went on to found **Fort Lee H3** (Petersburg, Virginia) in May of 2000. (Or so he thought! To his surprise, he later discovered that there had already been a **Fort Lee H3** founded by *Greasy Nuts* in March 1993). DVW branded Fort Lee H3 as the "Hash of One" after the US Army slogan "Army of One" and on occasions he would show up alone, set the trail, run trail, sing a song, and give himself a down-down. DVW left Fort Lee around 2003. He went on to co-found the **Lost Lakes H3** in Iraq.

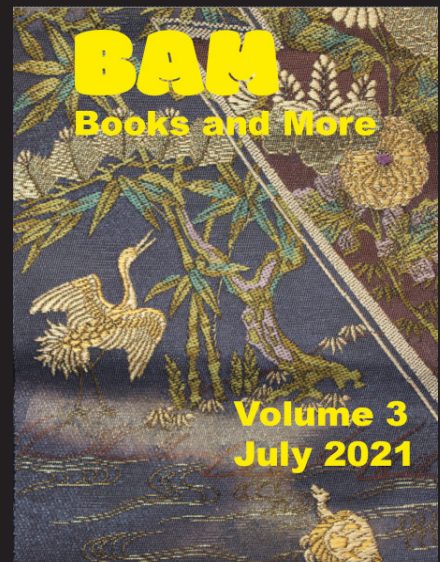
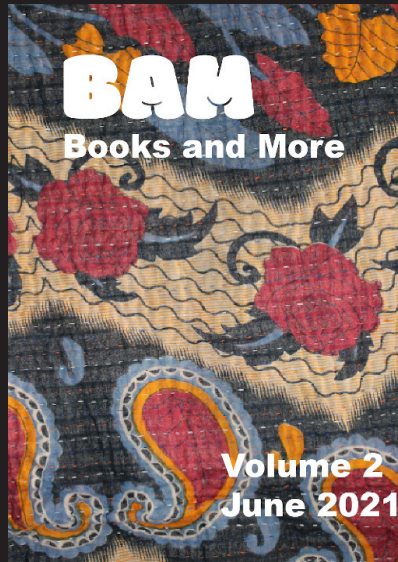
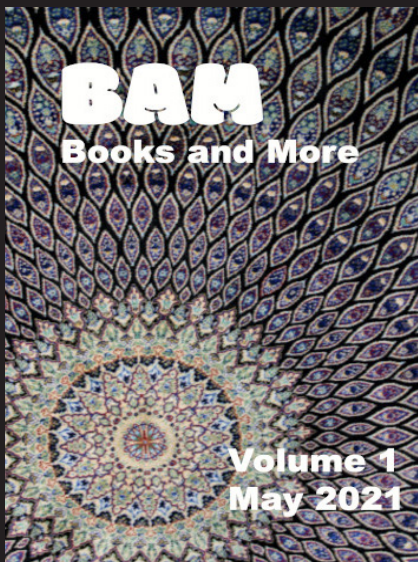

Ken Bird

Hobart H4 (Australia)

Completed 1500 runs with **Hobart** in 2012. He was JM in 1988 and GM in 2002-03. Has been a noted contributor to their website and a regular winner of the best run report. An enthusiastic hare, he was a 5 time winner of the 'Hardest Quality Run Award,' including three consecutive wins from 2000-04.

Digit

Eric McGaw

World Hasher

Eric *Digit* McGaw started hashing in Brunei with **Kuala Belait** in 1980. As he worked offshore he only managed a handful of runs, but it meant when posted to Manila, and hearing a squash partner mention 'hashing,' he knew what it was all about and went along. He spent eight years in Manila and although rowing was his first love he started to build up what was to become a legendary hash career. He was often scribe, became a regular roving correspondent for Magic's 'Harrier International' and served on the 1990 'Thriller in Manila' InterHash committee. Although he had actually left the Philippines before the event took place, he travelled back to help out and to

set a trail. On arriving in Hyderabad in 1989 Digit immediately set about founding a kennel, the 7-8 month delay between conception and the first run being due to a problem finding t-shirts. Digit hashed in India for the next decade and a half, during which time he became one of only two hashers to attend every Indian Nash Hash. He was also a regular at InterHash, including being register #2 for Rotorua. Digit did not think up the idea of bringing InterHash to India, but he led the presentation and went on to become chairman. Indeed, few InterHash chairs have imposed themselves on an event as much as *Digit* in Goa. Digit was head of a extended hash family (wife, sons, daughters, brother and dog). To general surprise he left India for the Middle East and then Ghana. Digit passed away in 2016. *On on to a great hasher.* (The name, by the way, comes from losing one by falling off an Indian train en route to a hash).

Diger Too

Lindsey Few

Medan H3 (Indonesia)

Was **Medan H3's** first GM and helped to get the Harriets started. *Ed: Can anybody tell us a little more about Diger Too?*



Dildo Dan

Dan Smith

Doha Nightcrawlers (Qatar)

Dildo was introduced to hashing in Dar es Salaam in 1999. He made a major contribution to this golden period of Tanzanian hashing with his enthusiasm, simple nature (proof of this being that his second hobby in life, after hashing, is supporting the mighty Chester City FC) and intriguing love life. His work as a road engineer enabled several weekend events to take place at the SkanPihl Colas Road Camp. These included a legendary joint run with the local Maa-sai village, featuring flooded rivers, a check in the middle of a cow pen and down-downs of warm cow blood mixed with milk. *Dildo* moved on, helping to found the **Curacao Monday Hash (CuM H3)**. He is immensely proud of setting the first hash through the 200 girl Campo Alegre brothel village. There were also hash spells with **Yaounde H3** and **Jamaica H3** and more recently the Middle East, (Bahrain and Qatar) where he has been a central figure on the **Doha H3** and the **Doha Nightcrawlers**. *Dildo* can claim to be possibly the most arrested hasher in history, having been detained by police while setting trails in Tanzania, Cameroun, Bahrain and Qatar (twice).

Dingaling

Bob Cox

Has clocked up 1137 hashes with **Bicester H3**.

Dingbat

Duncan Kirby

Desert H3/ Nicosia H4 (UAE/Cyprus)

Duncan's introduction to hashing came in 1981 when, as a gullible young lad new to the expat life, he was asked to set the first ever Baghdad run. Thinking it would be easy, he started to place strips of toilet paper in trees. What he hadn't foreseen of was that toilet paper was a luxury item generally not available in the shops, and by the time the run started it had mostly been gathered up by grateful farmers. It was a disastrous start to a most distinguished hash career. Having met and married *Pearly Dingballs* in Baghdad, *Dingbat* based himself in his wife's native Cyprus, where he was joint founder of the **Nicosia Horrible Hash House Harriers**. A spell in Oman was unproductive hash wise, with work hours limiting his ability to run, but a posting to Lebanon proved more promising. The country was just recovering from years of troubles and Duncan was able to run with the **Greater Beirut H3** before that kennel split into two rival groups. Other spells included

four years working and hashing in Athens (where he was working on a new airport) and Jordan. Around the time of the 1996 Cyprus Interhash he acquired the hash name *Dingbat Chubby* after receiving a letter 'from the President of Cyprus' congratulating him on completing his 150th NH4 run. However, as he moved around the world, Duncan has quietly dropped the *Chubby* and is now universally known as *Dingbat*. A stocky lad, he was a good rugby player, even representing Cyprus once, and later on a keen cyclist quite regularly going out for a 100 kilometre jaunt before breakfast. In recent years work has increasingly focused on the UAE, where *Dingbat* has been a long term member of the Dubai hash scene. He is a good song master and an excellent RA when called upon. He is now based in Abu Dhabi.

Dingles

Stewart Ingles

Canberra H3 (Australia)

Dingles started hashing with **Cooma H3** in 1976. His work as a public servant took him to Canberra in 1979 and he has been turning out with **Canberra H3** ever since. A knee injury now limits him to walking and short cutting.

Dingo

John Brigatti

Hamersley H3 (Australia)

Completed 1100 runs in 30 years of hashing with **Hamersley H3**. First joined the committee as Joint Master in 1989 and continued to serve until 2001. Was GM from 1993-94. A noted drinker, his worst hash moment was described in the Hamersley year-book as 'every Tuesday morning'.

Dinki

Sandy Crampton

Wellington Ladies H3 (New Zealand)

First hash run was with **Wellington Ladies H3** (WLH3) in 1979 and then with **Melbourne Ladies H3** from 1980-1984. Back in NZ she rejoined WLH3 and was a founding member of **Port Nicholson Geriatric H3** (PNGH3) in October 1985. Also a founding member of **Wellington H2 Bikers** (WH2B), mountain bike hash. *Dinki* stopped counting her runs with PNGH3 at 1111 runs, and at 1234 runs with WLH3. She was named *Dinki Di* after returning from Brussels in 1985 with a Brussels H3 sweat shirt and when asked if it was genuine, replied "*its dinki di alreight*". Now strictly a walker due to (in her own words) '*age and decrepitude*'.

Dipstick, Sir

Tornado H3 (USA)

A lifetime competitive runner who accidentally discovered the hash in 1998. Now the last survivor of the **Tornado Hash** from that era, having been knighted after his 1000th Run. Wife *LSD (Long Suffering Debby)* also hashes but avoids the circle.

Dirty Old Man

Ulf Burmeister

Helsinki H3 (Finland)

When Ulf Burmeister arrived in Finland in 1977 he was already a hash veteran with a CV that included **Singapore, Washington D.C.** and **New York H3**. He started **Helsinki H3**, making it one of the oldest kennels in Europe.

Dirty Old Men

Kim Hughes-Hallett

Mijas H3 (Spain)

Kim was brought up on the **Mijas H3** by her parents *El Porteño* and *Manuela*, *'looking on with joyous fascination as Hashing chaos unfolded around her'*. Kim got her name one Hash when she found herself walking with *Ash* and *El Porteño*, who were in deep discussion about the attributes of certain Harriettes. After some time listening, she was heard to mutter *'dirty old men'*. *Dirty Old Men* was never much of runner, but very much enjoyed the other side of Hashing. She eventually ended up working at the Hash watering hole, *Larry's Bar*. It was with huge sadness that Kim lost her fight against cancer in January 2012. *'She has left a huge void and is greatly missed, but her laughter and her beautiful smile will last forever'*. On on Dirty Old Men

Disco Wanker

Steve Charles

Bali H3 (Indonesia)

Although born in Wales, *Discowanker* has lived in Bali since 1993. He started hashing the year he arrived and served as GM and RA for over 16 years. He was co-founder of the Pan Asia Hash and Vice Chairman of the 2012 Borobudur and the 2016 Bali InterHashes.

Disneyland

Steve Ordell

Mexico City H3

Steve was a central figure on the **Mexico City H3** during the early nineties when he was noted for being the only high-ranking diplomat to drive a Volkswagen beetle taxi. He later retired to Tequisquiapan, a delightful village which the Mexico

City Hash regularly visited for weekend runs.

Doctor Butt

Bergen H3 (Norway)

The daughter of hash legend *Balloon Balls*. She start hashing with Bergen in 1996 and is now approaching 1000 hashes and 90 harings.

Doctor Feelsgood

Douglas Sims

Heidelberg H3 (Germany)

In an interview Douglas Sims claimed to have turned to a career in the U.S. Army because, *'I had no money to go to school. I came from a fairly poor background, and the opportunity to go to West Point arose.'* He graduated from West Point in 1966 and left for Vietnam soon after. Assignments in Wurzburg and Washington D.C. followed. He was a keen motorcyclist and a member of the **Heidelberg H3**, where he clocked up 460 runs, which was a hundred more than anybody else at the time.

Doctor Gonads

Daniel Salchow

New Haven H3 (USA)

Daniel Dr. Gonads Salchow, a distinguished ophthalmologist, was already a veteran hasher when he took a job in New Heaven, Connecticut. Soon after he arrived Dr. Gonads set off to lay a hash trail with the help of his sister Dorothee, who was visiting from Hamburg. Having laid the trail they noticed officials in hazmat suits inspecting the flour laid across the car park of the local IKEA store. Daniel tried to defuse the situation, explaining it was just flour and offering to sweep it up. Although it was quickly obvious that there was no public danger, officials stubbornly pursued the matter. Both City and State prepared to file charges and City Police tried to claim \$4,100 in costs. *'They acted irresponsibly in doing something they knew could have instilled fear'*, defended the Mayor's office. The case dragged on for some time before a settlement was reached.

Dr Diddle

David Checker

Edmonton H3 (Canada)

David was drinking in The Fort Saint George pub in England when he met the newly formed **Cambridge H3** who were out on a social evening. The next morning (despite a serious hangover) he pedalled about 10 miles to take part in their 4th hash. He was instantly hooked and became a **Cambridge H3** regular. He then moved to Edmonton (Canada) where there was no hash at the time. In 1988 he returned

City "Hashes" A Settlement On IKEA Terror Scare

Two members of an offbeat running club whose flour trail set off a terror scare at IKEA will likely not have to pay restitution, according to a deal reached with the city.

After originally seeking thousands of dollars in restitution for the cost incurred by a dramatic hazmat scene in the IKEA parking lot on Aug. 23, the city Friday agreed that community service, not monetary payback, would be a more appropriate punishment for the runners.

Daniel Salchow, a local ophthalmologist and Dorothee

to Cambridge, *'I think I was just over 100 runs there'*. By the time he returned to Canada, **Edmonton H3** had been founded and he joined them on their fifth run on October 7, 1991. He has now run over 1000 runs with them and has mis-managed each of the several other Edmonton kennels.

Manneke Piss/ Austin H3 (Belgium/USA)

When she was an American living in Brussels she often drank with the hash crowd but didn't think the runs would be for her. After moving to Austin she meet an old Brussels friend and - now having fewer drinking buddies - agreed to hash. To her surprise she loved it and became a hash regular around 1999. A good amateur opera singer, she was given the name *Penis Pavarotti*. Dr. PP. returned to Brussels via a few hashes in southern England and became a regular on the **Manneke Piss H3** where she was GM in 2002. She met her future husband *Big Bore* on a Brussels hash although they did not get together until meeting up again at Port Vuelta Inter-Americas. Dr. PP followed him back to Atlanta, where she was on the Savannah Inter-Americas hash committee.

Dog F*cker

Bunji Asakura

Samurai H3 (Japan)

A retired graphics designer who started hashing in

1989 and completed over 1500 hash trails. A former ultra marathoner, he still teaches martial arts, which is good going for a eighty-year-old. He has hashed with many other hash clubs in the region, as well as participating in major international hash events throughout Asia.

Doggy Dave

Dave Runciman

Angeles City (Philippines)

Doggy Dave was an Australian who started hashing with **Angeles City** but supported all hash clubs in the Philippines. In 2014 Doggy was murdered during a break in of his house. *'He was a friend to all and his voice will be missed'*. On On

Doggy Style

Nicole Garbarini

Cambridge H3 (England)

A former **Frankfurt** and **DRIFTER** hasher. *'I started in 1999 and became Joint Master and Hareraiser for Frankfurt from 2002-2005.'* She helped found the **Saturday Summer Hash** and then spent four years running with **Cambridge H3** where she was Grand Mattress in 2015 and Hair Raiser in 2014. In 2015 she organized IndoNostalgia No. 48 in Malta/Goza. Is currently living in the DC area where she hashes with **Mt Vernon** and the **DC Red Tent Ladies**. Is On Sec of Mt. Vernon H3 and claims a 2000 hash life-time total having hashed in close to 60 countries.

Dogshit

Sean Moore

Dhaka Mixed Hash

After a career in college and professional baseball, Sean moved into education and now works as an Athletics Director and PE teacher in Dhaka. He has ten years of hashing under his belt and is Hash Cash, Stats and occasional RA for the **Dhaka Mixed Hash**. He is married to the long term GM *Principal's Bitch* and coaches the national baseball team.

Dogs Bollax

Alan Biddulph

Mijas H3 (Spain)

Dogs Bollax started his hash career in 1990-1992, with the **Guadiaro Family Hash** based around Gibraltar. After around 75 runs he moved up to Malaga province where he founded **Mijas H3**. He currently has over 810 runs to his credit and is hoping to do a few more before retiring. He visited Mother Hash in 2005 and also completed a few hashes in Phuket. His day job is running Sierra MTB Mountain bike holidays.

Dog n'a Half

Michael Ogden

Michael discovered hashing in Hong Kong in May 1971, a day after his arrival there to work for Standard Chartered Bank. *'I was hooked, as it enabled me to visit parts of HK Island which very few living there ever got to see'*. In January 1973 he was transferred to Jakarta where hashing was still in its infancy. He was given the Hash name of *Hunter* and helped to found the **Bandung H3** (August 1974) and the **Surabaya Hash** (March 1975). His next assignment was to Qatar, *'where to my horror, I discovered there was no Hash'*. Michael and the late John Frith, who had been GM of the Bahrain Hash, got a Qatar hash started by June 1976. He managed 93 runs before returning to Hong Kong. Pressure of work led to 2 years without hashing, but in 1981, he was back in Indonesia, seconded to an Indonesian Bank in Bandung *'where I spent 18 months reliving the Bandung Hash experience'*. Then it was back to HK to head the Foreign Currency Deposit Unit for 5 years, where 12 hour working days left no time for hashing. By July 1988 he was in Kuala Belait in Brunei where he joined the **KB Mixed Hash** together with his dog, *Digger* who helped him earn the more salacious Hash name of *One and Half Dogs Fucking*. After 3 and a half years he moved to Mbabane in Swaziland where he joined the **HhoHho H3** and became known as *Dog n'a half*. (Perhaps the name was toned down because there were numerous children on that hash?) He retired

in 1995, (aged 49) and returned to the UK, initially hashing with the **Wessex, Dorset Hospitality, Haunch of Venison**, and annually with the **UK-Qatar Reunion**. There were also trips to InterHash in Cyprus, KL, Kuching, Jogjakarta, Belgium, Bali, and Fiji and a visit to Dubai for Intergulf.

Doig, H.M.

Mother Hash (Malaysia)

Doig was a pre-war Hasher who worked in the same accountancy firm as Cecil Lee. He was noted for being slightly older than the average Hasher at the time. Doig was killed in an air crash just before the start of the Second World War.

Don't Let Your Meat Loaf

Allison Stewart

Hindu Kush H3 (Afghanistan)

Allison *Don't Let Your Meat Loaf* Stewart was founder of the **Hindu Kush H3** in 2007.

Doofus White Boy

Patrick Foran

Various hashes (USA)

In 1982 *Doofus White Boy*, at the time a coast guard, was sent to Bahrain *'to straighten out the US Navy'*. He hashed a few times with **Bahrain H3** and the **Bahrain Black Hash** before returning to the USA, but at the time rugby remained his first love. Around 1992 he gave up rugby and moved to Jacksonville, Florida, where he joined the **Saturday Jax Hash**, which he describes as, *'small, inbred, and mismanaged. Their only accomplishment was the best naming of all time - Doofus White Boy.'* Doofus slowly took over the hash, *'finally purged the old GM by pissing her off so much she quit'*. His spell in charge is noted for the introduction of new technology such as email. A 2nd hash in Jax – the weekday **Jax Beach H3** (created by KFC, *Dickspicable*, *Butthare*, *Gepetto* and *Chin Deep*) brought an increase in hashing with packs of 50+ and 4 to 7 hash related events per week. Doofus then moved on, taking a new job in Gainesville, Florida which involved a fair bit of business travel. During 2001 he hashed in ten states which inspired a quest to hash in all 50 states, a project that took five years. *'The 50th state target was finally achieved on a warm Friday night with the Full Moon Hash in Hawaii'*. He continued to move around, from Gainesville to Miami (2009) to New Orleans (2012) and back to Gainesville (2016). In New Orleans he built the Boatbike for the New Orleans parades and this amazing contraption has been to numerous hash events. He is now a financial advisor with no plans to retire from work or hashing.

Doormat Fred Roissetter Turkish hashes

Following a career in the Royal Signals, Fred *Doormat* Roissetter went to work for Her Majesty's Diplomatic Service. This allowed him to hash with **Athens H3** and then with **Ankara H3**. His 2007 transfer to Istanbul brought the following message from his old kennel *'pleased to see our reject, Doormat, has been adopted by the Istanbul Hash. The transfer should help improve the average IQ of both kennels.'* Despite that warning, *Doormat* was GM elect within weeks of his arrival in Istanbul and quickly brought a military efficiency to the role. His hash handle came from the speed his son was conceived after *Doormat* returned from a spell of overseas duty, the hash believing that he and *Plonker* must have shagged on the doormat to achieve such rapid results. *Doormat* continues to hash and hopes to be at EuroHash in Prague. *Ed: Dear Plonker passed away some years ago. On On to a wonderful woman.*

Doraisamy, Joe Malaysian hashes

Joseph Doraisamy started hashing with **Johor Baru H3** in 1974. His hash CV includes being Chairman of the 1998 Kuala Lumpur InterHash and Chairman of the Hash Heritage Foundation for 2011-2012. He

is currently a founding trustee and member of the foundation's Board of Trustees.

Double Gee Bronwyn Gee Perth H3

A key figure in the early days of the **Perth Harriettes** with 200 hashes to her credit by 1985. She met her future husband on her very first hash.

Double-00-Dirk Guangzhou H3 (China)

One of the key runners on the young **Guangzhou** kennel where he was GM from 2011 to 2015. In 2016 he moved on, the hash trash noting: *'Double-00 looks to expand his geographical footprint across China in true German fashion. Hong Kong became too crowded, Shanghai became too trendy, and now Cantonese food has become too bland for our Dearly Departing Uber-hashmeister.'* Double-OO-Dirk and *'his spicy sidekick Angry Dragon'* then turned up in Hunan where he is listed as one of the hashers who re-founded the **Hunan H3**. Hunan records show him on 67 runs, with an incredible 55 harings!

Dowger Sue Swain

Harare H3//Nairobi H3 (Zimbabwe/Kenya)

A founder member of the **Nairobi H3**. In 1984, she moved to Harare with her husband Chris, where she formed **Harare H3**. *Ed: Does anybody know where Sue is now? On On Magazine would like to get in touch with her.*

Downtown Robert Mock USA/Rome (Italy)

Downtown was originally a hasher with **Great Falls H3**, Virginia. He worked for the US State department and was co-founder of **Rome H3**. He is now reported to be in retirement in Arizona.

Drainoil Bob Leonard Hong Kong & world hasher

A veteran of Hong Kong hashing who had a meteoric rise in the wild and zany world of Hong Kong Banking. His tendency to sing uninvited, and to recite the whole of Eskimo Nell from memory, have rightly made him a legend in his own lunchtime. He was on the original 1978 InterHash organising committee. From there Drainoil went on to run in every InterHash up to and including Chiang Mai 2006 where he was one of the Hares on 'The Old Farts Run', (this along with the four other remaining



survivors, *Chee Bye*, *Philthy Phil* and *The Wolf*). His pride in being one of the 'InterHash survivors' even stretched to getting his son to change his wedding date! Can still be found hashing in both Malaysia and London.

Dreary

Doug Drury

Calgary H3 (Canada)

Number 1 on the **Calgary H3** run list with 1513 hashes.

Dribble Dick

Derek Dixon

Hong Kong

Dribble Dick was a Hong Kong Hash legend. He was on the very first Wanchai run and at last count had 842 runs and 36 harings to his credit. He is also a regular with **South Side H3** as well as playing a central role in the founding of the **Typhoon Hash**. He has held many Wanchai committee positions over the years including, AGM in 1989-90, Horn in 1991-92, RA in 1992-93, Hare Raiser in 1993-94 & 1995-96, Sage from 1996- 97 to 1998-99, On Sec in 2003-04 and Cash in 2011- 12. Dribble passed away on 15 October 2013 after a long and brave fight against cancer. *On On Dribble*

Dribbler

Max Maxwell

Berkshire H3

With wife Angie was founder of **Berkshire H3** in 1978. Continued to run regularly up until 2015.

Dubai

Alan Cooke

Phuket H3 (Thailand)

Alan grew up in London during the war and joined the Royal Engineers at the age of 17. He became a navy diver and after leaving the service built a career as an international construction diver. Work took him to Libya, Ghana, Cyprus, the Seychelles, Indonesia, the Bahamas and Dubai. Since 1965 he only worked in his native UK for six months (as a technical adviser to the Channel Tunnel marine works). Somewhere along the way he became a keen hasher and was GM of **Medan H3**. While in Kuwait he was due to set the hash that took place the day after the Iraq invasion but was unable to reach the venue. A few weeks later he led a convoy of fleeing civilians across the desert and into Saudi. He first came to Phuket for the construction of the Deep Water Port in 1986. *'There wasn't a lot for an expat to do, so I founded the Phuket Hash House Harriers.'* On retirement he moved back to Phuket, where he separated from his wife and went into business. He co-founded the British Business Association, and was well known for many charitable fundraising events, including establishing the first cricket ground on the island. In 2001 he became the British Honorary Consul for Phuket, covering the island's *'murder, mayhem and numerous sorry tales of Brits abroad'*. His excellent work was acknowledged with a MBE and he published his memoirs in February 2016.

Duffy

Ron Duffield

Hamersley H3 (Australia)

A founder member of **Hamersley H3** and present on their first hash. Sat on the committee as Hash Cash, followed by On-Sec and finally GM in 1982-83. In 1999 he completed 21 years of hashing and was edging towards his 1000th run.

Dukie, Dame

Wayne Alomes

Hobart H3

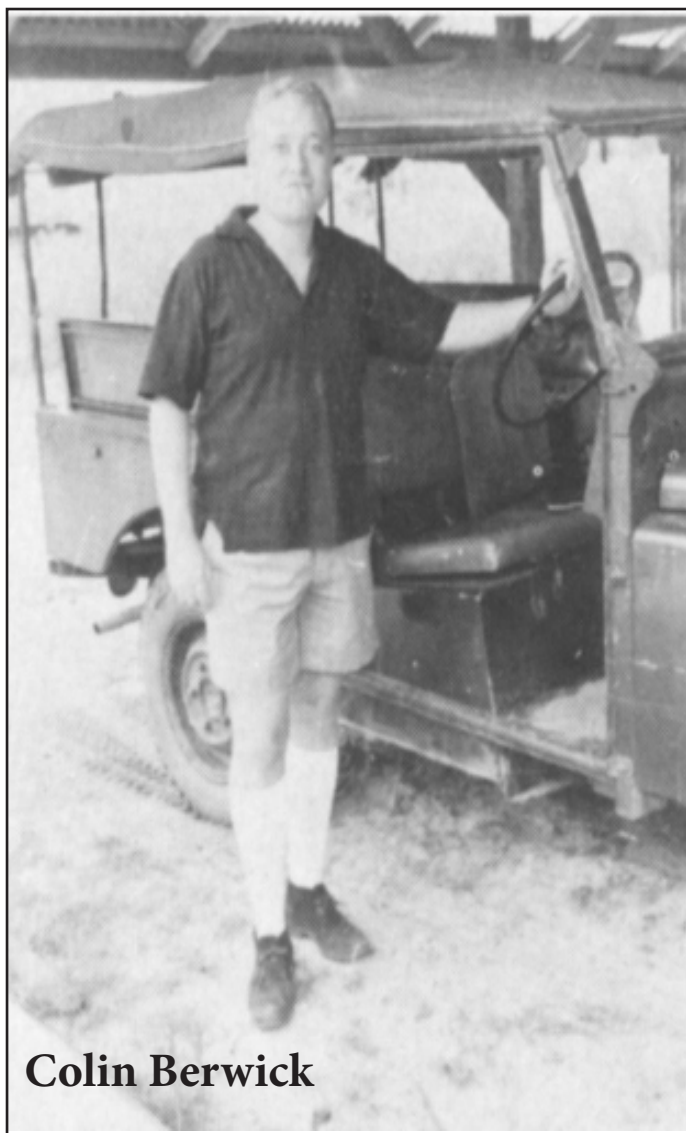
Wayne has completed 1135 runs with **Hobart H3** who made him a Dame in 2009. He was a Senior Finance Officer during his working career and was featured in local newspapers for his bravery in surviving serious surgery.

Dunafew

Pat Donague

Hong Kong/Japan

Dunafew was an Australian who first came to hash attention as GM of the **Hong Kong H4**. Their year-

book describes him as “big” “gaping” and “the most argumentative committee member that any committee has ever had.” He did not complete his year as GM, as he was transferred to Tokyo. On arriving in Japan he founded **Tokyo H3** (1976) and **Kobe H3** (1978). The Tokyo H3 100th run program gave an update, with Duna few noting he had returned to Oz, where he had run a few times with the local Hash on the **Gold Coast**. However, *‘the knees are not up to it now a days and a walk along the beach is about all I can cope with.’* The Tokyo Hash logo was drawn by tracing around the foot of his son.

Duncan, John **Mother Hash**

John Duncan is a hashing gentleman of the highest order and has three claims to hash fame.

- (1) He started hashing with **Mother Hash** in January 1961 and was still setting trails in 2004. This is the longest spell of non-stop hashing ever recorded.
- (2) It was John’s research through the Malaysian records that laid the foundation of our understanding of early hash history.
- (3) Duncan attended the first InterHash in Hong

Kong in 1978, where he agreed to bring the event to KL in 1980. This established the biannual nature of the event.

Durant, Charles **Mother Hash**

Joined Mother Hash some time after their first few runs. Otherwise little is known of him.

Dynamite **Charlie Chandran** **Mother Hash**

Charlie started hashing in 1992 and for the next decade ran regularly with six Malaysian kennels, although he will always be linked with **Mother Hash**. In his first year he became one of the founders of the Merdeka Run, and his energy and enthusiasm earned him the handle *Dynamite*. He became Mother Hash On-Sec in 1998, arguably the premier position in Hashdom, and even more so as this was the year Mother Hash hosted its second InterHash. *Dynamite* acted as Master of Ceremonies at the InterHash cabaret, a position he filled again in Goa. His CV also includes GM of the Full Moon Hash, serving on the committees of InterHash 98 and 2002, the 1st and 2nd Malaysian Nash Hashes and Mother Hash’s 3000th Celebration Run. He believed in the comradeship of hashing and was a great friend to many hashers in Singapore, organizing several joint celebrations. *Dynamite* was killed in a road accident in October 2002, soon after returning home from Goa InterHash. He was 46 at the time and was survived by 3 children ages 5-17. There is a memorial run in his honour each year. On on Dynamite!

Letter **E**

Eager, Her Highness **Sharon Willing** **Hobart H4 (Australia)**

Sharon *Eager* Willing has clocked up 1147 hashes, placing her 5th on the all-time **Hobart H3** table and the highest ranked woman. She was awarded the title *Highness* in January 2017. She was one of Tasmania’s best mountain racers, winning several competitive races.

Easy Rider **Alan Rider** **Hobart H3 (Australia)**

As a youth *Easy Rider* was a talented Aussie Rules football player and his conversion to Hashing was

unexpected and unpopular with the island's footy fans. He run with **Hobart H3** from 1967 completing 111 of their first 199 runs and acting as Joint Master. He was also one of the founders of the Mixed Hash in 1982. Alan played a major role in developing mass participation running events on Tasmania, founding the Point to Principle Race and being credited with introducing a half marathon and finisher medallions to the Hobart Marathon programme. He was part of the island's running administration and was a well-researched and colourful radio and newspaper commentator. He continued to hash for many years and eventually passed 1300 runs. Perhaps his most famous single act was rolling over the mini bus containing a large proportion of the Hobart InterHash committee. His retirement was marred by bouts of ill-health and he passed away in June 2019.

Eau Naturel started hashing in New Zealand in 1996. Since then her work as a teacher has enabled her to move around the world and she has hashed with **Calgary H3**, **West London H3** and the Netherlands.

Edgar Morris joined **Mother Hash** shortly after the first run. Little else is known about him.

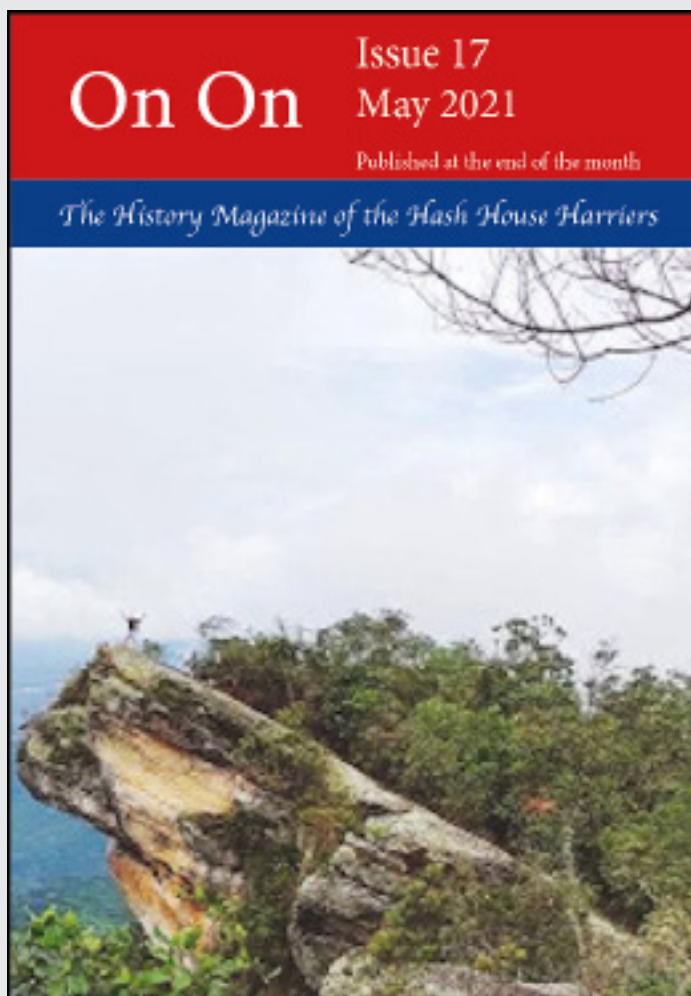
Edwards, Geoff

A trip to Kathmandu somehow ended up on Pattaya Beach where he stayed on (and on). He worked in various enterprises, including managing *The Wild Elephant Bar* and the *Tahitian Queen Bar*. He also discovered hashing, joining **Pattaya H3** on their 29th run and completing his 500th run on Payttaya's 684th run. He also clocked up 300 plus runs with the **Dirt Road H3**, which ranks him

Ethel the Aardvark, known by his mother as Andrew Osborn, arrived in Istanbul in 1992 on a six week contract, met a woman and stayed on. His contribution to the **Istanbul H3** includes two spells as GM and immeasurable down-downs.

EuroDong

Chris Bell

Madrid H3 (Spain)

A key figure on the Madrid hash during the 80s and early 90s when he was known as *Ding Dong* Bell. He was the driving force behind **Madrid H3** organising the EuroHash in 1993 and was thereafter known as *EuroDong*. Noted for setting long runs and was took numerous committee positions including RA, Master of Music and Dray. *'He was often seen trundling into the car park in a taxi, fully suited up, straight from work...'* Left for Brunei in 1995, where he lived for many years. Chris suffered a stroke and died in 2015. *On On EuroDong*.

Evans, Tony

Rotorua H3 (New Zealand)

Tony Evans was one of the Kiwi contingent with **Kota Kinabalu Hash** in the early '70s and went on to become a New Zealand Hash legend. He was responsible for putting house guest Brett Beastie in touch with John Kendrick, thus setting the **Wellington Hash** in motion. A little later, and after some procrastination, he himself founded **Rotorua H3**. Evans was the first New Zealand GM, a position he held from 1980-81.

Eve, Sir.

Adam Bridley

Hobart H3 (Australia)

Has clocked up 1600 runs with Hobart.

Ex Lax

Sherpa Ashland H3 (USA)

On March 31, 1991, which happened to be an Easter Sunday, Ex Lax collapsed on the hash and died. He was brought around by CPR and taken to hospital where he later had bypass surgery. He recovered, returned to hashing and has now completed 13 years of running since resurrection and so is *'the only Hasher I am aware who has died on a Hash and returned to Hash again'*. Eye-Full

Stockholm Underground H3 (Sweden)

Gunilla Piléus

An extremely charming, and very tall hasher (*Eye-Full* - Eiffel). She ran her first hash in Cyprus in 1990, *'having a good hangover from the night before'*. The next four years saw her travel around Asia, Oz and NZ as she *'became a true hasher'*. In 1994 she helped form the **Stockholm Underground H3** (this with *Floater*, *Sofa* and *Waiting For It*). Has clocked up 9 InterHashes, stopped counting her visits with other clubs *'when I got to 100'* and estimates to have just under 1000 runs with the Underground H3.
